CLOGGING HITS DENMARK

In August of 1993 I was part of a special group of dancers from various clogging clubs around Central Florida who had decided to go on a two-week tour of Denmark to introduce clogging. While in Denmark we were staying with host families and were able to see that life here is very much like the United States.

During our free time we would visit places like Tivoli Gardens or go shopping. The first Danish word the ladies picked up on was *Udsalg* which means sale. This was much to Nic Altuvilla's dismay because his wife was the first one to discover this. The rest of our time was spent performing at local festivals and places like Legoland.

Almost every evening we had a get together with the square dancers and folk dancers in the community we were staying in. Each group would do a short exhibition and afterward we would have a short workshop where cloggers would try to learn the Danish folkdance. Over and above all the dancing and everything

After we'd returned to the U.S. some of the Danes in Jylland thought it would be a good idea to get one of the cloggers to come back to Denmark and teach clogging. It was the job of the Americans to select a volunteer who could leave the U.S. for a minimum period of six months. Kristain Haldrup, coordinator of Club West Squares, had engaged the help of Danske Gynastik & Idraets Forening (DGI) to sponsor a clogger, organize the trip, the traveling within Denmark, and schedule clubs at which to teach. DGI is a national organization located in each county to arrange all the sports teams, dance groups, civic functions, and now clogging clubs.

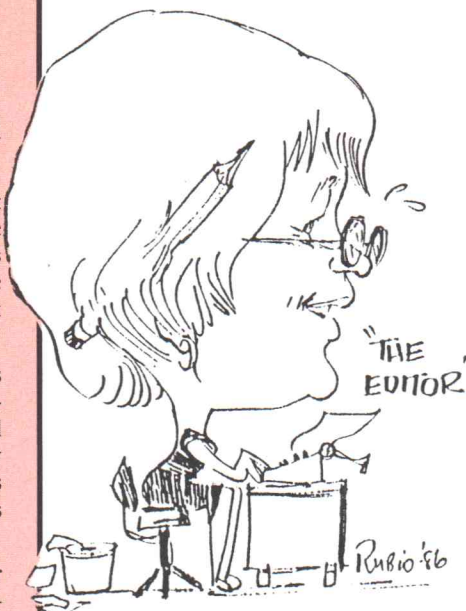

Who's T.A.P. For, Anyway?

Let me start with a little history. T.A.P. (Teacher Assistance Program) began officially in 1990 as a means of enhancing the annual Camp Clog Workshop held in West Virginia each Fall. We had been offering seminars for instructors as part of our events since 1986. Tandy Barrett and I felt that by giving special attention to the needs of instructors, they would become better teachers — drawing more students and providing more cloggers to attend workshops...like Camp Clog.

The service has a real trickle-down mentality. As a *promoter and business person*, it's Economics 101. Give something away and — not only will your image be enhanced — but your traffic will increase. As a *clogger*, I feel that T.A.P. has been a great way to share the knowledge I have acquired (and others have shared with me) throughout my 10 years of dancing and teaching.

T.A.P. was a quiet success until the Fall of 1992, when the concept of teacher certification was marketed as a big money-maker. Because T.A.P. was a free service, a great deal of interest was generated. We took advantage of this tide by bringing T.A.P. to national recognition by offering free seminars in conjunction with workshops nationwide. The response was overwhelmingly positive. The *Double Toe Times* graciously offered to provide a forum for the T.A.P. program, and this series was born. Throughout its run, Tandy and I have strived to instruct, enlighten and promote discussion on a number of topics and concerns relative to the teaching of clogging. (Continued on Page 27)

It is only a two hour drive for us — what more could anyone ask?

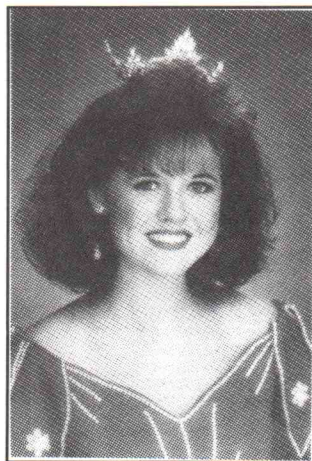

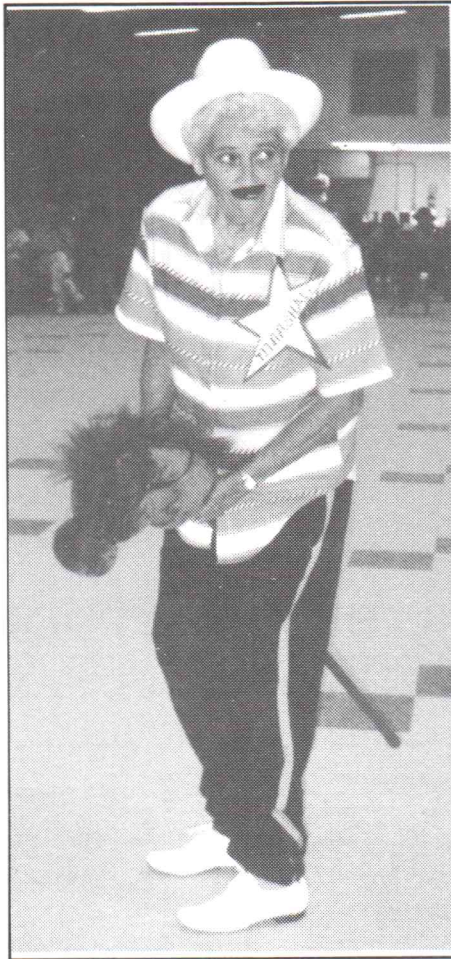
LaBelle Sidekick Cloggers Clogging Hoedown

This year's spotlight with the instructors was really funny and the spectators seemed to really enjoy it.

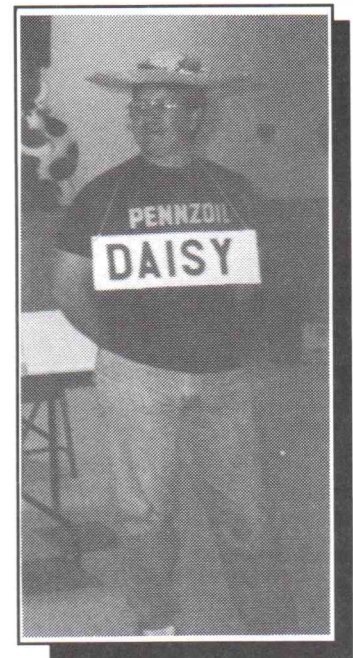

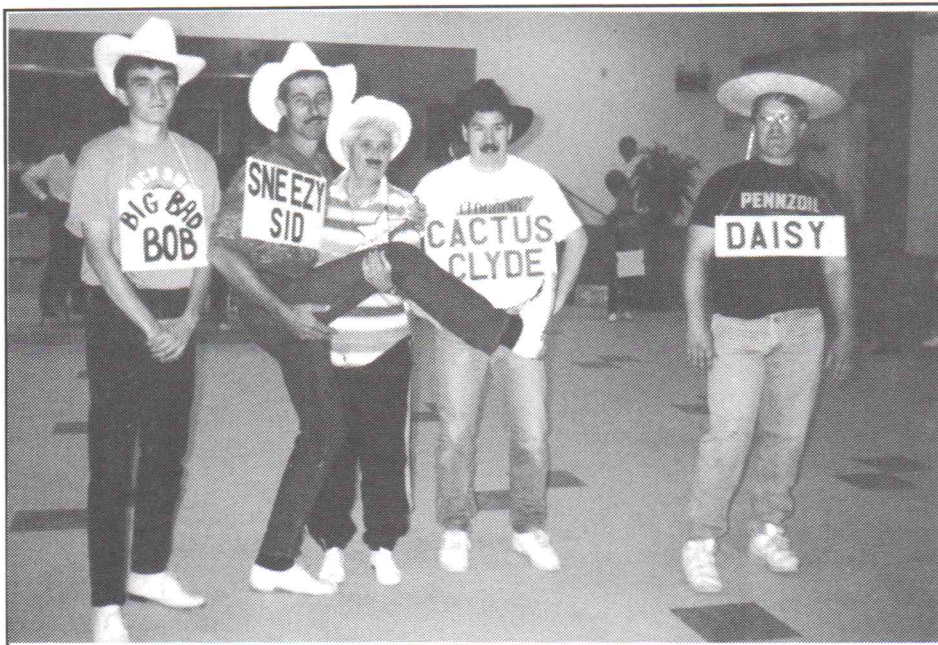

Clogging in Denmark Continued from Page 1

Club West and DGI were able to get enough support from communities across the country and generate enough interest with individuals to support clogging. Now all they needed was an instructor and about 50 pairs of shoes and taps.

After four months of going over old beginner routines I had forgotten existed and practicing techniques of teaching which I learned in Sunshine Cloggers in Maitland, Florida, I boarded a plane for Denmark.

I left Orlando on March 2 and it was about 85 degrees and sunny. When I landed in Copenhagen later that day it was about 25 degrees and snow was everywhere. Quite a change for a Florida native who has never seen snow! Now I had to get to the rail station and get a train for the cross-country journey which usually takes about 10 hours. Due to all the snow it took one taxi, two buses, one ferry boat, three trains, and just under 72 hours. When I got to Overlode I was thankfully told I had two days to relax and unwind.

My first class was Club West. The first day there were about 50 dancers and two weeks later there were about 75-100

dancers. The second class was in south-eastern Denmark in Ronnede on the island of Sjaelland (Sealand). I was able to get away from the snow for a few days and welcomed the kind of weather I'm used to in Florida. Rain. I spent two days in Ronnede then drove to Vissenbjerg on the island of Fyn in central Denmark. I taught there for one night but as I left they arranged for eight future classes.

As my schedule looks now I'm driving from one end of the country to the other almost every weekend with a class on almost every day. Most of the clubs are either square dance clubs or gymnastic dance teams. I have taught at a number of public schools in the area doing workshops ranging from one hour up to three or four hours. I've also had several classes in Gymnastic dance schools and even one class in an all-girl college for the arts. I have done performances at some high schools and have been asked to do some clogging workshops for several weeks.

Folkdancing and

Square dancing is a very popular activity in Denmark and most of the clubs range from 50 to 500 people. Since not everybody is able to do clogging I have recently started classes in Country line dancing and one-step and two-step and the response has more than doubled the amount of people in the classes. Some places have half the class time doing line dancing and the other half clogging and some clubs have arranged for one full night of each.

On March 26, Club West hosted a dinner party with a country group called the Rocky Tops and almost 300 dancers from clubs all over the area attended and we had square dancing and clogging and line dancing. We also had the first Danish mummy.

A few weeks ago I traveled to Copenhagen to have my first class with the Square Dance Partners club there and meet Margo Guzenhauser — the American who introduced square dancing in Denmark and now lives here.

Another American who now calls Denmark home is Loren Ramsey from the folk dance school and college in Berteau, Kentucky. He has been here for about 10 years, introduced and started a club that does American Folkdancing and every year there is a square and folk dance convention and this year there is a mountain-style caller coming from Kentucky and I will also be teaching a workshop in clogging. At the end of the day there is, of course, the grand march and there is going to be a live band playing blue grass and country music.

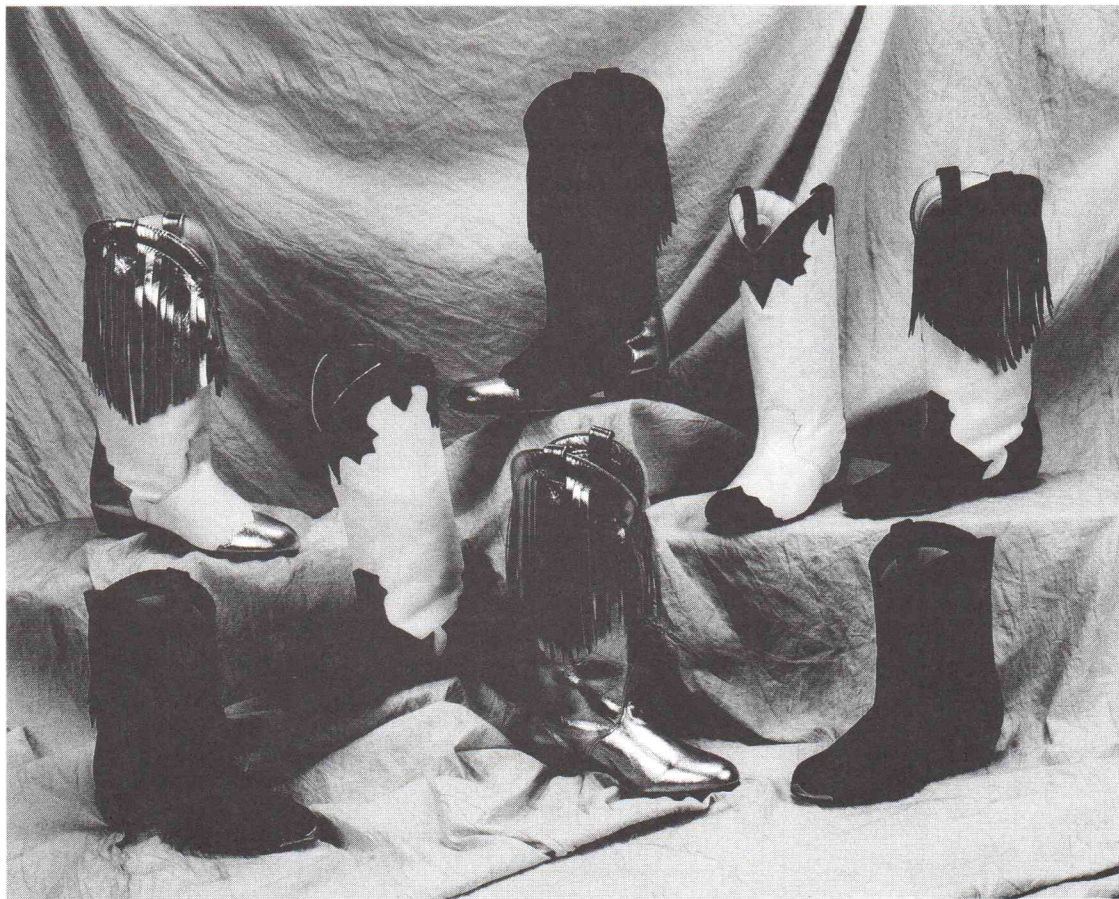

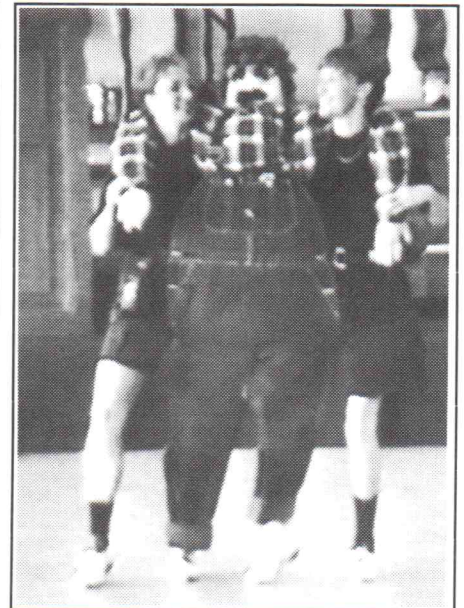

Lest We Forget

By Dan Angel, Founder America's Clogging Hall of Fame

Everyone always talks about how "Great" their duo or team fared at a competition and, if asked what route they took getting to the festival all they could tell you is the interstate.

Let's return to yesteryear. 1953 to be exact. Spring has once again returned to the mountains of western North Carolina and tonight begins another season at Helen's Barn. Nestled atop a 4,118 foot mountain, Highlands is the highest incorporated town east of the Rockies.

The dogwoods, daffodils, crocus and arbutus are in full bloom. As I leave Franklin to begin the 18 mile jaunt up the mountain the sun is winding its way toward the Majestic Wayah Bald. The road leads me along the sometimes lazy Cullasaja River up and along the hairpin turns to the awesome cataclysm known as Cullasaja Gorge that dips some 1,500 feet from the rim of Route 28. The only thing that is between you and your savior is a three foot stone retaining wall. Deep in the valley below the rush of ice cold, crystal clear water makes its way to the

Tennessee River on its final course to the mighty Mississippi.

Steadily my 51 Ford winds its way toward Dry Falls with its thundering water plummeting over 150 feet into a beautiful pool filled with rainbow, brook and native brown trout. The evening air is filled with fragrance of mountain laurel and cedar. Off in the distance a lonely hawk circles the sky in search of warm air that will lift him to greater heights so he can locate his evening meal far below.

The road meanders around the mountain and travels under the breathtaking Bridal Vail Falls that cascades over the car and showers us with a refreshing spray of cool water. Here we stop to get a drink of water before we enter the city of Highlands. The last golden rays of sunlight slips behind the lofty mountains and we see the summer resident scurrying around the Art Gallery and Bill's Soda Shop looking for some local treasure to take home with them. Later in the evening these same folks would be enjoying

clogging at Helen's Barn.

On the return trip to Franklin that begins shortly after midnight, we are once again out among the elements. God's Country. In the distance the full moon is climbing over Whiteside mountain and we are headed back down Route 28. We stop at Goldmine Bridge to get a much-needed drink of ice cold water from the crystal clear Cullasaja. Off in the distance a Whippoorwill ceases his midnight cry as a shooting star lights the heavens. 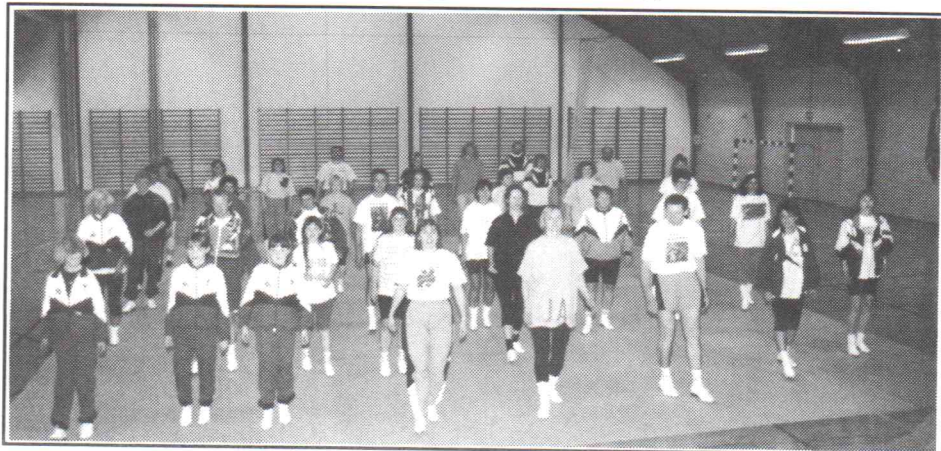

Lately, critics have questioned our motives regarding the T.A.P. Program — calling it a vehicle used only to promote its organizers. I certainly can't argue that the articles we've written have drawn attention to Tandy and me. Judging from some of the sensitive topics we've covered, and the stances we've taken, I think you'll agree that we haven't ventured to make friends in high places or buttered anybody's biscuit (as my Granny would say). Our ultimate goal has not been to draw battlelines, but to set a groundwork of fairness and positive thinking that will ensure the long-term growth of clogging and encourage instructors to excel.

Philanthropy carries with it warm fuzzies. Companies wouldn't spend millions on charitable causes and giveaways if they didn't think it would enhance their image. The bottom line is this: Regardless of the promotional benefits to the instructors associated with T.A.P., the program itself has been absolutely FREE. Tandy Barrett and I receive no stipend for the articles we write monthly, and we (along with the over half-dozen instructors who have participated) receive *no* payment for the additional seminars and all-day Sunday programs we have offered at scores of workshops throughout the country.

T.A.P. TEACHER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

It was our hope that the *Double Toe Times* articles would be a catalyst for local instructors to share their own methods and ideas for success. Monthly appeals for article ideas and stories have brought no response. Tandy and I feel that we will pursue T.A.P. through other avenues. We will continue to offer free seminars at workshops, and give free advice to instructors who request it.

Call me a weary soldier. I understand fully that my strong beliefs in many areas give reason for some to oppose me, and I have grown used to being the subject of gossip and innuendo. I choose — for now — to do what drew me to clogging in the first place — enjoy the good friends I've made and the dance I love. I plan to continue entertaining and instructing cloggers as long as they come to see me. I leave the fate of this column to you. Like many of you, the thought of one day teaching at a workshop or traveling beyond my home state, was once a dream to me. The opportunity to share your talents in a national forum is yours. You can make the T.A.P. article what it is truly meant to be — Teachers Assisting Teachers.
