

The team had authentic costumes made for the performances as well, to represent the by-gone era of traditional barn dances with live musicians picking out a tune on the fiddle and banjo.


Clogging is Tapping Across North Idaho!




Thunderfoot Cloggers — Auburn, California

Time for a Clogging Quiz

What's the one thing no competition can exist without? Judges. What's their main occupational hazard? Deafness — from screaming fans as well as taps. Is it a money-making job? No, it's a service job.

"I should get a trophy for sitting through everything," a competition clogger's parent said recently. Maybe, but there are five other people who sat longer and worked just as hard. The ones who decided which dancers would go home with trophies.

As with many sports, clogging judges are usually the anonymous faces of competition. But they don't have to put up with the junk baseball umpires do (with a few exceptions).

And they don't make the same kind of money pro sports officials do. Clogging judges are lucky to break even on their expense money (if they get any), and most have real jobs. "We do it for the sake of the dance form," Susan Phillips said recently. Ray Hattaway added "It's the best seat in the house. Plus, you get to watch the kids grow up and see the progress they make."

For those folks who haven't been to competition, here's how the judging works at a sanctioned event. From five to seven judges are used. Every judge marks a score sheet for each team in each category. Judges start with a perfect score and subtract points or fractions of points. High and low scores are thrown out and the remaining scores are added up. A rules judge makes sure everybody follows the category rules, and can assess penalties if necessary. Timekeeping is done by members of the host team.

Basically, judges fall into two groups — nationally certified, and local (often well experienced) volunteers.


IT TAKES TRAINING

This story will concentrate on the first group. The main organization that certifies judges is the National Clogging and Hoedown Council. C.L.O.G. also has clinics for prospective judges.

Becoming a certified judge takes time and training. Here's how the NCHC program works. Once a year, the Council holds a two-day judges clinic. Trainees learn the rules for each competition category, the types of infractions to look for, and analyze video tapes of different teams. Usually, they have a chance to judge live teams as well.

They learn the three basics to watch for — rhythm, sound and variety. And they are reminded that no dancer or team is necessarily better than another. They then enter the apprenticeship program. A year later, they attend another clinic, then apprentice for another year.

Right now, Brandy Blaksley is an apprentice. She must find

events to work on her own and must pay all her own expenses. Though she marks score sheets for each competitor, her scores are not counted. But her sheets are filed and evaluated as part of her training.

FACES AND FEET

Most people can watch a competition routine and tell you whether they liked it. But few could tell you exactly what the dancers did right or wrong. A judge can tell you, even after the category is over, exactly when and how someone messed up.


Mine — an open pit copper mine where I found a tiny solid copper pack mule.



Queen Elizabeth visited the festival while Special Edition was there and they were excited to see her so closely.


Many friendships were formed during their Wales visit. The Irish were especially enjoyable, and invited the team to be a part of Ireland's International Music Festival in 1993.

They're willing to give advice. "After the trophies are handed out, parents often ask us why their kids didn't win," Hattaway noted. "I explain the criteria we use in judging, and make some positive suggestions. If there were too many dancers to remember, sometimes I get the child to do some steps to jog my memory."

A judge's vision gets to be selective. At a recent competition, one of the team dancers was pregnant. Something like seven months pregnant. "I didn't even notice," one of the judges said later. "I was too busy watching faces and feet." Knowing how to watch takes training and practice, hence the apprenticeship program.

"We watched a hoedown team on a training videotape three times before anyone noticed that one of the dancers had one whole arm in a cast," another judge recalled.

NO PROFIT, NO GLORY

Judges are not always paid for their efforts. Sometimes they do it for free, like charities or fund raisers. Other times they swap labor with judges from other clogging organizations.

Even when they do get expense money, they're pretty much at the mercy of the competition festival organizers, who set their own rates. Usually, judges get meals, mileage and a motel room. Some judges are on the road several weekends a month, all year long.


Active judges quickly come to appreciate the way certain organizers treat them. "The reality is that the better treatment we get, the more effective we can be, especially in an 18-hour competition day," one judge noted.

It's the little things that count — giving the judges stretch breaks during the day, a lunch break with decent food, a nice motel room. And keeping their water glasses filled. At a recent competition, kids from the host team checked the judges' table regularly. When her turn came, one young lady summoned up all her courage to approach the judges. "Can I get you anything?" she asked Kerry Thomas. "Six hot dogs," he replied. Seeing the look on her face, Kerry quickly assured her that he was only kidding.

A (TYPICAL?) JUDGING DAY

Up at 6, grab breakfast, and head for the festival hall for the director's meeting. At the table for the 8:30 start, with a quick introduction by the festival hosts. Endless repetitions of MC Hammer and "Everybody Dance Now." Listen to irate director whose team has been bumped up to next age group because he tried to get around the rules. Coca Cola and coffee for caffeine. "That's not a show routine. They're in the wrong category." Draw a diagram on the score sheet showing how the duet moved around the stage. Disqualify yourself from one category because your team is competing.

Box lunch if you're lucky, or a hamburger from the snack bar. Back to the table. Sigh of relief when two solo age groups are combined (remember the girls challenge 16-19 category — 70 dancers in 7 groups). "Judges, they'd like to know if they can do the dance-off acapella." Brief break while the host team finds the right score sheets for the next category. Do those parents behind us realize we can hear what they're saying? Another upset director, this one an honest mistake; read her

the rules. A tiny dancer gets run over in solo dance-off and starts squawling, recovers and keeps dancing.

Supper break. Back to the table for another few hours. Boys 16-19 solo and girls go crazy. Where's the timekeeper with the stopwatch? Adult male solo dancer jumps the table and plants a smack on one of the judges; he's done it before, all in fun. "Only two more categories to go, maybe we'll be finished by midnight." Pick-up team is having a great time onstage, messing up all over the place, so bad you need more score sheets to keep up; judges fall out laughing.


It's over. Get expense money from the host team. Back to the motel to rest up for the 10-hour drive home. "This one went pretty well; hope they invite me back next year."

TIPS

Here are some suggestions for directors and dancers, from the folks who mark the score sheets:

• Read the rules. "Nothing upsets me more than to see a team that's dancing their hearts out in the wrong category or age group because their director didn't read the rules. There's plenty of information available ahead of time for the directors."





NCCA sponsors a 3-day convention in the spring. Membership meetings are quarterly, usually scheduled along with a workshop and dance. The Teachers' Forum also meets quarterly to discuss dances, terminology, levels, teaching problems, seminars for newer instructors, and everything else that affects clogging instructors.

NCCA has also published a Dictionary of Clogging Steps, now in its third edition. This is a compilation of over 2500 steps collected from around the world. The steps are listed alphabetically, have cross references, beat counts, footwork and bar graphing for the more difficult steps.

NCCA was originally formed as a forum of communication for cloggers and teachers in Northern California, however our membership includes many from So. Oregon, Nevada, Arizona and So. California as well. We get together to share ideas, get help from each other with problems, sponsor workshops to learn new dances, etc.

Membership is open to all interested individuals. We also offer an "Affiliate" status, usually for groups. This way, groups are eligible to join "The Network" to receive their own BMI/ASCAP licensing.

The Louisville Area Clogging Association, Inc. (LACA) was founded in 1984, and publishes a bi-monthly magazine, *LACA NEWS*, which is currently edited by Debbie Pait, 1107 Dogwood Drive, Jeffersonville, IN 47130.

LACA was founded to provide a means of communication and fellowship among area clubs and dancers; and to promote clogging in the area. LACA provides Kentucky and Indiana with clogging functions on both sides of the Ohio River: 1) 2 workshops per year featuring national or local instructors; 2) an annual "Welcome to Clogging" Dance; and 3) a "Crusade for Children" Benefit Dance.

Anyone interested in promoting clogging may join. To hold an office, you must have been a member in good standing from March of the previous year. Nominations are made in May; voting is done in July. Membership meetings are bi-monthly.



Syllabus Sting

It seems "the norm" that cue sheets are not correct and the choreographer, or workshop sponsor doesn't really care. Most average \$3-\$6 for a syllabus; multiply that by the number of attendees and that's quite an income.

A few months ago, I attended a workshop where the instructor was teaching a routine and had a paid attendee holding a cue sheet as he taught, and making the corrections as he went along. This is ridiculous. No one should have to be holding their sheet while instruction is going on. You should be able to enjoy the dance and style. The professional instructor should make sure that their cue sheet is written correctly.

About two months later, I attended another workshop with that same instructor, teaching that same routine, with that same incorrect cue sheet. I know that errors can happen when writing these, but please...once you know it's wrong...correct it before giving it to the next workshop sponsor.

As a dancer, I shouldn't have to make

all that many corrections on something I just paid for. It should be the instructor's responsibility to proofread and make corrections. Also, let's say you attended a workshop where three or four teachers were going on at the same time. You can't be in each class making sure your syllabus is correct. So now you go home with information not correct, confusing, and very aggravating. You have to search around for someone who may have attended that class and get the corrections, or purchase the record and play it over and over and try to figure it out yourself. I shouldn't have to do this; I feel this is why we pay for a syllabus...and it should be correct. The cue sheets are getting sloppier and sloppier...no right foot left foot designators, no beats to the step, and no count on each movement. The average dancer should be able to read these if they are written correctly with the above three items shown. Sometimes you just can't figure out what this step is supposed to sound like. When I pick up a cue sheet I should know exactly what foot is doing what and on what beat. I know

stylizing, twists, and body movements are hard to indicate on paper, but please get the footwork and beats written down so that I can utilize my time dancing the dance, instead of figuring out what this choreographer is trying to tell me.

There is one other thing that bothers me about the workshop instructors and that's telling me "I was up to 4 a.m. this morning choreographing this." This seems very unprofessional and usually means the "teach" will not go well. This is very disappointing. These instructors know well in advance of each workshop date and should be teaching quality dances. I have never hired anyone for a workshop yet, but from discussion the instructors seem to be paid well. And if they have just put together a dance the night before - fine - but don't announce it to the paid attendees. This leaves a very bad impression...like they just threw something together. They are not familiar enough to teach it yet and takes away valuable time stumbling through it.

There are a lot of super instructors, but their syllabus needs attention!!

- Screaming fans around the judges table can be a nuisance. "Sometimes we can't hear the dancers as well as we need to."
- Money will not guarantee trophies. Dancers are not judged by their costumes or props, but by their footwork and stage presence. Where money can make a difference is in helping with lessons, providing more chances to compete, and finding a nice practice hall.
- For solo dancers keep trying. Freestyle clogging is a matter of reflexes, unconsciously drawing on your combined experince.
- In mixed-age competition such as solo grand champion, dancers are not competing against younger or older dancers, but against themselves. "We watch how well you do your own particular style, not whether you can do what everybody else is doing. Remember, it's sound, rhythm and variety that count."
- An experienced judge can "read a room" and tell which teams, directors, and parents have good attitudes by the way they act on the sidelines.
- Finally, judges sometimes get tagged as elitist. But they're not "We want to spread the word about clogging, and watch it expand. And competition is a part of the whole clogging picture."

The Truth

OK, confess...how many of you didn't read the story about judges because you don't care about competition?

Well, do your group (or yourself) a favor and read this.

"The thing that bothers me the most," a competition judge/team director said recently, "is that a lot of cloggers don't understand what competition is *really* about. A lot of people have the wrong idea and they're missing out on a valuable experience."

"Competition is not about egos or bragging rights. It's about saying 'we danced as well as we could,' and having fun. It's also about expanding your horizons, getting exposed to other dance styles, and making friends."

"You're competing with other dancers, not against them. You're dancing against a set of rules and a score sheet. And the rules are there to help preserve the unique characteristics of each style of clogging."

"A lot of adults don't compete because they think they can't keep up with the teenagers. Well, the judges aren't interested in what you do, but how well you do what you do. If you can do a flatfoot doublestep cleaner than someone else's double-double, you'll get a higher score."

"Plus, competition is not just about score sheets. It's about helping other dancers, sportsmanship, and experiences. For many cloggers, a competition event may be the only place they'll be able to see traditional clogging or show, duet, or pop."

"In our national sanctioned competitions, we added show and line categories because we knew that's what the kids were interested in. But it's amazing how many of those kids see traditional clogging and want to learn. And it works the other way, too." "Something else — I believe dancers at competitions are actually more supportive than dancers at workshops. It's not unusual for a competition team to enlist the help of fill-in dancers from other teams. For example, I don't have any boys in my group, but I can go almost anywhere and find four or six or eight boys willing to help out in a mountain style. In fact, we have almost as many honorary team members are regulars."

"Also, competition audiences are more knowledgeable than local exhibition audiences and applause from them is not just polite. They're your peers and they know how it feels to get up onstage."

"I'll give you a good example of the sharing side of competition. Grits and Greens is a team that exists only at competition events. It's a pick-up team, made up of dancers from different groups — whoever wants to try."

"In a recent reincarnation, Grits and Greens had dancers from four groups. They ignored the fact that some of their groups had split off from some of the others. Most of them had never done mountain-style before. They got together the morning of the competition, learned some traditional figures, then went onstage. Though they didn't place, we could tell they were having a ball."

"The thing competition cloggers have to remember is that they're a small minority. Nine out of ten cloggers in this country could care less about competing. They don't see any benefits, or feel they don't have anything to prove."

We don't have anything to prove, except to our own selves. We're just looking for another excuse to dance."
