tractions built along the banks of the beautiful San Antonio River. For \$2.00 you can take a barge ride downstream and admire the historic landmarks along the way. However, public barges were scarce and secret service frogmen were combing the river bottom early Wednesday morning prior to Her Majesty's appearance. Large dogs on leashes sniffed the air as they preceded stern faced men in dark

business suits along the sidewalks. An audience of tourists and locals began to fill the banks of the calmly flowing stream. Restaurant tables along the River Walk were immediately filled. Couples wheeled strollers along the smooth flagstones. Reporters were everywhere . . . interviewing, snapping photos. The performing groups were scattered along the banks at intervals and faint music could be heard both upstream and down as singers, dancers and bands intermittently entertained the swelling crowds. Our contact from the city staff constantly reminded passersby that they could not park themselves in our performance area.

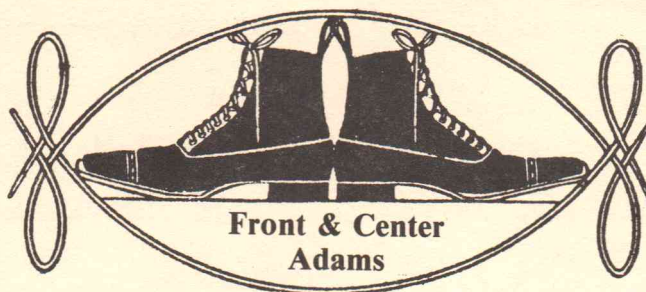

As an advertiser of clogging products or a promoter of workshops, conventions or competitions, everyone has experienced rising costs for goods, halls, trophies, printing, etc.

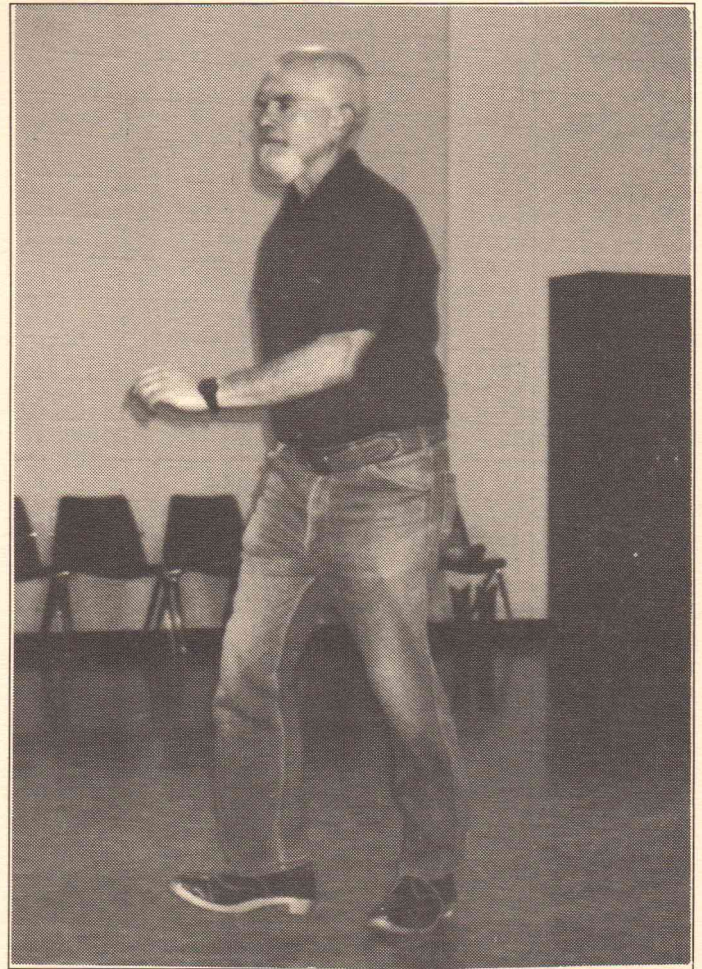

Cynthia K. Bowling is a clogger, a teacher, a scientist, a writer — and a fighter.

She's fighting for her life against cancer, but to watch her dance, you'd never realize it. And many people who know her believe clogging has helped her survive longer than her doctors expected.

"CK" (as her teammates call her) has been an integral part of the *Panther Creek Mountain Dancers* team based in Moultrie, Georgia; during the past year, she helped them become the highest-scoring NCHC open freestyle team in the country.

But several months ago, because of the pressures of her illness, she had to take a leave of absence from the team and was not able to dance with them at the NCHC national grand championships in Fontana.

Because, for the past 18 months, Cynthia Bowling has been fighting bone cancer, possibly the most frightening form of the disease.

Cynthia King was raised in rural west Georgia, in Mitchell County along the

Flint River, where her mother and a sister and brother-in-law still live.

(Note: in order to keep this story a surprise, it was written from information supplied by CK's family and friends.)

She earned a bachelors degree from Georgia Southwestern College and her masters degree in biology from Georgia Southern College.

Moving to Knoxville, Tennessee, she worked at the Oak Ridge laboratories, studied at the University of Tennessee, and was part of the team which went to Pennsylvania to investigate the Legionnaires Disease outbreak. Three years ago, she married Mel Bowling.

In Knoxville, CK first discovered clogging and danced with Ralph Pierce's group.

But it was also in Knoxville that she first learned she had cancer. After surgery, years passed without any sign of complications.

Then in December 1989, the disease reappeared in a form that is usually considered terminal. Instead of undergoing chemotherapy treatments, Cynthia travels to Houston for an experimental treatment program offered at several U.S. clinics. Her doctors in Georgia are monitoring her progress but are not sure what the outcome will be.

CK fights by keeping busy.

She teaches high school science and biology in Lee County north of Albany, Georgia, and is also in her third year as a science instructor with the summer "Discovery" program, an accelerated program for gifted students.

She's also reportedly writing an account of her experience fighting cancer - a book mixing humor, personal faith, and medical technology.

As a clogger, Cynthia danced in Albany before joining *Panther Creek* in early '90. She has performed with the team in competition and exhibitions throughout the Southeast, written routines (such as "Rock and Roll Angel") and taught at *Panther Creek* workshops. After working up a duet with teammate Bobby Goldfinger, the

two were featured in an *Albany Herald* newspaper article.

At a Cancer Society benefit in Albany, CK and *Panther Creek* joined other groups for an "Evening of Dance" program; the clogging reportedly was the hit of the evening.

Cynthia Bowling doesn't keep her illness a secret, but she doesn't make a big deal out of it either. She has given new meaning to the cliché "dancing through the pain" and has been an inspiration to her clogging teammates. They're all pulling for her and waiting to welcome her back.

Tasha Harris returned from the previous night to sing the Forrester's hit - *Men*. Caleb Warner belted out *Kawliga* and then led the audience in a sing-along version of *Y'all Come*. Amy Drake wowed the crowd with *Fancy* and *That Kind of Girl* while Rachel Rogers, a Tanya Tucker look-alike, performed *Highway Robbery* and *Strong Enough to Bend*. Newcomers Cheryl Arvin and Dennis Isaacs also sang crowd pleasers. Johnny Ann Samples rounded out the group with *Jones on the Jukebox* and *You Ain't Woman Enough to Take My Man*.

Condensed History of Clogging

Modern Clogging II
Diana Hatfield/Debra Austin 1981

In the early years of the eighteenth century, pioneers of English, German, and Scotch-Irish background began settling in the Appalachian Mountains. They were untouched by outside progress taking place in other parts of the country because of the mountainous isolation within which they lived. . . . Because of their isolated region, Appalachian music and dancing remained untouched by modern influence.

Even as their songs have been preserved, so have their dances. Today, this dance is known as clogging. This dance comes [to us] principally through two influences. Our ancestors brought steps with them that resembled the Irish Jig and Scottish Highland dancing. Appalachian pioneers adopted it early in their history, and they in turn added some dance steps from the Indians native to that part of the country. Back then folks called it flat-footin' or buck dancing. The word "clog" is an Irish word applied to the "slipstep" (reel tunes). It meant dancing to rhythm and time. "Clog" is originally the gaelic word for "time," which in this case means timedancing.

This type of clog dancing almost died out during World War I and World War II years. But with the growing interest in mountain heritage today, this dance is enjoying a great revival.

Clogging, in its early days, was a lot of foot stomping and hand clapping that bore no relative pattern of dance. It was a dance passed down from grandfather, to father, to son. But, today, after having been passed from friend to friend, it has evolved a whole new look. Today, clogging has been influenced by some modern dancing which lends to it a touch of modern tap.

. . . clogging . . . still evokes powerful hand-clapping emotions that make even onlookers want to join in. And it still speaks of Appalachian Mountain dancing when cloggers let out a scream or a yell that is characteristic of cloggers.

There are two separate types of clogging. One is square dance clogging and the other is freestyle clogging.

Square dance clogging involves couples who do lots of foot stomping and go through the motions of square dance patterns. Often, couples will break away, interrupting the square dance pattern tapping to their own style, then join back in the square. Square dance clogging is done in two different styles. One style is with freestyling where all members of the square or circle dance to their own tapping rhythm. The other style is where all members tap in precision, or exact with each other.

Freestyle clogging is another type of clogging which involves single dancers. There are no fancy dance patterns to be done with freestylers, only lots of fancy tapping rhythm.

Today, duet clogging is becoming popular. . . . Duet cloggers dance precision style clogging where both partners dance alike. Often, one of the partners break into a brief freestyle while the other takes the background, but then returns to the precision of their partner.

There are many different styles of clogging as a result of the different styles by which individuals learn clogging. However, they all have one thing in common - foot-stomping, hand-clapping, and loud-shoutin' fun!

Thirty minutes before arrival time, we began our show for those along the banks as well as those people across the river. Suzanne McAuliffe, staff reporter for the *San Antonio Light* newspaper, wrote: "The queen's barge, a regular river taxi, was decorated with roses, banners and topped with a red canopy. As it glided toward the Arneson River Theater mariachis, dancers and singers entertained along the way. Something different awaited the queen at each bend of the river. She seemed especially intrigued with the *Fire-on-the-Mountain Cloggers*, who clapped their heels on the patio of Cafe Ole restaurant, as she craned her neck to catch a long glimpse." As we danced and the barge floated by, Deb, Cindy and Mike (who was rapidly taking photos at the time) said indeed, Queen Elizabeth II had turned her royal head and "craned her neck" to see our rapidly flying feet. I hadn't believed them because I was too busy kicking up my heels and grinning my fool head off that we were performing for Her Majesty. But, I guess that reporters see the facts and pictures don't lie either. Ha! It was truly a once in a lifetime opportunity. What an honor to be invited to perform for the Queen of England!



The only other time we performed for "International Television" was when we performed for *El Sabado Sensacional* at the television studios in Caracas, Venezuela in 1986. But THIS time the British Broadcasting Network came to us (in a barge, no less) and had its huge camera lens focused unwaveringly on our feet, faces, etc. No doubt we'll be edited out, but it was great fun!

We understand that Queen Elizabeth got another taste of clogging when she visited Houston several days later and the *Rhythm Cloggers* performed.

Meet our instructor - KIM CARSON. Kim is 23 years old and is the Director/Instructor of the *Breezin' Easy Cloggers* and the *Lake County Cloggers*, both of Tavares, Florida. Kim became involved in clogging at the age of 13. She was very active in the Girl Scouts and was required to earn her dancing badge. To do so, she needed to complete a dance class - which, at that time, did not particularly appeal to her. However, she enrolled in a beginner clogging class under the instruction of Gloria and Lew McRae and was soon struck with "clogging fever" - even though she had two left feet at the time.

Throughout high school, she rode horses, showed in English horse shows, played in the High School Band, stayed active in church, and still found time for clogging. When she was a senior in high school, she wandered into a Thursday night class with the *Sunshine Cloggers* of Maitland, Florida, and there met Sue and Tom Toor, the instructors. They "pushed" Kim through her shyness and gave her the confidence to do something with her clogging. Kim later became involved with the *Passin' the Buck* competition team, and this was the real start of competition clogging fever. Kim will tell you that she owes a lot to Sue Toor who taught her "how to teach" by handing the mike to her one night at class and giving her a big push into the teaching world.

She started her own club - the *Breezin' Easy Cloggers* - in June 1987, and later began her all adult group - the *Lake County Cloggers*. She has a large exhibition team, she takes her dancers to competition, she dances with the *Buckin' Mules* Competition team, and she is a workshop instructor. Kim has written many routines over the past several years, all of which have been taught at various workshops or danced at various competitions.

Her greatest achievement in clogging was being named to the 1990 *All American Clogging Team*. Even though she had danced many competitions and won many trophies, that was the best trophy and personal gratification ever.

G.C.L.A. held their Spring Workshop, May 11, 1991, at the Agri-Center in Perry, Georgia.

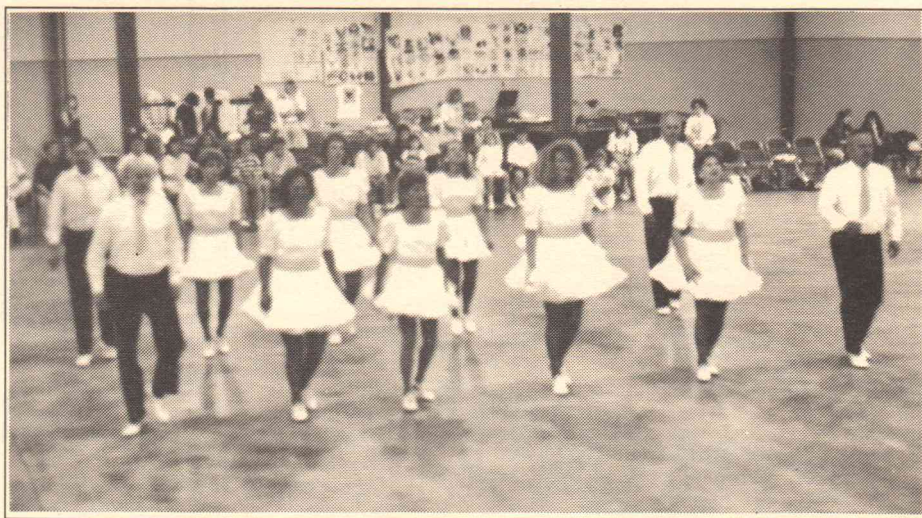
A variety of eighteen routines, taught by G.C.L.A. instructors, ranged from Bluegrass to Rock'n'Roll.

McCulloch's Conduct Clogging Workshop

During an evening performance at the Second Canadian National Square and Round Dance Convention in Ottawa in 1980, the audience was introduced to a dance form that has since changed many of their lives - clogging. The *Ontario Rhythm Cloggers'* demonstration was overwhelmingly exciting. The group's leaders were Dorothy and Jack McCulloch (pictured right) and Sylvia and Ron Hunka. They very effectively introduced clogging to the Canadian scene.



As a result of their performances and workshops at the 1980 and 1982 Conventions, clogging started in Edmonton in the fall of 1982. Now, nearly nine years later, the *Alberta Rhythm Cloggers* had the opportunity to meet Dorothy and Jack McCulloch. With the sponsorship of the Edmonton and District Square Dance Association and the *Alberta Rhythm Cloggers* of Edmonton, Dorothy and Jack conducted a workshop in Edmonton on February 9 - 10, 1991.

An excellent variety of dances at the Basic, Easy Intermediate, and Intermediate Levels were taught in the four sessions. Several of the routines were the McCulloch's own choreography, including their very successful "Hands Up". Their teaching style was an example of perfect team work as they took turns instructing, cueing and demonstrating. The Saturday evening dance included some mixers and couple routines which, along with a review of the day's dances, produced a fun-filled evening.
