Mule Day Calvary, Georgia

As the air is turning cool in Southwest Georgia, a small town on the crossroad of Georgia highways 111 and 179 comes bustling to life.

A handful of Lions Club members meet at the Lions Den to make ready for the Annual Mule Day festivities held each year on the first Saturday in November. The nearest motel was in Cairo, Georgia, eight or ten miles away. Most folks stayed in motor homes or campers on the grounds, and some arrived a whole week before Mule Day to get a good spot!

The doors of aged barns opened to reveal 'old timely' wagons, platforms, hitching gear and other necessary items to give the parade its originality.

The day began with a sunrise breakfast, done on the mulegrounds, with homemade biscuits and sausage cooked on wood stoves, the delicious smell permeating the air as cars, trucks and campers scurried to find their flea market sites. Local, state, and neighboring dignitaries were on hand to greet constituents, often numbering 30,000 to 40,000 by parade time. The local bands, dressed in uniforms of straw hats and overalls, stepped lively, but carefully, down the parade route.

Spectators wound their way back to the mulegrounds to partake of barbeque, fish fry, and short order items while they wandered among the various flea market craft booths. Many purchased cane juice to drink and syrup for home, freshly made by the mule driven cane grinder. Corn meal was also available, freshly stone ground on the site.

The museum of Dr. Maxwell holds pictures and items of original Calvary days. It is one of the original buildings moved to the Mulegrounds as a permanent home. Gospel groups and cloggers performed on platforms on the grounds, among them old friends Rex and Dot Akridge and The Capitol City Cloggers, Susan Boyd and The Rug Cutters, and Tootie Coker and The Clogging Express.

After the parade, the Mule Show began in an open arena surrounded by hay bales for seating. There were Mule 'beauty' classes for horse mule and mare mule on halter; riding pleasure and trail mule classes; one and two mule driving (hitch) classes with some wonderful old restored buggies and wagons; mule barrel racing and the plowing contest.

The plowing contest was hilarious - either the mule wouldn't cooperate or the young men who entered the contest were more accustomed to plowing with a John Deere. One elderly farmer in faded bib overalls seated next to me appeared to know about mules and plowing and kept up a running commentary that went, "Huh, Katie, Huh, Bess, Huh, Katie. You got to TALK to them mules, son!"

We moseyed on to the greased pig contest, and then made a wide berth around the tobacco-spitting area, especially since it was breezy, and we were down wind!

My one regret was that I missed the Mule auction. ('Course I'd have probably bought one and would have had to ride it home to Orlando!) I did find a neat, small pewter mule to add to my collection, and Sue and I came home loaded with home-canned pickles, peppers, jam, and cane syrup. I already have November 4, 1989 labeled 'Mule Day' on my calendar.

American's Clogging Hall of Fame (ACHF), a non-profit organization, was formed in 1984, and is heavily involved in the sanctioning of clogging competitions and the attendant Rules and Interpretations, Score Sheets, Judges, and Calendar. It is also devoted to honoring past and present leaders in the clogging community through annual inductions into the Hall of Fame and the forty-eight member All-American Team composed of current, top dancers from all over the country. They also award two college scholarships to outstanding high school seniors/cloggers every year.

ACHF's home base is The Stompin' Ground in Maggie Valley, North Carolina, and all Hall of Fame honorees' plaques adorn the walls of the lobby. A Spring Workshop and Fall Competition are held in The Stompin' Ground with the Fall Competition incorporating annual honors, the presentation of Hall of Famers, and the All-American Team. Members receive free admission to both. All first, second, and third place winners from ACHF sanctioned competitions are invited to compete at the Fall Competition with no registration fee.

The Ben Smathers Award, given to the highest scoring winner for male and female (over sixteen years old), will receive an invitation to dance on the Grand Old Opry (at Ben Smathers' discretion).

ACHF Rules for Competition and information regarding ACHF Sanctioning, Score Sheets, Judges, and Calendar are available from the Secretary.





A. D. I. D. A. C.

A.D.I.D.A.C. stands for 'All Day I Dream About Clogging!' - We are a 4-H clogging group with seventeen members ranging in age from eight to sixteen. The group started as a 4-H project for 4-H clubs in Orange County, Vermont. Last year A.D.I.D.A.C. became its own 4-H Clogging Club with members from Strafford, Sharon, South Royalton and Tunbridge.

There are nine senior members of the cloggers as a performance team, although the beginners group is also performing. The senior group has won the 4-H Stage Activity Championship for the last two years and has represented Vermont at the Eastern States Exposition in Massachusetts.

The cloggers have become well known throughout central Vermont with their lively clogging steps to traditional, bop, and original routines. Their colorful costumes of white and red check, which they designed, have become their trademark.

In May 1988, A.D.I.D.A.C. were hosts for a New England clogging workshop featuring Simone Nichols of South Carolina. Simone Nichols is their idol! Not being able to afford to travel to Ms. Nichols workshops, the kids organized their own workshop last May. Simone was a total hit! Groups came from New Hampshire, Canada, Vermont, Massachusetts and New York.

At one time, I worried that commercially-minded dudes, bent on a buck, would turn it into a robotic, disco gyration, but that possibility doesn't bother me anymore. 

Promenader Shoes Winder, Georgia

Editor: My insatiable curiosity about how things are made or why something is the way it is caused my car to make a quick left off Route 441 in Georgia when I saw a road sign saying Winder - 17 Miles. The little town of Winder, Georgia (pronounced wine-der), population 10,000, is the home of Jim White and Don Davis and their Promenader Shoe factory, D & W Shoes. We arrived unannounced at 8AM and Jim White graciously gave us the better part of a day for a really Grand Tour!





D & W Shoes is first and foremost a manufacturer of dance shoes. Jim White, while a business major student at Arkansas State, worked parttime for a shoe jobber. It was then that he met Don Davis, a master shoe craftsman. Jim said it all began when a lady brought a very worn pair of dance shoes to him to repair because she could not find replacements. He and Don couldn't repair them, but the seed of an idea about marketing dance footwear was planted. Their first sales efforts were at the National Square Dance Convention in Dallas, Texas in 1965 where Jim wryly relates, "We sold \$222.15 worth of shoes, and then the independent manufacturer would not produce them. We had to return the dancers money because we couldn't deliver." They partnered up and formed D & W Shoes, building the present 14,000 square foot factory in 1974. Jim and his wife are square dancers, and he is a former caller.

The tour of the plant begins and ends near the huge bay doors where all stock and raw materials are unloaded, and then ultimately shipped. The shoes follow a circular route through the plant, and when in full production, can produce 500 pairs a day. There are twenty-eight production employees, a five person office staff, and the plant runs forty-nine weeks a year.

Every pair of shoes in each size requires six cutting dies. This means that in order to have one style of ladies shoe in all the graduated sizes from 6 to 10½, they must have 60 dies for one style. The entire plant has recently completed computerization of stock and production control, and the optimum stock level is thirty-six pairs in every size of all styles.


The shoe du jour on our tour was a size 7, white, Ms. Stomper - our very own clogging shoe, though further down the production line, some red square dance shoes were being finished with a strap and a buckle. Jim began producing shoes for clogging in 1977 and the Mr. and Ms. Stompers in 1986.

The shoes begin as a pair when a two-side die cuts the reinforced insole strips into a right and a left insole. The shoes remain paired through their entire journey through the plant. There are eighteen pairs on a rolling rack which weighs about 100 pounds. Federal Trade Regulations require a non-leather shoe to be so marked, and these shoes carry an inner stamp stating "Leather upper and other parts man-made."




The white half of a cowhide is twenty-seven and three-fourths square feet. When cut, it will take 1.4 to 1.7 square feet to make one pair of shoes. Even the smaller scraps are used to cut tongues and straps.

Our THANKS to Jim White and Don Davis! They shared some news about future Promenader Shoe products that really sound exciting. If you have an individual shoe problem, write to them - they are big enough to supply all our shoe needs, but they will make time for personalized attention.






