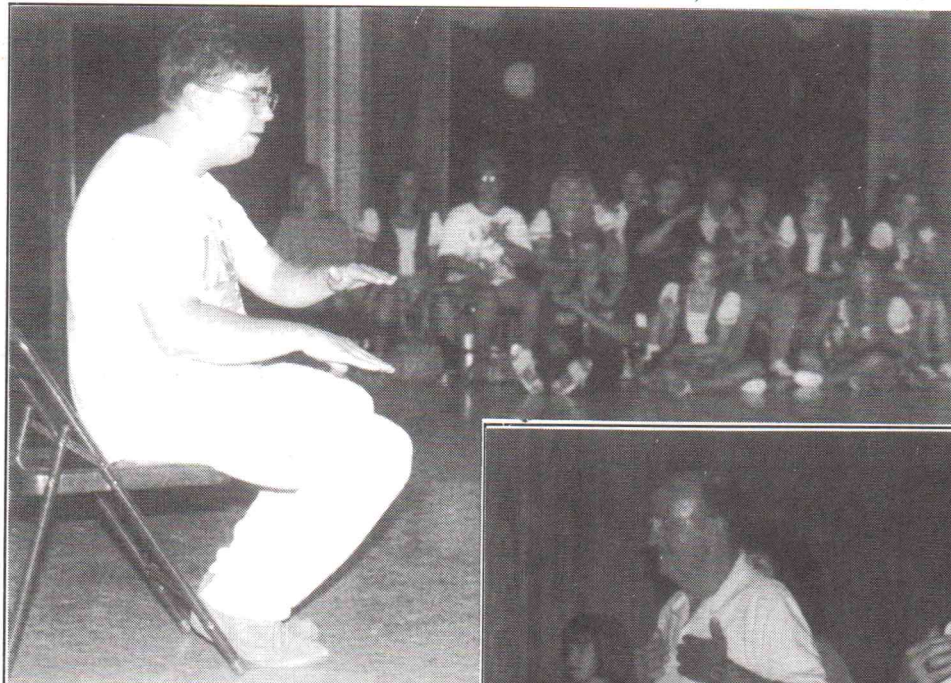

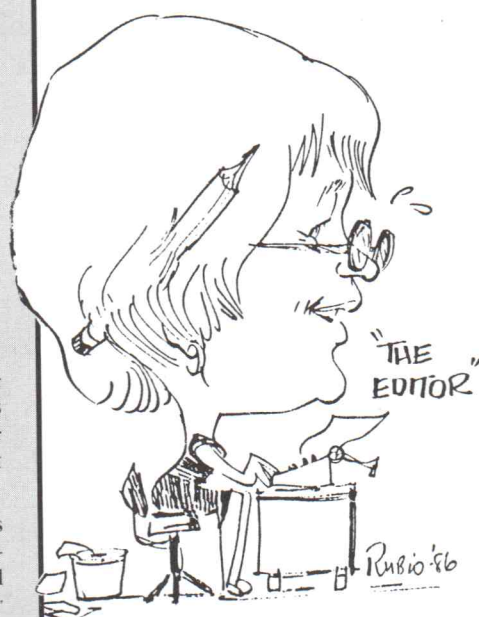

Dear Readers,

On continuing education: As a writer, editor and publisher I have somehow been put on several mailing lists for seminars designed for the print trade. *Design a Better Publication*, *Speech Writing for the 90's*, *How to Write Headlines*. Most of us who like our jobs are always eager to broaden and improve our skills. The brochures are tempting and the public relations specialist who put them together is a real pro. Until I get to the bottom line — how much? \$590 for a two-day seminar in Atlanta (not including meals or hotel or air fare) is beyond my means. For \$100 extra I can have one of their staff evaluate my publication and point out areas needing improvement. Please don't misunderstand — I'm not denigrating these seminars. I truly wish I could attend. Instead I haunt the bookstores (both local and the University) and the

library for anything on how to design a better magazine.

This past week I had an interesting phone conversation with a dance studio teacher/owner who has recently added "clogging" to her classes. She had been a clogger many years ago and wanted to begin attending some clogging conventions. After we reviewed some of the conventions, workshops and jamborees coming up, she asked what it cost to attend. When I stated that they range from \$10 to \$25 per person, she exclaimed "You're kidding!" I assured her I was not and asked if she thought this was high. It seems she had just attended a one-day dance studio seminar which (a) was boring; (b) she didn't get much out of it; and (c) *the cost was \$250 per person!*

There are obviously some differences here. A dance studio is a BUSINESS, offering many dance forms. Students probably would not want to participate in a dance studio seminar aimed at studio owners.

Our conventions and workshops are designed to accommodate both dancers and instructors for primarily one type of dance — clogging — at all levels.

A workshop for *instructors only* has been done by a few state associations. . . Northern California, Florida, Oklahoma and Michigan come to mind.

Apparently the desire for *continuing education* among clogging instructors is strong. When I suggested to Jeff Driggs that he put on a T.A.P. workshop here in Central Florida, I really thought we'd attract only 20 or 25 local folks. I even volunteered to provide lunch and to host it here in my home.

Nearly 70 instructors and friends signed up and we moved it to the Longwood Recreation Center. We even had instructors from Alabama and Michigan! Read about it in this issue!

P.S. Here's a picture of my Sadie, smiling! (She's under my desk at the moment, trying to catch a lizard that slipped in the door.)

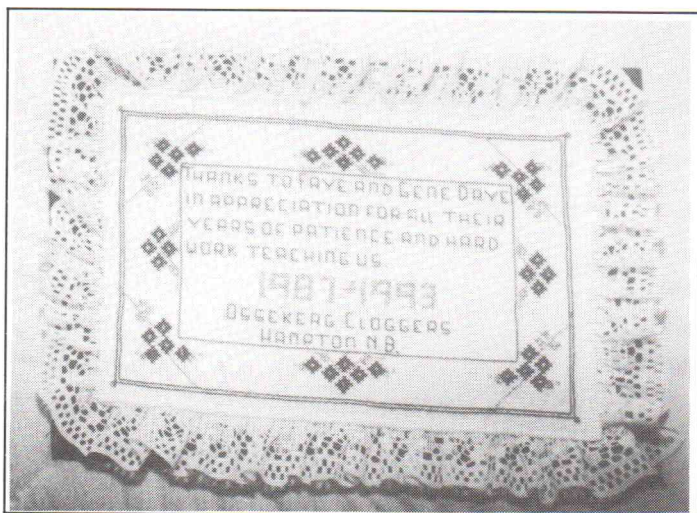
and leaders who attended from every state in Australia. The styling and precision of their routines was exciting and inspirational. It was a pleasure to learn new dances as they were taught by the choreographers, especially the bubbly comedienne of clogging, Diane Wells and the husband and wife team of Janie and Milton Strange. The teachers, Diane, Kim, Janie, Milton, Drew, Mike and Donna, as well as the other team members, were worthy clogging ambassadors. Nothing was too much trouble to help dancers and promote clogging. (Only hours before they were due to fly out of Brisbane they were able to do a demonstration and interviews for a national television network program.)

Our visitors did find some time to do a little sightseeing. They got to cuddle koalas, watch some sharks and crocodiles, and to feed and talk to several kangaroos, (especially Diane Wells, who had so many questions to ask them).

I'm sure that we will see some of them again, when we are able to travel to the home of clogging, U.S.A.

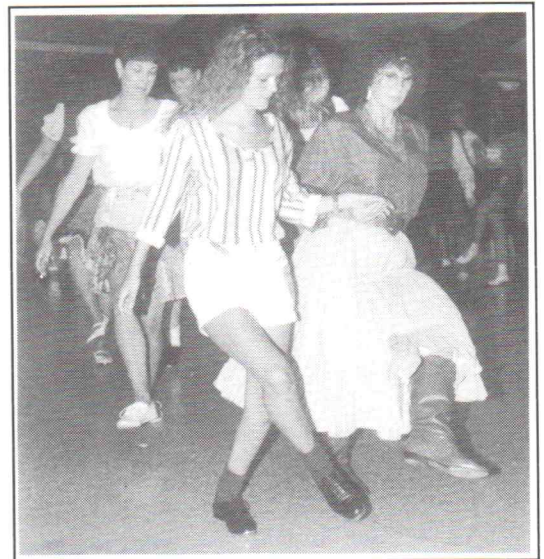

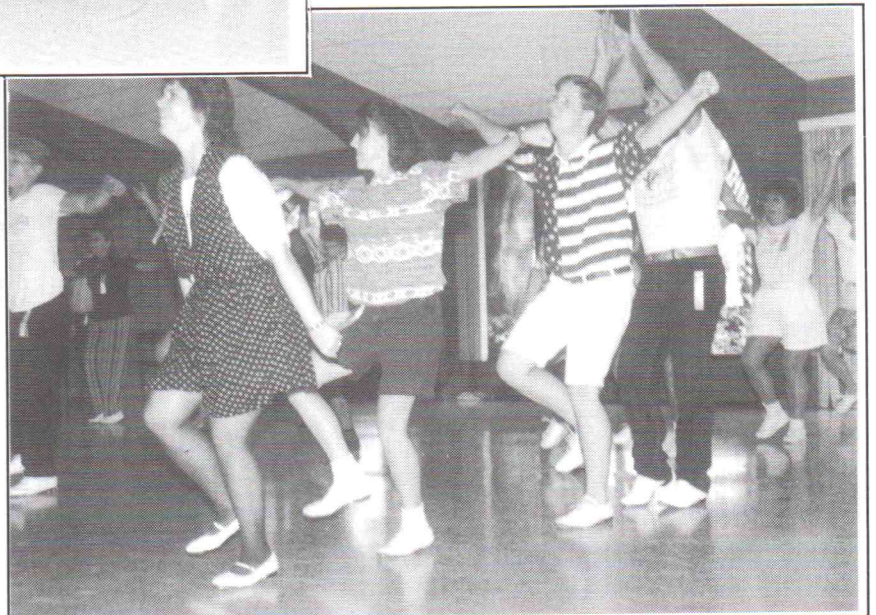

Portable Stage

Do you have problems performing on blacktop, cement, ceramic tile, grass, and smooth terrazzo floors? This may be a solution to those problems! One member of our group came up with this idea: a portable floor that could be carried in the back of a pickup truck or utility trailer and brought to wherever we may be performing.

The group purchased 16 sheets of one inch thick, tongue and groove 4' x 8' plywood, sanded on one side, and some strips of 3/4" thick x 6" wide wood, some #10 x 1 1/4" flathead wood screws, and a couple of gallons of high gloss polyurethane.

The originator of the idea then set to work on the construction of the floor. The smooth side of the panels were sanded, shop vacuumed to remove the dirt and dust off the sheets, and wiped down with a cloth and mineral spirits to remove any remaining dust. The top and bottom of the panels were given a minimum of two coats of polyurethane to protect and seal the wood. The 3/4" thick x 6" wide strips were cut into 4' lengths, and attached to the bottom (the rough side of the plywood) in the follow-

ing manner. See sketch. Our stage builder also color coded the panels that attach to each other so that assembly on site would be much quicker. You will notice in the sketch, that one sheet of plywood has two strips attached to it, and the other sheet only has one strip attached to it, and that the strips project out from the plywood sheets. These projections are where you attach the next set of plywood sheets to the preceeding set by placing the edges of the plywood sheets together and fastening them together with screws down into the projecting strips underneath. (Notice arrows on sketch.) This way there are no large gaps between the different sections of the floor.

If you don't want to color code with different colored paints, you may want to number the sheets that go together. When disassembling the floor for transport, just remove the screws that are into the projecting tabs and take up the sections.

Note: If need be, extra 6" x 4' strips may be placed between the joint strips under the floor for added strength and reduction of springing up and down of the plywood sheets.

The sixteen panels allow us to make a dancing surface of 8' x 8' to a 16' x 32', depending on the number of dancers attending the demo. The entire floor can be assembled in approximately 20 minutes.

We hope this will be of some use to other groups.

This sketch of 4 pieces of plywood will make an 8' x 16' Portable Dance Floor.

Materials Needed:

3/4" or 1" thick x 4' wide x 8' long

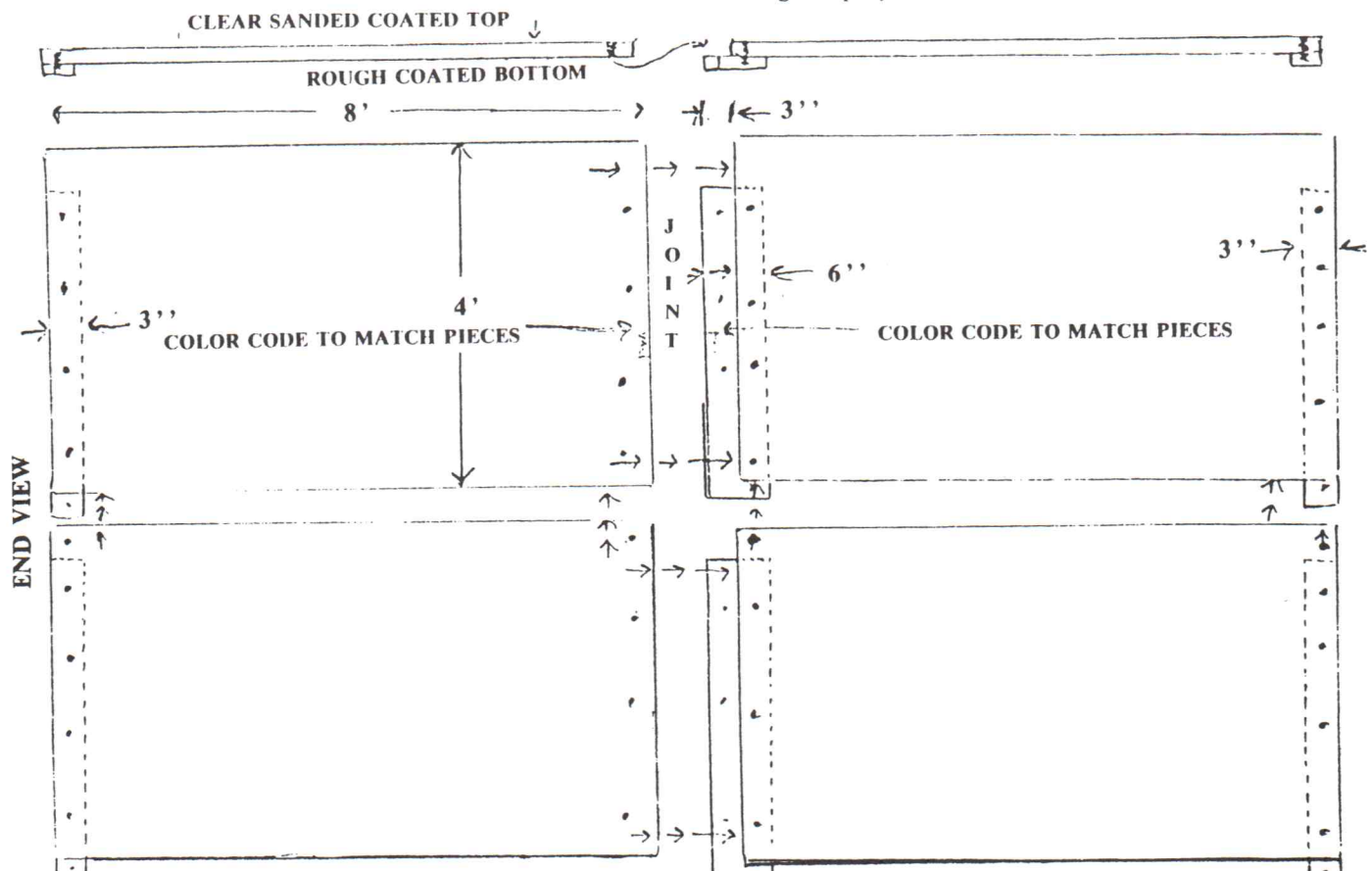

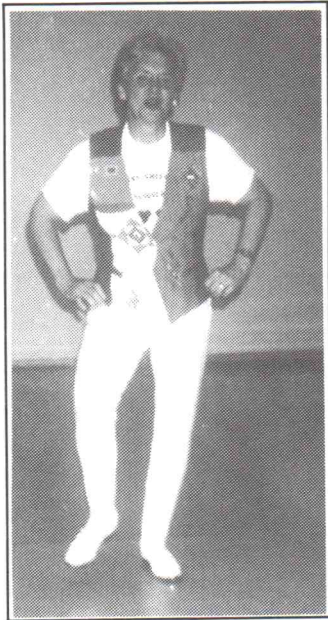

REMEMBERING HOLLYWOOD

TAP DANCES BACK INTO STYLE

Note to frustrated hoofers: It's time to get out the old tap shoes, put on some toe-tapping music and brush up on the waltz, clog, soft shoe, time step and shim-sham-shimmy.

For tap dance, that uniquely American art form, has not only become respectable again, it is also downright fashionable. Why else would we have a National Tap Dance Day every May 25, the birthday of the great tap dance king William "Bojangles" Robinson?

Congress established May 25 as National Tap Dance Day in 1989 — in a rare positive step for the arts — through a resolution authored by Senator Alfonse D'Amato, R-New York, and Rep. John Conyers, D-Michigan.

Both lawmakers called tap "America's only original dance" and said it was time the country recognized the work and legacy of dancers like Robinson, Fred Astair, Eleanor Powell, Ann Miller, Bill Bailey and John Bubbles.

The rebirth of tap was already under way, but the Congressional act has sparked an outgrowth of tap dance festivals around the country.

New York's tribute to tap — surely the country's largest — is a jazz and drama revue at the Museum of the City of New York, held each May.

Tap, which has its roots in African and European folk dances, was never a black or white, young or old, male or female thing. But it was black geniuses such as Robinson, Charles "Cookie" Cook, Peg Leg Bates, Sandman Sims, Bunny Briggs, Jimmy Slyde and "the Masters of Timing," the brothers Fayard and Harold Nicholas, who created much of tap's standard repertoire.

The Bomeshay and Suzy-Q, for instance, developed on the spot through improvisational rhythm tap, or challenge dancing.

When tap began to fall from favor in the 1950s, some blamed young black cultural leaders who associated it with racial stereotypes. Others said tap dance was buried in the rock 'n' roll explosion.

Fayard Nicholas probably had the answer when he said that after the television age began, "nightclubs, theaters and movies lost their interest in tap dancing."

Tap began its slow but steady comeback sometime in the 1970s. The revival of the Broadway show "No, No Nanette," featuring old-time tap dancer Ruby Keeler, may have helped. Then came the 1983 Broadway show "My One and Only" with Tommy Tune and Tony-award winner Honi Coles, the soul of tap sophistication.

Two other Broadway shows in the 1980s gave tap a leg up: "The Tap Dance Kid," featuring 12-year-old Savion Glover, and "Black and Blue," a musical tribute to American blues and tap dance.

The 1989 movie "Tap," starring Gregory Hines and the late Sammy Davis Jr., came out just before Congress passed the National Tap Dance Day resolution.

And 1992's "Jelly's Last Jam," starring tap artist Gregory Hines, drove home once again the universal appeal of this joyous dance.

It was, however, Bill Robinson who first gave tap its status as a genial, energetic and expressive art form.

Robinson, born in Richmond, Virginia, in 1878, never took a dancing lesson, but his artistry is legendary. He performed in nightclubs, stage and movies. His most famous films — like "Little Colonel" (1935) and "Rebecca of Sunnybrook Farm" (1937) — were made with child star Shirley Temple.

Robinson had various explanations for his remarkable vitality. One was that he soaked his feet nightly in hot water and two quarts of strong liquor "until they were drunk."

In a more serious vein, Robinson would often say: "I hear the music and something comes into my head which I send down to my feet. That's all there is to it."

Editor's Note: I've just finished reading TAP - The Greatest Tap Dance Stars and Their Stories 1900-1955 by Rusty E. Frank. Marvelous book for the serious student of any kind of rhythmic tapping of the feet! B.A.

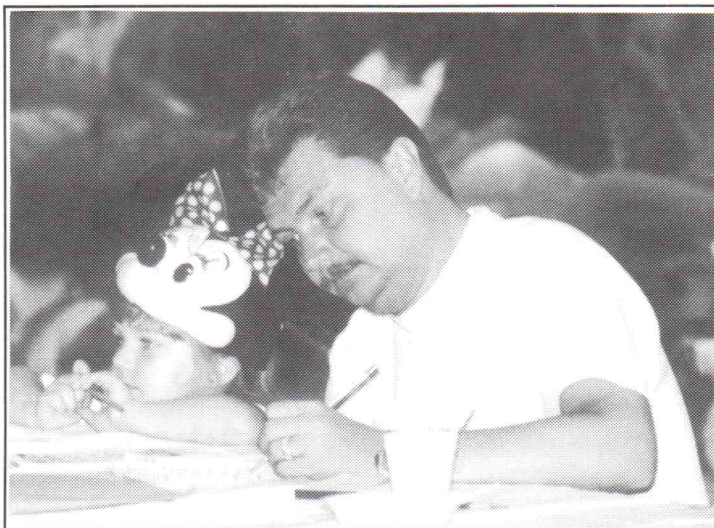

Poor Man's Variable Speed Tape Recorder

By Tim Spivey, Live Oak, Florida

Would you believe a good variable-speed tape recorder for under \$20? With some luck and a little bit of work, it's possible. The hardest part is finding the right flea market or yard sale. But my own experience makes me believe other folks could get lucky, too.

Here's how. It involves some simple modifications to an older-model tape recorder. The modified machine provides a good range of speed control, at least 6% slower and 9% faster.

Several years ago (10?), Radio Shack sold a small stereo recorder/player designed to be connected to a home stereo system. It has no amplifier or speaker and appeared in several models. It will play back through, and record from, your Hilton/Califone/Ashton/whatever. Sound quality is very good, and it has mike inputs, a normal-Cr02 switch, and adjustable output.

The recorder has been discontinued, but may show up at flea markets, yard sales and pawn shops. In the last few months, I've found two for \$10 each — in an area where the largest city has only 25,000 people.

GET THE RIGHT ONE

For this project, you'll need a "Realistic SCT-12"; the model number is on the top. On the bottom of the recorder, you'll see a tag with the catalog number 14-601. Try it before you buy it or get a return guarantee. (Other models might work for this project, but definitely not the "SCT-25".)

Next, find an electronics handyman — preferably one in the family who won't charge anything. Don't "do it yourself" unless you know how to work on electrical equipment. Take off the bottom of the recorder case. Then look at the motor and make sure it says "12 vdc" somewhere on it. If so, keep going. If not, you still got a bargain on a single-speed machine.

Remove the plastic top plate from the metal recorder chassis. There should be 7 screws holding the chassis to the top; one sits between the motor and the power transformer.

Next, visit your local stereo repair shop. You'll need to buy a 12-volt electric motor — a Mabuchi EG-530AD-2F variable speed motor with clockwise rotation and a 12-volt speed of

2400 rpm. I bought mine for \$7 from MCM Electronics at 1-800-543-4330; ask for catalog #28-041 (MCM has a \$25 minimum order on VISA/MC).

CHANGE MOTORS

Remove the motor from the recorder. Note: the SCT-25 uses a different motor and can't be modified this way. To remove the pulley from the motor, heat the pulley for 10-15 seconds

with a cigarette lighter and it'll slide off the motor shaft.

There may be a wiring diagram glued to the inside of the case; check it first. Cut the twin wires to the original motor and connect them to the new motor. The new motor is marked + and -; solder the wire with red marks to the + and the plain white wire to the -. Mount the motor in the chassis in the same place as the old one.

On the back of the motor is a small hole with a rubber flap. Hidden behind the hole is the motor

speed adjuster. To change the speed, you'll need to make a control shaft. Here's how:

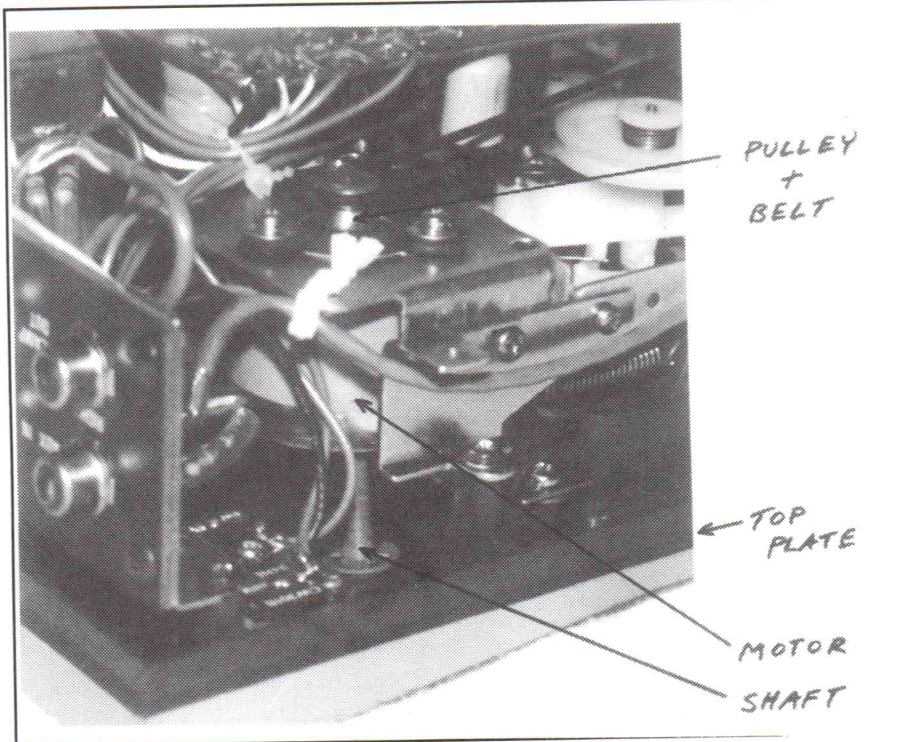
At Radio Shack, get a #64-2223 two-piece television alignment screwdriver kit for 99 cents, and a #274-407 hexagonal plastic knob for \$1.29. Also, get whatever cables you need to hook the tape machine to your amplifier.

FIT THE SHAFT

You'll be modifying the plastic end of the red screwdriver. Use a fine file or some sandpaper to reduce the diameter of the last 1/2 inch of the screwdriver. You'll need to get the diameter down to about 3mm, less than one-eighth of an inch, so it will fit in the motor hole. 3mm is about the diameter of a wooden Q-tip. Note: *don't* use a metal rod or screwdriver as the speed control shaft.

Be sure your modified plastic screwdriver still has a flat blade. Check to make sure it will fit through the hole in the motor, and into the slot in the speed control (go gently — you'll feel the blade slip into the slot). You may need to "sharpen" the screwdriver blade so the flat part is not as thick.

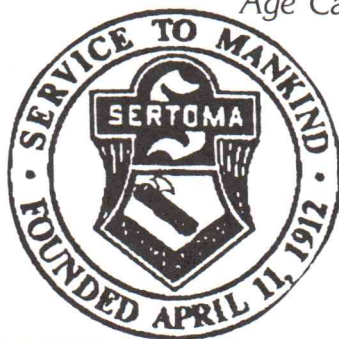

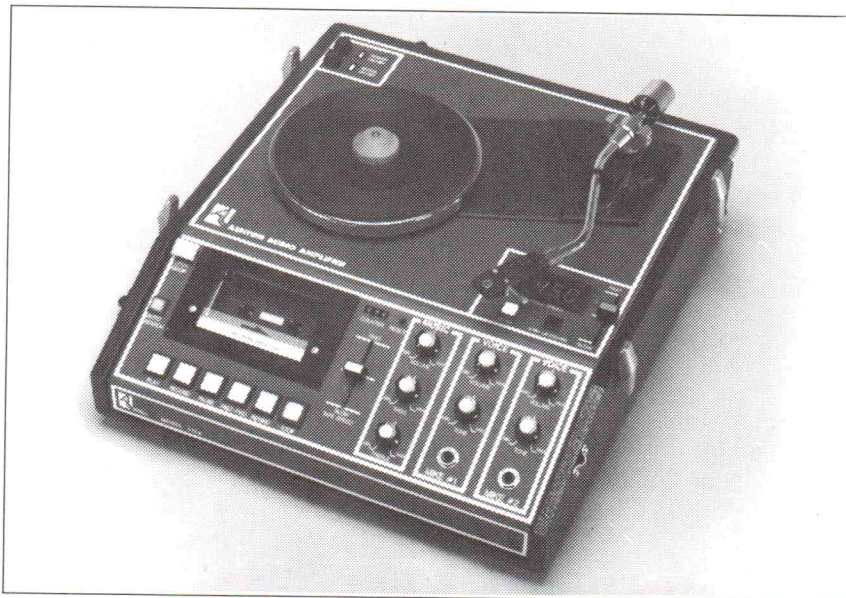

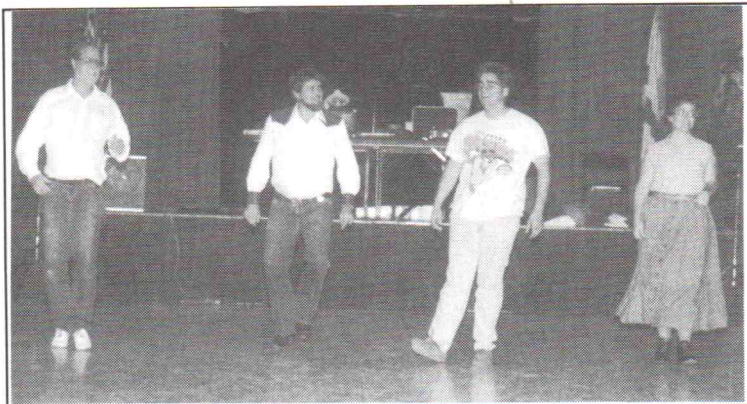

This year, again, two buses, a van and several cars making the trip with 108. We have won the largest group award for three years. Enclosed is a picture of some of the group with one of the buses.



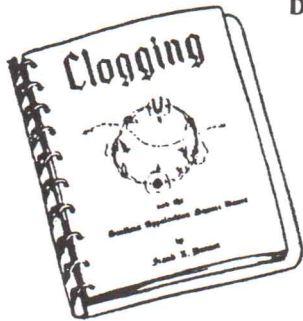
Homespun "Barn-Dance" Cloggers' Dance Recital

Poor Man's Variable Speed Tape Recorder

Don't turn the speed control more than a few degrees while you're checking. Now, make a mark $1\frac{1}{4}$ inches from the end of the screwdriver and carefully cut it off to make your shaft.

ATTACH THE KNOB

Mount the recorder's plastic top plate back on to the chassis (7 screws). Then make a $\frac{1}{4}$ - to $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch diameter hole in the top plate directly above the hole in the motor. There's plenty of room. The plastic is soft and can be cut with an Xacto knife if necessary. Blow any plastic chips or shavings out of the machinery.

Insert your new shaft through the hole in the top plate, into the motor, and into the speed control slot. Take the knob you bought, slide it over the shaft, and tighten the set screw in the knob. (If you want to keep the shaft from coming out of the motor, buy a small washer and a "C"-type retaining clip and put them around the shaft underneath the top plate.)

Finally, put some automotive belt dressing, not silicone or WD40, on the rubber drive belt and on the rubber strip around the white plastic wheel near the belt (use a Q-tip and just get the rubber damp, not dripping) — but *not* on the black rubber roller inside the cassette compartment.

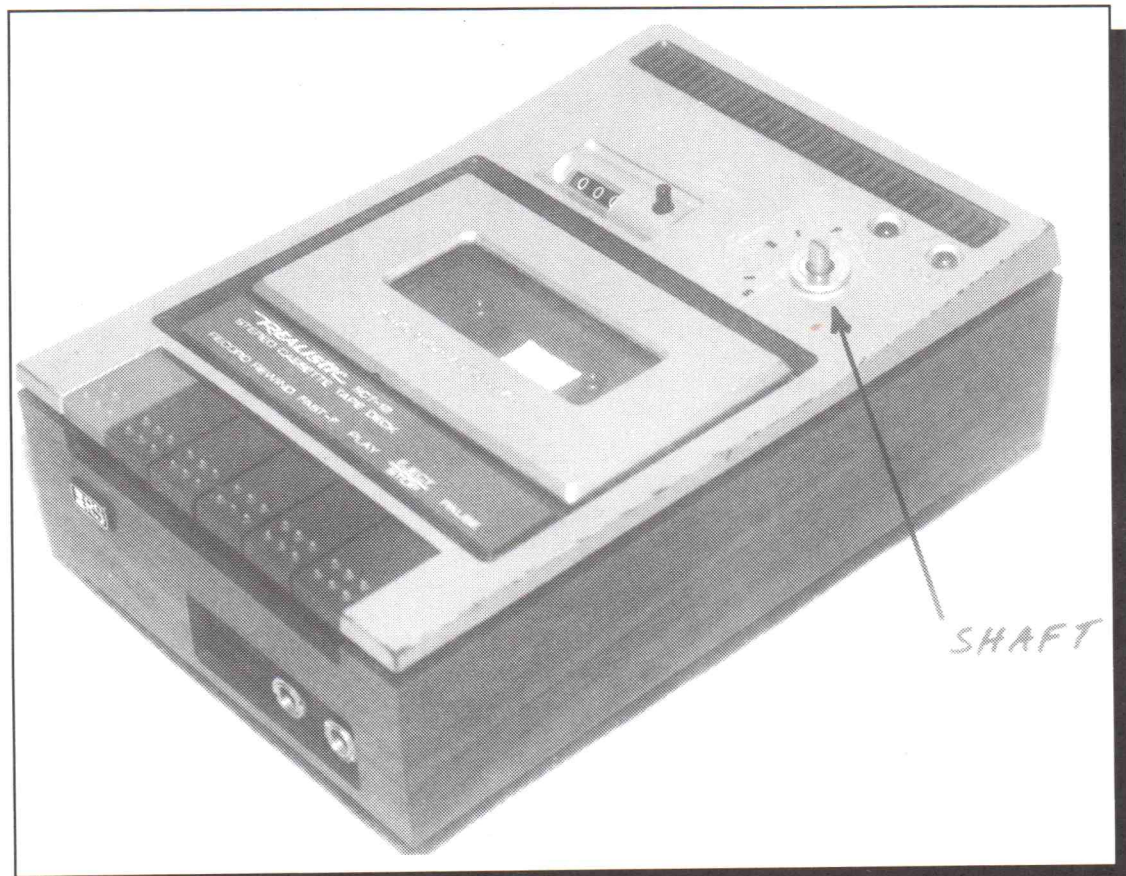
Put the bottom case back on the recorder.

CLEAN THE MACHINE

Before you play one of your valuable tapes, clean the machine's heads and demagnetize them — they'll need it. Buy a cleaning cassette and a demagnetizing cassette and use them every few months to protect your tapes.

Hook the recorder to your sound system. "Preamp out" on the recorder connects to the AUX IN or TAPE IN input on your amplifier. If you have a mono sound system (only one AUX IN jack), hook a "Y" adapter cable to the recorder first. You'll probably need to set the recorder "output level" control all the way up (clockwise).

The new knob has a white index mark on it. Play a familiar

tape and turn the knob until the tape plays at normal speed (NOTE: the new motor should come pre-set at the right speed). Then make an "0" mark on the recorder case by the knob's index mark. I made the marks on a piece of Scotch tape so they could be removed if necessary. Turning the knob clockwise will speed up the tape; counter-clockwise will slow it down. It may be a little hard to turn.

Finally, if the playback sound is dull or muffled, have the head azimuth checked and adjusted. Or, you can do it yourself the quick and dirty way. Look at the record/play head and you'll see a small mounting screw on either side; the screw with a spring under it is the adjuster. Play a commercially-recorded tape with some violin music, and use a jeweler's screwdriver to turn the screw either way until the violins sound the "brightest" and loudest.

REMINDER

If you use the modified machine to record from your system, remember to set the tape speed at normal first! You can use the SCT-12 to make custom tapes containing music and step cues. Plug a microphone into the right MIC jack on the front of the recorder, and connect the LINE OUT or AUX OUT from your sound system to the left AUX IN on the back of the recorder. When you press Play and Record at the same time, the machine will record the music on the left stereo track and your live cues on the right. If you play this tape back through a mono system, the music and cues will be "mixed".

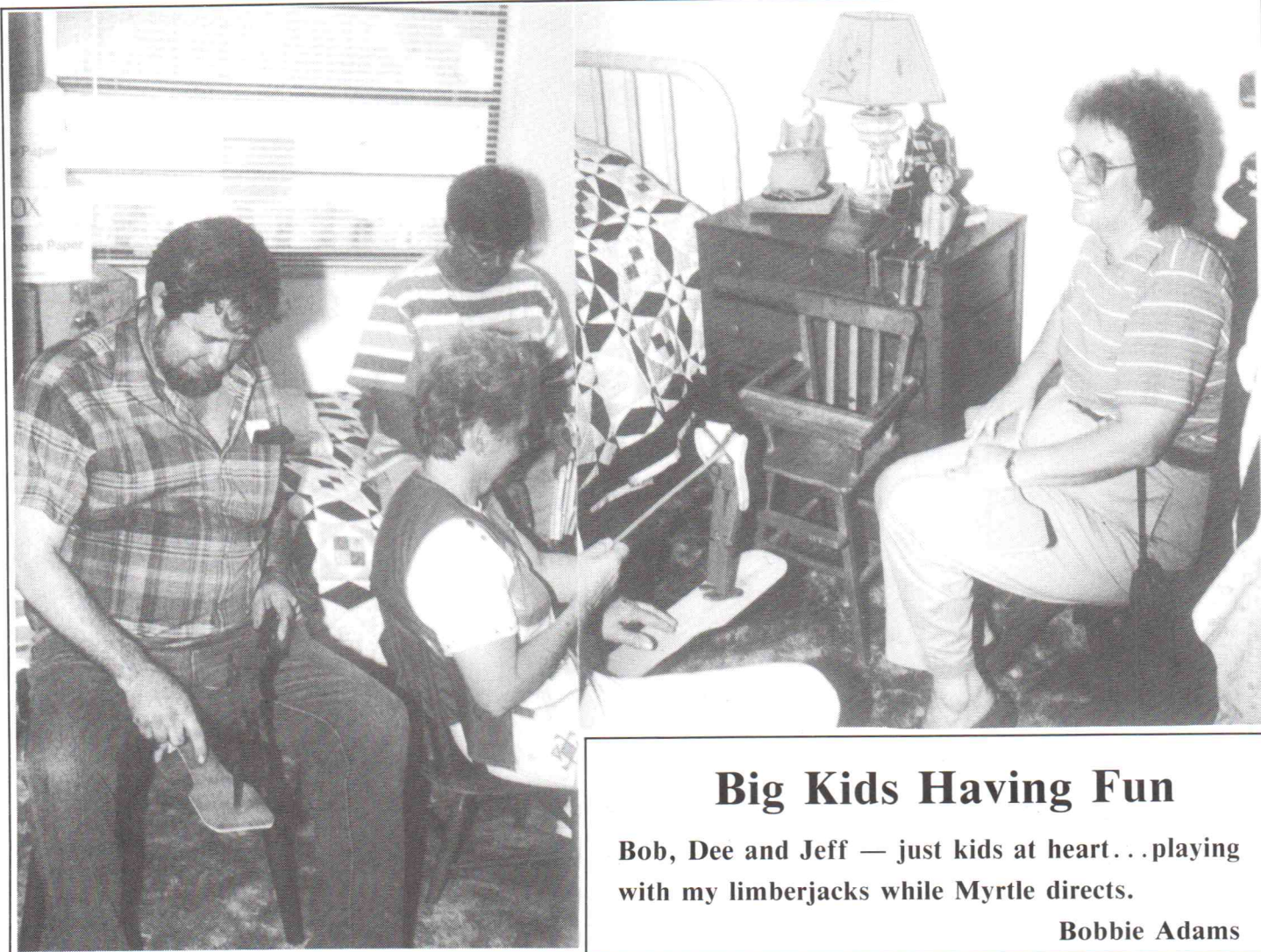
Dear Bobbie,

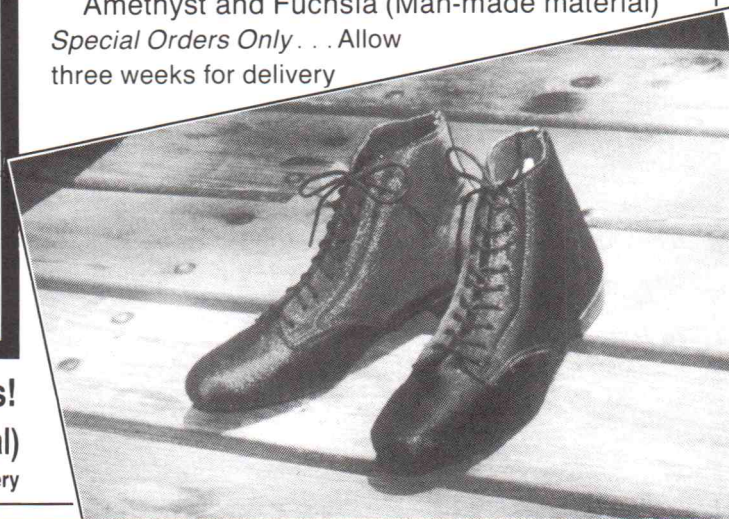
