NATIONAL CHAMPION DANCE-OFF, AND JUDGES & DIRECTORS WORKSHOP JEKYLL ISLAND, GEORGIA By Bobbie Adams

The last weekend in January looked mighty inviting for a getaway on an island off the coast of Georgia. The weather was bright but windy and cool; the drive, an easy four hours or so. At this time of year, Jekyll Island was nearly deserted except for over 750 cloggers, and two other small conventions.

The competition was held in the Holiday Inn on the southern end of the island and the Judges and Directors Workshop, which was ongoing throughout the weekend had meeting rooms near the Comfort Inn, midway up Beachview Drive. 

Jekyll Island is one of Georgia's barrier islands, and was named by Oglethorpe to honor Sir Joseph Jekyll, who contributed 600 pounds toward the founding of Georgia in the mid-1600's.


Privately-owned, a group of America's wealthiest men purchased the island in 1886 and formed the exclusive Jekyll Island Club. The State of Georgia bought the island from the Club in 1947 and it now operates as a State Park. There are about 1150 permanent residents of the island, whose 660 homes are privately owned, but the land is leased from the Jekyll Island


Authority. No further building is allowed. There is a lovely new convention center on the beachside. I'd love to go back when the weather is a bit warmer.





#### From the Archives...



Oxon Hill Cloggers, Oxon Hill, Maryland

Wayne Newland's family owned a fish camp near Hurricane Deck Bridge, Lake of the Ozarks near Bronson, Missouri. As a teenager in the summer of 1953 Wayne participated in the jig dancing and Southern Circle dances in a local tavern there.

Music was provided by a fiddler and two guitars. The caller also danced and called from the set. This group went on to become the Promenaders on the Ozark Jubilee.

When Wayne turned 18 in 1955, he joined the Air Force and was shipping to Bolling Air Force Base in Washington, D.C. He met Ralph Case and the Ralph Case Dancers at the Service Club and Continued on Page 24



Following is a special report. In reading we shall find a little bit of ourselves, somewhere.


#### **ROWDY BUNCH IS HERE**





## T.A.P. TEACHER ACCREDITATION PROGRAM

You're settled in a seat for the ballet. The curtain goes up. Several dancers are on stage, smiling. An M.C. comes out and announces the opening party number from the "Nutcracker." He also tells everyone in the audience the names of the people on stage. They dance the number. Applause. Lo and behold, here comes the announcer again, giving us the low-down on the Papa and the girl in the nightie (perhaps a duet?). He tells us their names — then says: "Let's hear it for them...they've only been dancing six months!" You begin to wiggle. What kind of show is this anyway? Then, the big number. All the toys come alive - sure enough, her comes the M.C. - after telling us some do-dahs abut their personal lives, he says "Don't forget, the louder you clap, the better we dance! Aren't these toy costumes great?"

Ridiculous? Of course it is — why would anybody interrupt a beautiful show for all that? We would be astounded. Yet, we do it all the time in clogging shows. We never think anything about it. We should!

Let's go back to the show — a different one. The curtain goes up. Before we take a breath, things are moving. The music immediately draws our attention. Something is definitely happening and we don't need an M.C. to tell us about it. And we could care less about the dancers' names. Plenty of time for that later. For now, we want no interruptions. This is a class act.

The story progresses. There are high and low spots — big numbers and small ones — ones with adults and some with children. There is a nifty portable backdrop that turns around for a second scene. There are a few carry-on props. The music has great sound even though it's obviously taped. The narration, when needed, is on the tape, too. The costumes are simple but colorful — and

the show is 30 minutes long and has a cast of 15 or so. Was it the "Nutcracker"? No, a clogging group I visited recently. The director

knew exactly what she was doing. I was riveted to the chair and thoroughly enjoyed myself.

Right away, our minds swim with excuses. "We don't have enough people." "We aren't good enough." "We don't have enough money, enough time, enough ideas."

**ENOUGH!** 

Drop any ideas about what you used to do. Think about the ballet. What really impressed you? It was the *story*! It had a beginning, a middle, and an end. You waited to see *how* it would end, not *when* it would end.

How simple. Think of Lil Abner or Huck Finn — think of a farm story — with a farmer and animals (if you have little ones, make them veggies). Think of cowboys and indians, or "Grease", or fairy tales. How about the pioneers' trek West? Or a "Guys and Dolls" street type scene. Or "West Side Story". (Great for teens!)

You don't have to follow the story exactly — just pull ideas. Now you've got something for young and old. Experienced and beginner dancers. And anyone with a touch of apathy. This will set you apart from the other guys.

#### LET'S GET STARTED

- Bounce the idea off your dancers. Tell them you've got a great idea and you'd like some input. Mentally list all the positive aspects. Everyone will get a part the costuming will cost very little, at least no more than a regular outfit. You'd like to have four big trips a year theme parks even Disney World. Let them participate in the excitement.
- Have some story lines to present. (Say 'Lil Abner'). It's good to have some music ready to play...really good music. Guaranteed someone will jump up with other ideas. You've got them hooked!

- Browse through show tunes at the tape stores. Remember, you'll need to buy several tapes to get a few good songs. (And renew ASCAP B.M.I.!)
- Rent some videos from movie musicals. Watch the staging and formations. Even the ones from the 30s and 40s have great staging. Jot down some moves and walk your crew through them next practice.
- and have some music to start with pick two or three dancers with good "people experience" to help you. Divide the music into several sections and assign a person to help choreograph those parts. You may be amazed at the talent at your fingertips.
- Once things get started start thinking of how you'll present each piece of music, logically in a story line. Remember, use other talents on your team...singers, fiddle players, spoons...put them in the show for variety.

Use those hot-shot teens! Let them choreograph a number — all stops pulled out!

- Now, keep your mind open for other show-type music to complete your show. Remember, it doesn't all have to come from a particular show. But if you're going hillbilly don't use West Side Story music. Stick to the theme. Remember, your show is 25-30 minutes long. You may want to splice music to shorten or combine numbers.
- After the music and dance numbers are in process, and you've got an idea how they'll follow in the show, you've got a big job ahead. How to make it a show instead of a series of exhibitions to similar music. Tricky.

Well, we've ditched the announcer, right? If at all possible, don't empty the stage or turn off the music until the SHOW IS OVER. Never let one group leave the stage without another already on. No group should walk on and stand in place. Once in sight of the audience everyone should be completely choreographed — even if its hoeing corn

— or chopping wood. "Backgrounding" is very important. The story should continue without stops for transitions. If you must change a scene, keep background music going. No dead air!

- Costuming does not have to be expensive. But *color* costs no more than drab. Use all the bright colors you can even clashing ones. What looks good on the street may be extremely lackluster on the stage. Get a little crazy. Think of Holiday on Ice. How drab is that? When in doubt add sequins.
- You've picked your music your numbers are being worked on your costumes are promised in a few weeks. You've found two bookings already. You're ready to fix your music. Take it to a real sound man a professional. Spend the money and save the heartache. Prepare a list of the music and the sequences. If you want narration have that written down too. The sound man will be glad to read it for you. Have all your notes on splices and such. Be absolutely prepared. You'll be paying him/her by the hour!

Put everything on one tape. Music, narration, background, everything. Have the sound person make several masters. You want to touch the tape player only twice come showtime. At the beginning and the end.

Start with a bang. Good orchestrated music with intensity. Lots of color and movement. Get the audience interested right away. Never be predictable (do costumed pigs have to

be pink? No! How about orange or blue stripes?). Build your show and tell the story with music and action. Always curtain with the whole cast — put some of them off stage — even in the audience. Have a rousing piece of music at the end...even if it isn't a real good clogging beat. Improvise.

Remember, each section of music can be choreographed to the dance abilities of your individual cloggers. Theme costumes can be varied to fit different ages and sizes (okay, no comments about the PIG). Everyone will have a special and important slot. (Hey, are we STARS or what?). A sure cure for the "I can't come Saturday" syndrome!

At best, this just skins the surface of possibilities — just enough ideas to get your noggin' a bobbin'.

No doubt about it... This prop it can be a mighty one.


If you have less than ten dancers it may mean too many costume changes and timing problems — but it can be scaled down. The important thing is to get started. Once you get a show together, you'll be surprised at how many new dancers in your area will want to be a part of it. Have some fliers ready at your shows — inviting them to share in the fun.

If you have twenty dancers — all ages and sizes, you've got it *made*. Get going!

Some good music sources: Show tunes in general - Sound-track section; Erich Kunzel - Classical section; Fiedler Boston Pops - Classical section.





eventually became one of the lead dancers in that group.

In 1956 a professional clogging group was formed calling themselves The Green Mountain Cloggers, later to become The Country Cloggers; performers at the Old Dominion Barn Dance in Richmond, Virginia and regulars on the Wheeling Jamboree in West Virginia.


In 1974, after 18 years and several thousand shows, the Oxon Hill Cloggers closed their doors and packed up their taps.

#### Clogging Fever Strikes Nuns

I just came across some pictures from last Valentine's Day with, I think, a rather unusual story.

Our team, the Missouri Heritage Cloggers, were invited to entertain for a Valentine's Party at the St. Joseph's Home for the Aged in Jefferson City, Missouri. Before taking the stage we were completely up-staged by a couple of "clogging nuns." Sister Mary Catherine (left) and Sister M. Clara (right) — Carmelite Sisters of the Divine Heart of Jesus, who did a couple of routines just ahead of us. They certainly had everyone caught up in their dancing and spirit.

Sister M. Clara told me she learned to clog in Owensboro, Kentucky, with the help of Stacy Austin who gave her Steve Smith's tapes on a loan basis and later gave them two songs to dance to choreographed by Steve.

Sister M. Clara said, "We learned the routines as a surprise program for our Superior's Saints Day. Our Sisters in St. Louis almost fell off their chairs. At first they thought the Clydesdales were coming, but when they saw us, it was really a big surprise. We did this in November of 1989."

The competition was in full swing when I got there and Bill Nichols, who was "Door Guard" asked that I take over for a while — and then promptly disappeared!


A portly elderly man was trying to see into the room and indicated he was there with another convention.

Door traffic hit a lull and he began asking questions. He was a retired school principal and while he had seen clogging, he'd never seen a competition or workshop.


He stood watching for a long while and finally, before he left, remarked "The dancing is wonderful, but the thing I find amazing is that whole families participate."


