

I'd like, one more time, to take the communter train in to Philadelphia, eat a thick, soft pretzel with mustard, meet under the Eagle at Wanamakers and lunch at Bookbinders on hot clam chowder or turtle soup with sherry. Or take the train from Trenton to New York and a cab to F.A.O. Swartz just to look at the exquisite toys from 'round the world. Many years ago Lionel Trains had an elaborate model railroad set-up, at their office in New York City, that drew young and old by the thousands each day. We are never too old to delight in the things of childhood, or to see each holiday through a youngsters eyes. My seven Florida-born grandchildren

On Christmas Eve, we all went out to dinner with Gramma and Grampa, and I remember Sue and Jackie sort of conspiratorially whispering with my Mom, but didn't give it much thought. I did think it odd that Sue and Jackie and John had to go

up to the barn to check on the animals when we got home, but I didn't go with them because I had to tuck a sleeping Katie into bed.

Early Christmas morning, I was puttering around the kitchen frying bacon and scrapple for a big breakfast and letting the kids sleep in. Sue and Jackie came whizzing through the kitchen, all dressed with barn-coats and boots on, mumbling something about getting chores done early before we opened presents. I had no more than poured a cup of coffee when the kids hollered for me to come out on the porch and there stood Onkey with a huge red bow around his neck! The plot unfolded! Sue and Jackie scraped their allowance together and borrowed some from Gramma and bought the donkey back. He had surrepticiously been delivered to our barn while we were out to dinner.





End of everyday life. Expectations and ideals that are crushed by the stressful reality of everyday life.

What's your stress index?

Answer "Yes" or "No" to whether or not these common indicators of stress apply to you. Then tally your answers to see how stressful your hobby really is.

1. Do you have little or no control over your club, how it's defined, and/or how you're supposed to fit in?

2. Are you often pushed too hard? (e.g., could you do better if you had more time?)

3. Is it hard to make decisions at class?

4. Has the quality of your dancing deteriorated (e.g., do you make excuses or tell lies to cover up poor performances?)

5. Are you unable to keep up with new routines or steps?

6. Has your group recently reorganized, merged with or been taken over by another Instructor, which you feel significantly threatens you?

7. Do you feel that your codancers are openly or covertly biased against new members?

8. Is it harder for you to go to class (e.g., do you often go to class late or take days off because you don't feel up to it)?

9. Do you find yourself losing your temper at class over things you know to be trivial?

10. Have you suddenly become accident-prone?

11. Are you experiencing physical symptoms that occur only, or are more pronounced, at class (e.g., dizziness, headaches, nervous stomach, back pain, or heart palpitations)?

SCORING:

3 or more "Yes" answers: You are experiencing some degree of stress. 5 or more "Yes" answers: You are experiencing enough stress to threaten your well-being. —G.W.



chore. Shin splints and fatigue. Former friends yelling "YOU messed up."

Suddenly you realize that you are behind with the housework or the homework. You overslept twice last week and were late to work or school and then fell asleep in a sales meeting or History class. Your grass is a foot high because the only days it did *not* rain you were out at Performances.

At this point you have a minimum of three choices:

1. Quit clogging and stay home and watch sitcoms.

2. Quit your job, hire a housekeeper - sleep all day, clog every night.

3. Re-think your priorities.

Burnout can be conquered! First admit you are under stress and then analyze the times you feel under pressure.

Oddly enough, we are hearing a lot about cloggers who feel they are experiencing *Burnout*. I claim this is 'odd' because clogging is usually begun as a *stress reliever* from school, job or home.

Most of us have a career (or school) and a family the equivalent of a pressure cooker seven days a week, year in year out. When we pick up our shoes and head out to the clogging hall one or two nights a week, we may be grumpy and tired when we arrive, but drop a needle on a lively piece of music, get the feet moving and the heart pumping and we forget all our cares. A welcome respite. Good exercise. New friends.

We learn all the basic steps and twenty or so routines, invest in a club outfit, begin performing with the group, attend a workshop, and then another workshop, pick up a little Buck steppin', learn another twenty or so routines and suddenly find we are "Advanced Dancers." Someone suggests entering a competition and we add considerably more hours of intense clogging practice to each week. It's beginning to be a

10 ways to control stress

Paul J. Rosch, M.D., president of The American Institute of Stress, offers these do-it-yourself tips:

1. Set realistic goals and priorities and identify those things you must do *first*. (You'll go to a performance on Saturday afternoon with a freer mind if your grass is mowed or your term paper is done.)

2. Organize your time in accordance with those priorities. (A calendar with good sized boxes around each day will help.)

3. Learn to say "No" when asked to do something stressful. (This will probably be one of the most difficult but most necessary parts of stress control. An excuse is not necessary - just say "No"!)

4. Recognize that some stress is unavoidable—it's part of life. (Learn

to recognize the difference between a "challenge" and "stress.")

5. Make a list of stressful situations in your life.


6. Divide the list into things you can't avoid or control and things you can hope to influence.

7. Use your time and talents effectively to address those stressful situations you can change.

8. Don't waste your energies in a frustrating attempt to conquer what you can't control.

9. Don't be afraid to ask questions, solicit suggestions, and share your problems with others. (You'll probably find that a lot of your clogging friends are in the same boat.)

10. Do allow yourself time out to enjoy personal interests or just to smell the roses. —G.W.

The championships were held October 26-27 at the Stompin' Grounds in Maggie Valley, North Carolina (the national headquarters for ACHF).

Only teams that placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in ACHF sanctioned competitions during the 1991 ACHF clogging year were eligible to compete at this years' Hall of Fame Grand Championships. Sanctioned categories were: Country Hoedown, Running Set, Open Precision, 4 Couple Precision, Smooth, Southern Appalachian, Line, Open Free Style, 8 Couple Precision, Exhibition and Show. Non-Sanctioned events included: Male and female solo, M/M Duo, F/F Duo, and M/F Duets. Once a year this event takes place and cloggers from all over the country gather to compete and be inducted into America's Clogging Hall of Fame.



Special Edition is an Atlanta, Georgia clogging show team, featuring sounds ranging from traditional bluegrass, to country, to rock and roll. *Special Edition* is Georgia's Stone Mountain Park's host clogging team, and the teams manager is Stone Mountain's clogging coordinator. As such, the team hosts the annual Springfest, Fantastic July 4th Celebration, and the annual Yellow Daisy Festival.

Clogging is a rhythmic, energetic dance, from the Appalachian Mountains, with its roots in the hills of Ireland. This genuine original American Dance form combines influences from Scottish and Irish jigs, and dances of the Afro-Americans and American Indians. Clogging consists of rhythmic dance steps, in time to the music, with names like Broken Ankle, Maggie, Pot-Hole Jump, and Windmill. Some of these names, like the steps they refer to, are traditional; others are of recent origin.

The two team members (husband and wife) responsible for the team's instruction, have numerous clogging honors to their credit, outside of *Special Edition*. Team members were voted "Entertainer of the Year" in 1986 at the McIntosh Opry, a showcase for southern talent, located in Peachtree City, Georgia. All the members of *Special Edition* have their hands (and feet) in the process of choreographing material. This is evident in the variety of steps and routines performed.

Enclosed you will find some photographs of the Hapeville Clogging Extravaganza for the Hapeville, Georgia Centennial celebration on August 24, 1991. Our group, *Special Edition*, was the host team, and we had quite a few other groups join us for a nice "day in the park". As you can see from the photos, we had all the age groups represented, from very young to the very young at heart.



For those dancers who are in the throes of potentially "burning out" there are some alternatives. First ask yourself why you got involved in clogging in the beginning. Exercise? New friends? The dance itself? If you are simply driven to continue the hectic

As all seniors do, we had a Follies Nite, with impersonations of Instructors, and a real treat for some of the Continued on Page 30







The Sportsmanship Award presented to the Pride of Carolina Cloggers directed by Mercy Martinez, and the Kountry Kickers directed by Mike Hale won the People's Choice Award. Bob Johnson, caller for the Flatland Travelers, won the best caller award.

The Ben Smathers Dance-Off consisted of all the grand champion soloists from all the ACHF sanctioned competitions. All the grand champions had to be 16 years of age to qualify. The best of the best danced off for the Ben Smathers Award. Heidi Baker won the female award and Shawn Johnson with the Flatland Cloggers won the male award.

Judges for this years American Clogging Hall of Fame Championships were: Ruth Reynolds - Chandler, South Carolina; Martha Revis - Waynesville, North Carolina; Judy Gordon - Ocala, Florida; Renee Givens - Williston, South Carolina; Paul Vaught - Hayesville, North Carolina; Earl Powell - Horseshoe, North Carolina; Lib Mills - Clemson, South Carolina; Aldon Hall, Jr. - Brevard, North Carolina; and Bob Phillips - Canton, North Carolina.

A big circle mountain dance was performed by the 1991 All-American Team. Garland Steele, President of the National Clogging and Hoedown Council, was the caller/patter singer. Fifty dancers from 25 different teams hit the floor, and showed off their skills to the many mountain figures called by Garland. Garland ended the dance with the traditional King and Queens Highway.

Nominations for the All-American Team were submitted by ACHF members during the competition year. Judy Baker, All-American Committee Chairperson, along with two other committee members received the nominations. This committee evaluated and watched the nominees at the various ACHF functions and sponsored competitions during the year. Nominees were evaluated on their leadership, clogging skills, enthusiasm and team spirit.

Nominations for induction into the Hall of Fame were submitted to Nancy Aycock, Chairperson for the Hall of Fame Inductees. ACHF members nominated individuals from across the country and submitted their names and biographies for evaluation. Those taken into consideration for nomination as an inductee into America's Clogging Hall of Fame must have been in clogging for at least 25 years.

The following three individuals were inducted into America's Clogging Hall of Fame:

Ralph Case is nearly a legend in his own time. He and his wife and his six sons have been instrumental in the growth and promotion of country music, square dancing and clogging in the Washington, D.C. area for nearly 45 years. His Ralph Case Dancers have entertained and delighted audiences all over the world.


Ralph was born near Candler, North Carolina and began square dancing and calling as a teenager. He gathered 16 dancers and formed the Enka Square Dance Team, traveling widely promoting and demonstrating Appalachian dancing.

In 1941, Ralph Case moved to

Washington, D.C. to work for the Government. He began Calling and found so many folks eager to square dance that he soon was calling seven nights a week. He often supplied the band too, because at that time most callers did not have microphones or recordings. He quit Government work and became a full time Caller. "One Halloween I had 188 musicians playing at 18 different square dances," he said. One of Case's young cloggers was Roy Clark, of *Hee Haw* fame, who began dancing with the group when he was 10 or eleven.

Richard Jett is well known in Kentucky as "Mr. Hoedown Island." He is an outstanding Mountain Square Dance Caller and an accomplished Master of Ceremonies.

Richard was born of a farm family in Puncheon Creek, Kentucky, a town, by the way, that isn't even on a map. His earliest memories of hoedowns were in folks homes. They'd just move all the front room furniture out into the yard so they could have a dance, with a single fiddler for music.




Richard Jett

During the Korean Conflict in 1950, at the age of 17, Richard Jett joined the Army and was stationed at Ft. Belvoir, Virginia. This Army base is twelve miles from Washington, D.C. and Richard Jett became one of Ralph Case's demonstration team.

In 1963, the folks at Kentucky's Natural Bridge State Park in Slade, Kentucky, asked Richard to conduct square dance sessions during that summers tourist season, in the open-air pavillion known as Hoedown Island. After 24 years and more than 900 dances, Richard Jett has become known as Mr. Hoedown Island!

Buck Aycock passed away January 1, 1991 after an extended illness. He is survived by his wife Nancy James Aycock

Dancing through life after injuries

When Dave Roe walked into a booby trap in Vietnam in 1969, shrapnel ripped into his legs in 17 places. His chest was struck three times.

Doctors told him he never would walk again without aid.

But there were no crutches in view Thursday when Roe tapped out basic clogging steps for his young pupils at the Bridget McCarter Dance Academy in Gilbert.

The Glendale resident has had no use for the equipment during the 17 years he has taught clogging, square dancing, round dancing and country dancing, he said.

"I'm just stubborn," said Roe, 48. "So when you tell me I can't do something, I'll just show you."

His legs showed no weakness from the injuries as he beat out the rhythm of a two-step dance in white clogging shoes that have become gray from scuff marks.

Clogging is a high-energy form of tapdancing to bluegrass music. Cloggers wear leather shoes with metal taps.

"Step, close, step," he called out, as a group of nine preteen girls followed him from one side of the dance studio to the other.

Roe was an Army first lieutenant

when he was wounded in Vietnam and evacuated to a military hospital in Japan. He said from the moment doctors in the hospital told him his prognosis, he refused to accept it.

From Japan, he was sent to William Beaumont General Hospital in El Paso,

Texas, where he befriended a dietician who became his walking coach.

About eight months after the explosion Roe said he could walk without assistance.

"I guess I was too bullheaded," he said. "I never thought of never being able to walk."

He took medical retirement from the Army in 1975, and dancing caught his interest.

Since then, he's taught clogging to people of all ages, from New Mexico to Maryland. He prefers the high-energy folk dance because of "the individuality of it," he said.

When he's not teaching, Roe is competing.

Five times during the 1980s he won first place in the Hee-Haw International Clogging championships for his age division, 41 to 50, at Opryland USA in Nashville, Tennessee, he said.

His pupils garnered first-place trophies this year at Arizona and national competitions of the "I Love Dance" championships.

Although Roe said he still feels numbness and pain below the knees, his active lifestyle, which includes weightlifting, running and jogging, help keep the pain away.

But Roe said he doesn't let the pain get in the way of doing what he likes.

"He's amazed everyone," said Jim McCarter, co-owner of the studio where Roe teaches. "Some people would have just given up."



and two sons, Bruce and Jason.


Buck with his wife, Nancy owned and operated Cripple Creek Corner in Burgaw, North Carolina.



Several other numbers were performed, but the audience enjoyed the belly clogging culture shock the most. It was truly an East meets West showdown, and the winner was the audience.


It's always as much of a family reunion as a hoedown - the annual *Kountry Kloggers Hoedown* in Tifton, Georgia.




