

My Heart Knows Where the Wild Goose Goes...

Reprinted from Footnotes, Volume 48, Number 1, September 1997



Fact 1: As each goose flaps its wings, it creates an "uplift" for the birds that follow. By flying in a "V" formation, the whold flock adds 71% greater flying range than if each bird flew alone.

Lesson 1: People who share a common direction and sense of community can get where they are going quicker and easier because they are traveling on the thrust of one another.

Fact 2: When a goose falls out of formation, it suddenly feels the drag and resistance of flying alone. It quickly moves back into formation to take advantage of the lifting power of the bird immediately in front of it.

Lesson 2: If we have as much sense as a goose, we stay in formation with those headed where we want to go. We are willing to accept their help and give our help to them.

Fact 3: When the lead goose tires, it rotates back into the formation and another goose flies to the point position.

Lesson 3: It pays to take turns doing the hard tasks and sharing leadership. As with geese, people are interdependent on each other's skills, capabilities and unique arrangements of gifts, talents and resources.

Fact 4: The geese flying in formation honk to encourage those up front to keep up their speed.

Lesson 4: We need to make sure our honking is encouraging. In groups where there is encouragement, the production is much greater. The power of encouragement is the quality of honking we seek.

Fact 5: When a goose gets sick, wounded or shot down, two geese drop out of formation and follow it down to help and protect it. They stay with it until it dies or is able to fly again. Then, they launch out with another formation or catch up with the flock.

Lesson 5: If we have as much sense as geese, we will stand by each other in difficult times as well as when we are strong.

Davis and Elkin College, Elkins, West Virginia

We were all happy to hear that you won't need chemotherapy. Hope you continue to feel well and remain healthy!

I just wanted to tell everyone about the incredible clogging experience four of us had in July at the Augusta Heritage held at Davis and Elkins College in beautiful Elkins, West Virginia. We participated in the week-long "Clogging Intensive" under the instruction of Ira Bernstein. We four brave souls are Donna and Reid Lofton, Charlene Ranlet and yours truly.

What fun we had, and oh what we learned! A more perfect week could not have been had (unless my husband had been able to attend, but alas, dear John stayed home to cat-sit so that I could go!)

Our clogging class met every day, Monday through Friday, 9:30-11:30 and again from 1:30-3:30. We were told to bring leather-soled shoes, and by the end of the first day, many of us had worked our way through a box of Band-Aids. It was awesome being in the same room with Ira, as well as having the opportunity to learn from him. What a fantastic dancer he is. His style is effortless, and his sound is crystal-clear. Ira is an easy-to-follow instructor, and he moved around the room providing helpful individual attention.

The class consisted of warm-ups, instruction and lecture, and was sometimes followed by a video for those interested (e.g., "Talking Feet"). We learned steps that are the foundation for Ira's style of flatfooting. He empha-

sized the importance of listening and feeling the music, which is the same emphasis mentioned over and over at the percussive workshop held earlier this year at Mars Hill in North Carolina. We had to learn what was a new technique for many of us: dropping down flat on our feet on the down beat, and then leaving the ground totally on the drag and landing squarely to produce another clear sound. the four-sound, with variations and other steps in between. The four of us had tried to prepare ourselves for the class by becoming familiar with Ira's video "Flatfooting Workshop," and while Ira basically followed the same format, we picked up more by being there, listening to the instruction, and practicing in class. We were disappointed only in that there was less dancing than we expected. The course write-up was not entirely accurate when it advertised "physically demanding dance for a minimum of four hours daily." This is not to say that we weren't sweating profusely! But a lot of our dancing was practicing the steps we'd been taught, which helped us get a grasp on each stage prior to moving on. It was a real change from contemporary clogging.

One of the pleasures of the class was the live music provided by the fiddle of John Herman. What a difference it makes dancing

One of the pleasures of the class was the live music provided by the fiddle of John Herman. What a difference it makes dancing to beautiful live music. As an extra bonus during our last class, we were treated to music from Ira on the fiddle (he's great!), John on the banjo and the guitar music of a woman whose name I did not get.

Two evening concert performances were given during the week by the master instructors. Ira wowed the audience when he performed. He danced on a 4 x 6 surface of narrow wooden slats glued closely together on a backing of canvas (similar to the roll-top portion of a roll-top desk). The sound was just fantastic, and everyone watched without a blink, afraid he/she would miss something!

This particular week (July 7-11) was also Cajun/Zydeco week at the Davis and Elkins College, and we all took part in the nightly outdoor dances—what fun!! But you should have seen Ira dance—

he's a wild man out there! In fact, everyone stopped to watch as he and Cajun dance instructor Mona burned up the floor during one of the numbers. We found out later that he used to teach Cajun/Zydeco at the college in its early years!

In addition to our class, dances and concerts, the jam sessions on the magnificent porch of the Halliehurst Building were the ending ritual of each evening. This porch is so huge that three different jams took place at the same time without interfering with each other. And there was room for dancing, as well! We heard some beautiful old-time music, as well as Cajun.

As for the accommodations, three of us stayed in two-person dorm rooms, which generated its own set of tales. Such as the time when Reid, not wanting to journey to the men's room two floors up, used the women's bathroom to shower, somewhat guarded by his wife, Donna. When another woman came in,

Donna tried to keep the conversation short, well aware of Reid, quiet as a mouse, in one of the shower stalls. Finally, Donna confessed and Reid came walking out (fully clothed)—introductions were made, and the conversation continued!





sized bed! I loved it, and there were treats here, too. One night I enjoyed an impromptu lobby jam session with Brian Bowers, master autoharpist.







Young Lake Odessa Native is accomplished Georgia Clogger

Clogging her way across the USA— and France—is a niche that Lake Odessa native Becky Schelter has come to enjoy.

At age 15, Becky is already considered among the best in the south. She teaches beginners how to clog, competes with the competition team, Clogg'n FX and travels with the exhibition team, Li'l Foot Stompers.

"I like the attention," said Becky, the daughter of Ron and Shellie Schelter who have lived in Cummings, Georgia since Becky was eight.

Ron is the son of Don and Joann Schelter of Lake Odessa. Shellie the daughter of Elden and Marilee Jackson of Sunfield.

"I've been clogging about seven years," she said.

Being a member of Clogg'n FX is a real honor, she said, because the owner of the competition team, Scottie Bilz, is considered to be one of the best in the world. He has teams all over the United States, she said.

As part of the competition team, Becky has held to garner the junior division cloggers over 40 first, second and third awards.

Her love for the special, tap-like dancing, which originated in Appalachia, spawned out of Becky's earlier introduction to dance by Woodland's Della Meade.

"I was in Della Meade's class but we moved to Georgia," said Becky. "One day, my mom was looking inthe newspaper an saw a clogging class advertised."

Becky and her cousin, who lives in Cummings as well, were soon signed up.

"And I never quit," she said.

Now, she is the teacher of a about 15 students, ranging in age from five to 30-plus.

Becky was specially chosen to teach the class by a man name Big John Walters who had been teaching it for years. When he retired, it was Becky he wanted to replace him.

"Big John Walters started (founded) clogging - in Georgia," said Becky. "He's very well known and he's the one who taught me how to clog. He's like a grandpa to me."

Becky keeps tapping those basic triple and mountain goat steps on the upbeat because it's a way she can entertain by doing something she's good at.

"I love to perform," she said. "There is not a lot you can do in front of a crowd and I was good at it. You have to have the heart to do it because it takes a lot of practice."

"It's kind of like a natural talent," said her grandmother, Joann. Her performances have taken been to seven national clogging conventions, six specialty shows and one appearance on television news to give the clogging team some, media exposure.


And in France, the Li'l Foot Stompers represented the United States at a folk festival five years ago.

Becky enjoys doing formation dancing and line dancing as part of the team, which performs all kinds of styles to all kinds of music.

"Tap, jazz and ballet, to me, all seem so slow." said Becky of her preference for clogging, which requires a !much faster rhythm.

Music she has danced to has included "Play that Funky Music, White Boy," "Unbelievable," as well as "Boot, Scootin' Boogie" and even some Broadway tunes.

"We do stunts, jazz and cheerleading type stuff," Becky noted.


