Clogging Has Had Many Beginnings

Q. I am having an argument with someone as to where clogging originated. I say it was in the southern United States, but the other person said that it came from Europe.
B.J., Sarasota

A. The region that lies between the Appalachian and Blue Ridge Mountains encompasses parts of southern Pennsylvania, Kentucky, Tennessee, Virginia and West Virginia, North and South Carolina, northern Alabama and Georgia. For centuries, this stretch of land had been occupied by Cherokee Indians. By the early 1700s, immigrants from all over Europe were calling the region home. The Germans, followed by the Scotch-Irish and

the English came in the greatest numbers, closely followed by the Swiss, French, Welsh and Pennsylvania Deutsch. Each group brought with them country dances. From these dances came a mixture of steps and styles, which within 100 years came to be known as flat-footing, buck dancing, jigging... and eventually, clog dancing.

In the book, "Clog Dance in the Appalachians" by Jerry Duke, he says, "The terms 'clogging' and 'clog dance' were used to describe a solo dance style taught in public schools, colleges and private studios during the first third of this century. This dance style came from the theatrical jig and clog dances popular during the 19th century.

Clogging... continues to service a purpose —
to draw people to their feet, dancing alone or with another,
reveling for those few moments in the joy of being alive.

Called clog dance because of the wooden-soled shoes, the substitution of metal taps on leather shoes in the 1920s created the name "tap dance." It is apparently related historically to the Appalachian clog dances styles in that both either originated, or were influenced by, the solo dances of the people who settled in the Appalachian mountain region." However, Duke says, "the two terms apparently were not used to describe the dances performed in the Appalachian mountains until after 1939."

What happened in 1939? Bobbie Adams, editor of "Double Toe Times" magazine explained. "There was a dancing troupe called the Soco Gap Dancers from North Carolina who were asked to perform their brand of folk dancing in Washington, D.C., for President Franklin D. Roosevelt, King George IV and Queen Elizabeth of England. After watching them perform, the Queen was to have remarked, "That's just like our clogging!"

"Miners in England," Adams explained, "wore thickly carved wooden soles on their shoes. These shoes were called clog shoes. At break times, the miners would tap out rhythms on the cobblestone streets, sometimes dancing to the lone sound of a Jew's harp or a small drum. This became known as clog dancing."

This is not to confuse you as to the origin of clog dancing by saying that England created it or that any one country or group of people can take full credit for its invention. The evolution of clogging is best summed up in the following quote from "Crazy About Clogging" by Jeanice Birch and Steve Cohen in the February 1992 issue of *Country America*: "Clogging is a paradox. It's a cultural tradition. It began from not one beginning, but many, and continues to serve a purpose — to draw people to their feet, dancing alone or with another, reveling for those few moments in the joy of being alive.

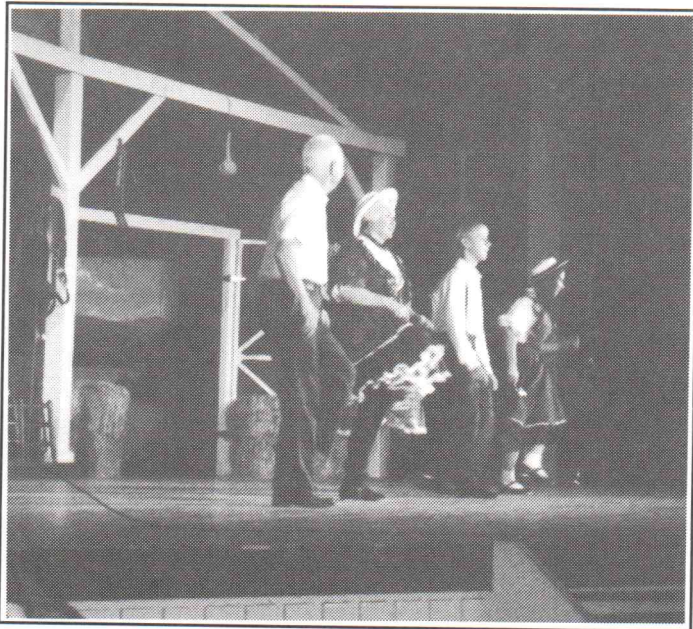

Last year, after my family visited the Museum of Appalachia during their Fall Homecoming Celebration, I was so impressed with the old-time music, dance, and festivities that I wrote to tell you about it. Since then, I have found another unique place that you may find of interest:

Nestled in the Ozark Mountains of Arkansas, approximately 75 miles due north of Little Rock, lies Mountain View — the county seat of Stone County, home to the Ozark Folk Center.

The Ozark Folk Center is an Arkansas State Park and America's only facility devoted to preserving the true heritage

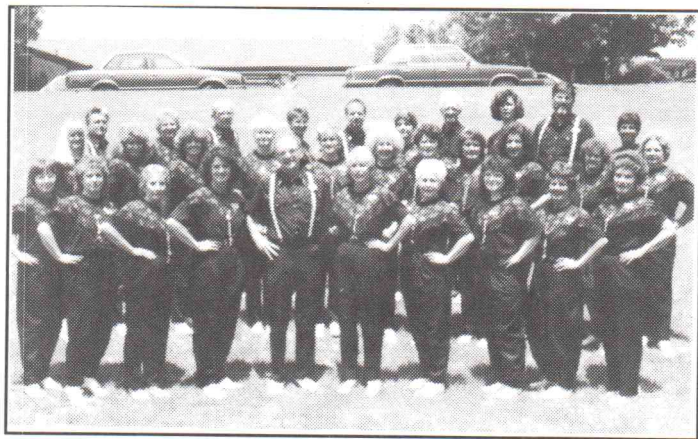

of Ozark Mountain Folks and their way of life. You can relive the past with daily demonstrations of over 20 pioneer skills and crafts as they were practiced during the period 1820-1920. In the Craft Area you can experience basket weaving, spinning, woodcarving, blacksmithing, pottery, quilting, gun smithing and candlemaking among others. You can even take part in one of several dance workshops offered throughout the season which are sponsored by The Ozark Folk Center and feature such people as Jacky Christian, an old-time rhythm buck dance master, and Country Kicks, a professional dance troupe whose dancers are recognized for their free-style performances.

During the season (April - November) live entertainment is presented in the Music Auditorium six nights a week with special Sunday gospel concerts held May through October. The nightly programs feature songs of the Ozarks performed on traditional instruments, Ozark humor, jig dancing, square dancing, and clogging. Other features of the park include a Conference Center, scenic restaurant, and a 60-room lodge. A schedule of the park's activities, including festivals, special music shows, contests, workshops and craft exhibitions can be found on their Calendar of Special Events. For additional

information on The Ozark Folk Center call 501/269-3851. The slogan of this Arkansas State Park is "The Ozarks' Past Is Our Present To You."

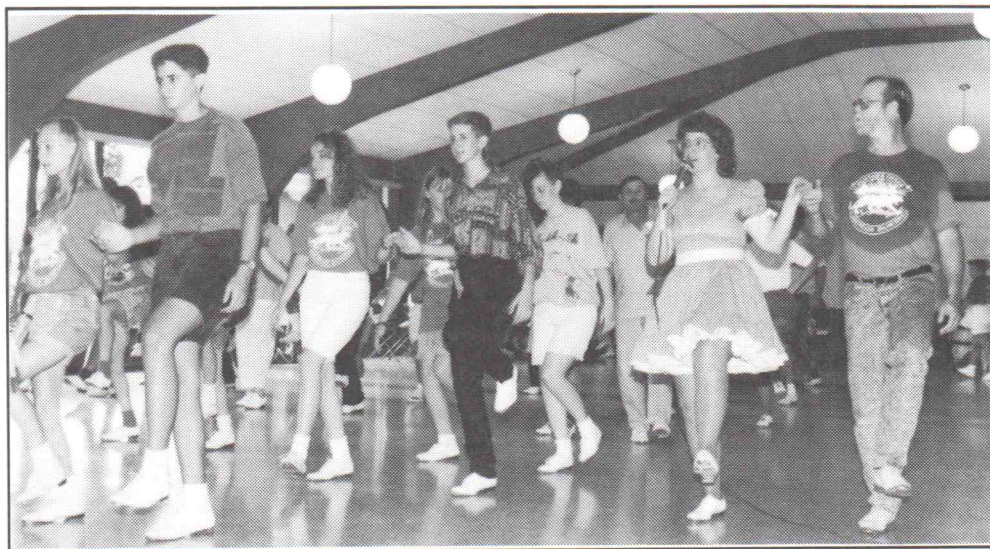
doing "teaches" on Southern Appalachian (Smooth), Southern Appalachian Mountain Square Dance, Kentucky Running Set to Kentucky Hoedown, and Country Hoedown. Jacky Christian taught three segments of Traditional Steps — Flatfoot, Rhythm Steps and Freestyle and a one-hour "hambone, juba and spoons" with a little "jug" playing using large empty Coke bottles. Ray Hattaway led classes in Freestyle Fundamentals for Mountain Style, Figures, and Calling Mountain Dances for Exhibition. Sue Toor taught a couples dance to *Sugar Foot Rag* which is entitled to "old time" status because the routine was written nearly twenty years ago by Sue and her sister Jacky. At four o'clock there was a one-hour review of Quadrille (four couple) and the hall cleared out for supper, a rest and perhaps a swim.

The music in the Auditorium was *all live, all day*, thanks to the *1-800-WHO CARES BAND*. I thought that the Band was only going to play in the evening. Bob Johnson said "Well, if you don't want them to play during the day, they'll just sit out in the parking lot and pick all day and you'll wind up with most of your dancers out there free-styling!" Naturally, we were delighted to give them the stage in the cool auditorium!

At 7:30 p.m. the hall was filled with dancers in their dress-up finery for an evening of an old-time party, kitchen-junket, open dance with nine-pins, guest callers Bobby Whitefield and Mike Hale, a parking lot team performance and special shows by *The Flatland Cloggers*, *Panther Creek Mountain Dancers*, and *Jacky Christian with Leann White and Chris Ginn*.

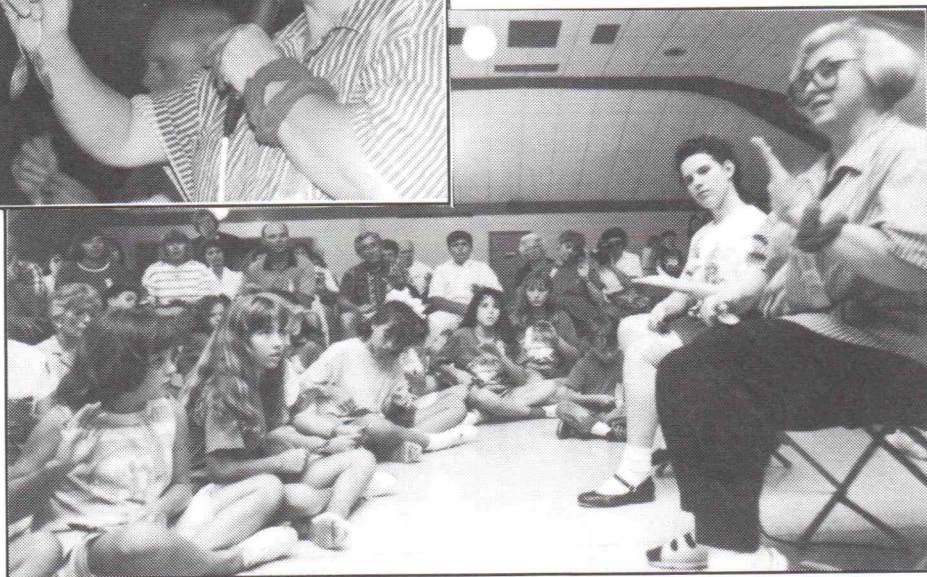

The council sponsors a combination workshop and competition in March, in which members receive discounts on admission and syllabus costs. The workshop is hosted by a different South Carolina team every year. We have three nationally-known instructors along with at least two local guest instructors. The competition is sanctioned with the American Clogging Hall of Fame, which at this point only Line, Duo, Duet and Solo is offered. A new category is offered every year.

The council gives its members a party in October. The party is free of charge to SCCC members and there is a small fee for non-members. The party, known as the SCCC Party-Fest, is hosted by the Fancy Free Cloggers in Charleston, SC.

Members also receive insurance, voting privileges, and legislative proposal powers.

There are approximately seven independent competitions and workshops held in South Carolina each year. Not to mention the Miss American Clogger Pageant held in August.

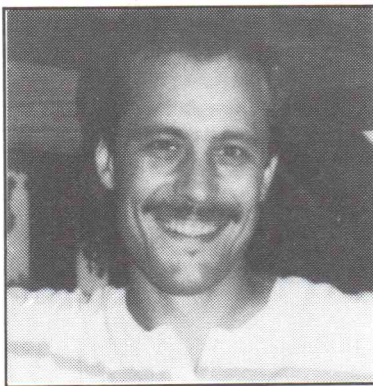

Our banner was made by Dennis and Linda Cassidy with the help of Irene Izzo, doing some high-lighting. Our trailer

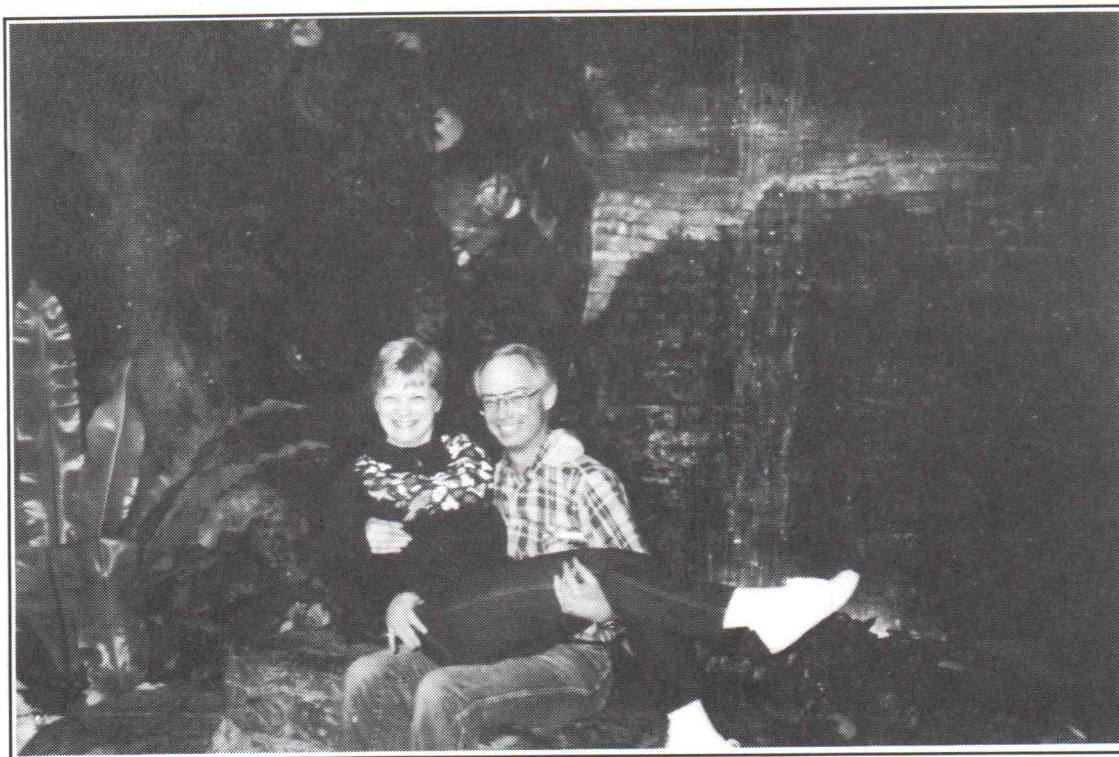


The Hilltop Cloggers at the Alumni Parade in Woodstock, Vermont, in June.

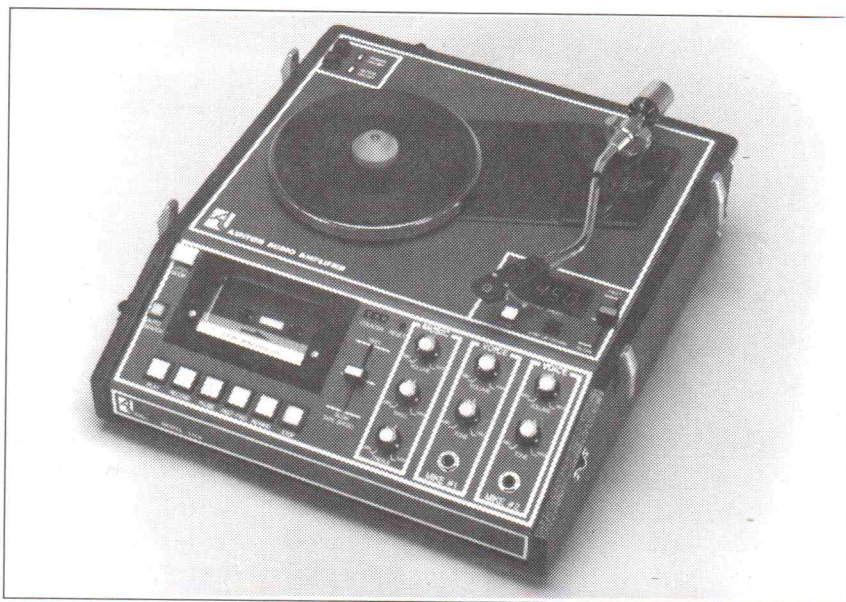

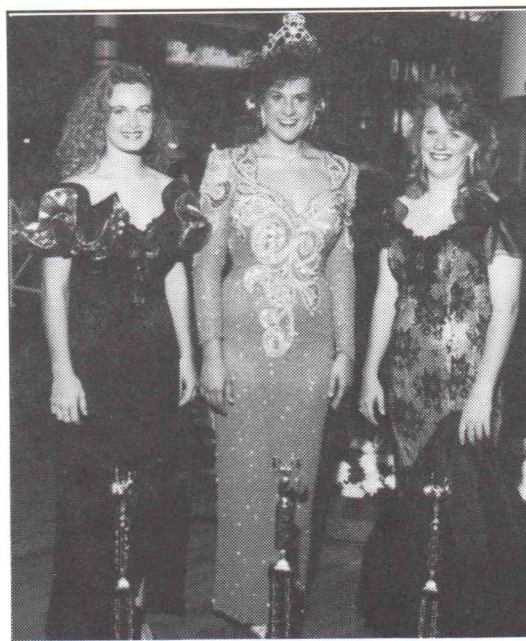

Lake States Workshop

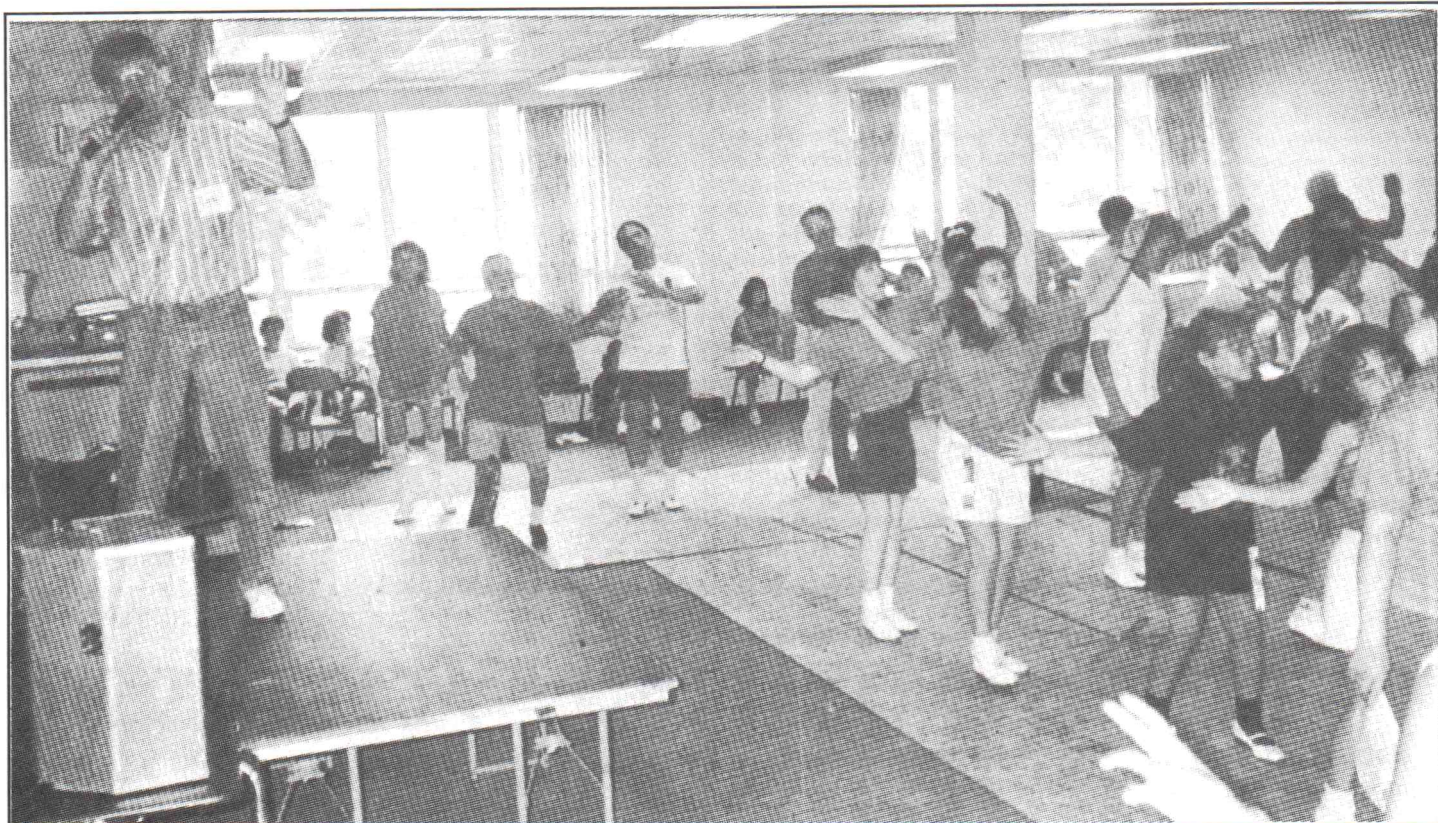

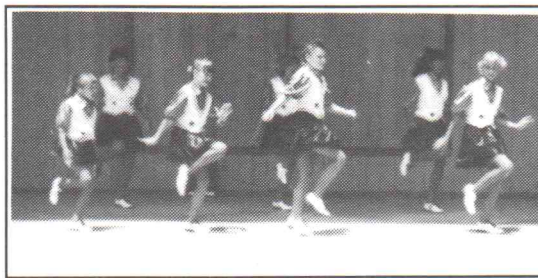
July Summer Clogging Spectacular

Senior citizens lined up right along with children, teenagers, young couples and other adults recently to clog to music ranging from blue grass to rock and roll to top 40.

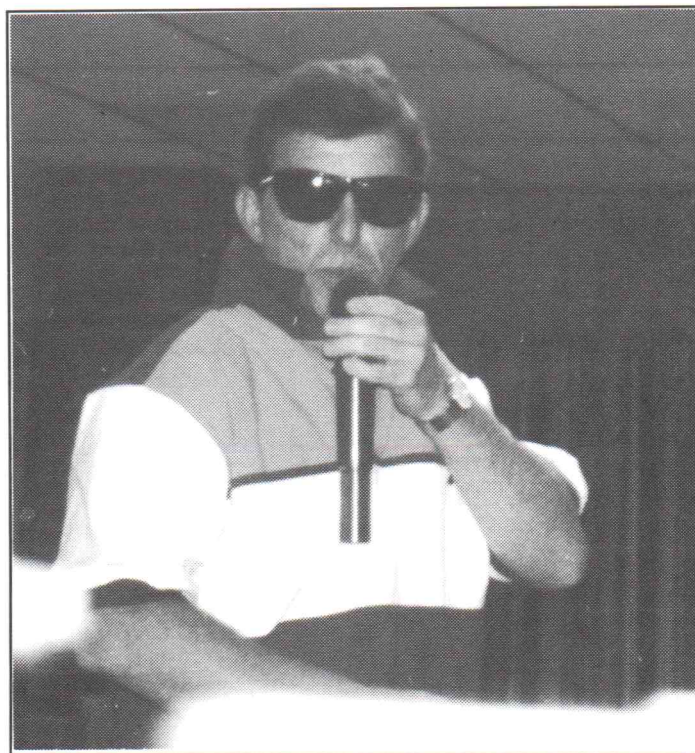
