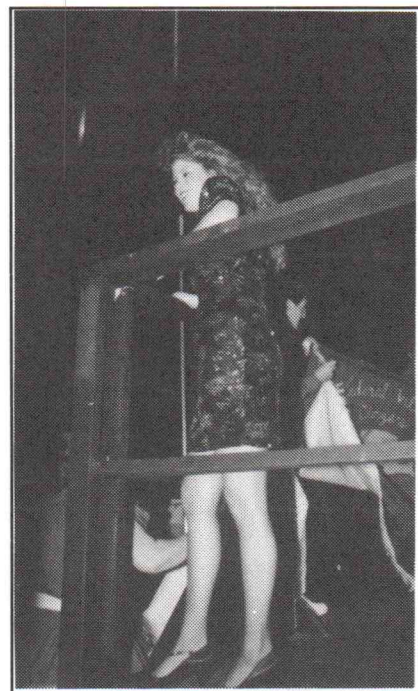

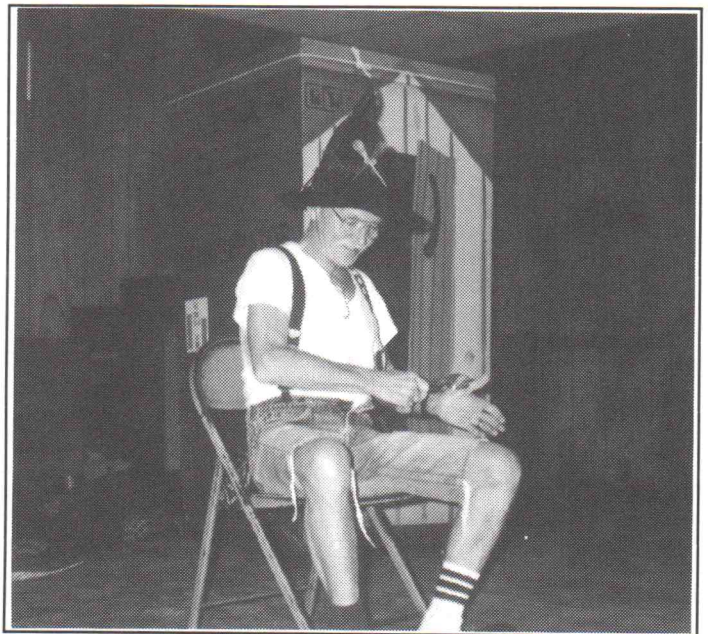
In February they were part of a benefit show for the Heart Foundation and took part in a fundraiser for the Animal

The L'il Foot Stompers operate under the direction of John and Shirley Walters of Cumming, Georgia. Mr. and Mrs. Walters have been involved for the last thirty years in teaching clogging and in building the intense interest in clogging that exists in Atlanta today. Their work with the L'il Foot Stompers, now in its fifth generation, is entirely voluntary. The group is instructed by Scotty and Connie Bilz of Stone Mountain, Georgia. Both couples are nationally recognized as being top ranked in their field.

L'il Foot Stompers is an exhibition team, as opposed to a competition team, and they are asked to dance 20-25 times each year.

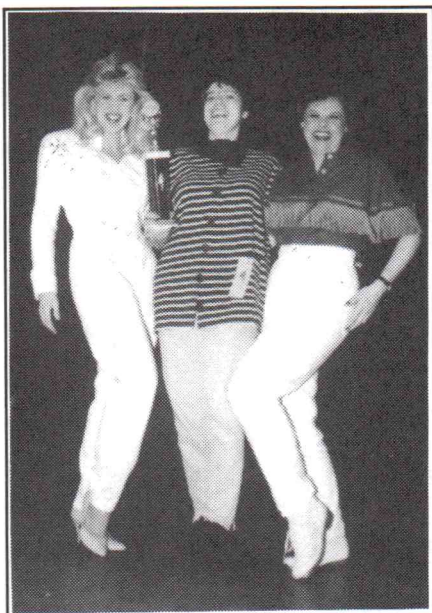

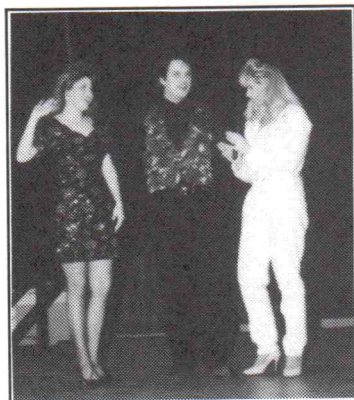

say no when they have turned in their requests on time!

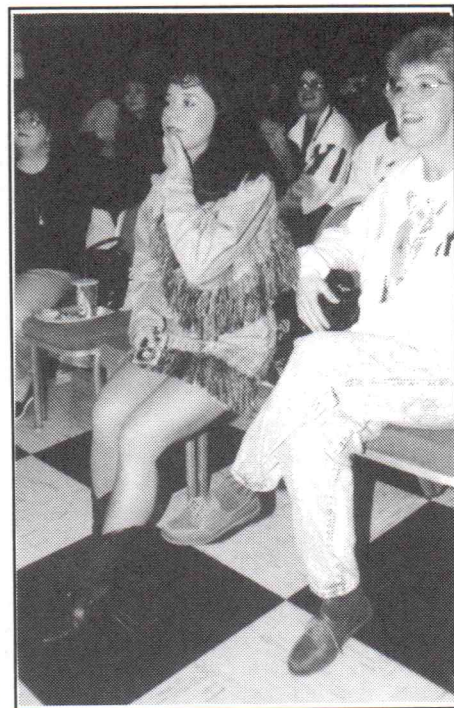

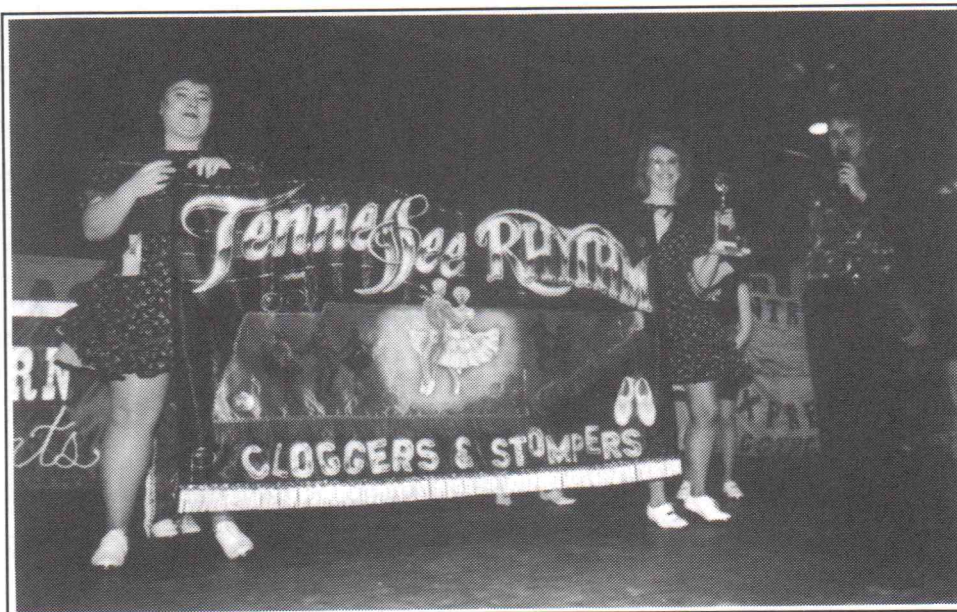

In the past, they have entertained at nursing homes, retirement centers, and craft shows. They have performed as far away as Hawaii and Utah, and have participated in the National Clogging Conventions in Orlando, Florida, Nashville, Tennessee, and Memphis, Tennessee. The team has been a featured performer at the AT&T Octoberfest, a charity event, at Six Flags Over Georgia, Dollywood, Silver Dollar City in Branson, Missouri, Sea World in Orlando, Florida, the Opryland Hotel in Nashville, Tennessee, and for several years at the Octoberfest in Helen, Georgia.

The L'il Foot Stompers do not require a fee, and are happy to dance upon request. There are presently twenty-four children in the group, ranging in age from nine to twenty-one, who represent not only Cumming, but Roswell, Alpharetta, Gainesville, Dunwoody, Snellville and Stone Mountain.

L'il Foot Stompers have received an invitation to attend the *World Festival of Folklore*, a children's dance festival sponsored annually by the cultural division of the government of France, in Matha, France, in July, 1993. There are usually no more than seven children's dance groups invited each year, representing countries from all around the globe. Over the years, more than 30 countries have participated in the Festival. The purpose of the Festival is not only to offer an opportunity to the participants for exposure to the cultures of other countries, but to provide, as well, a chance for the citizens of small French villages to come into contact with people from other countries. The L'il Foot Stompers was the children's dance team invited to represent the United States in the 1993 Festival.

The L'il Foot Stompers are presently involved in a fund-raising campaign to help defray the considerable expense to the families for their children to attend the Festival. Each family will be responsible for the airfare for their child, and for miscellaneous expenses. The children will be staying with French host families and will, therefore, not incur any expense for room and board. Presently, we estimate that airfare alone will be between \$600 and \$800 per child.

Our fund-raising activities will include sales of various products, car washes, bake sales, and a pancake supper. The activity about which we are most excited is a clogging festival to be held in Cumming, Georgia on May 15, 1993. The cost of the festival (\$8 for dancers and \$6 for non-dancers, advanced reservations) will include three one-hour workshops conducted by Scotty Bilz, a spaghetti dinner, and an evening of exhibitions. Tickets will be sold at the door at a slightly higher price. Of course, we are, as well, seeking outright donations and sponsorships from corporations and community groups.

A few wanted pictures with the teacher, others wanted a picture with their special friend or whatever struck their fancy. Well, up came this particular group of whom I have enclosed their picture. These ladies all happen to be good friends as well as about the same ages. They arranged themselves and were ready with their smiles as soon as the photographer said "say cheese." The photographer being the clown he always is did not tell them to say "cheese," he instead looked into the lens, grinned, and said "let's hear it for the 'Geritol' gang." This picture is the result of their reaction to his comment. And I just wanted to share it with your readers. Cloggers, wherever I have met them, are THE BEST PEOPLE and are ever ready to have the most fun times they possibly can. We always have a great time when we get together and I have made MANY friends since becoming a clogger.

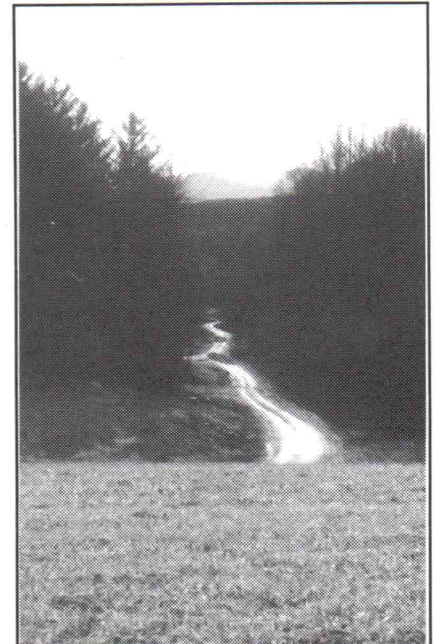


Dear Bobbie,

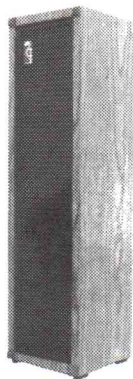
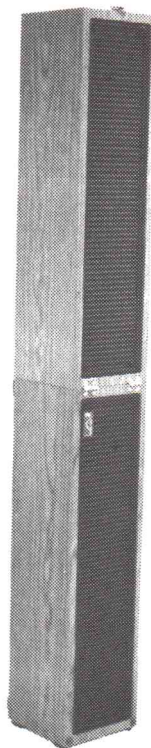

TEACHER ACCREDITATION PROGRAM

This month's T.A.P. offers for your interest the topic of networking. Networking is a catchphrase of the 80's which has been used to describe our insatiable thirst for communication. The information age has changed our lives forever. Our cuesheets are in the computer, ready to modem or fax to any interested party. We spend countless dollars on workshops, seminars, publications and videos to get the latest in teaching techniques and current material from clogging's "National" instructors. What I think we sometimes forget is the amount of wisdom held by those in "the trenches" — the local clogging instructors or team directors doing most of the teaching, directing and promoting of clogging in the world today.

Most public workshops are structured in a way to get material to a great number of people at one time. As a social event, it can't be beat. I still get my drawers in a wad over instructors who don't want their students attending workshops. "If there is something I want them to learn, I'll teach them." As Bugs Bunny would say, "What maroons!"

I know instructors like getting material for their teams and classes from workshops, but they're robbing their students of such a growing, learning experience. I digress.

My point is, workshops just aren't designed in such a way as to give instructors a chance to mingle and exchange ideas. Clogging publications plead monthly, quarterly, or whenever about the need for articles. Instructors just don't send much. I've heard instructors say that they really don't have any ideas good enough to print. I think they're selling themselves short.

One of the components of the T.A.P. program I'm especially excited about is the instructors notebook — a collection of ideas, articles, handouts and outlines covering a range of topics. We've asked (and extend an open invitation to) instructors to submit ideas, etc. for inclusion in the notebook. Those whose ideas are used will receive the entire notebook at no charge. Those who wish to purchase the notebook, without a submission, can do so for \$25.00.

Networking: Overcoming the Fear of Sharing Ideas

The idea is to encourage instructors to share ideas. The problem is, we haven't exactly been overwhelmed with entries. About 3/4 of those that I have received begin with the same introductory sentence, "I know this is stupid and you probably won't use it, but..."

Come on, you guys! I've received some wonderful ideas and handouts from instructors I would not have otherwise gotten a chance to share with. The true spirit of networking is an open flow of ideas, that gives those participating the chance to edit ideas to suit their needs and situations.

With that in mind, here's the pitch — take time to jot down some of the methods you use in teaching, running your club, getting sponsors, ideas for costumes, getting and keeping bookings, structuring your exhibitions, working with kids, adults, a mixture, handling stress, clogging poems, cartoons, funny anecdotes and experiences. You have something to offer others. Your opinion is as important as any of those who call themselves "National" teachers.

The editors of today's clogging publications would like to be just that — editors — professionals who take a vast array of material and determine that which is for publication.

Networking will happen when we loose the attitude that "nobody wants to read my ideas," and take pride in saying "this works for me, I hope it can be of help to you." Go ahead — grab that notepad full of unanswered phone messages (a confession) and get a clean slate. Start easy. How do you teach your classes? What method do you use to explain the double-toe? What rules do you have for your club or group? We'd love to network with you. Send your ideas to your favorite clogging publication, your local or state association, and to the Teacher Accreditation Program. You have something important to offer. Good luck and happy clogging!

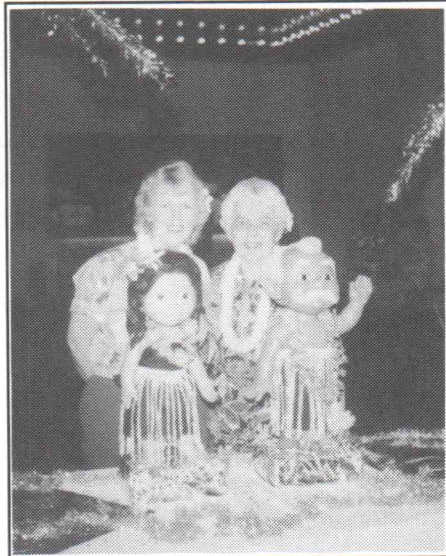

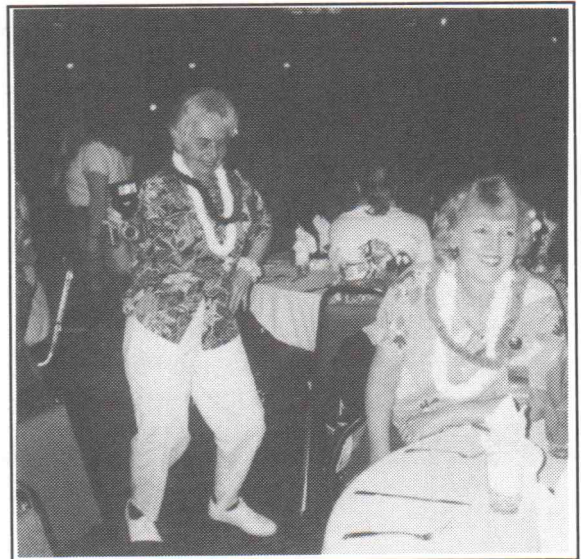

Chill-Out Tips for Hot-Weather Workouts

Your body likes to keep things around 98.6°F inside, so when you generate heat through exercise, your body has to get rid of it. Sweat is the body's own air conditioner. When sweat evaporates, it cools the skin and helps regulate your body temperature. In Florida, however, some days are so hot and humid that sweat can't evaporate and body temperature rises. If it gets too high, you may suffer heatstroke, a serious medical emergency that can prove fatal. Heat exhaustion — a precursor of heatstroke — is likely to alert you to trouble. Symptoms include extreme fatigue, headache, nausea, dizziness or shortness of breath.

The temperature at which these symptoms occur will vary with the individual. If you like to exercise outdoors during Florida's hottest months, don't lose heart. Bryant Stamford, PhD, exercise advisor for *The Physician and Sports Medicine* magazine, offers a few smart tips to help you avoid heatstroke.

- Respect the heat. Hot, humid, sunny weather is a potentially life-threatening challenge to your body.
- Monitor environmental conditions before exercising and adjust your workout accordingly. Exercise in the coolest parts of the day: early morning or after sundown.
- Avoid dehydration. Drink water before, during and after your workout, even if you are not thirsty. You will quench your thirst long before you replenish your body's fluids. Water works well, but commercial sports drinks help replace the salt and potassium lost in sweat.
- Wear loose-fitting clothing that allows air to circulate to your body. This helps promote sweat evaporation.
- Allow sufficient time to adjust to new climates — anywhere from a few days to two weeks.
- Restrict hot-weather activity if you are older, markedly overweight, have heart disease or have experienced heat injury.
- Ask your doctor about the effects of any medications you are taking. Some may reduce your heat tolerance.
- Stop exercising at the first sign of heat illness. Cool yourself gradually by going to a cool spot, drinking fluids and, if possible, changing into dry, loose clothing.

DANCE — TAP ROOTS

Dancers needn't be dance historians: they can get all the history they need simply by being alive to the act of dancing. Sometimes, however, it happens that they luck into a time and place where they can see themselves as part of a tradition in the making. This seems to be the case currently for virtuoso tap dancers. As Gregory Hines and Brenda Bufalino observed in a recent public forum, tappers are enjoying a golden age now, in the sense that their field simultaneously contains master elders, stars in their prime, and dazzling Young Turks, all of whom appreciate each other's gifts and understand each other's place in the time line. This understanding can make for brilliantly unpredictable performances, where dancers take the sorts of imaginative risks that are routinely found in a community in which refined appreciation is a given.

Any New Yorker can be a part of that community. One way is by attending tap evenings around town. Another is by catching up with the past through historical films. On January 27, you can see an entire evening of them — six decades' worth — at Lincoln Center's Walter Reade Theater. The program will include clips of the young Nicholas Brothers, the Berry Brothers, and the lightning-footed Bunny Briggs. And on February 15, the New School is holding a seminar, with "im-promptu performance," on a hundred years of tap-dance history, with Mr. Hines, Ms. Bufalino, Ira Bernstein, Savion Glover, Jimmy Slyde and other guest artists.
