16th International CLOG and STEP DANCE FESTIVAL

On arriving at Altwood School in Maidenhead, some 40 miles west of London, every nook and cranny appears to be filled with dancers and players who are busy keeping alive one of Britain's oldest forms of traditional clog. In one room the Canal Boatman's steps, another the Northumberland Hornpipe, around the corner Dartmoor stepping, Lancashire clog, Scottish

Hornpipe; all these and many others are being handed on to a dedicated, energetic audience of dancers.

The aim of the festival is to encourage the revival of traditional step dance and is organised by the "Reading Cloggies," who themselves were founded in 1965. Workshops are graded according to difficulty and you spend the day learning the steps and style of one particular routine. Each routine is learnt to live music and the group works hard to find the right role model for each dance. When trying to master a style, from stance through to foot position; this is imperative and the festival scores highly with its impressive array of traditional dancers.

Throughout the day I observed workshop groups coming to grips with the intricate steps and styles that were on offer and there were two displays in the afternoon.

The first was the 'Performers Show' which provided entertainment from the tutors and visiting guests.

Dear Bobbie,

I have no excuse for being so late in getting this material to you. Please forgive me!

I read the Double Toe Times as soon as I take it out of the mailbox. I am really enjoying the traditional clogging articles. I think putting the designator by the "Old Time Instructor" is a wonderful idea. Anyone interested in an "Old Time Workshop" will know exactly who to call. I would love to go to a strictly traditional workshop. Even the younger ones are beginning to lean toward "traditional." I have noticed a change just in the past year. They are asking about workshops that have more traditional and hoedown style routines being taught. One we especially enjoyed this year was Easter Weekend in Durham, North Carolina with Joann Gibbs. Several traditional and hoedown style routines were taught by Anna Breeding, Elliott Skeen, Daryl Moreland, Bill Nichols and Garland Steele. All the instructors there were great. These stood out in my mind because of the traditional couple routines they taught. That was the Four Seasons Dance Festival.

Galax, Virginia, claims to be the "Old Time" capitol of the world — a sign upon entering the city limits says so. "Old Time" meaning the music and flatfoot dance so prominent in this area.

On any Saturday night a fifteen or twenty-minute drive can get you to any of at least three square dances where you can flatfoot or clog with or without a partner until you drop. The music is from any of eight to twelve different bands that live and play in this area.

On Tuesday nights in Independence, Virginia, fifteen miles from Galax, everyone is invited to the home of Blanche Nichols. Get there early so you can get a kitchen chair. Anywhere from twenty to thirty "musicians" show up with instrument in hand (or, in my case, tape recorder) to "make" music. It doesn't matter if you are a beginner or an accomplished musician, you are invited. If something strikes your fancy and you can no longer sit still, you can join the others on the kitchen floor. The furniture has already been moved out by the early arrivals just for that purpose.

Dear Bobbie,

In the August 1994 edition of *The Double Toe Times* you ran an article about a clogger with leukemia. They said they would like to hear from any other cloggers who had battled it, well, The Foggy Mountain Cloggers have a very special member named Andrea Negrete.

Andrea was born February 18th, 1972, and was diagnosed with acute lymphatic leukemia on February 22, 1977. She underwent



17 cobalt treatments three times a week for three years. She fought numerous infections as well as the leukemia. She had pneumonia six times that first year. In October of 1978 Andrea was diagnosed with neumosistus, a severe form of pneumonia. The doctors told her parents she had a 5% to 10% change to survive. In the three weeks she spent in Intensive Care, they did a lung biopsy and a tracheotomy to help her breathe, Andrea received eight blood transfusions, and was on chemotherapy until January 22, 1980. She has remained in remission to this date, and is now 22 years old. She has a slight learning disability from the damage done by the cobalt.

Andrea began taking lessons from me in August of 1989. She learns a new dance about every six weeks. She performs with my adult ladies line class, and is one of my most enthusiastic dancers. Her parents are also members, and her teenage brother was until recently. Her bright personality is evident at performances, and she often receives comments from our audience. We have performed for Muscular Dystrophy, The American Heart Association, and sponsored a child through St. Jude Hospital. In all of these, Andrea was our top fund-raiser, knowing that the money is so important to the people who need it. The people who are now where she once was. She is an inspiration to those who know her. And an inspiration to those battling leukemia. She beat it back when they knew so little about it.

I am enclosing Andrea's Senior picture, taken in one of our

outfits. Her sunny smile and bubbly personality are a definite asset to our group. In many ways, we're lucky to have her.





(Caution experienced dancers not to adjust)
Swing the nearest lady
Promenade Home.

These people are doctors (our anesthesiologist plays fiddle), lawyers, dentists, farmers, factory workers, homemakers and students. All are here for one purpose, to enjoy a good time.

Brian Grimn, whose music is on side A of the cassette, started playing here when he was about ten years old. He plays with the Konnorock Country Critters. Greg Hooven, who plays with the Ballard Branch Bogtrotters, started playing here when he was twelve. Greg was the big winner at the Galax Fiddlers Convention this year. Both guys play fiddle "old time." I use a lot of their stuff in my classes. I wrote a routine to Brian's group doing "Lost Indian," and I use Greg's "Cottoneyed Joe" to teach beginners the "Cottoneyed Joe." They love it.

On Thursday nights a forty-five minute to an hour's drive on Route 58, just before you get to White Top on Mt. Rogers, is the largest "jam" session I have ever been to. It's held in an old country store that is no longer in business. They pass the hat once a month to pay the electricity. So many "musicians" show up there they take turns. If you get up to go outside to smoke or whatever — you lose your seat. Seats being chairs, benches, stools or whatever there is to sit on. I have dozens of tapes I have made there. Everyone is welcome and they love the dancers. The floor is always full. You talk about "Old Time Flatfooters," John always ends up putting his banjo down and dancing with them. Most of these people are ones he grew up with and has known all his life. He picked up some of his steps from the "Old Flatfooters" who come there.

John plays "clawhammer" banjo. He has three banjos. Two Old Time (clawhammer) and one Bluegrass. The difference being Bluegrass has a resonator and the Old Time has a hollow back. Bluegrass is played with picks on the fingers and Old Time is played with the hand held like a claw. John plays what is called "dropped thumb." He also has a dulcimer a friend made for him who lives here in Galax. He has tried to teach me to play, but so far what talent I have is in my feet. I even bought a fiddle a few years ago. I thought that would be easier to play. I can saw out a little bit of Boilin Cabbage and that's about it.

I am a transplant here from Atlanta, Georgia, and I am still in awe of the talent in this part of the country. Most everyone I know here can play something. They can "switch" instruments as easy as I change shoes.

I have been dancing as long as I can remember. My uncle could dance and he called what I did "Buck Dancing." I never called it anything. I just like to dance. I learned by watching and listening to the music. I could dance and keep time to the music when I was three years old

In the summer people would come to our house or we would go to someone else's on Saturday night and make homemade ice cream (I still make a lot of homemade ice cream.) There would always be music. I would get as close to the fiddle as I could. All the other kids would play outside, but not me. You couldn't pry me away from that music. I would dance until Mother would make me go to bed. I guess I about drove her nuts. I would listen way into the night and dance in my mind. I still "write" routines "after" I go to bed at night. John says my mind never sleeps. My uncle encouraged me to dance. He would give me a quarter to get up and dance with him. I never told him but I didn't need a reason. His wife, my aunt, who was old fashioned and up-tight about "showing off" (she

didn't approve of his dancing either), told me once if I didn't stop "that dancing" I would end up in a Dance Hall someday. Wow! If she could see me now!

There are four festivals on Mt. Rogers each year that feature "Old Time and Blue Grass" music. The third and fourth weekend in March is the first. The Maple Syrup Festival. Pancakes, maple syrup, and sausage are served all day at Mt. Rogers School and music and dancing are held inside the rescue and fire station. All proceeds go to the Mt. Rogers Fire and Rescue Squad.

The second is the third weekend in May. The Ramp Festival. There is a Ramp eating contest if anyone is interested. Ramps grow wild here and look like a little green onion. But much, much, stronger. They also have food cooked with ramps which is served there. It is held outside next to the fire station. There is "Old Time and Blue Grass" music all day long and nonstop dancing. Some of the dancers never sit down. Because one band goes on right after the other there is no break in the music. All the clogging groups in the area are there to show their stuff. There are also arts and crafts of all kinds. The crowds are estimated to be from ten to twelve thousand. All proceeds go the the Mt. Rogers Fire and Rescue Squads.

The third festival is held the first weekend in October. The Molasses Festival. Again music and dancing all day long. Arts and crafts and the making of molasses are part of the activity. It is held in the same place. This is the biggest one of the three. About fifteen thousand people come from all over. Proceeds go to the Mt. Rogers Fire and Rescue Squad. This one is also held outside.

The fourth festival is held in Grayson Highlands State Park, located on Mt. Rogers. Route 58 across Mt. Rogers will take you to any of these festivals. It is the Grayson Highlands Festival and is held the last weekend in September. Their specialty is the BBQ chicken prepared by the Rugby Rescue Squad. There is music, Old Time and Blue Grass, all day as well as dancing. Also, arts and crafts of all kinds. This is the biggest one of all. Everyone who ever lived here and moved away comes back for this one as well as the regulars who keep coming back every year. Reservations for the campground are booked solid months in advance of this one. All proceeds from the festival go to the Rugby Rescue Squad. Gospel music is featured on Sunday.

The Fiddler Conventions start in March and run through September. The Ruitain Fiddlers Convention is held the second weekend in March in the Ruitain Building on Route 89 outside Galax, Virginia. In May, Memorial Day weekend, is Fiddlers Grove, held just off I-77 outside Yakinville, North Carolina. The second weekend in June is the Mt. Airy Fiddlers Convention. This is my favorite. There is better music here than you will find anywhere. All the "natural" musicians are here. Everyone is so friendly. The last weekend in June is the Elk Creek Fiddlers Convention. July is Mountain City Fiddlers Convention. That one is usually announced. August, first weekend, Ash Country Fiddlers Convention, held in Ash Park in West Jefferson, North Carolina. August second weekend is the Galax Fiddlers Convention, held in Felts Park in Galax, Virginia. August, third weekend, is the Fries Fiddlers Convention held in the Fries Ball Park in Fries, Virginia. September, second weekend is the Laurel Blomery Fiddlers Convention, held in Laurel Bloomery, Tennessee.



There was also a treat in store with a display from "Cloverleaf", a group who keeps alive the traditions of Canal boat stepping.







We never leave home without clog shoes and banjo.

I have a collection of Old Time music and I don't mind sharing any of it. I don't believe any of this belongs to anyone. Most of it has been around so long no one knows where it actually came from. All the people I have talked to play it because their fathers did and their grandfathers did and their grandfathers before them did.

I have heard "Rueben" played every way there is, and I have several versions of "Rag Time Annie." Each band adds their own style and sound which makes each one sound different and so great. I love them all. These fiddlers conventions have all the best bands and musicians around both Old Time and Blue Grass and they all bring their latest tapes and you can usually find about anything you are looking for. "Black Mountain Rag" is absolutely one of my favorites. I feel about it like John feels about "Leather

Britches." The Grayson Highlands Old Time String Band made me a tape of "Black Mountain Rag" during one of their practice sessions. It is 4.45 minutes. We use it all the time. It is wonderful to do running set hoedown. They are wonderful friends of ours and they have some great tapes out. Their new one just out is called "Just Trotting Along." It features "Katy Hill" recorded just for the dancers and is about 4 minutes. An address just in case you are interested is Joann Redd, 23 Marion Heights, Galax, VA 24333, (703) 236-5696.

Brian Grimn's group, The Konnarock Country Critters address is Route 2, Box 61-A, Damascus, VA 24236, (703) 388-3543. Brian's sister, Debbie plays the "clawhammer" banjo in the "modal" tune which makes a lot of their stuff have an Irish sound. John loves their sound.

Another great tape for dancing is The Iron Mountain String Band, "Music From The Mountains." It features "Lost John," 3.50 minutes, "Going Across The River" 4.40 minutes (we use this one a lot), and "Sugar Hill" 6.04 minutes. These were recorded especially for the dancers. This tape can be ordered from the Heritage Studio, Route 3, Box 290, Galax, VA 24333, (703) 236-9249.

Greg Hooven's tape, "Tribute to Fred Cockerham" features a very good version of "Cottoneyed Joe." I use it to teach the "Cottoneyed Joe" to my beginner's clogging class. Greg has a new tape just out, The New Ballard Branch Bogtrotters, "Same Branch, Different Trotters." It has some wonderful 3+ music that is great to dance to. Heritage Studios also produced this one. Bobby Patterson owns Heritage and is a wonderful musician himself. He carries all the local "Old Time and Blue Grass" tapes, and a lot of hard to find stuff. 90% of all our shows are done to live music, performed by local bands. We love it and they do too. We complement each other and don't hesitate to say so.

I have one Doc and Merle Watson album called "Pickin The Blues." I regret that "Rangement Blues" is not on it. I wish it were.

I have a version of "Rueben" called "Lonesome Rueben." Some people up here call it "Rueben's Train." This one is 9.01 minutes. It is on a Tony Rice album called, "Tony Rice And Guitar." Produced by Rebel Recording Co., Route 12, Asbury, West Virginia 24916. I got my copy from Bobby.

Another one I got from Heritage is by Country Ham, "Music For Clogging." All are 3+, three are 4+ and one is 5.45 minutes. All songs give "beats per second," which some bands are beginning to do just for the dancers. All are "Old Time" which is what they play. Their lead singer and Auto Harp player is a clogger and always joins our group in a freestyle when they play for us.

One more and I will hush, Hobart Crabtree, "Old Time Listening Music." It was recorded at Maggard Recording Studio, Big Stone Gap, Virginia 24219. His address is 914 2nd Avenue E, Big Stone Gap, VA 24219, (703) 523-2963.

Anna Breeding wrote a routine to "Golden Slippers" and I wrote one to "Sugar in the Gourd." John and team member Michael Sexton do a "Flatfoot" routine to "Mississippi Sawyer." These are all on this tape. He has a warning on the label that states: "Listening to Old Time Banjo can be Hazardous to your Listening Habits." Hobart is usually at Anna's Sugar Cane Workshop held in Norton, Virginia, in June. I have been attending this workshop since the early 80's. It's one of my favorites. It's the only workshop that I know of that they actually teach "Flatfoot." I hope some of this stuff has been helpful. I have just scratched the surface of the material available out there.

The tapes are for your enjoyment and to give you some idea of what we have to "put up with." We love you and what you are doing. The *Double Toe Times* is my Clogging Bible. The series on Call & Count is worth its weight in gold.

I am enclosing a photo of the High Mountain Steppers just so you can see what we look like. Keep up the great work. I promise to stay in touch.





Danced on working canal boats, the steps were danced in time with the beat of the engine, therefore the routines were danced within very strict confines and "Cloverleaf" provide their own decorated boards to dance on, thus restricting their movements in an effort to uphold the style. There was more there than I could quite take in and it was a treat to see the different styles of English Clog displayed with such enthusiasm and commitment.

The day ended with a "Workshop Showcase" when all the dancers displayed the routines that they had been working on throughout the day. There were many tired, happy faces and the concentration was tangible, no-one wanted to let down their leader and no-one did. It was joy to watch them proudly step out and a real pleasure to make the journey home knowing that on Sunday the weekend would disperse to all corners of England with dedicated dancers taking home with them a little bit of history, hopefully to pass on, in turn, to other dancers. To see these people dancing the day away in heavy, wooden soled, leather studded clogs was quite a humbling sight, perhaps I should dust my own off and start again, trying to master the rhythms and steps that survive from the mills and cobbled streets of the England of yesteryear.





About 40 minutes to analyze, 10 minutes to teach, and 3 seconds to execute. Such is an instructor's lot, but when those 3 seconds are performed to the gratification of the target teach group, life is indeed sweet and the "grin" is worth the "grit" it took to get there. The tom-toms on which this series keeps beating on are these:

- 1) LEAD dancers ENGINEER the figure and dictate SPEED and PLACEMENT regardless of whether they are guy/guys or gal/guys.
- 2) A bevy of ALL POSITION DANCERS (APDs) is an instructor's greatest asset
- 3) Dancing complex, athletic step combos to hot tempos does not imply you can handle 90°, 180°, 360°, 450° twirls, rolls, or spins, find your partner and corner, clap your hands, square your set, and dance with two, three or four people at once; and nowhere is it written in stone that figures have to be taught in a large circle.


A great many imprint cloggers (cloggers who learned their dance as youngsters while dancing with parents and grandparents) have a wonderful feel for the dance. They gallop grandly around the floor, feet flying at incredible speed. Many times when these great dancers are asked to slow down and simplify, they simply bog down. Many great artists and performers fall short as teachers. And some of our best teachers turn to silly putty on the exhibition platform.


We take a clinical look at partnering and the bare bones of figure dancing to encourage clogging instructors and instructor "wanna be's" to educate themselves and build their own sets of PARTNER DRILLS and BARK PATTERNS so that they can begin to feel comfortable teaching and calling the old time figures.


OK! Preamble is over. Here come the bones.


If you are teaching beginners the rudiments of figure dancing and throw them out on the floor in a big circle consisting of 2 couple squares, twisting their heads around on their necks trying to see what you are demonstrating, mirror images, and multiple changes of direction will more than likely initiate some degree of low level panic. Setting dancers up for success is the major part of our teaching job.

Take a quick look at Exhibit A. It sets a 2-COUPLE SQUARE inside a WALL CLOCK (November issue). The back wall is 12 o'clock.









The front wall is designated 6 o'clock. The instructor stands at 6 o'clock, looks at 12 o'clock. The 9 and 3 o'clock walls are located to the left and right, respectively. So much for review. Forget Exhibit A for the time being.

Let's teach SWING YOUR PARTNER (2/4) to couples made up of beginners in such a way that they get a feel for the turning and placement without having to deal with circles, twisted necks, and mirror images.

Concentrate on Exhibits B, C, & D, all three of which have two parts. (Oh, come on!! Be brave!! Read on!! Graphics require some study but they do not devour the researcher.)

Set your DRILL COUPLES (Exhibit B1) facing the back in HAND-HOLD position, LEADs on the LEFT, TAGs on the RIGHT. Have them turn toward each other, face to face (Exhibit B2).

Have your LEADs and TAGs set themselves right hip to right hip (Exhibit C1) and have the couple revolve 360° to return to exactly those same spots (Exhibit C2) and facing those same walls.

At this point, remind your lead dancer that LEAD dancers ENGINEER the figure and take charge of SPEED and PLACEMENT regardless of whether they are guy/guys or gal/guys. Have your LEAD dancer rotate the couple an additional 90°. Your LEAD is now facing front (Exhibit D1). Call attention to the fact that the TAG is again facing the back (Exhibit D1) and that the LEAD must execute an INSIDE COURTESY ROLL to place the TAG in the correct position facing front (Exhibit D2). Recall from the September issue: an INSIDE ROLL is one where the tag faces her partner's position in 1/4 turn.

I like to set the first time drill from facing back to facing front because the dancers get a small dose of instant gratification when they end up facing you for your words of praise. But what can be executed from facing back to facing front and be executed from facing front to facing back.

Old Timers may find it hard to relate to the fact that a SWING YOUR PARTNER drill executed in this matter turns the couple 180°, from facing back to facing front. But the key word here is "DRILL.". Progression in a small square is dealt with on the next page. So hang in there!





As to style of swing, there are several. Let's deal with two:

1) The partner swing: The LEAD has total control. The LEAD places the TAG on his right hip and wraps his right arm around the TAG's waist. Their other hands are clasped in standard dancing position. The LEAD can now pull the TAG around with his right arm and push her around with his left hand. And "Boy Howdy!", I do love to "swang" with a guy/guy who is a knowin' what he is a doin'! Yee Haw!! But I forget myself.

What sometimes gets out of hand in open hoe down freestyle dancing is that the guy is not aware that he needs to turn his gal. He positions himself, and for him, the move is a finished one. It is entirely up to the gal to turn herself into position which is OK if she is young and strong has a good set of brakes to forestall the free spin.


Beginners thrown to the four winds will always come up out of position. They lose confidence quickly. But if they understand that if they come up out of position, they can blame it on their intermediate level LEAD who was asleep at the switch, and if our LEADs understand that they are making a major contribution to the dance and get to show off a little. . . Well now!! We've got everybody's attention.

Beginners need the confidence of knowing that they will be rolled into position. Intermediate leads need to understand that engineering the courtesy roll is their job, rolling the tags into position and steady them when they get there.

The courtesy roll is a major enhancement of precision dancing. But we'll discuss that topic in an up coming issue.

2) The balanced swing (partner spin): This is the swing that should be taught to APDs. Both LEADs and TAGS must establish hip to hip position and the pull positions necessary to effect a tight, well executed swing (spin). photograph illustrates the almost correct positions, but is inadequate when addressing the question of torque (pulling around a tight center with all four hands). Glance at the photo, but read and analyze the instructions.

Cup left hands upward and plant them on the waist. Right hands cup downward, right arms reach across partner's waist and form a tight latch with the planted left hands. Without moving the left hand from the waist, rotate the left elbows towards the back and push the right shoulders forward. Now establish the spin by pushing the shoulders around a tight center, pulling with all four hands and spinning around the center.



12 SWING YOUR CORNER sets up ODD LEAD/EVEN TAG & EVEN LEAD/ODD TAG, hip to hip, straight line, LEADS on the OUTSIDE, TAGS on the INSIDE.

An additional 90 degrees and our LEADs are correctly positioned, looking inside the square. Our TAGs are still out-of-wack. EXHIBIT



BALANCED SWING

If you want to enhance your drill, combine the UTILITY CALLS, CAROLINA TWIRL [2/4] (from front to back) and SWING YOUR PARTNER [2/4] (from back to front).

Let's set up a progression drill with a small square set. When we get pretty good at exactly changing spots with our partners while changing from facing back to facing front, and visa versa, its time to deal with progression. Let's stay squared up with the walls. Set odd couples facing back (12 o'clock), even couples facing front

(6 o'clock) [Exhibit A is reprinted here for quick reference].

The first call is SWING YOUR CORNER (2\4). Note that corners are already facing each other. LEADs place the CORNER TAGs on their right hips. At this point both pairs should be lined up hip to hip on the CENTER LINE (Exhibit X). One 360° spin will return the pairs to their

center-line/hip-hip position. An additional 900 turn will set the two LEADs facing the INSIDE of the SQUARE; the TAGs, however, are facing the OUTSIDE. The LEAD must now execute the COURTESY ROLL to turn the CORNER TAG to face her partner.

The revolutions and changes of position have caused the sides of the square to rotate 1/4 turn left. This change is called "progression".

The next call is SWING YOUR PARTNER (2/4). Engineer the swing in the described manner and attend to the same set of motion mechanics. and the sides of your square will rotate an additional 1/4 turn. Our neatly ENGINEERED PROGRESSION now has ODD COUPLES FACING FRONT and EVEN COUPLES FACING BACK.

From a neo-instructor's point of view, having all the odd couples and all the even couples facing the same direction has it's teaching conveniences. Nobody, including an instructor who is instructing him/herself in the vagaries of teaching Appalachian figures, needs to be dealing with mirror images while in the early learning stages.

The simplest way to put the square back into starting position is to call CIRCLE HALF, 3,4. Of course, you could drill SWING CORNER, 3, 4, and **SWING** YOUR PARTNER,3,4, again. That would do it. Or how about, CORNERS PULL-BY, FACE TO FACE [4\4], followed by WITH YOUR PARTNER CAROLINA TWIRL [4/4]. You can now start your drill again. Are we having any fun yet?


ARK-LA-TEX Clogging Workshop
