Arizona's Elaine Steele Goes "DOWN UNDER"

On the 20th of March I took off from Phoenix, Arizona for my trip to Australia, where I would be doing workshops in many different places. This trip was made possible through an Arts Development Fund Grant approved by the Gympie City Council and the Widgee Shire Council.

My first workshop was an introduction to clogging at the Gympie High School, and I also taught them an American country line dance. Then, I went to the Gympie Senior Citizen Group where I explained clogging and along with some members of the Moonshine Cloggers did several clogging dances of different levels. Later that same day I attended one of the younger groups who had done some clogging and taught them one of the dances we do here in the States. This group is associated with the Moonshine Cloggers and are named the Moonbeam Cloggers.

While in Gympie the local newspaper interviewed me and did a lovely article in the local paper. This was a small town and several times when we went shopping people knew who I was because of the picture in the paper. The Daily Mail, which is a Sunday newspaper for Queensland, also did a feature on clogging and interviewed me along with members of the Moonshine Cloggers.

My first weekend in Australia I was the featured instructor at their Annual Storm King Dam Campout — which was wonderful fun. One hundred-eight cloggers from many parts of Eastern Australia attended and from Friday evening until Sunday noon we clogged, talked clogging and clogged some more. Some of the local instructors also taught and I got an introduction to Australian country-western music. I brought some music back and I hope to teach some of the routines that their local instructors choreographed.

My stay in Gympie ended too soon and it was time for me to head south to do some workshops. One of the local instructors, Edith Sandy and her husband Dean, were kind enough to drive me to the different cities and we had a really fine trip.

Appalachian clogging has become very popular over here in the last few years with visits from Eileen Carson and the Fiddle Puppets and occasional visits from teams from the U.S. such as "The Wild Goose Chase Cloggers."

Many of the dancers and musicians who have formed Appalachian clogging groups over here have, by and large, been involved with traditional British music and dance for many years. Others have been attracted to it by the energy of the dance and the excitement of the Old Time Tunes.

Although the teams in the U.K. generally dance as "Precision" teams, (in that we perform "rehearsed" team routines) we are unlike the "modern" precision teams which are popular in the U.S. We perform mainly at folk festivals and the dancing is not competitive.

Although the emphasis is on performing as a team, we also enjoy the chance to flatfoot and improvise. "Clog-Ins" are becoming more common over here and are popular with both dancers and musicians as they provide the opportunity for everyone to meet, play tunes and dance together.

We sincerely hope Kay will continue to keep us apprised of clogging activities in Merry Olde England.




We like to use brand new routines at our workshops, and include some new steps and a capella steps for competition level.



Our host motel, The Quality Inn on the beach, is a great weekend getaway location with indoor pool and charming restaurants.




Several people walked away winners:



ing. If anyone ever gets the opportunity to go "Down Under" take your clogging shoes — you will find the nicest cloggers there. But aren't they great everywhere?!






the table to take the above photo of the Red Devil Cloggers.



Clogging: The Best and The Worst

This month's article is a gentle reminder to teachers who may be mired down in the frenzy, politics and burnout of clogging — just what brought us here in the first place — what's GOOD about clogging. Of course, in the spirit of fairness (and in order to fill the page) I also offer to you my observations regarding the worst things about clogging.

THE BEST THINGS ABOUT CLOGGING

THE MUSIC.

Where else can you see teenagers alongside us old folks, gettin' it to the likes of Charlie McCoy, New Grass Revival AND Madonna.

THE PEOPLE.

How grass roots can you get? Sure, there's a few stinkers (some literally) in every crowd, but, for the most part, cloggers are the nicest people in the world. Why else would we drive 90 minutes each way to dance 45 minutes.?

THE PRICE.

Quit complaining. Dollar for dollar, compared to almost any other dance form or entertainment venue — clogging is still a Consumer's Digest best buy.

THE WORST THINGS ABOUT CLOGGING

THE ADDICTION.

It starts slow. Beginners class. Intermediate class. Beginner class again. You join a club, go on an exhibition, attend your first workshop. Soon it's every weekend and you're sharing hotel rooms with people you've probably never even invited over for dinner. Your neighbors wonder where you go and why the lights are on in the garage, but you never park the car there.

■ THE PHYSICAL AND MENTAL COMPLICATIONS.

You tap your feet alot — especially at church. You dance with your hands on the dashboard. You walk through the grocery going "Ball, heel, ball, heel, ball." Every time you hear a new song, you count the 8 beats. In the throes of passion, your mind races to that step you just can't do. You begin to talk in abbreviations. You DR around records in case someone asks "what's clogging?" (see, I told you you talk in abbreviations). You develop monster calves and find you can pick up dirty laundry with your toes.

OF SPECIAL INTEREST...

THE "I CAN'T STOP DANCING" SYNDROME
Usually hits after 2 sets of classes and lasts for about
3 years. I've seen cases go one for ten years or more.
The symptoms:
☐ Multiple trips to the request list.
☐ A desire to talk about clogging at after-parties.
☐ Clogging in hotel hallways at 3 a.m.
☐ Taking the syllabus to the bathroom with you

☐ Wearing your flashing pin at all times.

☐ Actually getting excited when invited to watch the tapes of the exhibitions — all 43 of them!

Although this syndrome is perfectly healthy, those afflicted may be subject to disdain or envy from those suffering from laziness or burnout.

Next month's article will offer a ready-to-use proposal to help tie your club or group in with a radio station. The results can be mutually beneficial.






Vicky Dean, Instructor — Storm King Dam

As cloggers departed there were calls of "See you in Brisbane, Sydney..." When we can do it all again. A truly memorable time. We learnt so much.



Tips for the Novice Choreographer Who is Green Enough To Listen To Driggs for Advice

In an effort to help all those burgeoning choreographers out there who long to see their dances on the request list — I offer these helpful tips used by clogging's most respected instructors.

- 1. When in doubt, do a Samantha. If all your routines end up containing a Samantha, make one move to the left and call it a Samantha Vine, while another turns around the popular Samantha Turn.
- 2. Take a step everyone knows and change the name of it to fit the music. For instance, if you're choreographing to Achy Breaky Heart (which you should) do a karate turn and call it a Billy Ray Turn. Half of the dancers will be so confused by this they'll swear it's a new step...until somebody else calls it a Madonna turn.
- 3. Think up a new way to write cue sheets. Draw lines, feet, arrows and an array of L's, R's and abbreviations. Thow in a few slashes and hyphens. They'll love you for it!
- 4. Find a song that hasn't been around for years. This way, you know no one will be teaching to the same music you are. This is also a great way to get acquainted with clogging's vendors who will all be calling you to find out just where the ----- you found this ancient vinyl.
- 5. Make sure your routine has lots of turns, faces all four walls at least 3 times and has lots of hand moves. Today's clogger likes a challenge. Meet that challenge head-on with a routine that would even make Jeff Parrott dizzy.
- 6. Change your routine while you teach it. It's an artistic prerogative. Just don't tell the crowd you are doing it. They enjoy trying to figure it out themselves from the new cuesheet format you learned in number 3.
- 7. Don't wear clogging shoes. They're very distracting when you're teaching a very intricate buck or Canadian step. Nike hightops will give you that clear, rubbery, old man with gas sound that cloggers appreciate when learning hard steps.
- 8. Dress the part. Follow the lead of clogging's national instructors. From the untucked look, to the Garth Brooks starter kit, to a bat suit...fashion statements abound. Gain weight and get teenagers to demonstrate for you. And don't forget to work on your impressions and corny jokes. Cloggers don't come to workshops to learn, they come to PARTY!
- 9. Advertise. Take out a full-page ad in the *Double Toe Times* each month offering your services. (Item #9 paid for by the DTT.) EDITOR'S NOTE: *NOT!*
- 10. Always be pleasant. Courteous, kind, helpful, friendly ...(I'm sorry it just came back to me) Even when you've taught eight straight classes in a row, haven't done your video session yet, and are in serious need of Gold Bond Powder.

I certainly hope these suggestions have given you the burning desire to try to count the beats of any rap song. I wish you luck. I wish you bookings. I wish I could think of something serious to write about.

"Lest We Forget America's Clogging Hall of Fame

Several weeks ago I was teaching a group of young cloggers mountain figures when the director suddenly asked, "Could you please put some shoes on that have taps, we can't hear you stomp the floor with the shoes you have on?"

To answer my friend, I have never worn taps. I like to keep my style of clogging pure and simple. Let me explain please...

When I first started clogging in Franklin, North Carolina at the age of four, no one had ever heard of taps. I'm now 58 years of age and have done without them this long, so why rush out and buy a set. It's all I can do to walk and chew chewing gum at the same time. I would probably fall flat on my somewhat and bruise my otherwise if I tried to dance with them.

The late Hubert Hayes, known as the Master of Heritage and founder of the legendary "HUBERT HAYES MOUNTAIN YOUTH JAMBOREE" that was held each spring in Asheville, North Carolina would never allow cloggers to use taps at his festival.

I love bluegrass music. To me there is no sweeter sound than the crying of a fiddle, the clear-ringing of the five-string banjo, the beautiful pitch of the mandolin, the rhythm of a guitar backed up by the upright base being played without amplification. Add to this the shuffling of feet, a sprinkling of mountain figures and the late Sam Queen of Soco Mountain fame calling the set, my friend you have true Southern Appalachian Clogging at its purest. Clogging feet and traditional music should complement each other, with neither over-riding the other.

In defense of those who use taps, I take note of Bob Johnson's Flatland Cloggers. He has skillfully worked into several of his routines a segment when the teams dance a cappella for around 30 seconds. This to me is a work of art and lets me, as a judge, listen to the rhythmic beat of the dancers in some of the more difficult step changes used in the routines.


