Klogghoppers of Kansas City, Missouri perform in Austria




Klogghoppers performing "All Shook Up." Andy in Elvis attire. Josh King's routine.

The Klogghoppers of Kansas City were one of eight dance groups selected to perform at the 1997 Austrian Alps Performing Arts Festival. The festival took place during mid-June and organized the performing groups into two eight day sessions. The Klogghoppers chose the last session along with the Main Street Cloggers (of Michigan), the Waymouth Canadian Heritage Step Dancers, and the North Carolina University Wolf Pack Cloggers. Along with the dance groups there were five groups of Sweet Adelines (female choral ensembles) who also performed during this session. The Klogghopper team was represented by eight adult cloggers and 6 non-dancers. The dancers consisted of Missy Shinoski (director), Delta Grantham, Becky Farrow, Wanda Gooch, Andy Magee, Betty Kasserman, Pat Ward and Doris Deml. Two of the dancers had just turned 70 years old!

On June 16, 1997 the Klogghoppers met at the Kansas City Airport. We flew U.S. Air to Philadelphia where we hooked up with the seven Main Street Cloggers for the flight to Munich, Germany (7 1/2 Hour Flight). Arriving safely in Munich on Tuesday morning, all of our bags were accounted for and loaded onto a private bus (which was a relief after our 1994 Klogghopper trip to Russia left us without our bags for 3 days). On our two hour bus ride in to Austria, we celebrated Doris Deml's 70th birthday. Luckily, Pat Ward brought a hostess cup cake and a candle from home just for this occasion. We all sang happy birthday and Doris blew out the candle as she made her wish.

Your daughter will ultimately want the same shoe and tap that the group wears, but it is not necessary in the beginning. My guess is that UPS will be back to work by then!

As we neared Austria's boarder we experienced the beauty of its landscape. We would be staying in the magnificent Tyrolean portion of Austria, within the small town of Kitzbuhel. The Tyrolean Alps were breath taking and reach so high that many of the tops were shrouded in clouds. June is the rainiest season for Austria and it rained six days out of eight. But this did not seem to make a difference in the beauty of Austria. We all decided it was still pretty and enjoyable in the rain.

We arrived in Kitzbuhel and settled in to our hotel, The Goldener Greif. We soon found out that our group and the Main Street Cloggers were the only people staying in this hotel, as the

owner had opened the hotel several weeks early to accommodate the performers. The hotel staff was very friendly and each of our rooms were unique and comfortable. Our meals were well presented and served.

Our first side trip was to the city where Mozart lived, Salzburg, Austria. We walked through Mozart's home and viewed many of his belongings. Our favorite part was seeing a lock of Mozart's hair from his (and we quote) "egg-shaped noggin". We also took a cable car up into the Hohensalzburg Fortress. The view was spectacular.

For the opening ceremonies, all the groups paraded down the main street of Kitzbuhel and gathered around the grand stand. The Mayor and the President of Tourism spoke and all the group leaders presented them with a gift. The President of Tourism (who looked like the jolly Green Giant and Fred Flintsone all wrapped in to one) picked Missy up and whirled her around when she reach to give him a polite kiss on his cheek. It was very funny and a picture of it was published in the local newspaper. Each group performed one song (with the Sweet Adelines singing a song in between).

The next side trip was an all day excursion to Venice, Italy. We boarded the bus of a 6 hour bus ride to Venice. We stopped once after we crossed the Italian boarder and was convinced by our guide to skip our second break so we could get more time in Venice. It turned out we arrived before the other buses on our tour and we had to wait for them. We boarded a chartered boat and 30 minutes

later we were in Venice. We found it extremely dirty but unique. The gondola ride was the best twenty dollars many of us spent in Venice. After five hours of exploring with the last hour being rained on, we reboarded the boat and then the bus for another six hour ride back to Kitzbuhel. We were very tired, but we all decided we were glad we had experienced Venice.

Our favorite side trip was to the 1,000 year old Austrian town, Rattenburg, and then a hike up the Krimmel Falls (Europe's highest waterfalls). We shopped in Rattenburg and found many finely crafted glass items. The Krimmel Falls were very full and beautiful. We saw a lot of the country side on this trip and learned many interesting facts about life in Austria. Austria receives a tremendous amount of snow and therefore, skiing is its major tourist attraction. In fact there are several places you can ski year round. Cows are kept indoors from October to May. In May they bring

the cows up to the tops of the Alps to graze. When October comes they have an elaborate parade where the cows wear head dresses. The cow with the biggest head dress is the one who produced the most milk and the cow who was the worst producer ends up with a heavy bell around its neck. This is so the cow will hang its head in shame. We also learned that if a person in Austria wanted to be-

come a farmer they could only be a farmer if they were born or married into a farming family.

That evening all the dance groups performed in the small town of Kirtsburg, Austria. At the end of the performance all the dancers selected a member of the audience so we could teach them the Cotton Eyed Joe. With Missy cueing and Matthew (from Canada) playing the fiddle, the floor was alive with dancing and smiles! It was really a good experience for dancers as well, because they had a chance to interact with people from several other countries. The next day we had blue skies and we explored Kitzbuhel on our own. We went up to the top of the surrounding Alps and took in the wonderful view. That evening we had another performance in Kitzbuhel. We were told each group was to dance five songs. The Klogghoppers were the first clogging group up after the yodelers and Tyrealon Folk Dancers. As we were lining up for our third song the Austrian announcer thanked us and changed the format of the entire show. Ray Hattaway, who was the festival director for the cloggers ended up taking over the announcing as the other guy left. The other dancers re-adjusted their performance to two routines and then we each did another song for the finale.

After spending five fun days in Kitzbuhel, we packed up our bags for the city of Innsbruck, Austria. On our route to Innsbruck

we stopped in Chiemsee, Germany to visit the 1800's King Ludwig II's Castle. When we arrived in Innsbruck we were tortured oops we mean toured around the city by bus. The tour was a hair and nerve raising experience since our guide we picked up in the city forgot she was using a microphone. She yelled the entire time making the majority of the people hold their ears. We also think she may have thought we were Spanish speaking since see really got in to rolling her "R's". Finally we got to our new hotel the Grauer Bar (this hotel was not as enjoyable as those in Kitzbuhel).

Exploring Innsbruck on our own we found the Golden Roof area where we would have our 30 minute performance. We also passed by the Congress Center where all the festival groups would perform together. Most of the Klogghoppers walked up (which is a long way up when it comes to the Alps) to the Alpine Zoo which had a great view of the Olympic ski jump arena (which seats 60,000). The winter Olympics were held in Innsbruck two times. At present

Each group performed one routine and afterwards there was a small presentation for the directors. We boarded the bus for the airport in Munich the next morning and returned home on June 25th.



Lest We Forget

The Marine Corps is always looking for a few good men. Those of us who are involved in Southern Appalachian Square Dancing are no different. What team do you know of, either big or small, which has an over abundance of male dancers? None, you say? You're right. When you are lucky enough to have a quality male dancer associated with your organization you indeed have a rare commodity in your midst.

Several years ago, while judging a competition in Cookeville, Tennessee, I observed a young kid dancing in the solo category who was head and shoulders above all the others his age. He knew what to do when he was on the stage. This youngster has grown into adulthood and is still doing what he loves to do—dance. He has the honor of being a member of the Melvin Sloan Dancers, who dance each Saturday night on the Grand Ole Opry.

I'd rather look at his educational background. He is currently enrolled at Tennessee Technological University in Cookeville, majoring in accounting with a GPA of 3.87. He was the Cookeville High School class Valedictorian. Senior class graduates numbered 400. Listed in Who's Who Among American College Students;

Beta Alpha Psi, Accounting Club, Society of Business Scholars, Alpha Lambda Delta Honor Society; Beta Gamma Sigma National Business Honor Society & Phi Kappa Psi Honor Society.

This young man goes about his business in a very professional manner. He has set his goals very high. What does he do in his spare time? He teaches clogging, enters competitions, travels about the countryside helping youngsters become involved in square dancing and, yes even dances on the world famous Grand Ole Opry for Melvin Sloan.

I asked Melvin about this young man and his response was instantaneous and without reservation. "This is the type of kid that any parent would love to have as a son. He is dependable and hard working," Sloan stated. "Like all of my other dancers on the team, his character is above reproach. He comes from a very loving family. They back him in any of his endeavors. This young man will be a leader in our state in the near future and you can count on that."


Unfortunately we had to head back home Sunday morning,



Yona chock, Chairman of the Contra and Traditional Dance Committee is pleased to announce that the committee has chosen BIG CIRCLE SQUARE DANCE as the Traditional Dance of the Quarter for the period July 1 to November 1, 1997.

Big Circle Square Dance

from Dance A While, Handbook of Folk, Square, Contra, & Social Dance by Jane A. Harris, Anne M. Pittman and Marlys S. Waller

Music: Big Circle mountain Dance Music LP 36L, "Boil The Cabbages Down"; MacGregor 1 100, "Old Joe Clark"; Folkraft 1071 or any rowdy, long lasting tune.

Formation: This dance can be done in a square with as few as four couples, or in a big circle with an even number of couples. In the square one couple at a time is active and dances with each couple to their right in turn (#1 couple dances with #2, then #3, then #4). In the large circle couples count off 1, 2, 1, 2 around the circle. All #1's are active and will dance with the #2 couple to their right and than move on to the next #2 couple.

Figure # I * Bird In A Cage: Circle four hands around.

Cage the Bird with three hands 'round. Active lady steps into the center. Inactive couple and active man join hands and circle left around the active lady.

<u>Bird flies</u> out and the <u>Crow</u> hops <u>in</u>. Active man steps into the center as the active lady joins the circle left with the inactive couple.

Ring up three and you're gone again. Circle left.

Crow hops out and you make a ring. Still circling.

Swing your partner and on to the next. All swing partners. #2's stay at home while #1's move on to the next #2 couple to the right. Repeat this figure or change to...

Figure #2 * Lady 'Round The Lady

Lady 'round the lady, and the gent solo. Active lady leads, her partner following, and goes between the inactive couple; the active lady turns left around behind the inactive lady and around in front of her while the active man goes right behind the inactive man and around in front to end facing him.

Lady 'round the gent, but the gent don't go. The active lady again goes between the inactives this time, turning right behind the inactive man and around in front of and facing him; the active man stays in place until his partner arrives on his right side, when he shifts slightly to the left.

Now circle four go once around and on to the next. The two couples circle left one time, then veer left to face new couples.

Yona Chock, chairman of the Contra and Traditional Dance Committee, is pleased to announce that the committee has chosen QUEEN KA'AHUMANU TRIPLET as the Contra Dance of the quarter for the period July 1 to November 1, 1997.

Queen Ka'ahumanu Triplet By Yona Chock

Sic: Any 64 beat tune that can be played through 3, 6 or 9 times so that the #1 couple ends back at the head of the set where they started.

Formation: Three couple proper sets. Ladies to the caller's left, men to the right facing their partners.

Figure:
Intro:
Lines of three go forward and back. Facing partners about 5 feet apart; take 3 steps toward each other and bow/curtsy on the 4th beat; back out 4

1-8 ---, #1 man and #3 lady Dosado diagonally in

the center of the set.

9 - 16 ---, #1 lady and #3 man Dosado

steps to lines.

17 - 24 ----, #2 couple Dosado partner across the set.

25 - 32 ---, #1 couple promenade down the center 8 steps.

33 - 40 ---, #1 couple turn alone and promenade up the set to cast off

41 - 48 ----, #1's lead the lines down the outside to the foot where the #1's meet and make a four hand arch.

49 - 56 ---, The following #2's and #3's go past them and turn in to go through the arch and promenade up the set to stop at the top.

57 - 64 ----, Lines go forward and back.

The dance is repeated with the former #2 couple as the new #1.

Traditional (Continued from previous column)

Repeat this figure or change back to #1 or use any other familiar figure such as: Mountaineer Loop, Butterfly Twirl, Box the Gnat and Swat the Flea, Dive For The Oyster, Take a Little Peek, Shoot the Owl, Pop Them Through.

RESOLVE. Swing your partner and Promenade. When all are promenading Line of Direction, they can wheel to face in and do an Allemande Left and a Right and Left Grand. This is a great way to say "Good Night" to all of the friendly folks in the hall.



Is Your Club Name Really Your Own??

By Ginny Bartes Gilbert, Arizona

Every clogging club or team has selected a "name" that the dancers in that club or team can identify with. A "name" gives the group its identity and offers a label by which to be known. Naming the group helps form a cohesive bond between the members in addition to the pride shown in letting other people know that "We are the LMNOP (or whatever) cloggers!"

But, is your group name really yours? Have you officially registered the name and gone through the procedures to make the name legally yours? In many cases, you may have, but if you have not, and would like some information on how to make your club name official, read on.

I can only speak for Arizona, but I am assuming procedures in other states are similar. In Arizona, you can write (or call) the Secretary of State's office and request an "Application for Registration of Trade Name". The address in Arizona is:

1700 West Washington 7th Floor, Phoenix Arizona 85007-2808

In return, the Secretary of State's office sends the application along with a booklet explaining how trademark and trade name laws work in the great state of Arizona. If you live in states other than Arizona, of course, you should check the state government listings to find a specific mailing address for your state's trademark and trade names registrations. All you have to do is fill out the application and send a check for about \$10.00. About a month later, the state will send you an official certificate stating that your name is really your name! The certificate states that your trade name has been registered to you, the registration date and the expiration date (which is usually 5 years). The certificate is signed by the Secretary of State and bears the official state symbol. Of course, no one can legally use your exact name and if your requested name has already been taken, you will be notified.

Remember, procedures to officially register your trade name may vary from state to state, but every state has a procedure you must follow to make your trade name legally your own. Call your individual state governments to find out what those procedures are.

Editor's Opinion

While I realize that squables over "club names" occur now and then, I also know that courtesy and good will can prevail. There were, at one time, five (5) separate <u>Sunshine Cloggers</u> groups. With the simple addition of "of Brownsville, Ohio" or "of Red Creek, Illinois" everyone was happy.



His mother, part of the Maggie Campbell family danced for the king and queen of England. He has danced for the Smithsonian Museum in Washington, D.C. and there's film i the Natural History Museum to prove it.

From the Magnun Cloggers and Stompin' Ground Cloggers to the current Mountain Legacy, the family has always joined together in celebrating its mountain dance heritage. Burton, Becky and notable dancers such as professional soloist Ira Bernstein and others from a wide geographic area of Appalachia are joining together to celebrate and show the joy of dance in "Mountain Legacy" in a world-class production to take place at Pack Place in Asheville.

Rough Creek Cloggers

The Rough Creek Cloggers of Haywood County have danced their way into hearts of Europeans, people in many parts of the United States, nad all of the southeast. Organized more than 20 years ago, members of the group traveled with Folkmoot founder Dr. Clinton Border to France in 1980.






