



They discussed names, policies, and plans for this new group. Immediately upon their return, they contacted several people who were former cloggers to see if they had interest in resuming clogging. Thus began Cadence Cloggers of Amarillo.

C.D. and Anne are competitive cloggers, participating both in team events and in the duet category. They have competed in Dollywood, Branson, Kansas City, Sherman, and Winter Haven, Florida. 
De-Winterize * Re-Cloggasize Middle Georgia Clogging Workshop A Success



Overall, I had a great time. I give it "two clogging shoes" up!







Sponsoring Your First Workshop Part IX: Wrapping It All Up/ Analyzing Your Success

Well, it's all over...now what? You may think all of the work is complete when the final dance is over, however, there is still much to be done. Typically, when your event is over, you'll want to forget about it for awhile. I recommend you "wrap" it all up before collapsing from exhaustion or departing on that six-week vacation. If you set it all aside, you'll more than likely procrastinate, and next thing you know, considerable time will have passed and some things will not be as meaningful or effective had they been taken care of right away.

So, what do you need to do that is so important?! Start by paying your bills. Don't make your hired instructors wait for payment. Pay them prior to their departure. They've fulfilled their obligations; now you should fulfill yours. They will remember you for it and will be more inclined to have a favorable impression of you and your event.

The same goes for the facility you used. Their part of the deal has been fulfilled, and they should not have to wait for payment. This not only helps establish a good relationship with the facility, it establishes a favorable credit rating for you and/or your group should you have to use this facility as a reference in the future.

Also, be sure to take care of any other outstanding bills you may have from other suppliers, i.e.., flooring rental, etc. Suppliers will be anxious to work with you again in the future if you pay your bills promptly. They may even negotiate lower fees with you for having a history of prompt payments.

Keep detailed records of all your expenses. These will be helpful in planning future events.

When using facilities where their staff assisted with much of your setups and provided other services, it's important that you show your appreciation by leaving a small gratuity. This is especially true if you're working with a hotel facility. Some people to consider for monetary gratuities include: catering/convention services manager, setup crews, bellmen, registration desk staff, and anyone else who displayed a pleasant attitude and made an extra effort to be helpful. If your sales representative was especially helpful, send him/her a small gift showing your appreciation. Typically, monetary gratuities are not given to sales people. I do not recommend gratuities for everyone, only those people who stood out as exceptionally helpful.

I've mentioned in earlier articles that you should provide a means for your attendees to provide feedback about their experiences at your workshop. This is more important than many of us realize. Not only does it say to your attendees that you're interested in fulfilling their needs, it is an excellent source of suggestions and new ideas.

The simplest means of requesting and receiving feedback is a written evaluation form made available to everyone in attendance. Keep it simple, so it can be completed quickly. I recommend a checklist with a simple rating scale. Provide areas to critique the facilities, the workshops, and space for additional comments. You may even want to ask how they heard about the workshop to determine which

advertising avenues are working best for you. A simple layout I use is:

Let your attendees know you want to hear from them. Provide a visible place for them to deposit evaluations, as well as an address to mail them to after the event.

Then, don't just collect them, read them! Pay close attention to the comments and suggestions your attendees offer. After all, you do want them to come back. Within two weeks after the event, tally up all the responses and look for trends in attendees' reactions. Even if only a small number of people respond, you can usually get a good idea of the general feeling overall. Share the results with your volunteers and with the facility you used. Keep the good suggestions and constructive criticism in mind for improving future events.

After the event, meet with your volunteers or key staff to discuss their reactions and experiences. Do this while the event is fresh in everyone's minds. This is a good time to determine everyone's willingness to do it again in the future.

Lastly, although you probably thanked everyone on site for their assistance and contributions to the success of your event, send out written thank-you's to all who contributed. This can mean an awful lot to many people, and you should make an extra effort to show your appreciation. Do not take people for granted, or you may find yourself without helpers in the future.



Sponsoring workshops may sound easy, but it's not. To be successful requires a lot of hard work and dedication. You can have fun doing it if you: 1) plan ahead; 2) work with your volunteers; 3) promote it every chance you get; 4) keep your perspective; and 5) remember, you cannot please everyone.



When to Ice When to Heat

(U.C. Berkley Wellness Letter, May 1994)

What you do during the first few hours after you've sprained your ankle, pulled a muscle, bruised your shoulder, or torn a ligament can help determine whether you are back to your normal routine quickly or still hobbling a week later. The key is ice, applied as soon as possible. Icing is simply the most effective, safest, and cheapest form of treatment. It can also help with some chronic problems such as an overuse injury of the knee (tendinitis) that flares up after exercise. Even if you're on your way to the doctor, start to ice the injury right away. Not only does ice act as a local anesthetic by reducing the impulses of pain receptors, the cooling also reduces blood flow, muscle spasm, and inflammation (though inflammation is part of the healing process, too much of it can impede healing). This in turn helps limit tissue damage and hastens the healing process.

Although commercial ice packs are available, plain ice is fine. Simply put ice cubes or crushed ice in a heavy plastic bag or hotwater bottle, or wrap the ice in a towel. Apply the ice to the injured area for 10 to 20 minutes, then reapply it every two waking hours for the next 48 to 72 hours. Packs that remain flexible when frozen, such as a gel pack or even a bag of frozen peas, can provide more cooling since they conform to the body. If you have injured a foot or hand, you can immerse it in ice water. Be sure not to go over the 20-minute limit; longer than that may damage skin and nerves.

To minimize swelling, especially in severe injuries, use ice in conjunction with three other measures that are often referred to with the acronym RICE: Rest, Ice, Compress, Elevate. Resting not only reduces pain, but also helps prevent aggravating the injury. To apply compression, wrap a towel or an Ace-type elastic bandage around the injury (not so tightly that you cut off circulation). You can often combine ice and compression by holding the ice pack in place with a bandage. At the same time, elevate the injured extremity above heart level. For certain injuries, you can also combine ice with massage: just wrap ice in a towel and move it gently over the affected area.

A few precautions

Don't leave an ice pack directly on the skin: either keep moving it, or wrap it in a thin towel or damp paper towels.

To avoid skin damage or frostbite, stop icing once the skin is numb. Set a timer so that you don't go beyond 20 minutes or fall asleep while icing.

Be careful with refreezable gel packs and self-freezing chemical packs, which may be colder than regular ice. And beware of punctures in the pack, since the chemicals can burn.

Don't use ice on blisters or open wounds, or if you are hypersensitive to cold or have a circulatory problem.

Be particularly cautious when icing the elbow or knee. where the nerves are near the surface and can be damaged by prolonged exposure to cold. To avoid any possible nerve damage, never put an unwrapped ice pack over the elbow or the outside of the knee. Remember that icing is not a substitute for seeing your doctor in case of a serious injury and/or an injury that does not respond to self-treatment in 24 hours.

When to turn up the heat

Traditionally people started applying heat to an injury soon after icing it. But that may be counterproductive, since heat stimulates blood flow and thus may increase inflammation. Most sports physicians and trainers recommend that you stick with ice for at least the first 48 hours after an injury, and only then, after swelling has subsided—try heat. At that point, the increased blood flow caused by heating promotes healing by helping to remove waste products in the injured area. Heat also helps relieve pain, relax muscles, prevent spasms, and reduce joint stiffness.

You can use either dry heat (a heating pad or heat lamp) or moist heat (a hot bath, whirlpool, hot-water bottle, heat pack, or damp towel wrapped around a waterproof heating pad). There's still debate about whether dry or moist heat is best. Each has advantages, so check with your doctor about which is appropriate for your injury. If you have a heart condition or a fever, you may be told to avoid using a hot bath or whirlpool. Don't apply any heat if there's an infection or loss of sensation. If pain or inflammation get worse after heating an injury stop.

The key word is "warm," not "hot." Use heating pads on low or medium settings, and keep the water in baths between 98° and 105°F. (It should feel comfortable when you dip your wrist in). Apply the heat for 20 to 30 minutes, two to three times a day. You can also use heat for 5 to 10 minutes before exercising to reduce stiffness. To be safe, wrap a hot water bottle, hot pack, or heating pad (if it doesn't have a cover) in a towel.

Sometimes Both Help

For some types of chronic pain or muscle spasm, ice or heat may help. For instance, some people with lower-back pain find that ice works, while others can't tolerate the cold and prefer heating. For some chronic or recurrent pain, once the initial ice treatment has brought the swelling down, a doctor or trainer may recommend what's called "contrast therapy"—alternating cold and heat (usually cold and hot water).






