Music Choices in Today's Clogging World

- 1) A Capella sans music.
- 2) Non-acoustic live string band music featuring truly old-time tunes such as "Cripple Creek," "Boil that Cabbage Down," and early reels and hornpipes.
- 3) Contemporary country-western music.
- 4) Contemporary rock and roll, rap, pop, "top 40," acid rock, cajun, etcetera.

All of this must be further classified by the type of clogging a particular instructor adheres to, or by what is prevalent in a particular geographic region.

- a) Memorized choreographed routines.
- b) Freestyle solo.
- c) Mountain style square dance clogging with a caller.

In the *Meadows of Dan, Virginia* on nice Sunday afternoons, elderly old-time freestyle clog dancers dance on a wooden platform to the tunes of a fiddler, guitar and string bass, seemingly for their own enjoyment, to the delight of onlookers. Each has his own patterns, rhythms and shuffles.

In Louisiana, many teams have choreographed material to cajun music, which delights their Cajun audiences.

At a *National Convention*, over 1000 cloggers made the windows rattle doing a wildly popular choreographed routine to *Jump*.

Shelia Popwell, the first Editor of *The Flop Eared Mule*, and a pioneer in the art of writing out cue sheets, said "Folk dancing is what folks are dancing."

Music choices are primarily determined by a good danceable beat or rhythm, and by the dancers' personal preference. Many instructors and choreographers are guided by those factors alone, and some never hear lyrics. Since clogging is, and has always been, a family activity, and since most family activities must be guided by moral choices and lifestyles, some censorship in what is presented in classes and public performances becomes necessary. Those who want to listen or dance to music that is violent or has obscene lyrics will do so on their own. It is hoped that no one will bite the heads off of bats during a clogging performance. We represent a middle-American wholesome family activity, whether it be purely traditional or contemporary music and styling. The genre of our dance form might be compared to the art works of Grant Wood, Norman Rockwell and Wyeth (1, 2 and 3).

On a personal note — my choice of music ranges from Classical (symphony orchestra, violin and piano), to old-time cassette tapes of lap dulcimer, hammered dulcimer and string bands. When Arthur Fiedler was the conductor of The Boston Pops Orchestra, he did a concert and recording titled *Up with America*. One of the cuts was *Pops Hoedown* by Hayman. It is one of my all-time favorite pieces of music to clog to, and has bits and pieces of Turkey in the Straw, She'll be Comin' Round the Mountain and the like — done by a 150-piece Symphony Orchestra!

This Editor hopes that all the new "spoon" players have seen the NutraSweet television commercial featuring a young man beating out a dynamite rhythm on a pair of spoons. To Bobby Whitefield: "Tape it and practice — we'll expect a solo next year at the Bear Workshop."


Front & Center Continued

RUNOUTOFNAMES

By Ed Gilmore

REFERENCE:5 years of Square Dancing with Sets in Order,

Bob Osgood 1954.

FORMATION: Squared Set

MUSIC: Traditional hoedown or caller's choice

SQUARED SET:

1 and 3 bow and swing Promenade outside the ring

Go all the way around two by two 2 and 4 do a right and left thru (while 1 & 3 are promenading, 2 & 4 do a right & left thru)

1 and 3 go on to the right Circle four you're doing fine Spread right out form two lines (circle to a line)

Forward eight and back with you Forward again and pass right through

Turn to the left go single file Make a wheel and turn it awhile (an eight hand, left hand star)

Gents reach back with your right hand (with right hand, gents reach back over their left shoulder and take right hand of lady behind them — original partner)

Now pull them thru to a right and left grand (pull the lady around to face the gent and start a right and left grand with her)

Go right and left and don't be late Meet your honey and catch all eight

That's a right hand half way round Back with the left hand all the way around

And promenade the corner when she come down (original corner)

PRESERVATION OF CIRCLE TO A LINE

Submitted By Grant Logan, Willowdale Ontario

Recognizing that the activity was losing one of our traditional calls, Circle To A Line, because the dancers were substituting Slide To A Line in its place, Frank Pearson originated this contra to preserve the traditional way of dancing Circle To A Line. To preserve the timeing of this contra, insist that your dancers execute the call as it was written.

Author: Frank Pearson, Willowdale, Ontario

Music: Summertime Dream — Chapparal 403 or Put Another Log on the Fire — Thunderbird 132.

Formation: Alternate Duple, Form Lines with men on Caller's Right, Partners across from them; Have 1st, 3rd, etc. cross over (exchange places with partners); All face corners, Actives are facing

away from caller (or head of set).

INTRO WITH CORNERS SLIDE THRU

- 1 8 then Partners Star Thru, Circle to a Line of Four (Active man break to a line facing down the set)
- 9 16 — —, Four in line Promenade (down the set about 6 steps)
- 17 24 -- -- , California Twirl, Come Back
- 25 32 - Bend the Line, Right & Left Thru
- 33 40 - - - Flutterwheel
- 41 48 — —, Slow Square Thru (a 16 beat square thru, take 3 steps and turn on 4th, repeat for 2nd & 3rd leg of the square, 4th is straight ahead)

49 - 56 - - - - , - - - -

57 - 64 — — —, with Corners Slide Thru*

*Cross over on the Ends every other time.





Surge Protectors

This column is meant to be read by everyone using electronic sound systems, i.e. record players or tape players.

Let's begin with a discussion of what is an electrical surge and how it can affect your electronic equipment.

An electrical surge or spike is a fluctuation in the electric voltage that exceeds the usual 120 volt level. A surge is usually longer lasting than a spike, but a spike will usually have a higher voltage. Both spikes and surges occur so fast that you would not even notice them. All electronic equipment is designed to run on 120 volts, with a usual acceptable range of 100-140 volts. The problem is that voltage surges, and spikes in particular, can easily exceed several thousand volts.

The sources of surges and spikes are not only from the electric company, but are many times generated by nearby electric motors, such as refrigerators, air conditioners, etc. These surges and spikes can easily damage all electronic (i.e. transistorized) equipment such as

sound amplifier systems, stereo sound systems, microwave ovens, TV's, clock radios, etc. and all computer equipment; and unfortunately, equipment warranties DO NOT cover damage due to voltage spikes! Do not be lulled into thinking that the fuse on your sound system will protect it from surges and spikes. Fuses are designed to protect equipment from surges in current, not voltage. Also, most fuses will only trip if the current is suddenly increased over the rated limit and will usually take several hundredths of a second before tripping. In comparison, a voltage spike can occur and cause damage, in less than 8 millionths of a second.

As you can see, ALL electronic equipment should be protected against electrical voltage surges and spikes. This can be easily rectified. Most stores that sell electronic equipment sell devices advertised to provide surge protection. However, there is a catch. Many of the less expensive protectors do not provide adequate protection. The reason is that to provide adequate protection the surge protector must protect all three lines:

the hot line, the neutral line and the ground line (also called 3-way protection). Many of the expensive surge protectors only protect the hot line. Also, many less expensive surge protectors also do not include a circuit breaker. This means that if the protector interrupts a surge or spike the protector is destroyed.

In purchasing a surge protector, and I highly recommend that every piece of electronic equipment should be protected with a surge protector, look for the following features. First, the surge protector should provide 3-way protection. Second, it should have a circuit breaker. Third, it should have two or more outlets.

One such readily available surge protector that meets the above requirements is available from Radio Shack stores. It is their "2 outlet spike protector," catalog number 26-139 5. This unit is small enough to easily fit in a brief case. The list price is \$18.95, but it often goes on sale. Radio Shack also sells 3-way surge protectors with 4-6 outlets.



CLOGGING — A DANCE FOR ALL AGES

It is said that life begins at 40. For Donna Robbins, age 40 marked the beginning of her clogging life.

Her interest in clogging germinated back in the 70s when she traveled to Tennessee with her husband, John a square dance caller.

One group, the Tennessee Mountain Cloggers, so impressed her that she became caught up in the dance. When she returned to her home in Jacksonville, she signed up and graduated from the first class of the J-Ville Cloggers.

In 1990 Donna formed a second group, the Cross Country Cloggers.

Donna's group includes elementary school students, retirees, homemakers and working-class heroes. But when they meet on the floor to stomp and kick, they are "just cloggers to the bone."

Says Donna, "You don't just clog, you become a clogger."

The true origin of clogging remains a mystery but is generally viewed as a mountain dance. Celtic explorers found the Appalachians so like their homeland that they settled there with their customs. This may be why the dance resembles an Irish jig. It also resembles tap, rap, jazz and rock.

Most of the time a partner is not required, she says. But at times cloggers pair off and circle dance to "Mountain Dew" and "Cotton Eye Joe."

Clogging guru Donna says, "Clogging is more than just good fun and great aerobic exercise, it's therapy. You can forget your problems, the house, the job. When learning to clog, you can't think past your feet."




I was asked to do a clogging exhibi-





The organization formed as a communication and participation link between clogging clubs and classes in the surrounding suburbs of Buffalo, NY, getting together for workshops and expanding the friendship base through common interest. It was felt that it would help clogging in the area as new clubs and classes were formed and new instructors became active in the clogging experience. In the mid 1980s, the Nickel City Festival was started and has became an annual event in Buffalo. Through the festival, our membership has grown with the inclusion of many new clubs and cloggers. World Square Dancing Convention August 7-9, 1992 The Hague, The Netherlands

We took all our things and sound equipment and moved to the hall where the shops had their booths. The dance that was workshopped impressed everybody (and almost desperated some cloggers). But everybody sticked to it, Naomi showed the steps and the dancers practiced until everybody could do it.

I would like to take the opportunity to thank Naomi for the workshops she did. We all really learned a lot! She was able to offer a program that satisfied everybody. We were laughing a lot and all of us had a very good time. We hope to get more clogging on the program at the World Square Dance Convention next year, which will be held in Germany.


