# America's Clogging Hall of Fame Spring Workshop

Just after sun-up in "The Valley" dancers from across the nation began gathering at the entrance to the Clogging Capitol of the World, "Stompin" Ground." Cloggers estimated in "Mountain Idiom" as "A tad under 500" had come to Maggie Valley, North Carolina for the Annual Spring Workshop.

The workshop, which is *free* to all who hold current membership in the *Hall of Fame*, featured nationally known "*Old Time Clogging*" instructors who stress the preservation of Southern Appalachian Mountain Square Dancing. These instructors donated their time and energy to help those attending the workshop sharpen their clogging skills.

It all began with the "Tall Texan," Bobby Whitfield, from Austin, who ably guided the dancers through Smooth Mountain Square Dance figures. He had the class gliding across the dance floor with the grace of an angel. Whitfield, with his smooth, dynamic Texas drawl added a "Touch of Class" to the workshop. The state of Texas should be proud to claim Whitfield as a native son.

From Tallahassee, Florida, and director of the award-winning *Panther Creek Mountain Dancers*, Ray Hattaway taught steps used in Mountain Dancing and from the looks of the smiles on the faces he certainly exceeded all expectations. Most folks who had experienced only line dancing left the session with a new-found love for clogging. Later in the day Ray taught Country Hoedown and as earlier in the day the dance floor was covered with dancers experiencing a different style of dance.

Workshop director, Lou Mauiri, who hails from the great state of West Virginia and serves as Treasurer for the *Hall of Fame*, showed everyone why he is a much-sought-after instructor.

# What does it take to be a National Traditional Instructor?

Elliott spends time looking at old videos and reading anything he can find about figures and clogging. If you had to define a traditionalist, Elliott would be a part of that definition. He believes in holding on to the heritage of the dance form.

When Bobbie asked us to write this article, it was very hard to narrow it down to this particular subject. This is a broad topic and there are many different ways to learn:

One way is to collect your information. It is better to verify facts from more than one source. Be prepared for questions because there will be many.

There are many places to gather and verify your information, some ways of doing this are:

- Attend other traditional instructor's classes.
- Discuss traditional material with the instructors who have the knowledge of what the heritage and the traditional form means.
- Check out the books and videos from your local library. You would be surprised at what you will find on this subject.
- Take the time to visit and dance with known traditional teams and through these teams you may learn of other traditional teams who in many cases have had little or no exposure to competition dancing. These types of teams are where you can find rarely danced figures.

Still, truly the best way to become knowledgeable in traditional dancing is not only reading and looking at the information, but to be right in the middle of it. Don't be afraid to ask questions! After all, you have to learn somehow.

In traditional dancing you not only have to learn the figures, you also have to learn the different square dance setups, ("setups" — meaning how your couples will be set on the dance floor) and order of dance for each of these square dances.

When you get ready to teach the workshop, don't forget to have a lot of patience. Eighty to ninety percent of the people you will be teaching will know little to nothing about traditional dancing.

You have to be able to talk to people. Answer their questions to the best of *your* knowledge.

When Elliott teaches his class he not only teaches the figures, he teaches the proper setup and order of dance because as a traditional instructor it is very important that you teach 100% of the tradition, not just the figures and not just the footwork.

One last note, when teaching the traditional form, don't forget to use the correct type of music and remember that it takes being a good listerner as well as a good teacher. Elliott and I are always looking at traditional teams and learning from other traditionalists.



## Martha Lee's Rebuttal

Port Townsend, Washington

I enjoyed reading the interesting and caring opinions about American clogging and its history in both letters, "Our Readers Write: Two Views," in the May issue of *The Double Toe Times*.

In response to the writers who were offended by my article ("What is Clogging?" February *DTT*), no offense was intended, and I gladly concede that most of the facts they report from their research are substantially true as far as they go. Their research confirms that the banjo is an instrument of African origin. Agreed. But I can't entirely agree with their assertion that clogging is a solo step dance in wooden soled shoes brought to the USA from Britain (England, Scotland and Ireland) in the 19th century.

Certainly that is a respectable definition, but *American* clogging is a descendent of southern Appalachian step dancing, which I believe had more than one antecedent, and I know of no evidence that wooden clogs were even the dance footwear of choice in the area. I also wonder if the *18th* century settlers of the region really waited so long before they did any step dancing!

From interviews reported by Mike Seeger in *Talking Feet* with oldtimers whose families have included respected step dancers in the southern Appalachians for generations, none mentioned any tradition of wearing wooden soled shoes. Dancers wore what they had, "every day shoes" or "Sunday slippers" (dress shoes) with leather soles, and without the metal taps which have become popular in recent times in conjunction with amplified music.

It's not unreasonable to suppose that most of the early settlers were not trained dancers and that they simply brought with them whatever they knew and could remember of their traditional folk dancing. Picking up dance steps and ideas from each other and from other dance traditions wherever they found them, they and succeeding generations invented a highly individualistic *American* dance heritage in tandem with mountain music and based on pioneer spirit, adaptability and "do-it-yourself pride."

These suppositions are reasonable because from what we do know about traditional Appalachian step dancing, from observation of those who have preserved the traditions of their own families and communities, and from our own dance experience, it is unique. I would even go so far as to suggest that the American pioneer spirit of individualism, self reliance and innovation are the very heartbeat of clogging today. And its soul is the inner grace and enthusiasm brought to it by individual dancers.

Most encyclopedias and dictionaries are the bane of a modern clogger's existence — I have yet to find a useful definition of American clogging in any. "No," we say when non-cloggers tell us what clogging is on what they believe to be irrefutable authority, "We don't wear wooden shoes and that's not exactly what we do. It's hard to explain, just watch and listen to the



sounds..." and we execute a few steps. We talk best with our feet, which may be why so little of the history of our dance form is included in standard reference books. *The Double Toe Times* and other clogging publications that encourage research and the written exchange of information, opinion and ideas will be invaluable sources for future clogging historians, and perhaps reference books will eventually update their information.!

An excellent reference source that I think clearly illustrates, (far better words can describe) some of the influences of earlier traditional folk dances on Appalachian step dancing and modern clogging is Ira Bernstein's video *Clog*, *Tap and Step Dancing* 

which includes authentic examples of British, African and American solo step dancing. Careful comparison of the dances performed may convince doubters that American clogging combines aspects of both British and African dance traditions (and that tap dancing which developed in parallel with early jazz and blues music, is markedly different from clogging, although their origins are probably similar).

I confess I've been unable to substantiate my use of the word *juba* (in my February article) to refer to the rhythmic hand-clapping, slapping and hitting often called *hambone*, and I would appreciate being corrected if I'm wrong. Percussion sounds using hands, sticks, spoons and other household items, as well as tapping feet, were often added to early Appalachian music. Where did this tradition originate?

In many ways "country music owes a heavy debt to black culture," although "rhythmically the larger debt is owed to earlier forms of English and European country dances." (*The Smithsonian Collection of Classic Country Music*) Yes, children, there was music in the mountains before the advent of Bluegrass which rejuvenated traditional country music in the 1940's. (And incidentally, speaking of Bluegrass, correct spelling of one of the banjo artists listed is Earl *Scruggs*, not Scroggs.)

The influence of Native American dancing is more conjectural, difficult to pin down, and possibly almost neglible, but consider the alterating light and heavy drumbeats and emphasis on downbeat in the toe-HEEL combination of the footwork, and compare them with the percussion sounds of much of today's basic clogging and how they are made. Also, what were the origins of the delightful ''imitations'' of animals used in some oldtime Appalachian solo step dancing, and our use of the names of animals and birds to designate many clogging steps we use today?

Wonderfully adaptable, modern American clogging "borrows" from any and every dance form. We see clogging adaptations from jazz, tap, swing, break dancing, western lines, you name it, even ballet. Far from being a "purist," I, for one, enjoy trying every clogging innovation I can, and try to retain

Lou's expertise in teaching Running Set Hoedown had folks doing moves that were reminiscent of former N.F.L. quarterback Fran Tarkenton scrambling for his life. He is a master at calling square dances. He kept the session moving and the dancers on their toes. Lou concluded his tutoring by leading a dance floor covered with students through the "Tush-Push" which was a crowd favorite to say the least. As an "old" football official I have never seen so many "Backfields in Motion."

Due to the untimely illness of Bob Johnson, Director on the nationally known Flatland Cloggers, and instructor par-excellence, he was not able to be with us. *However*, with help from Bob's daughter Terry and I, we were able to "weasel" our way through figures used in Southern Appalachian Free Style Dancing. Emphases was placed on keeping the feet low to the floor, excluding all high kicks, and especially listening to the rhythmic beat of the feet that is so common to true free style dancers. It is easy to see why Bob and Sarge are so proud of Terry. When it comes to knowledge of true Mountain Square Dancing she is a "chip off the old block" and has the ability to handle a floor filled with excited dancers.





The workshop continued with Steps for Solo Competition being taught by Chip Harrison of Gastonia, North Carolina. Most of us "Old Timers" took a back seat as this young, energetic instructor had the young ans doing steps that even "Mr. Bojangles" would have been proud of. Seems as if these young folks are chompin at the bits to learn every new step they can. After this class we noticed many of the newer dancers take to the floor and try out their new steps when a good foot stompin tune was played.

The workshop concluded with solo competition and, after a dance off of all first place winners, the overall grand champions were Lauri Rogers of Stanton, Kentucky and Craig Suggs of Chesapeake, Virginia.

Just after sundown and after everyone had an opportunity to partake of the "goodies" offered them in "The Valley," Stompin' Ground came to life again. The house band served up enough good "Old Time Mountain Music" to keep the floor covered all evening. Many requests brought everyone to the floor as the *Tush-Push*, Texas Two-Step and line dance music was played. Special performances by the Stompin' Ground Cloggers and the Panther Creek Mountain Dancers brought the crowd to their feet.

As the evening ended, so began a much-needed rain. It seemed only fitting that the rain reminded us of tears of joy. For, once again, cloggers had come to the Clogging Capitol of the World, enjoyed a day of fellowship with folks they could relate to and return to their respective homes after having experienced a day of good, clean, wholesome family entertainment.

To all who attended the workshop as a member of the Hall of Fame or as a spectator, we, the Officers and Founders, deeply appreciate your sharing this time together and we look forward to serving you in the future. But I also believe "If we throw tradition aside then we lose a valuable part of our humanity — when we dance the old steps we are dancing with all those who have gone before." Honoring the best of my own Tar Heel tradition, I stand by my February article.







If you are looking for a belly laugh and a half, catch Jeff Driggs at a workshop doing his pantomime of two dancers trying to figure out how to connect up whose hands in which order, everybody waving, flapping, snatching and grabbing for everything and nobody coming up with anything.

Let's take a closer look at some inter-related partnering maneuvers, the absence of which typically cause frustration, loss of time, tempo, and square (position). Let's consider what kind of instruction puts you, as instructor in control of your group, or as LEAD, in control of your TAG. Let's take a look at the "center spot", the LEAD's active hand, and \_\_\_\_\_

#### THE CENTER SPOT

the TAG's passive receiving hand.

Why teach "center spot"? Why put on your regular recurring "nag list" reminders to pay attention to and dance in, into, around, on the outside of or stay out of the "center spot"?

- 1) It keeps partners a working distance apart.
- 2) It is teaches them that their bodies take up space, how to share space, and how to negotiate space.
- 3) It speaks to keeping couples "square" regardless of whether they are dancing shoulder to shoulder, face to face, back to back, or back to front.
- 4) It reminds LEADs that it is their job in a couples dance to engineer the figure patterns and formations in such a way that TAGs can best execute whirls and twirls without loosing their balance, ducking their heads, or twisting their backs.

### IF YOUR PAIRS ARE SQUARE, YOUR SQUARES ARE SQUARE.

Couples who have been schooled to think "square" and who make their own "squaring" corrections on the move are going to make noticeable contributions to your exhibition and/or precision team. You can scream "square up" until you are blue in the face; but if your group is not infused with dancing members who have a list of criteria against which to square themselves and their partners, you might as well be arguing with the gum balls in the corner vending machine.

#### HAND CONTACT

The first contact position we examined was the handhold. We called it a "latch-up" and directed the LEAD to actively apply pressure to his TAGs passive hand (not fingers) so that he could pass on "change of position" information to his TAG through hand-to-hand communication. That's the LEAD dancer's job: To instruct the TAG through "touch communication" where to go and what to do. The LEAD's

application of a "respectful pinch" on his TAG's hand activates the communication system between partners.

Schooling LEAD dancers to an active "latch-up" is your best first step in setting up a cohesive, long term clogging program featuring "pairs and squares". Within your All Position Dancer (APD) format, the greater the number of schooled LEAD dancers you have at your disposal, the faster you will be able to work in your beginners.

If you are starting with all beginners, then you'll have to teach "latch-up" basics. A correct latch-up eliminates whimpy,

fluttery, tickle fingers that generate cases of the fidgets and other signs of discomfort and inattention.

#### BREAKS IN HANDHOLD

The human skeleton is strapped together at the shoulders in such a way that the hand can be held palm up with the elbow down or palm up with the shoulder rolled forward and the elbow up. Breaks in handhold are required to successfully accomplish a good many of our most commonly executed rolls. Knowing when to make and reset the break is the LEAD's job (Double Toe Times, September 1994). Knowing when and where to present a receiving hand is the TAG's job.

We don't want to get so strict and stuffy that we can't have a stomping good time galloping around the "Yee-Haw" floor; but as instructors and team coaches, we need to make our dancers aware that there is a difference between executing skillful "break-latch & re-latch combinations" and being forced into fuzzy and uncontrollable break downs

resulting in loss of timing, position, and contact between partners

When I go from group to group and dance with people whom I do not know, I know in 32 beats whether or not I am dancing with a "working partner". When I am dancing LEAD and I latch-up my TAG, if my TAG responds to my latch-up with return hand pressure, I am pretty sure I've got myself a "working partner". (I refer to this "latch-up and tug" as "gim'me-gim'me back".) When I am dancing TAG, if my LEAD does not latch-up, I am pretty sure we're going to fake it.

Let me illustrate with a recent experience. The Florida Clogging Council held it annual convention May 26-27 in Orlando, FL. Greg Dionne, Jacksonville, FL, taught us a lengthy, fairly tricky partner routine to "Blues Berry Hill" featuring intermediate+ step combinations, a swing, rolls and wraps, and a change of hands to right of the ring.








#### THOUGHT FOR THE MONTH FROM YOUR EDITOR:

# IN THE COUNTRY OF THE BLIND; THE ONE-EYED MAN IS KING.







I managed to hitch up a partnership with Elaine Enfield, Blackwood Cloggers, Trilby, FL. Besides being a National Clogging & Hoedown Council judge, Elaine is an expert at teaching group mixers and is a skillful LEAD.

She knows how to break handhold and wind up for every outside roll, wind down every inside roll, use her hands to direct the dance patterns, and her arms such that she does not interfere with the movements required of her TAG.

Elaine took full charge of the dance patterns. She was the LEAD dancer and took her job seriously. I was the TAG and followed her lead. If we had been in freestyle hoedown and I had been wearing my skirt and petticoat, I could have been whirling and twirling, showing off my footwork, my lace bloomers, and a lot of ruffle.

We may have fuzzed over a couple of those sticky-tricky step combos, but from the waist up, we were cookin'. Handhold breaks were deliberate and well timed. Re-latches were smooth. At no time were we forced to break handhold because we got out of sync.

Unfortunately, midway through the teach Elaine was called away to rehearse for the evening's exhibitions. I was without a partner. So I found myself scavenging the perimeter for another partner midway through a challenging teach.

I found "Lisa" sitting on the sidelines with her lips kind of pooched out, the kind of look that says "I really would like to be out there doing that." Lisa allowed as how she and her partner had quit because they were messing up so bad, not the intermediate step combinations, but the wraps, rolls, and exchange of hands. Enveloping myself in the flowing folds of my expert-in-residence power cape and assuming my secret identity of "SUPERLEAD", I replied, "Oh, come on. I can dance anybody through anything!" encouragement from friends, out on the floor she came.

Having solved the partner problem, we had to find a place in the already established ring to break in. Getting past the glassy eyed glares of couples who have already established a recognized pattern and know for a fact, "If you guys break in next to us, we're gon'na lose it for sure. Don't break in here!" is a toughie. But find a place we did, and the game was on.

The first few passes were pretty rickety rackety. Lisa was trying to make wrap and roll decisions by herself. There were a lot of forced breaks in handhold. We were always behind the count and out of position.

During a pause in the teach, SUPERLEAD was again able to emerge. Latching-up both hands, thumbs firmly in place, SUPERLEAD quietly said, "Lisa, don't fight me. Let me roll and wrap you. Listen to my hands and let my thumbs do the talking. Relax and let me do the work." At this point Lisa became aware that we could communicate through our hands, and, BY CRACKY!, things began to smooth out.

The second thing SUPERLEAD said was, "When I break a handhold, don't drop or hide your receiving hand. It needs to be out front, a little higher than your waist, where I can find it." She began helping us out by making a conscious effort to make her hands available and the wraps and rolls started to string together as one long smooth progression.

Now that Lisa had quit bucking and pitching, SUPERLEAD could anticipate where Lisa was going to be and what she might be doing. So SUPERLEAD was able to begin working the space (the center spot) between them and engineering the moves. On executing the break and wind up for the wrap or roll, SUPERLEAD stepped into the center spot and allowed Lisa to turn on her own spot so that she was better

able to keep her balance.

The third thing SUPERLEAD said was, "When you get the message that you are going to be rolled and in which direction, push your arms up over your head so you wont have to duck your head or bend your back. Help me help you fully execute the roll." She did and she was able to elegantly execute her turns with her head up and her back straight. No stumbling, no fumbling, no fall back.

She was a quick study. We got a lot of good work done during the remainder of Greg's teach. [And Lisa. I don't even know your last name or where you come from. It was a great experience. Thanks!]

OK! Preamble is over. Lets get down to business.


Lets drill a wrap up executed from face-toface, two hands across (Exhibit 1). There exists a center spot between the two dancers. The TAG dancer should be instructed to hold her home spot while turning. The LEAD should be instructed to step to the far side of the center spot nearest to the TAG's home spot when he wraps up her up (Exhibit 4). When he unwraps his TAG, he then returns to his home spot. The LEAD has moved forward and backward. The TAG has executed two 1800 turns but has not left her home spot.

A HOTDOG ROLL requires a handhold break up front (Exhibit 2). The TAG does not move or adjust her hand receiving hand. When the unwrapping is executed, a handhold break is forced at the end of the movement. The TAG assists the re-latch by making sure her receiving hand is presented out front, a little higher than her waist.


The above drill can be executed with the LEAD's right hand or left hand. If your LEADs have been schooled to apply latch-up pressure to their TAGs' hands and to respond to the instruction, "BREAK LEFT, BREAK RIGHT, or WIND UP LEFT, WIND-UP RIGHT," no spoken instruction as to direction of the TAGs' turn needs to be crafted or delivered by you. Instruction time is reduced.

The well schooled LEAD will pass the turning information on to his TAG by way of hand contact.

You don't need to say a word.

I am also sending some pictures taken during the workshop. I hope they entice you and other dancers to attend next year.


The top picture is of Dana, our youngest demo at 3 years old — a real heartwarmer.


Even though clogging as a whole is down slightly from last year, the dancers are the greatest, and an event like this let's us get to know each other.

Remember, the last Sunday in February 1996 will


be time for the next Country Note Clogger Workshop in Canada. Come to Canada — visit a foreign country. Not so foreign, just fun.

Hope to see you at a workshop before then, but see you then!







