#### Jamboree by the Sea

1992 marked the tenth year for Jamboree By The Sea. The activities began on Friday night at the Myrtle Beach Boardwalk. We had performances by the several clogging teams, we taught the electric slide and slappin' leather and we played requests from 7:30 until 8:45; we were followed by a band that played until 9:30. Though it was cold, many people walked across the street to the Pavilion to take advantage of the rides and games.

The workshops began Saturday morning at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center. One great highlight of the workshop for me was teaching "Papa Loved Mama" with my dad, Mr. Bill Nichols. From noon until 12:30 Chip Futurell taught a mixer in the intermediate hall — he must have had between 200 & 300 people in the circle doing "Dance of the Ol' Swamp Rat." Later we took a BEACH BREAK until 7:00 pm when we returned to the convention center for the parade of teams,

exhibitions, awards, and fun dancing.

In honor of our tenth anniversary, Jamboree By The Sea paid tribute to Shirley Heyward and the O.D. Cloggers of North Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. Shirley was the founder of Jamboree By



Chip is now in graduate school and has turned the reins of the workshop over to the direction of Simone.

Shirley and the O.D. Cloggers, as our guests of honor, led the parade of teams and were the first of 26 teams to exhibition. The winners of the best banner contest were the Happy Feet Dancers from Anderson, SC under the direction of Ruth Brown. Their members range in age from 65 to 83. Millie Grontoft was the 83-year-old beauty who won the oldest dancer in exhibition award! The youngest clogger in exhibition was from Pinnacle, NC under the Direction of Monika Ward. She danced on Fanasia Express.



Silver Dollar City in June is H.O.T.! It's the kind of heat that makes you sweat while you're sitting still. Then add 15,000 to 17,000 bodies per day, and, well, it just gets hotter!

The K.K. Kickers from Lawton, Oklahoma, along with the CloggHoppers from Kansas City, Missouri, and the Touch of Class Cloggers from Billings, Missouri, had the honor of working a week in Silver Dollar City. Doing four 30-40 minute shows a day will really test your clogging legs, and your smiles. Each team would do their own show, take an hour break and come back and do it again. Since everything needed to be traditional, a lot of the old clog-que routines were done — Ida Red, Black Mountain Blues, etc. Along with hoedown and precision squares. Each team did their own version of freestyling and duet dancing, and The Kickers performed a hillbilly show routine. A lot of interest was generated in clogging judging from the number of questions and comments from the audience.

You never know who's watching your shows. A Japanese T.V. station was filming several shows along with many tourists from all over the U.S. who stopped by and stayed through several performances.

Beside our shows at Silver Dollar City, the Touch of Class Cloggers performed every night at Mutton Hollow, just down the road. The Kickers and the CloggHoppers received an unexpected treat by being asked to be part of the opening number of a live telecast for TBN (Trinity Broadcasting Network). The show is seen around the world and was done in the New Grand Palace Theatre. Although we had short notice, everything came off without a problem. We appeared with Glen Campbell and Jerry Clower, a real treat for us.

Besides all the hard work, a good time was had by all. New friendships were made and a lot of sharing was done. Isn't that what clogging is all about?

Being with cloggers in 1992 has not changed since I began clogging some 54 years ago as a youngster in Franklin, North Carolina. Only the date is different. However, I do not see very many dancers without taps of expensive costumes. (The costumes only make the ladies more beautiful.) Clogging is basically still the same...though in my earlier years a lot of us didn't have the money for taps that everyone uses today.

As a founder of America's Clogging Hall of Fame, I feel a great deal of humility walking into the hallowed halls of "The Stompin Ground" and seeing my name beside the true legends of clogging and those people who, year after year, preserved our great Southern Appalachian Heritage, with their annual folk festivals which we attended and competed in as young kids. These memories will last forever as well as such people as Hubert Hayes, Sam Queen, Bascom Lamar Lunsford, Richard Jett, George Arthur, The Bannerman Family and Ben Smathers.

America's Clogging Hall of Fame is now entering its 11th year. It was a dream I had that became a reality. When I see cloggers whom I have never met, wearing a jacket with All-American Clogging Team on it I get a little teary eyed knowing

A grand ole time?


Yee Hah! SIDE ROCK, SLAP BACK, A hot DRAG SLIDE!





Dear Bobbie: In our recent

phone conversation you asked me to send you an account of how my group got started, for the magazine.

I'm not much of

a writer, but I'll do the best I can.

In 1987 I just happened to be in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee while a clogging convention was taking place. I became very interest, due to the fact that I taught tap dancing in Baltimore from 1939 to 1945 before I was married and had to give it up to raise a family. I felt like clogging might be something I could do, since there is a similarity.

When I returned home from

Pigeon Forge, I located a clogging instructor, Simone Nichols, and began taking lessons. However, being the only older lady (I was 64 at the time), I felt very out of place, so after nearly one year of lessons, I contacted the Senior Citizens Program of Anderson County and spoke to the Diector about starting a clogging class for seniors over 55.

We had no idea that the class would be so successful, and after only seven months, we had a group good enough to perform at different functions where seniors were involved. Later we were performing at malls in the area. We became involved in the Senior Follies at

Anderson College, and danced at fairs and festivals all over the county on a regular basis. I presently have four classes with around 60 seniors, and a performing group of around 15—ages ranging from 65 to 83. We are also involved in tap dancing.

We find dancing to be the very best form of exercise and the most fun anyone can possibly have.



#### **Tap Dances**

By Anne Schley Duggan Teachers' College, Columbia University A.S. Barnes and Company, Incorporated New York — 1932



Now that "tap dancing" appears in curricula with "clogging," instructors are constantly asked to differentiate between the two. The author feels that no sharp line of demarcation can be drawn between them. Clog and tap dancing are both types of the same thing, having their common root in the so-called step dances of a still earlier age. Historians of the dance refer to tap, shuffle, and clog steps of the various countries. "All the Latin countries, no less than Scotland and Ireland, have their Jig. In Italy, as elsewhere, it is a combination of rapid clog and shuffle steps." In Ireland, the clog and shuffle type of dances were most highly elaborated. Mr. Thomas Hill, the famous Irish dancer, is quoted thus: "The thing of greatest importance in Irish dancing is the music of the shoes. In the eleven years that I have been dancing, the greater part of my attention has been spent on the development and control of the variety of tones that can be produced by taps of heels and soles on the floor and against each other."

The term "clogging" arose through the use of stiff, wooden shoes or "clogs" which were a characteristic accessory of the early Irish peasant costume. Clogs were introduced in this country by our early settlers for use in inclement weather. They appeared later in their professional capacity when Irishmen, who were among our first professional tap dancers, wore them for the execution of their tap rhythms. Among the first popular tap dances performed in this country was the *Lancashire Clog*, so called because of its origin and because of the wooden shoes worn for its execution.


With the evolution of modern popular music with faster and more syncopated tempo and rhythms, the evolution of modern tap dancing kept pace. Wooden shoes proved clumsy and precarious as steps became faster and more intricate; wood-fibre soles came to be used only to give way to softer, leather soles to which were attached aluminum toe tips or taps. Jinges and heel tips or taps are additional accessories of the modern tap dacing shoe.

If a differentiation between clogging and tap dancing is to be made in our educational institutions, the author feels that the term "clogging" should be applied to those dances of a simpler nature, a more even timing, and a decided folk quality, - dances in which the typical folk dance steps appear, and in which the emphasis is not primarily on the tap sounds themselves. Tap dancing, on the other hand, is a term applicable to a more professionalized and intricate type of dancing; emphasis is upon the variety of rhythms secured through rapid manipulation of the feet. There may or may not be a folk quality to the tap dance, but the time is usually

syncopated and a great many more tap sounds are achieved to each measure of music than those tapped out in the slower, more even rhythms of clogging. To say, however, *exactly* where tap dancing begins and clogging ends is a difficult matter and cannot be settled arbitrarily.

The first books of clogging built up a terminology for certain tap sounds which are not in consistent usage among professional teachers of tap dancing. Steps were called "2's," "3's," "5's," et cetera, according to the number of tap sounds made. Inasmuch as there is no standardization of terminology among the professional group itself, and inasmuch as tap dancing has entered educational circles after a background of clogging, the author feels that, at this time, it is wiser to use the terminology already established in the minds of students and teachers of clogging all over the country. The differences are distinctions in name only, and applicable to but a few of the steps. There is a need for standardization of terminology among the teachers of tap dancing, especially among those in educational institutions.

Editor: This book, published in 1932, contradicts the old-time Southerners who claim not to have heard the term "clogging" used for their dance until the late 30's and early 40's. Many folks still call it flatfooting or buckdancing.



#### Stack The Wood

A YELLOWROCK BY ANY OTHER NAME IS STILL A HUG!!!!

Webster — HUG — of Scandanavian origin:

akin to ON HUGGA to soothe. To press tightly especially in the arms; to hold fast; cherish; to stay close.

Someone recently asked why a hug was called a "Yellowrock"!! As Gomer Pyle says, "Golleeeeee"!!!! Never thought about it! Just as tissue is Kleenex, an automobile is a car, feverish becomes a cold — a HUG is a Yellowrock!

We put it to Danny Robinson, Square Dance Caller, and Editor of the Square Dance Bulletin.

Years ago a hug was called a "clatch" or "kwetch." In California it is known as "Stack the Wood." In the midwest, (Kansas or Arkansas Danny thought), a prominent caller opened a huge Square Dance Barn and called it The Yellowrock Barn. The hugs there became knwn as Yellowrocks — a catchy slang word that soon spread from club to club, state to state.

There has been much written recently on "Hugging." Someone sent Danny a book on the subject. A friendly hug just plain makes you feel good. Apparently the book states that 4 hugs a day are a *minimum* requirement for well being. All this time I thought it was only 3, which probably explains my irritability occasionally. #### Rhododendron Cloggers & Roan Mountain State Park Host Clogging Workshop for Rudy Ruritan Bear

May the nineth, 1992 was a special day for the Rhododendron Cloggers and their friend, Rudy Ruritan Bear. On this cool, mountain day, we hosted our first clogging workshop in Roan Mountain, Tennessee.

Roan Mountain, Tennessee and the State Park rest at an elevation of approximately 3,000 feet. Above the State Park lies what is fondly called the Highlands of the Roan. This 6,285-foot mountain and its surrounding ridges stretch for a distance of 14 miles through beautiful rolling grass balds, adorned with rare and unusual high elevation plant species. In late June, the Roan is famous for the Catawba Rhododendron, a crimson shrub, and has earned the reputation of being the largest natural garden in the United States.

On this particularly exciting day for Roan Mountain and its State Park sponsored clogging team, we were joined by three wonderful instructors — Chip Summey, Jeff Hill, and Tammy Igou. The workshop was offered free of charge so that we could sponsor the "Rudy Ruritan Teddy Bears for Children" program. In lieu of a regis-

tration fee, donations were accepted to buy teddy bears, which in turn are to be donated to the Tennessee Highway Patrol, District 5. Rudy Bear was developed by the Ruritan Club with a very special, caring purpose in mind. Rudy can be found in the vehicles of local police, Tennessee State Troopers, and emergency personnel. In any situation in which they encounter children, they will give the child a teddy bear to help ease their fears. Rudy Bear has proven to be a lifesaver in many ways; and the Rhododendron Cloggers along



Oklahoma clogging is growing rapidly and the O.K.A. is excited about future plans for clogging, and Oklahoma is a nice place to visit!





monetary scholarships. A handbook, directed toward the new clog dancer, is available to new class members of 60+ TCC-registered clubs.









The Carroll County Cloggers, based in beautiful — yes, you guessed it — Carroll County, Maryland, has become very well known in these parts over the years. We dance for fun — and that's exactly what everyone has lots of. All of our members, from beginners (once they've graduated from our classes) to advanced dancers, are encouraged to participate in demos. The club consists of all ages, from 9 to 76, from all walks of life, whose members come together with just one thing in mind — to have a GOOD TIME!

From our club's modest beginnings in 1979 we have just been growing (and clogging) by leaps and bounds! We started with about a dozen members way back then, but now our membership numbers 65 and is ever climbing, what with the classes we offer for beginners each year in October. By the time the class graduates the next spring, most dancers are "hooked on clogging" and join the club as full-fledged members. There have even been two "spin-off" clubs formed from the Carroll County Cloggers!

But this wonderful growth would not have happened without the fantastic, dedicated instructors we've been so fortunate to have. First there was Terry Goodling, who started the club and whose routine to *Uncle Pen* has become our club "anthem" — performed

faithfully at the closing of every performance. Fast-paced and lively, it's something our audiences never tire of. When Terry retired as our director in 1986, club member Brad Durrant stepped in to fill his shoes. Brad had been clogging with Carroll County Cloggers for four years by that time. Under his tireless leadership, our club progressed speedily along the path to greater recognition in our area. Always encouraging beginners and advanced dancers alike, leading us into the world of workshops, and stressing the most important requirement of all - to have fun - the club has evolved into a very well-received, much-sought-after entertainment group.

We perform a wide variety of demos in an expanding range of locations from community festivals, church functions, and club meetings to annual performances at the state fair and most recently an exhibition at the 1991 National Convention in Nashville. Our reputation for good, country-style entertainment has become such that requests for our performances now come from not only throughout Carroll County, but also from Baltimore County and City, Maryland'ss Eastern Shore area, mountainous Western Maryland, and more and more frequently, the southern Pennsylvania region.

Last year Brad made the difficult decision to give up his directorship of the Carroll County Cloggers in order to return to college and finish up his bachelors degree in physics, and then to pursue a masters degree in electrical engineering. There just wasn't enough time to do both, but Brad still remains an active member of the club. So in October 1991, the reins were handed over

to our current director, Rick Duvall. Rick has been clogging with our group for ten years, and now as our new director, has taken up those reins and charged full-speed ahead!

Before we knew what hit us, Rick was teaching a routine he'd written for *Get Rythmn* — to be performed as an exhibition at the National Convention in Nashville! That exhibition was a first for us — everyone was, to put in mildly, *really* nervous; but nevertheless they enthusiastically "hopped to it" when it was our turn to clog, and the performance, we felt, was one we could be proud of. There was a great feeling of exhilaration afterwards — and, at the same time, many sighs of relief that it was all behind us!

Having thrown himself wholeheartedly into his new role as director, Rick has taught the club several new routines, attended — in addition to the '91 National Convention — Spring Fling '92 with a number of club members, wrapped up his first beginner's class, and is now keeping busy with summer practice sessions that started in mid-June. Our regular Sunday afternoon practice sessions at Westminster High School terminate shortly before school ends, and after a brief break, resume two nights each week for the summer in a hall generously offered to us at Im-Church manuel Lutheran Manchester.

Who knows what the future holds for the Carroll County Cloggers, but with guys like Terry, Brad, and now Rick, ever forging new trails for us through the world of clogging, it's bound to be a bright and happy, tappy one!



sit around in groups and play for hours. There is a show on the outdoor stage for several hours (at the same time), featuring dancers, singers and musicians. This July 4th is really special as it is the Bicentennial anniversary of Buncombe County. My junior team "Appalachian Valley Cloggers" are so excited to be one of the two dance teams featured that night and have been selected to appear at the Mountain Folk Festival as well as in August.

Toward the end of July, dancers from 38 countries arrive for "Folkmoot," a glorious array of costumes and traditional dance. The 6th through the 8th of August brings the Mountain Folk Festival, created by Bascom Lamar Lunsford. The wealth of talent, both musicians and folk singers is not to be believed. Virtually all of these folks are self-taught and all of the material is handed down through the generations without benefit of a written record.

All of the towns surrounding Asheville, have their own festivals going, not to mention "Old Time Fiddle Contests" just about everywhere. There are week-long camps with instruction in Dobro, Banjo, Fiddle and dance as well. Anyone interested should check with the Asheville Chamber of Commerce. The good stuff is around but you have to know where to look. True, there are not as many of the young dancers involved as in the past decade, but this is beginning to turn around. I have a group of nine boys and nine girls "Mountain Dew Cloggers," all first graders, who are thrilled to do the traditional dance figures. They have not seen Rock - Clog, so their loyalty is still to their heritage. No matter what, all variations will survive in the long run.

#### Silver Creek Cloggers in Exhibition

They dance until they drop.

They're The Silver Creek Cloggers.

The cloggers with their instructor, Elizabeth Potts will be performing during exhibitions at the 17th annual Tennessee State Square and Round Dance Convention scheduled for Aug. 16-17 at the Nashville Convention Center.

Elizabeth will also serve as chairman of the clogging workshops to be held in conjunction with the two-day convention.

The Silver Creek Cloggers derived their name from Silver Creek located in the Fountain Creek area of Maury County.

Elizabeth began clogging in 1983. She began teaching clogging in 1985 when husband David promised his new square dance class that "my wife will teach you to clog." Her classes meet twice each week year-round and she currently has more than 100 cloggers enrolled in her classes ranging in age from 6 to 65.

"I've had some younger and some older," she said.

Elizabeth's favorite group of cloggers is each beginner class when it "dawns on them for the first time that they can really do this stuff," she said.

"Teenagers are more flexible dancers because they can get the speed and moves that older persons can't get," Elizabeth explained. "Our present need is for more young men and boys. Once they get into it, the young men really enjoy clogging."

Elizabeth works hard to provide a variety that appeals to all ages and levels. In her classes she uses ideas from other instructors as well as having her own theory.

"As long as people are paying me to teach them to dance, they'll get their money's worth," she added.

The clogging instructor keeps on top of the very latest methods and techniques by attending workshops both in Tennessee and Kentucky. Already this year, she has attended



three with two more on her agenda for this fall.

The Silver Creek Cloggers are not a competitive group but do exhibition dancing.

"Our group does not enter competitions. I want them to perform as a team. There are no solos — no stars," said Elizabeth. "When they get on the floor, they are all equal. I want everyone to feel like they belong to one group."

The Silver Creek Cloggers are the only group in the Middle Tennessee area who have been invited to perform for five

consecutive state conventions.

Elizabeth, who is the only female western square dance caller in Middle Tennessee, also does some Appalachian calling. She is a member of the Nashville Area Callers Association, the National Clogging and Hoedown Council, and the Clogging Leaders Organization.

Even though it takes a while to build up stamina, according to Elizabeth, clogging is good aerobic exercise and burns a lot of calories.

"One night of clogging would probably be equal to walking five miles,"

she added.

When asked if her family shared her enthusiasm for clogging and square dancing, Elizabeth replied, "They really don't have a lot of choice."

David is a square dance caller for the Duck River Squares and their two daughters have danced with both groups. Their three grandchildren are all potential dancers.

"Clogging is one of the cheapest forms of entertainment and exercise you can find," said Elizabeth. "I try not to use overly suggestive music and moves. It is very family oriented.

"Teaching is not the same as dancing. The dancers really work harder than I do," she added.

However, not a day passes that Elizabeth doesn't do something related to clogging — whether it's writing clogging routines or watching tapes for new techniques and routines.


