Grandma said, "Her name is Patty Garner."


Patty said, "Ok, everybody, let's line




The following paragraph struck me as the perfect explanation of why I am so entranced by clogging and cloggers.



The Woman in the Glass


When you get what you want in your struggle for self And the world makes you queen for a day,


For those country western dancing enthusiasts, we had great fun with Kurt Wysel who taught us some line and circle dances.





She's in swing of things

76-year-old Gean Dentino's been teaching dance for 60 years.

PEKIN — Maybe it's because Gean Dentino has been teaching dance for 60 years that her weight is less than her age. The 76-year-old tips the scales at a mere 74 pounds.

And yes, Gean is spelled with a G. "My name is the Italian Gina on my birth certificate, but my teachers called me Gean. They never changed the first letter."


Dentino leads Body Recall exercise classes at Miller Senior Center three mornings a week. On Thursdays, she puts senior dance students through their paces.

"All right now, let's try the butterfly position. There are six weight changes, hitch and strut." The box-dancing students follow her lead. When their feet get tangled up, she smiles and says, "Maybe we'd better go through that one again."

When Dentino was a little girl living in on Peoria's South Side (where Village Green now stands), her mother enrolled her and her sister, Rose, in Violette Holly's dancing school.

"Rose joined the Dorothy Byton Dancers and toured in vaudeville. They went all over, even to the Palace in New York," Dentino said. "Vaudeville died when movies came in, and Rose opened dance studios in Peoria and Pekin in 1932. I taught with her."

The Bradley University graduate also taught physical education and dance in Peoria School District 150 for 39 years, retiring in 1981 at age 65. After retiring, she substituted at Pekin Community High School for two years.



At age 76, Gean Dentino is one of the area's oldest dancing teachers. Here, she puts senior line dancers through their paces at Miller Senior Center in Pekin. Dentino says when she isn't teaching, she's learning new methods at national workshops and exhibitions.

"When I'm not teaching dancing, I'm getting ready to teach," she said.

"When I started at Roosevelt Junior High School in 1942 in physical education, the principal encouraged me to go to summer school and work on a major in the field. The first one I attended was at the University of California at Berkeley. I enjoyed it so much that I haven't missed summer sessions and workshops in physical education and dance ever since."

She attended the National Physical Education convention in Indianapolis and a clogging convention in Nashville in April. She taught line dancing at the Illinois Physical Education convention in Arlington Heights last November.

Every year, Dentino teaches at a women's sports workshop in Minnesota and leads line dancing and clogging at the Rocky Mountain Round-Up in Colorado.

Dentino became involved in modern square dancing and clogging in 1978. She is a member of two square dance clubs and leads round and line dances locally. She is a member of River Valley Cloggers and clogged at Silver Dollar City's Mountain Fo'ks Music Festival from 1986 to 1988.

Her list of honors includes the Quarter Century Club Award from the Illinois Association for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance for 25 years of teaching; Pekin YWCA Sports Achievement Award and Illinois Governor's Leadership Award in the area of senior health/physical fitness.

Dentino was named a Senior Olympic Celebrity by the Central Illinois Regional Senior Olympic Committee and attained emeritus membership in the American Alliance for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance.

How are her legs holding up through all those years of dancing?

"My legs are fine, but every five weeks I go to the chiropodist so he can trim my calluses. There's a lot of pounding in dancing."







Supreme Court rejects expanded music royalties

WASHINGTON — The Supreme Court turned a deaf ear Monday to the music industry's pleas to get more money for the tunes you hear while shopping or watching cable TV.

The justices, without comment, rejected a pair of appeals by songwriters and music publishers seeking to expand their ability to collect royalties on their copyright.

In one case, the court let stand rulings that said retail stores don't violate federal copyright law by not paying to play radio broadcasts for the entertainment of customers.

In the other case, the court rejected arguments that said cable services and local cable operators should not get the same copyright-licensing breaks given for music played on radio and over-theair television.

A copyright owner generally has the exclusive right to perform the copyright work publicly. But exceptions exist for certain performances, including playing a radio broadcast of the work "on a single receiving apparatus of a kind commonly used in a private home."

Playing a radio broadcast can become a copyright infringement, however, if a direct fee is charged or if the broadcast is "further transmitted to the public."

Broadcast Music Inc., a performingrights organization that licenses the public performance of copyright musical compositions, sued two national retail chains over alleged copyright infringements.

One of the suits, filed in Chicago, alleged that Claire's Boutiques Inc. played BMI songs over loudspeakers in

most of its stores. The suit said Claire's Boutiques had not obtained BMI's permission and had not paid a licensing fee.

A second suit, filed in St. Louis, raised the same allegations against Edison Brothers Stores Inc. Based in St. Louis, Edison Brothers owns a chain of about 2,500 retail clothing and shoe stores doing business as Chandlers, Jeans West, Fashion Conspiracy, J. Riggins, Bakers, the Wild Pair and others.

Federal trial judges threw out the suits, and the dismissals were upheld by federal appeals courts.

The appeal over music played on cable television was filed by the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP), which also licenses public performances of the copyright music.

At issue was whether huge cable services such as Turner Broadcasting, the Disney Channel and MTV Networks and the thousands of local cable systems to which they supply programs must be given so-called blanket and per-program licenses to use copyright music.
