#### Bailey Mountain Cloggers Perform at Kennedy Center


Mars Hill, NC -- The Bailey Mountain Cloggers (BMC), five times national clogging champions, proudly represented North Carolina at the Kennedy Center's 25th anniversary celebration recently. The 29 member team gave an hour-long performance to an enthusiastic audience of about 300 in the Kennedy Center's Grand Fover.

Their performance, which included several costume changes, covered the gamut from traditional smooth clogging to contemporary music with modern choreography. Barbara Kohler, a former professional dancer with national prominence, made the trip with the cloggers. "I've been in show business all my life and the greatest compliment performers give to each other is to say 'they are true professionals'. The Bailey Mountain Cloggers are four star true professionals. They made their costume changes in a hot, tight area, danced on a slick stage, tripped, sweated and still kept on smiling! They were on time and on cue and they made it all look easy," she explained.

"The performance at the Kennedy Center is without a doubt the most important performance I've ever done and I believe the team feels the same way. Bailey Mountain represented North Carolina, the art of clogging and teamwork better than anyone I can think of," explained Kevin Griffin, one of the cloggers.

The cloggers successfully raised about \$8000 to make the trip possible, thanks to a pre-trip fund-raising performance at the college and the generous support

and contributions of many Bailey **Mountain Cloggers** friends and family. They traveled to D.C. in style on a 40-passenger touring bus provided at cost by Lynx Bus Service, a Christian in Action group based in Orlando, Florida. The bus was provided just in the nick of time by the creative efforts of the cloggers. When a tentative arrangement for a

## Clogging at Mars Hill College

Ars Hill, North Carolina - The five time national championship Bailey Mountain Cloggers roots began in 1974. They took their name from the Bailey Mountain Square Dance Team who had started dancing at the mountain Lunsford festivals. Bascom Lamar Lunsford, the grandfather of clogging and creator of the festival, named the clogging team after the mountain because of the mountain's prominence on the Mars Hill College campus. The team died around the early 60's and the Bailey Mountain Cloggers picked up where they had stopped.

The team has come a long way since the square dance team's conception in the 30's. The original team, made up of young adults from the area, consisted of 16 dancers and five band members. Now, the college team includes 29 dancers with most having many years experience. The group dances to continue the tradition set by the original team.

"The Bailey Mountain Cloggers (BMC) have arrived as a clogging team and as an art form," said Richard Dillingham, BMC director for more than 10 years. "BMC has brought a new perspective to an old mountain tradition."

The cloggers work hard for the team. They understand the dedication and training required for this athletic and artistic exercise. "This year, we started with the motto that 'attitude is everything'," said Jay Ledford, BMC captain. "Everyone has worked hard and participated. Attitudes are great on the team and so is teamwork."

This past year in Charleston, South Carolina, BMC swept the title of national champions for the fifth year against teams from across the US. This year's win was different from previous years for the cloggers. BMC took first place in all five categories and first place overall. "This is the first time that we have ever taken first place in every single category," said Ledford. "It felt great!"

Located in the town of Mars Hill, only twenty minutes from Asheville, North Carolina, Mars Hill College is unique in its clogging experience and in many other areas. The campus is spread over 180 acres and is set against the backdrop of the Blue Ridge Mountains. About 1000 students from 24 states and 15 foreign countries attend the school and its intimate size allow a student/faculty ratio of 13/1. It is a college where community is important, as expressed through its Christian heritage and service learning orientation.

Mars Hill College offers four-year bachelor's degrees in the arts, humanities and the sciences. It combines rigorous academics with applied Christian values and an emphasis on excellence.

Over the last six year period we have expanded to include two instructors and three groups in the Toronto area. In all. I instruct over eighty-five students and still going strong!



**Clogging Grandmothers** 

The Clogging Grandmothers are an energetic group of seniors from the Lindsay, Ontario, Canada area. The Group evolved out of the Lindsay Recreation Department clogging classes, which were started in 1988 and taught by Moira Fallis. Moira is a former Ontario Rhythm Clogger.

In the beginning Moira had eight cloggers. The ladies decided to entertain at local nursing homes and charity fund raisers in the area. They became so popular their numbers increased to eighteen, and they began to perform to a broader audience. The only criteria to be a Clogging Grandmother is to be 55 or over and a grandmother. A good sense of rhythm plus a knowledge of clogging is also necessary to be a Clogging Grandmother.

In 1991 the Grandmothers travelled to Toronto to appear in the Seniors' Jubilee Concert at Roy Thomson Hall and have been appearing every year since. They have also appeared at the Rodeo in Fenelon Falls, the International Plowing Match, numerous fall fairs as well as Harbourfront in Toronto, the Good Age Show at the International Centre, Toronto, many Senior shows and festivals from Lindsay to Port Hope, to Oshawa and Bowmanville and north to Gooderham.

In 1955 they appeared on Breakfast Television with Ann Rohmer, City TV and at the Canadian National Exhibition. They performed for many private celebrations such as special anniversaries, birthdays and retirement parties.

The present Director of the Clogging Grandmothers is Marilyn Eige. Under Marilyn's capable tutelage, the ladies have mastered several new routines and, along with the old favourites, are ready to dance up a storm. Several engagements have already been booked for 1996 such as Canada Day celebration, various festivals and of course the highlight of the year, the Seniors' Jubilee at Roy Thomson Hall.


Although the Capital tour was conducted in the evening, both the house and senate were in session so the group was privileged to observe the political process at work, observing from the balcony above both chambers.


"As a senior, this trip was the chance of a lifetime for many of us. All the cloggers helped make this an everlasting memory," stated Kevin Parries, a team member.





#### LINDA ROSS - TEACHING HANDICAPABLES

For Linda Ross, few things top the feeling she gets when teaching clogging steps to her students.

Ross, a clogging instructor with the *Italian Canadian Handicap Association* in Windsor and District, has been teaching students with disabilities for the past seven years. Last month, she was inducted into *America's Clogging Hall of Fame*.

"It feels strange being honored for something you love to do." Ross said. "When I come to the classes, I just can't wait to get here."

Being inducted into the *Hall of Fame* was a big surprise to Ross. At first, she didn't take the award seriously.

"I just thought it was a gimmick," Ross said. "I didn't realize it was serious until I got a phone call from someone from the Hall of Fame. I was asked if I would be attending the ceremony."

On October 20, Ross arrived in Maggie Valley, North Carolina, the site of the prestigious *America's Clogging Hall of Fame*.

Prior to being inducted into the *Hall of Fame*, each clogger was reviewed by a panel of judges based on information gathered from fellow dancers.

"We also had an hour and a half to put together a routine." she said. "Then all the dancers had to perform the routine in front of 3,000 people."

Each person being inducted was not only given a plaque but their picture and contributions to clogging were placed into the Hall of Fame.

Ross said she personally received a nice surprise from the audience when they announced her name. "When the audience heard that I taught clogging to handicapables, I got a standing ovation," she said. "People came up to me afterwards and said I must have a lot of patience to teach." "I wouldn't trade it for anything," she said. "When they learn a new dance step, I am happy for them."

#### HOPE PENNOCK-ALBERTA RHYTHM CLOGGERS

The Annual America's Clogging Hall of Fame Dance Off at Stompin' Ground in Maggie Valley, North Carolina is unreal. My wish would be to pick up the entire weekend and set it down in Alberta for all to see. What an inspiration! The competi-

tion was amongst cloggers who had placed first or second at recent competitions, so we were seeing exceptional talent. A few years ago, there were only two competition categories -Freestyle and precision. The popularity of this dance form has evolved into several competition categories - Smooth Mountain Square Dance, Country Hoedown, Open 6 or 8 Couple Freestyle, Four Couple precision, Southern Appalachian Traditional, Running Set Hoedown, Exhibition Dance, Show - to name a few. We were told that there were more entries this year than ever before. From 8:30 AM on Saturday to 12:20 AM on Sunday and again 9:00 AM to 4:20 PM Sunday, one entry after another presented their carefully choreographed and dili-

gently practiced routines. The only breaks were during the presentation of winners at the end of each category.

1995 is the first year that an International Team has been selected to recognize instructors who have introduced clogging in their countries - Germany, Czech Republic, Belgium, Australia, England and Canada. Dorothy and Jack McCulloch of Cambridge Ontario (who introduced clogging to Canadians), Linda Ross, Judy Wood and myself were chosen from Canada.

Dan and Sandy Angel, founders of America's Clogging Hall of Fame, hosted the International Team through the week-end.

Our group of International Inductees developed quite a camaraderie in the few hours we were together and all felt honored to be chosen for the first International Clogging Team.

Another thrill was to meet Bobbie Adams, the Editor of the Double Toe Times. She is a very knowledgeable and hard-working lady. Wrap all of these features together with a blanket of fall colors spread over the Appalachian Mountains, sprinkle with friendly folks, grits, biscuits and gravy, and tie with new clogging friendships! It was a short stay for the distance travelled, but thanks to the encouragement of friends and family, I went and I am glad! It was more than worthwhile.

Editors Note: At my insistence, Linda and Hope shared these write-ups (edited) from their respective Canadian newspapers. I received another write-up from Jarka Vasakovi, Czech Republic but there was no English translation. The International Team nominees for 1996 are soon to be announced by Dan and Sandy Angel.





#### AN ANALYTICAL LOOK AT THE LITTLE **SOUARES**

Let's take a look at five identifiable small circle set formations, Exhibits 1-5. These five formations represent the starting points from which our executable figures begin.

Making the transition from being a dancer-onthe-floor to becoming a "traditional" teacher/caller requires us to look at the geometrical structure of floor shapes constructed by people standing or dancing across from or adjacent to each other. Although we call "Circle up four", no real circle ever exists. There are too many joints and angles.

How we teach four people to "take up a position" can be considered in terms of how we teach individual dancers to relate to three other individuals on the floor. In Exhibit 1, dancers in the small circle set are squared up with their "opposites". Otis faces Eddy (gent faces gent). Olivia faces Edwina (lady faces lady).

For those of you who have tuned in late to this series, some liberties taken with "traditional" dance terminology are here restated:

- 1) For the purposes of Call and Count analysis, the small circle sets in Exhibits 1-3 have been identified as "hoedown squares". They do have four corners. We call them squares.
- 2) People names have been given to the dancers: Our ODD couple is Otis and Olivia. Our EVEN couple is Eddy and Edwina. Beginners are sometimes overwhelmed with remembering whether they are supposed to be the odd couple gent or the even couple lady. Naming, for example, our odd couple gents "Otis" and say "All you Otis's do thus and so", the reduction in response time is noticeable.

When you are teaching in an environment where couple dancing is not a regular recurring activity, the above ploy has merit. Once people get a feel for the turning and changes of position, they have little difficulty making the transition to the "odd couple thisits" and the "even couple thatsits" in a more "traditional" environment.

3) Since so many of our clogging teams tend to be predominately female, the "gent dancer" has been dubbed the "LEAD" dancer and the "lady dancer" has been dubbed the "TAG" dancer. Since more and more of our women are schooling themselves to dance both LEAD and TAG positions, we call them All Position Dancers or APD's.

Assigning certain position responsibilities to a LEAD dancer or a TAG dancer eliminates a lot of sluggish gender translation.

OK! Preamble is over. Let's get on with breaking this "traditional" dance structure into recognizable pieces-parts.

> Exhibit 1. The OPPOSITES are facing each other. Otis squares up with Eddy. Olivia squares up with Edwina. Or generically stated, LEADs square up with LEADs and TAGs square up with TAGS.

> Exhibit 2: The PARTNERS are facing each other. Otis squares up with his partner, Olivia. Eddy squares up with his partner, Edwina.

> Exhibit 3. The CORNERS are facing each Otis squares up with Edwina. squares up with Olivia.

> The majority of hoedown square formations are initiated from the Exhibit 3 formation, squared up with your corner. You usually interact first with your corner dancer.

> Exhibits 4 and 5 reflect "circle to the left" and "circle to the right", respectively. Note the joints and angles. Also, note the angle change in the icon shoulder. It's called a leading shoulder.


> Those of us who have been at this pair dancing for a number of years will remember the many times we had a great time dancing at workshops and the memory meltdown we suffered when we got home, even with syllabus in hand.

> It is a relatively simple matter to refer to a syllabus cue sheet and workout some vaguely remembered step combination for the feet. It is something different to find oneself alone, with syllabus in hand, trying to recreate a figure in one's mind when the other three dancers are missing. Learning strategies have to be developed as do teaching strategies. Analysis is part of our game.

Let's take Otis, Olivia, Eddy, and Edwina through one of the simple small circle figures sometimes called a Butterfly Flip. Let's take a look at the timing, the execution techniques, and dress it up a little bit for the purposes of

You can "pad out" the figure in order to facilitate teaching it to a group of real beginners or "streamline" the figure for your hot shots.

We prudently recall two cardinal standards for figure presentation: How we ultimately prepare and present any

How many cloggers out there are true cloggers? Now, I'm not talking about your line dancers, exhibition dancers, show and so forth. You can't call yourself a true clogger until you can also dance truly traditional. At every competition we see teams who get on stage and it looks like we stepped into the glitter and flash of a dance recital

Worst of all, the directors of these teams are trying to judge traditional categories. There is something wrong when a judge is sitting at the table and makes the comment about how boring are running set hoedown or eight couple Appalachian freestyle. A word to these cloggers-"You don't know what you're missing!"

Being on stage in front of a crowd, dancing freestyle, is the most exhilarating experience you will ever have.

Sit down to watch freestyle. I don't mean just at a glance. I mean really watch. There is nothing more stunning which can take your breath away, than to watch a traditional team that has really got it together, and you will see beautiful formations taking place.


You know it must be contagious when you see the smiles in the audience, the feet tapping, and the hands clapping.

The only thing that I ask as a clogger, instructor and true lover of this dance form is to please don't put down traditional clogging before you have tried it. After all, if it wasn't for traditional dancers and the mountain folk there would be no clogging.



The college is also well equipped to provide the skills needed for the 21st century. Its extensive computer network, free e-mail and Internet access and student/computer ratio of 7/1 (a superb ratio for any college anywhere) offer students the tools they need to succeed.



Mars Hill College - Mars Hill, North Carolina

The college not only boasts the National Champion cloggers, it also offers college courses in clogging and a clogging scholarship program.

The school provides many opportunities for clogging credit to all its students, not just the cloggers. The beginning clogging class. PE 188, is taught every semester by the BMC team itself. The class allows room for 30 students and last fall had to turn away 90 others who wanted the class. In four years, the team teaches 250 fellow students to clog for the first time. "This number represents 25% of the college population," explained Dillingham.

Two other classes are offered at the college for students who already know how to clog. The first is PE 288. This class is for those wanting to move past the beginning level stage and maybe audition for the team. Dillingham said he believes this to be a good step for those wanting extra help before auditioning for the team.

MUS 469, also a class for credit, is required by all the BMC members. This class is an advanced arts activity that helps the team learn more about traditional and choreographed square dances.

Editors Note: Stay tuned! In mid July (around July 19th) the opening ceremonies for the Olympic Games in Atlanta, Georgia will be televised. Among the 2000 performers, are 24 cloggers who went through a rigorous audition before Kenny Ortega, the Director/Choreographer of this years ceremonies. The dancers are from Jay Ledford's Leather-N-Lace, Ryan Rickard/Marci Taulli's Unlimited Power and Henrietta & Tara Holms' Silver Star Express. Jay Ledford is Captain of the Bailey Mountain Cloggers, and just finished his junior year at Mars Hill College.

December 24, 1915 - April 5, 1996



We know he can never be replaced and he will be sadly missed. To his wife, "Peedee", we all extend our heartfelt condolences and we pray God will keep her in his care and assuage the anguish of her bereavement of a loss so overwhelming and leave her only with the cherished memories of more than 60 years with her beloved Cameron.



figure to the general public is up to us. How we prepare and present a figure to any set of competition judges is strictly up to them.

#### **BUTTERFLY FLIP**

The Butterfly Flip consists of five 2-count calls:

Circle to the left.
Ladies flip
Gents flip
Circle to the right
Everybody flip.

If we were to "pad out" this figure so that all the 2-count calls were always initiated on a 4-count phrase downbeat, a Call & Count (C&C) design might look like this:

"Circle to the left"-3-4. Dance-2-3-4-5-6-7-8.

"Ladies flip"-3-4. Dance 2-3-4-5-6-7-8.

"Gents flip"-3-4. Dance-2-3-4-5-6-7-8.

"Circle to the right"-3-4. Dance-2-3-4-5-6-7-8.

Everybody flip-3-4. Dance-2-3-4-5-6-7-8

[Keep circling to the right until everybody is in home spot squared up with corner].


If you were operating in a super support teacher/caller mode, you would vocalize the "three and four" counts of the call phrase. It gives beginners time to hear and translate into body motion what has been called. You might even bark "three and GO" on the 3-4 counts. After a time you can encourage your beginners to listen for the extra counts in the call phrase and initiate the dance phrase by themselves on the next 4-count downbeat.

Let's talk about the instruction to "Drop hands and flip" and the execution of the flips. For real beginners, I much prefer the instruction: "Let go of hands and dance yourself around in 4 beats".

First: The real beginner is having enough trouble just putting one foot in front of the other. He or she is not likely to be able to execute a 2-count 360° flip and still keep moving forward. So don't require it. When we go to workshop to dance with a bunch of revved up hot steppers, we get to execute our high powered twirls and flips. It is easy to forget that a 360° tight turn IS a very big deal to a beginner. Plan to program that extra time into your C&C choreography.

Second: Dropping one's hands is the last thing we want our dancers to do in this figure or any other figure where smooth latch-up is shortly going to be required. It's OK for our Friday/Saturday night recreational dance bunch to travel with their hands below their belt line. In the YEE-HAW environment, who cares if Uncle Bob, Great Aunt Sally or Little Jimmy gets out of whack and takes 16 extra beats to get back in the line of dance?

HANDS, I say, HANDS are always carried at the belt line. Even when you "let go of hands" you



never "drop hands" even during the 4-count flip. Hands should be in latch-up position at the belt line when the flip concludes and the "flipper" regains the circle. Hands should remain in latch-up position regardless of whether you are the current "flipper" or the "catcher" traveling in the circle.

What about the ability of beginners to relate to the instructions to "flip left" or "flip right". The same person who knows his right from his left in ordinary civilian life will be unable to make the same right-left discernment in dance formation. The dance floor is a scary place. Brains go to mush. However, there are other ways to hook into the brain cells that drive the feet left or right without actually having to say "right" or "left".

Calling attention to the <u>leading shoulder</u> and instructing the "flipper" to turn the thumb of his leading hand to the outside of the circle and to follow his thumb around in the flip... Think about it! Show & Tell to the rescue.

Actual "flipping"? We say "flip", but we actually execute a walking turn while moving forward in 8 counts. The actual turn is executed 2-3-4-5. Ideally, the forward motion of the circle never slows down.

You can dress this figure with a clap on count 4 of the call phrase. The embelishment encourages beginners to keep their ears "inside the music" and "on the count". On the flips, ladies can pick up their skirts, gents put their hands on their hips. Or everybody with hand on hips. Whatever works.

Regardless of embellisments the hands always return to "ready latch-up" at the belt line. Hands are never dropped. Nag! Nag! Nag!

A caller looking to move up in class, and/or looking to move his group up in class, would nail his initial 2-count call on counts 3-4 of the call phrase. The dancers still initiate their execution on the downbeat of the dance phrase. The classy caller's next 2-count call would overlay counts 7-8 of the dance phrases. Now the dance phrases begin to string together one after the other. The calls overlay the dance phrases and the figures flow smoothly from first call to last move.

But we don't have to start out being perfect. We just need to be tuned in to our current caller skill level. When we get really good, we remember how it was to start dancing at the bottom. Good caller/teachers give generously of their teaching and program time, no matter how tiresome.

In other words, folks, we put ourselves in the position of instructor. We are supposed to be more knowledgeable and skillful. Having a few teaching tricks up our sleeve doesn't hurt. Who fits the pieces-parts together, teaches themselves to make the sticky adjustments? We do. Ain't we got fun?!


