# MULE DAY


# Calvary, Georgia

On the 31st of October the Annual 4-H Clogging Competition was held at the State Fair in Phoenix, Arizona, There were seven groups competing from different parts of Arizona, a total of 119 youths and 6 adult performers.

The competition was to start promptly at 9 a.m. but due to some sound problems caused by a power surge, it was underway at 10 a.m. The first event

was the exhibition — 4-H members who are not yet 9 years old. Each one is awarded a ribbon as a reward for being in the exhibition group.

The next group, judged by our three judges from Arizona; Ellen Roe, Amanda Stavro and Christopher Moore, was Rise and Shine. There were 58 contestants, 53 juniors and 5 seniors. Each contestant was awarded a red, white or blue according to their score. In the Junior Division the top award, a ribbon cluster, was awarded to Chelsea Worthen from the Maricopa Cloggers and the Senior Award went to Laura Mecham from the Cottonwood Group.

The next event was duets and there were 34 pairs. In the Junior group the top award went to Shauna Spear and Laura Gordon, Cotton Wood 4H, and the Seniors Award went to Kera and Theresa Parkes from Hi-Country Cloggers 4-H group.

In the Precision event there were 13 groups from the various clubs. The Junior Division top award went to the Maricopa Cloggers and the Senior Award also went to the Maricopa Cloggers.

Our last event was the Mixed groups where you can have a non-4-H member dancing with the group. This gives some of the parents a chance to dance with their children.

We hope to keep the contest a worthy event each year stressing the importance of giving everyone a chance to participate and being a winner, whether it is first, second or third place. The quality of the dancers has improved over the past few years as more and more of the 4H groups are attending workshops held in the Arizona area and the leaders of the groups are doing a splendid job of preparing their group for the competition. It has been my pleasure to be a part of this event for the last five years, first as a judge and the last two years as the Volunteer Coordinator for the State of Arizona 4H Contest.



She had approximately 300 students and a very successful "Annual Clogging Jamboree" every May for the past four years.

She leaves behind three children; Linda, Donna and Cindy, her husband, Bob, nine grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Her whole life evolved around clogging. She "loved" teaching and had a very devoted Demo Team.

At her funeral we played clogging music in lieu of organ music. She always wanted her funeral light. She would have been proud. When they carried out the casket they did so to the tune of "Cajun Moon." It was her first "very successful" choreography.

She was diagnosed with cancer in January and she passed away September 18, 1992.

This is a picture of my mom. I hope I have given you adequate information. I could go on about her forever!


I spoke at my mother's funeral with a realization that came to me during the two days when people came to pay their respects prior to the funeral.



# **American Clogging Hall of Fame**

To most people, the end of October means "Halloween," but to over 117 clogging teams it means the end of the year championships for the American Clogging Hall of Fame. The championships were held October 24-25 at the Stompin' Grounds in Maggie Valley, NC (the national headquarters for ACHF).

Only teams that placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in ACHF sanctioned competitions during the 1992 ACHF clogging year were eligible to compete. Teams that qualified were notified and invited to compete at this year's Hall of Fame Grand Championships. Sanctioned categories were: Country Hoedown, Running Set, 4 or more Couple Open Precision, 6 or 8 Couple Precision, Smooth, Open Smooth, 6 Couple Southern Appalachian, 8 Couple Southern Appalachian, 4 or more Couple Open Hoedown, Line, 6 or 8 Couple Open Southern Appalachian, Exhibition, and Show. Non-Sanctioned events included: Male and Female Solo, M/M Duo, F/F Duo, and M/F Duets. Once a year this event takes place and cloggers from all over the country gather to compete and be inducted into the American Clogging Hall of Fame.

Teams as far away as Virginia and Florida participated at this year's championships. 8 states were represented by the best competition teams across the country. 117 teams were registered for Saturday and Sunday's competition, as well as, over 300 solos and 35 Duo/Duets.

The Solo and Duo/Duets grand champions resulted in Brian Lowery as the grand champion male soloist; Lori Beth Rogers as the grand champion Female soloist; Bobby Hodge and Miranda Fowler as the grand champion duet couple; Shumma Eckard and Sarah Lail as the grand champion duo couple.

Team grand champions were: the Bailey Mountain cloggers directed by Richard Dillingham as grand champion free style team and precision team; the Carolina Country Cloggers directed by Darryl Plyler as Grand Champion Smooth team; the Bialy Mountain Cloggers directed by Richard Dillingham as over-all grand champions for the festival.

The Sportsmanship Award was presented to the Pride of Carolina Cloggers directed by Mercy Martinez. Jamie Conn, from Florida, won the best caller award.

The Ben Smathers Dance Off consisted of all the grand champion soloists from all the ACHF sanctioned competitions. All grand champions had to be 16 years of age to qualify. The best of the best danced off for the Ben Smathers Award. Andrea Johnson won the female award and David Watson won the male award.






A great time was had by all. This was our first clogging competition to host and it was a huge success.



# **Clogger Appears in** Shape Magazine







As the formal 11:00 a.m. opening, the parade winds through the small town's bustling blocks. Judges look for the prettiest, ugliest and most ornery mules. Local, state and neighboring dignitaries wave at constituents often numbering 100,000 by parade time. The local bands' uniforms of the day are straw hats and overalls as they step lively, but carefully down the parade route.



Spectators wind their way back to the mule grounds to partake of barbeque, fish fry, and short order items while they wander amongst the various flea market craft booths. Many will purchase cane juice to drink and syrup for home freshly made by the mule-driven cane grinder. Also, corn meal is often stone ground on site.

The museum of Dr. Maxwell holds pictures and items of original calvary days. It is one of the original buildings moved to the Mule grounds as a permanent home. The children as well as adults gloried in their efforts of catching the greased pig. Also, at catching the roosters that were sailed above the crowd.

Gospel groups, cloggers and other entertainment performed on platforms and/or on the Mule grounds.

Nancy Aycock introduces into the Clogging Hall of Fame:

"First, let me say that this job is a pleasure and a privilege for me. It is a real joy to discover those characters among us who have contributed to the art of clog dancing and who represent what our organization's purpose really is — that is to preserve and promote the tradition of clogging. There are three inductions into the Clogging Hall of Fame this evening — all of them especially dedicated to working with young people. What better way to carry on this traditional folk art than to teach it to the children.

"And so, I can't tell you how interesting and inspiring it has been to have come in contact with these special people, whether it has been personal conversation with them or talking with their friends and relatives — it sure has been fun!

"The first person we would like to honor is Mrs. Olivia Smathers. I am telling you her name before telling her story because she is not able to be with us here tonight to receive this award. Even though she and her husband, Kenneth, have been married about 53 years, which makes us know she is somewhere in her "golden years," the reason she is unable to be here is certainly not any ailment or such — the fact is that she and her team are doing a performance. They are somewhere down in Georgia tonight — dancing.

"Now "Miss Olivia" loves dancing, but she loves those kids on her team even more. Just talking to her, one soon knows her main focus when she speaks of the Little Generals from Kennesaw, Georgia. And even though she started dancing herself more than 50 years ago, she started the team of "her kids" in 1972 to celebrate the homecoming to Kennesaw of the honored Civil War locomotive, the General. She told me that they needed something for family entertainment at this big town event and it had to be some-

thing historically correct for that period of time — it had to be "barn dancing." That one event went over so well, that from that time, her dance team, the Little Generals have been goodwill ambassadors for the state of Georgia. "They travel all over the world sharing a little bit of history and this exciting dance with all they meet. They have done eight consecutive years of appearances on the Grand Ole Opry and other national television shows. "Miss Olivia" says they are not interested in competition, only sharing their American heritage through dancing.

"The daughter of a Baptist minister, this delightful lady says her father put people out of the church for dancing — but "just as there are some books you read and some you don't," she told her father, "there are some dances you do and some you don't." And clogging she does with all her heart. So, Mrs. Olivia Smathers, we are proud to honor you with induction into the Clogging Hall of Fame."

"The second person to be honored by the Clogging Hall of Fame would usually be found in Henry County, Virginia. Specifically Fieldale, Virginia. This lady began dancing about 34 years ago, competing individually in different festivals including the one in Galax, Virginia. Once again, the team idea came about through helping her daughter and a friend prepare to perform at a fiddler's convention — getting those kids dancing! This beginning became the Patrick Henry Travelers who went on to dance every year for six years in the festival in Langley, Oklahoma; to go on trips to England and France promoting tourism for the state of Virginia; and, continuous appearances at the Fiddle and Banjo Club in Roanoke, Virginia. This team, organized in 1977, is still under the direction of this special lady who continues to keep young people involved in clogging.

"She says they are interested in mostly traditional clogging — what she calls "old time square dancing," and she has been teaching "flat-footing" and dance figures for some 20 years. Even though the Travelers do not enter competitions, she directs competitive events for other people at the Harvest Jubilee in Danville and in Reidsville for the Farm and Home Show. When asked if she did anything but clog, she said, "Sure, I am retired from DuPont after 40½ years and do macrame and crochet. And now I am

learning to play the dulcimer — anything to keep from cleaning the house." She enjoys her family which includes two children and two grandchildren. Her granddaughter, Christy, dances not only with her but also with the Pride of Carolina Team directed by Mercy Martinez.

"Tonight she is here with us in Maggie Valley. We are proud to present now our second inductee into the Clogging Hall of Fame — 61 years young —

### Mrs. Pearlie Reynolds

"Our final choice for Hall of Fame honorees in unique in that it is not an individual but a very special husband and wife team who have been familiar folks involved with clogging competitions and festivals including our Hall of Fame events. They have two sons, a daughter and four grandchildren — three of whom dance on their team. When this couple was nominated for this honor, I contacted one of their sons who works with them, and I would like to have Heidi Hedrick share the letter he wrote about them:

"I am writing this letter to recommend [my parents] to the America's Clogging Hall of Fame. This year as they celebrate their 50th wedding anniversary, I'm sure it would be very special for them to be inducted together.

"Ever since I was a very young child, my parents have dedicated themselves to the sport of clogging. With love and dedication, they have supported me from the beginning, when I was just a clogger to today, when we have our own team, The Land of the Waterfall Cloggers.

"They became directors of this team because of their desire to help me and many other children, who might otherwise have no where else to clog. They have contributed emotionally and financially to many cloggers in need.

"As directors, they are always anxious to help others in need with benefits. Even though both of my parents are in their mid-60's, they always go with and support the cloggers at practices, dance dates, benefits and competitions.

"They have volunteered their time to clogging for many years, and through their great love and dedication for children and clogging, I feel that this induction wuld be a great honor for them.



# **Honey Creek Cloggers**

Here are some memories I would like to share with you. I thought they were very special.

Last August, my wife, Martha, and I went to Nashville. When we got there, our friends Melvin and Beverly Sloan and the Melvin Sloan Dancers were our hosts for the Grand Ole Opry. Between performances at the Opry, the Sloans suggested we visit "Mr. Roy" (Acuff) in his dressing room. While visiting with Mr. Roy, a couple of musicians were having a jam session in one corner with a guitar and a mandolin. They were playing a perky bluegrass tune. My wife can never be still (especially her feet) when there's music playing. Her feet were really moving while she tried to sit still. I noticed "Mr. Roy" staring at Martha's feet. After a while, he turned to Melvin and said "She loves music, doesn't she." Melvin said "She's a clogger from Texas." Mr. Roy turned to my



wife and said, "Martha, would you clog for me?" My wife has never been shy. She hopped to her feet and started doing some freestyling. Later, when we were leaving "Mr. Roy's" dressing room, Mr. Roy put his arms around Martha and said "Little lady, don't ever stop dancing." Melvin told us, "Mr. Roy doesn't ask too many people to clog for him!" This will be an event that will be a fond and cherished memory for a long, long time.

The lighting was kind of bad from the hallway where I took the picture, but maybe you can make out the three main characters.

# **Stage Presentation 101**

A COMMENTARY BY BOBBIE RAMEY Hawkinsville, Georgia

Those of you who have had an opportunity to perform at the Georgia National Fair in Perry any of the past two years know me as the coordinator of clogging for that event. However, major decisions, such as staging, types of shows and the timetable for those shows has remained in the hands of the executive director of the fair. This particular fair, being a young institution, is still in the process of evolving and discovering the best arrangement pertaining to the final quality of the [outdoor] entertainment. There were improvements over last year, but I wish to comment on only one aspect of putting on a quality show — sound.

This year, an acoustics company from Pennsylvania was contracted to provide service to entertainers on not only the Westgate stage, but the larger GTE stage as well. The benefit for the "clogging" stage would be eliminating the hassle involved in the change-over of sound systems from one group to another. Also, the company provided needed assistance to the other non-clogging acts on that stage. It was observed by the technician working the mixer board that many clogging groups have very little conception of what goes into good sound accompaniment. The levels (of


volume) at which songs were taped varied from not only group to group, but from one song to the next within a group's repetoire. The mixer board, that black panel with all the knobs the technician works, is designed to enhance the recorded sound, but can't make a poor recording sound better. The large amplifiers are there to carry the sound to the audience and the smaller monitors to provide the entertainer the same sound at a reduced level. They are run through a separate channel from that of the main amps, and as such, can be adjusted to the individual listening needs of each clogging group. As an example, one group's tapes were recorded at such high gain (volume) to begin with, that upon playback, the volume adjustment from the mixer board was next to impossible to make. This could be quite a turn-off for those in the audience sitting close to the speakers. (In Corey's defense, he was unfamiliar with clogger's preference of having speakers behind the dancers but told me he had received a valuable education.) Also, not to begrudge those who still use 45's, but once again the sound output is hard to anticipate, not to mention the obvious blemishes on a much used piece of vinyl.

What's my point? Unless a clogging

group dances solely a cappela, the quality of the musical accompaniment is a factor in the overall enjoyment an audience gets from a performance. (It could also be argued that playing songs at warp 9 causes audience distraction. After all, they don't hear those tunes played over the radio that fast.)

Those responsible for putting the performance songs on cassette would do well to use a system whereby the recording levels can be monitored for consistency, whether on individual tapes or multiple-song tapes. I would like to point out that use of 5 minute cassettes as opposed to one, multiple-song cassette is an option that would prevent the possibility of a major catastrophe, should the tape you're using be consumed by someone's playback machine.

Group leaders or instructors should double-check to see that all tapes are cued AND have a decent interval in between each song - preferably 5 to 8 seconds. Usually, the soundman has no way to monitor your tape for the sake of cueing up the next song. Of course, this is not a problem for those instructors manning their own variable speed cassette player during a show. Lastly, keep your equipment in peak working condition. Consult the owner's manual and educate yourself in the use of your equipment, because the soundman may not be familiar with that particular unit. Most of all — SMILE!!! when you perform. It can cover up a lot of goofs.





# Oklahoma Klogging Association Workshop

The first Oklahoma Klogging Association Workshop was held October 17, 1992 in Norman, Oklahoma at the Moose Lodge and there was a good attendance. 





