A Frontier Christmas

A hundred years ago, Frederick Jackson Turner declared the end of the frontier era in America's history. It was a stark realization that we had crossed and colonized an entire country in barely half a century. Of course, Daniel Boone was pioneering new land in the 1780s and President Jefferson commissioned Lewis and Clark to explore the West in 1803. However, it was not until "Manifest Destiny" was proclaimed in 1845 that the mass movement of settlers began.

During the Trans-Mississippi migrations, pioneers carried their dance practices westward along with other treasured memories, as well as their hopes and dreams. The desire to settle new land was complemented by the determination to hold on to old customs and habits. Westerners quickly adapted their existing concepts of order and behavior in the towns and homesteads to which they moved. Jay Gitlin questioned how much "cultural baggage" pioneers transported to a new frontier. (1) He found an unwillingness to relinquish associations and practices of the homes they left behind. An earlier study by Roy Madigan also depicted the "sense of place" that cultural traditions provided for the westward pioneer. (2) He identified value systems, customs and behaviors as intangible manifestations of the place where Appalachians lived. Thus, the square dances of frontier settlements resembled the Running Set of the southern Appalachian area. The practice of group

entertainment at frolics continued, but with growing significance to its participants. The intimate communities of Appalachian experience faded away as life in the West created a different kind of isolation. Individuals were spread farther out across the frontier. The socialization afforted by occasional dances became an important means of bringing the people together in common play. In fact, so much of their lives were spent working on secluded farms that it was often the only alternative for interaction between the sexes. The calls and figures of America's square dance thus remained a vivid part of the nation's oral history throughout the 19th century.

However, with new communities of settlers from varying backgrounds converging in the West, fewer people remembered the figures; someone was needed to announce the calls so that everyone could join in the dancing.

If you, too, find yourself feeling this way I hope you'll remember that you're not alone. I hope that, like me, you'll *try* to focus on what's good *now*.


What serves as a true beacon for me is the knowledge that *you* are there for me... just as I am here for you.


Caramella on the Road

- and finally, to visit our friends and to make new friends and to see a lot of the beautiful American countryside.




Above and on right: Niagara Falls

All together on the boat. Last day in America.





J.C. Smith

October 6, 1930 - October 2, 1994

J.C. was the clogging instructor for the Electric City Cloggers, Anderson, was inducted into the National All American Clogging Hall of Fame at the clogging capital of the world, the "Stompin Grounds" in Maggie Valley, North Carolina. He was the 11th person to be inducted in the past 23 years. J.C. was presented this distinguished award for his many years of loyal and dedicated service in the quest to teach and preserve Southern Appalachian clogging. In view of his many accomplishments, he was not only recognized by his peers, but was named the 1993 inductee.

Born in Chicopee, Georgia, J.C. and his wife, Evelyn had lived in Anderson for the past 40 years. They have one son, Tony.

For 17 years J.C. worked in his church, Concord Baptist Church, with the youth and college students. He organized Boy Scout Troop #502 in Anderson and served as Scoutmaster for 12 years.

Following Scouts, he began teaching Southern Appalachian clogging. He preferred to clog to the traditional country bluegrass music which has a beat that can't be missed. He spent many hours with his clogging teams; which performed at all area nursing homes, county fairs, parades and festivals as well as Six Flags Over Georgia, Carowinds and other amusement parks and competitions.

J.C. enjoyed teaching clogging and knowing he was playing a part in keeping clogging alive for the next generation. He'll be sorely missed.



Janette Godwin

September 9, 1946 - September 24, 1994

In the September issue of the *Double Toe Times*, my article "Perserverance Prevails, Even in a Clogger with Leukemia," told of Janette's "never give up attitude" and strength to continue her clogging whenever possible despite visits in and out of the hospital. It told of how she was such an inspiration to all of us on the team.

My article ended when she was to re-enter the hospital to receive her sister's bone marrow for a transplant. Janette did receive the transplant, but complications set in and was never able to graph the new marrow.

She was a fighter and always alert, never complained, and won the hearts of all her caregivers.

I had the honor of delivering a eulogy at her memorial service and would like to share my closing comments.

"On behalf of the Company Shops Cloggers, we know Janette will not be here with us in body, that the absence of her dancing and laughter will be missed, but...we do know that her spirit will be preserved in us, in each and every dance we do, and each and every performance will be in her honor.

"Thank you, Janette, for your steadfastness, your perserverance, your endurance, and for touching our lives."



A Frontier Christmas Continued from Page 1

The caller thus became "the conductor of a living symphony of movement, a weaver of patterns whose elements are men and women." (3) Carole Howard suggested that the caller evolved in the West as a response to the frontier's lack of music. She pointed out the need for someone "to carry on the rhythm of the call." (4) In fact, this may explain the colorful rhyming verses, otherwise known as "patter," that survive in the square dance.

Bascom Lunsford once pointed out that in the Southern Appalachian region, the caller serves merely to prompt the figures, guiding the players in a way that does not distract from the joy of the music or the beauty of the patterns they dance. Garland Steele told me a long time ago that mountain dancing is called with very little verse, and not always on the beat. The caller is directing the moves as the dancers are ready to perform them, not necessarily to match a particular beat of the music. Lunsford recorded a series of square dance calls for Columbia University in 1935.

Eight couples, all catch up. Big ring, go left, half way back Circle four, turn and swing, Promende, go right Swing your partner.

His simple calls received new ornamentation in the western version. Circle to the left, going down south,

Take a little moonshine in your mouth,
Halfway round, go the other way back,
Make your feet go clickety clack.
When you get home, you're gonna stop and dance,
Swing that girl with the hole in her...stocking,
Knees keep a knocking and her petticoat's rocking. (4)

The use of a caller to direct the action on the floor broadened the reach of the dance tradition, allowing many nationalities to participate. Since announcing the figures was his primary responsibility, he improvised with rhyming verse to add to the entertainment of the dance. But the absence of women on the frontier caused a crudeness to develop in the language of the calls. Thus, it became more than directions for a square dance, but a record of its own survival, as each wave of migrants invigorated the dance tradition with new impressions of life in the West.

Perhaps the best reflection on a frontier frolic appeared in a poem written by Larry Chittenden in 1890. A West Texas rancher, Chittenden wrote about his experience at the annual "Cowboys" Christmas Ball" and poignantly characterized the excitement that accompanied the event. (5) The dance was held on the last Saturday before Christmas each year at the Morning Star Hotel in Anson, Texas. It was entertainment for the local cowhands and ranchers, who arrived at the hotel, checked their "shootin' irons" and spurs, and looked for a "padnah." The caller was W.W. "Windy Bill' Wilkinson of Stanton, Texas, who was clever enough to constantly invent new rhymes as the dance progressed. In cowman's language, Chittenden illustrates the frantic speed of the dance, as the "dust riz," dancers "galloped," and cowboys "buckled on" their partners to keep from losing them during fast swings. Their enthusiasm is evident. All the images of life on the frontier are crystalized in his poem and give us pause to wish for a simpler time, when life reaally seemed that extraordinary. I offer it here, in its entirety, as a gift of Christmas cheer.

The Cowboys' Christmas Ball

Way out in Western Texas, where the Clear Fork's water flows, Where the cattle are "a-browsin'," an' the Spanish ponies grow; Where the Northers "come a-whistlin'" from beyond the Neutral strip; And the prairie dogs are sneezin', as if they had "The Grip": Where the Cayotes come a-howlin' round the ranches after dark, And the mocking-birds are singing' to the lovely "medder lark"; Where the 'possum and the badger, and rattlesnakes abound, And the monstrous stars are winkin' o'er a wilderness profound; Where lonesome, tawny prairies melt into ary streams, While the Double Mountains slumber, in heavenly kinds of dreams; Where the antelope is grazin' and lonely plovers call — It was there that I attended "The Cowboys' Christmas Ball."

The town was Anson City, old Jones' county seat, Where they raised Polled Angus cattle, and waving whiskered wheat; Where the air is soft and "bammy," an' dry an' full of health, And the prairies is explodin' with agricultural wealth; Where they print the Texas Western, that Hec McCann supplies; With news and yarns and stories, uv most amazin' size; Where Frank Smith "pulls the badger," on knowin' tenderfeet, And Democracy's triumphant, and mighty hard to beat; Where lives that good hold hunter, John Milsap from Lamar, Who "used to be the Sheriff back East, in Paris, Sah." 'Twas there, I say, at Anson, with the lively "Wider Wall," That I went to that reception, "The Cowboys' Christmas Ball."

The boys had left the ranches and come to town in piles;
The ladies — "kinder scattering," had gathered in for miles.
And yet the place was crowded, as I remember well,
T'was got for the occasion, at "The Morning Star Hotel."
The music was fiddle an a lively tamborine,
And a "viol come imported," by the stage from Abilene.
The room was togged out goregous — with mistletoe and shawls,
And candles flickered frescoes, around the airy walls.
And "wimmin folks" looked lovely — the boys looked kinder treed.
Till their leader commenced yellin: "Woah! fellers, let's stampeed."
And the music sighin', an' a-wallin' through the hall,
As a kind of introduction to "The Cowboys' Christmas Ball."

The leader was a feller that came from Swenson's Ranch, They called him "Windy Billy," from "little Deadman's Branch." His rig was "kinder keerless," big spurs and high-heeled boots; He had the reputation that comes when "fellers shoots," His voice was like a bugle upon the mountain's heights; His feet were animated, an' a MIGHTY MOVIN' SIGHT, Whe he commenced to holler, "Neow fellers, stake yer pen! "Lock horns ter all them heifers, an' russel 'em like men. "Saloot yer lovely critter; neow swing an' let 'em go, "Climb the grape vine 'round 'em — all hands do-ce-do! "You Mavericks, jine the round-up — jest skip her waterfall," Huh! hit was gettin' happy, "The Cowboys' Christmas Ball!"

The boys were tolerable skittish, the ladies powerful neat. The old bass viol's music JUST GOT THERE WITH BOTH FEET! That wallin', frisky fiddle, I never shall forget;
And Windy kept a-singin' — I think I hear him yet —

"O Xes, chase your squirrels, an' cut 'em to one side,
"Spur Treadwell to the center, with Cross P. Charley's bride,
"Doc Hollis down the middle, an' twine the ladies chain,
"Varn Andrews pen the fillies in big T-Diamond's train.
"An pull yer freight together, neow, swallow fork an' change,
"Big Boston' lead the trail herd, through Little Pitchfork's range,
"Purr 'round yer gentle pussies, neow rope 'em! Balance all!"
Huh! hit wuz gettin' active — "The Cowboys' Christmas Ball!"

The dust riz fast an' furious, we all just galloped 'round, Till the scenery got so giddy, that Z Bar Dick was downed. We bukled on our partners, an' tole 'em to hold on, Then shook our hoofs like lightning, until the early dawn. Don't tell me 'bout cotillions, or germans. No sir'ee! That whirl at Anson City just take the cake with me. I'm sick of lazy shufflin's, of them I've had my fill. Give me a frontier break-down, backed up by Windy Bill. McAllister ain't nowhar! when Windy leads the show, I've seen 'em both in harness, and so I sorter know — Oh, Bill, I shan't forget, yer, and I'll oftentimes recall That lively gaited sworray — "The Cowboys' Christmas Ball."


