# Build a better clogging tap... and the world will dance a path to your door!

This humble *Double Toe Times* office had a delightful visit from Wayne Newland, Director of the Oxon Hill Cloggers, Columbia, Maryland. Wayne and his wife were in Florida on a business trip, and brought scrapbooks and memorabilia of Wayne's nearly twenty year clogging career, which began in 1953. (More on that in a future issue.) Among the Opryland programs and White House Blue Room "performance" photos, was a box of taps.

the first "taps" were used, and by whom.

English "clogging" was [and is] done in stiff leather shoes with one-piece wooden soles. Originally the wooden soles were a cheap and practical method of insulation in wet coal mines. If you've ever heard someone simply walk across a hard floor surface in English clogs, you'll understand the unusual rhythmic sound they make, and perhaps why "clog dancing" evolved. Today's English clogs have additional leather toe and heel pieces nailed on with brads. It

is possible that the brads make a clicking sound.

I spoke with Marti Stevens of Stevens Worldwide, manufacturer of Buck Taps and Dale Isackson, manufacturer of Bell Taps.

Dale, (who is currently doing research on the proper display of the American flag) was intrigued by my tap questions and sent all of the following material.

In order to receive a patent on a new invention, a patent attorney does an extensive search of existing patents.

Congress enacted the first U.S. Patent laws in 1790. Design patents are granted for a period of

3½, 7 or 14 years at the option of the inventor.

There may be other taps marketed which weren't patented, and, indeed, there may be other taps patented.

The first two patents shown here were applied for by Emanuele Landi New York, N.Y. Filed November 14,

1933. Granted April 9, 1935. Tap Dancing Shoe.

My invention relates to improvements in dancing shoes of the type for use particularly in tap or clog dancing.

The principal object of my invention is to provide an inexpensive, durable means for incorporation in the sole of a dancing shoe and operative at will by contact with the floor to produce a snapping or similar sound or emphasizing the rhythm of the dance music and attracting the attention of the audience to selected steps in the dance.

Another object is to provide means for the purpose above set forth which is operated by pressure and by very slight effort on the part of the dancer.


To the accomplishment of the above and other objects presently appearing, a preferred embodiment of my invention has been illustrated in the accompanying drawing and will now be described in detail and defined in the claim appended hereto.



Pictured here is the cover of the box. The mid-1940's pin-up artwork is reminiscent of the "girlies" painted on the B-49 bombers in World War II.

Wayne indicated that this was the tap his group used until the tap became unavailable in the mid 1970's.

It occurred to me to question when

# FRONT & CENTER EDITORIAL

Dear Ms. Adams,

I am writing this letter in response to your editorial in April's issue of the magazine. Yes, "the time's they are a changin'!" and it's time people accepted it. I am sick of all the articles and complaints regarding the popularity of rock and roll music and the "encroachment" of jazz or hip hop steps with clogging. Clogging is no longer just a folk art. It is currently undergoing an evolution, of sorts. The modernization of this "beautiful, innocent dance from the Appalachians" is one of the reasons it has become so popular recently, and not just among young people.

Sure, the majority of teenagers today enjoy pop and rap music (a select few listen to acid rock, even fewer dance to it) but they are not entirely responsible for its increasing popularity at workshops. My clogging class is made up of both children and adults who, for the most part, equally disfavour "fiddle" music. As a result, I teach more dances to pop music. NOT just for the kids, but for everyone.

The modern music and wild choreography *does* help to keep the kids interested. I know I never would have taken up clogging if I had to wear a cowboy hat and dance in a circle. People should be happy kids are interested regardless of what music they dance to. They have fun and that is all that matters. Think of it this way; they could be trashing your car, gang fighting or doing drugs! Music and choreography doesn't seem so important now does it?

Everyone is entitled to their preference and I do not think they should be ostracized because of it. What is wrong with having different kinds of clogging? If people wish to learn "old-fashioned" clogging, let them attend classes which teach "old-fashioned" dances. Old-time clogging still exists. If all you traditionalists got out there and requested "big circle hoedowns" I'm sure you would see more of them. Make an effort! "The Bear went over the Mountain — Old Time Clogging Workshop" is a start.

No one is purposely setting out to destroy clogging. It is just changing like everything else in the world does. Lighten up and try to remember that clogging is *supposed* to be fun!

## A Clogger Captures State Pageant Crown

Susan Tigges, from Clinton, MS was crowned Miss Mississippi National Teenager in the Vicksburg pageant recently.

Susan Tigges, a junior at Clinton High School, will represent Mississippi in the national contest in Nashville, TN, August 9-15.

In addition to gifts and a \$1,000 savings bond, Tigges received \$21,000 in scholarships in the state level contest.

"I'm still shocked," Tigges said. "Winning

was unexpected. I felt privileged just to be in the top 15." Tigges, 16, competed against 71 girls from around the state in her age division. The scholastic pageant required competition in talent (clogging), interview and evening gown.

Contestants also performed a dance routine as a group, and did sign language to America The Beautiful.

To compete in the pageant, contestants must be recommended by their school guidance counselors and must furnish their grades and a list of activities and leadership roles to pageant officials.


For her talent on the state level, Tigges clogged to *Kamuela Breakdown*. At the national level, she plans to sing and clog.

Tigges, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Don Tigges, said this was her first pageant.

"It's not like anything I've ever done before," she said. She did, however, choreograph the routine for last year's talent winner, and has choreographed routines for contestants in other pageants.

"So I thought, why give that scholarship money to someone else, when I could win some," the teen said. And of course, she wanted the experience of having competed in a pageant herself, so she could better choreograph for other contestants.

The next few months will be busy for Tigges as she prepares for the national level of the contest. She has had her picture made with Governor Kirk Fordice.



# Build A Better Clogging Tap Continued from Page 1

Mr. Landi's second patent, filed March 26, 1934, granted November 3, 1936 is titled **Jingle Dancing Shoe**.

This invention relates to dancing shoes and more particularly to such



shoes which may be made by the dancer to give a jingling sound.

In 1938, Salvatore Capezio, East Patterson, New Jersey filed a patent for Side Tap and Tap Assembly for Dancers. The patent was granted six months later.

The primary object of the present invention resides in the provision of side taps which will facilitate the production of extra taps or clicks with the side of the toe or heel, all without reducing the flexibility, light-weight, and fast action of the shoe. A more particularized object is to make the tap assembly of multiple parts, the side taps preferably being separate members which are relatively adjustable so that they may be moved snugly against the side of the shoe, while using only a reasonable number sizes for the bottom tap. Further objects of the invention are to make the side taps inexpensive and light in weight, and with this object in view, I prefer to stamp the same out of sheet metal. The tap surface is convex to give the same the desired thickness and rigidity and to permit a snug fit against the side of the shoe. The side tap is preferably secured in place by means of an attaching flange extending sidewardly therefrom beneath the shoe, and an additional advantage of the

sheet metal construction is that the flange is thin and is thereby adapted to be received between the bottom tap and

the shoe.

August 12, 1936 Albert Sothen, Chicago, Illinois, applied for his patent simply titled **Dancing Tap.** The patent was granted a year later.

It is one of the main objects and purposes of my invention, in its various forms, to provide an improved dancing tap comprising a specially arranged sound chamber con-

taining means for creating a positive and sirene metalic or ringing sound, and further to provide special ports or channel means for omitting a clear and strong metallic sound directly outwardly of and beyond the confines of the shoe bottom.

Another object of this invention is to provide tap devices adapted for use for a variety of purposes, whereby to produce jingling, tapping, turning and spinning effects.

Finally we come to the tap that started this search. F. J. DuMont et al, **Dancing Tap.** The patent was filed in 1947 and granted in 1948. Both toe and

heel taps were two-part affairs. The base was nailed to the shoe and an ingenious plate with an insertable flange slid into

> the plate on one end. The other end had a spring-loaded pin which with a finger nail could be depressed, slid into place and the pin locked the plate.

I spoke with Mr. Teener, long-time owner of Teeners Theatrical Supplies in Minneapolis, Minnesota. He said he had "tuned" many pairs of these Twin Tone Taps. Mr. Teener learned to clog from "the purple lady" Ida Seibel!

The dancing tap described above is characterized by the feature that all screws for attaching the tap to the dancing pump are concealed or held out of contact with the floor or other dancing surface, thereby avoiding marring said surface by the screws becoming loose and projecting beyond the outer





stances that allow a fuller involvement. Everyone, however, should feel he has a voice and the opportunity to help create success.

A second point brought out by Jeff was that — and I quote — "When you stop to think about all the politics, gossip and power-brokering that go on in the clogging world, it sure does take the fun out of it — doesn't it?" In my opinion, he's right. It's a hobby (unless you're an instructor making a living from it, and few, if any, in New England are). It should be enjoyed as one. If you want to consider what really matters, turn to family issues, the environment or the homeless. Clogging gossip should take a back seat to these topics every time.

So, how do we remain upbeat and lighthearted in the face of these heavy concerns? We could follow the example of instructors such as Jeff Driggs and make learning (and dancing) fun. From personal experience, I found he uses humor which is often self-directed, patience, and genuine praise for all his students.

Sandi Rentala and I had the opportunity to enjoy one of his seminars at the Nationals. Those of us who wished got the chance to join in as "guinea pigs" for a lesson in spicing up line dancing. We were given the freedom to make mistakes, have a lot of nervous giggles and take a couple of trial runthroughs. We laughed at ourselves and *learned*. It was fun and it left us wanting more.

That's what I feel the keys to good leadership are: helping people enjoy accomplishment and leaving them feeling they want more.

We are fortunate that there are many cloggers in our area who choose to utilize these factors in their leadership roles. Let's continue to build a happier clogging community and leave the "Dark Side" behind.





# New England Hoedown and Competition

Four to five inches of snow was not enough to keep the hale and hearty from being a part of New England history, as the Hickory Flat Express hosted its first workshop and held the region's first-ever sanctioned competition on April 11th, in Westbrook, Maine.

The workshop itself was unique to the region as it featured the Appalachian Style, something totally foreign to folks this far North. With Bob Johnson at the helm, participants from as far away as Rochester, New York and Nova Scotia. Canada were put through the paces of all-hand ring and eight-hand ring formations, King's and Queen's highways, and free-style footwork. Many had come with all sorts of apprehension; they had occasionally seen and admired this style, but felt totally overwhelmed at the thought of attempting it. But no one went away disappointed: they found that everyone has a bit of Appalachia in them.

The evening's competition — sponsored by America's Clogging Hall of Fame — was limited to solos and team line dances as the hoedown categories are totally absent up here. But that did not lessen the enthusiasm as dancers from Virginia, Maine, Massachusetts, Vermont and New Hampshire shared their talents in vieing for top honors in this fledgling event.

Probably the most exciting thing about the competition occurred when two entire solo age groups — twenty-seven dancers total — had to be recalled three times each before first, second and third place could be decided! This proved the axiom that competition raises the level of performance of dancers, and also spoke well for the level of clogging in the region.

Plans for next year's event are already underway and hopefully will include smooth set, four couple and eight couple sets. For this to happen, we will need support from the Southern teams to show these Yankees the fun, the style and the camaraderie of old-timey dancing. The call is out to our clogging brothers and sisters South of the Mason-Dixon line: help us make this style a

familiar sight up North as there is a lot of interest.

As a sidelight to this event, Dan, Di, and the Express hope to promote this style of clogging by teaching Appalachian workshops. Anyone interested need only give a call — we'll come "a running."



surface of the base member. Further, the dancer is thus saved from embarrassment by having the screws become loosened and permitting the tap to become disengaged from the pump."

There are many cloggers today who do not wear taps, preferring a softer leather-shoe sound which does not overpower the musicians. It is interesting to note that Mr. Landi's patent application in 1933 specifically stated the Tap Dancing Shoe was for tap or clog dancing.

My thanks to Dale Isackson for his prompt and extensive contributions to this bit of clogging history.



Step by step the group has grown and becomes better and better. We perform square dances in old time style at so-called "country balls" for public with live music of country-music bands or with play-back from the tape, we teach these people very easy dances in old time.

In 1987 we first time saw clogging on video tapes by our friends, Mr. and Mrs. Smolik. The wrought in America some year and they chancely saw some clogging group and turn it. We were enthusiastic of this dance but we can't understand what these peoples do so quickly with foots!

In spring 1988 we tried some square dance figures for the first time. Without success again. In summer we were lucky. Ten couples travelled to the West. # Clogging in the Heart of Europe

By Carolyn Stevens, Mercer, Pennsylvania

Visiting recently in the home of Jiri (pronounced Jirry, with rolling r's) Musialek, we were watching videos of clogging and live Western bands. I felt that I must be seeing scenes from the Grand Ole Opry in Nashville. But we were in Prague, Czechoslovakia, a city of castles, cobble-stone streets, and a skyline panorama filled with historic church spires. And the cloggers we were watching were from the Czech group Caramella.

Caramella does clogging show numbers, as well as traditional Country Western and square dances. The calls are in Czech language with English interspersed. Routines vary from traditional Appalachian dances in couples, to

line dances, to "rise and shine" numbers featuring individuals in the group. Their costumes reflect a wide variety of themes from folksy gingham granny dresses, to fringed cowboy and cowgirl outfits, to short, red satin dresses worn by the women for a "saloon ladies" routine incorporating French can-can music with country mu-

sic. Fellow Czechs respond to these performances with avid applause and encore demands, and they have many questions to ask about this new dance style.

Recently, Caramella won the Prague Dance Open (a competition open to performers of all dance types) with a clogging routine. They will be competing in the All-Czechoslovakia Dance Open within the next month — Good Luck!

How did this group of 25 accomplish this convincing level of clogging showmanship in an almost total vacuum of clogging peers? The story I uncovered is one of a love of country music and dance form and incredible resourcefulness on the part of these Czech dancers.

Czechoslovakia is a culture permeated with a sophisticated appreciation of music and dance in all forms, and one in which virtually all young people take classical dance lessons and attend regular dance balls. In this environment another Jiri, Jiri Vasak (the name Jiri, a nickname for Jirka, is equivalent to George in English), conceived the idea of forming a country dance group after seeing the movie A Coal Miner's Daughter. He and a group of his friends formed the group Caramella eight years ago. They chose the name Caramella because it is the name of a popular sweet candy in Czechoslovakia, and the girls in the club are sweet.

Jiri (Vasak) looked westward to Germany for music and dance instruction. He learned American style square dancing and imported it into Czechoslovakia, becoming the first square dance caller

in his country. In 1987, the group saw videos of a clogging performance filmed by friends of theirs visiting the States. They watched this new dance form enthusiastically but could not understand the quick footwork. They travelled to see the Country Cloggers of Munich and received some records and cue sheets from Monika Zoller of



that city.

Caramella decided to focus on clogging. But this was not easy in an environment with few clogging contacts and a communist government not at all enthusiastic about this "American activity." In fact, they were only permitted to perform publicly by identifying it as just one folk dance among folk dances of many nationalities.

An indication of just how unknown and foreign clogging was, is seen in a funny incident that happened when some Russians from Moscow visited Prague. At a *Caramella* performance, these visitors marvelled at seeing such a dance in a communist block nation. They felt they must have taken a wrong turn and ended up in the West. Afterwards, the Russian visitors wanted to

borrow the dancer's cowboy hats to have their pictures taken.

The group continued to learn clogging step by step as they caught glimpses of scenes from the opening ceremonies in Calgary and a film make at Disney World. The Good Time Cloggers performed in Czechoslovakia and Caramella dancers saw them. Through these bits and pieces they have achieved a dance level that has made country dancing, generally, and clogging, specifically, popular in that country. In fact, Czechoslovakia now has regular "country balls" with clogging performances and called Western dances about every three weeks. Country music and dance has really taken off.

What are Caramella's goals now that the communists were expelled from Czechoslovakia one year ago? They are

eager to have foreign exchanges with clogging groups interested in visiting Prague to see the city and share steps and fellowship. A second goal they have is to attend a large clogging convention and tour in the United States, perhaps as early as this year.

Jarka (Georgia in English) Vasak, Jiri's wife, is the female dance leader for the group. So now we have Jiri, Jiri, and Jarka (George, George, and Georgia) — and don't think that didn't get confusing at times! Jarka also handles planning and co-ordination of the club's many activities. Participation in the club is a major time commitment for club members, between twice-weekly practices, "country balls," shows and the many support activities (such as sewing their variety of costumes in an environment where Western supplies are short). Jarka is on top of these activities and

assists in the group's own choreography.

Jiri Vasak, who directs the group, is a physical education teacher and thereby has access to the hardwood floor gymnasium at the school for practices. The group called a special Sunday practice session at the school so that I could see the routine with which they won the Prague competition and some of the new material they are developing. The dedication to perfection of these cloggers is amazing!

After looking through the very complete scrapbooks kept by the club historian, watching the practice and viewing numerous performance videos, we moved onto one of the many wine bars for which Prague is famous to continue our discussions. While the wine is delicious, Czechoslovakia is actually more famous for its beers. The original Budweiser beer is brewed in that coun-

try. And there is a line from an old Czech folk song: Kde se pivo pije, tam se dobre zije. (Where people drink beer, life is good.)

Over a delicious plate of paprikaspiced Stroganoff, we shared clogging information and stories. Without Jiri Musialek's impeccable English, gathering the details for this article would have been next to impossible. He also travelled and studied widely and provided me with the background necessary to understand Czechoslovakian culture and politics in an international context. While containing a vast number of religious and secular cultural treasures, the country is just beginning to emerge economically from decades of communist rule. This makes access to Western goods prohibitively expensive for most Czechs, but the strong work ethic, intelligence and practicality of these people bode well for a strong economic recovery in the near future.

I really did not want to leave Prague, as anyone who has been there can understand. But I did leave with the feeling that *Caramella* will continue to popularize clogging there and delight audiences when they get to the States.






