Symphonic Bluegrass ... Could It Be True?!

When the phone call came in July, the woman identified herself as the operations manager with the **San Antonio Symphony**. She continued, "We are interested in booking your group to perform during the *San Antonio Pops Concert Series* in September. You would be performing **live** with the symphony itself" Ho, ho, ho. I asked the normal questions: time, date location, payment, etc. and she said she would get back to me once they had reached a firm decision. Hmmmnn. Our team normally uses hard core bluegrass music and I wondered how well the two entities could work together.

Meanwhile, no time to ponder. The Texas Folklife Festival (the first weekend in August) would soon be upon us and we had to prepare for our performances. In addition to our usual shows, we had invited various dance groups who participated in the Festival to dance with us in a huge combined routine. We started this "tradition" last year and had great fun. So we joined forces with other dance groups at Folklife to present our 2nd Annual Folklife Dance Sampler featuring dancers from Ballet Folklorico Boriken (Puerto Rican), Hula Halau Ohana Elikapeka (Hawaiian), San Antonio Irish Dancers, Boys of Wexford (Irish), Hill Country Highland Dancers Continued on Page 3

Dance AV "Boyzone of Percussive Dance"

Bridgwater Arts Centre has the distinction of being the oldest arts centre in the UK, now in its 50th year. Based in an attractive Georgian terrace in one of the more pleasant areas of this small town, it is also the home to Somerset Dance Connections who strive valiantly to increase the profile of dance throughout the county and the south west in general.

Part of their annual programme (UK spellings throughout!) is a day of percussive dance, gathering between 150 and 200 dancers, held in late October just as the joints prepare to stiffen up for the winter! This year, the 4th of these events, was to feature DanceAV, billed as the "Boyzone of Percussive Dance" a reference which may be lost to foreign readers and also to those of us who take little interest in pop music for reasons due to age or musical taste. They are, however, five extremely talented young men who specialize in various forms of percussive dance and are able to mix and match styles seamlessly.

Actually, the "five" was reduced to "four", their Irish dancer having been just been poached to join the "Riverdance" chorus for the next London season, and almost became "two" due to major traffic delays caused by road accidents extending a 3 hour drive to 7 hours!

So, in amongst all the panic about the traffic delays, Dance AV's early arrival via a different route, Gary O'Mahoney led a workshop on his specialty, English clog (wooden shoe), concentrating on a few complex steps to a studious group of 20 plus, using a variety of music from traditional to current chart hits.

Secure from his previous night arrival, Lee Payne began with a jazz tap style warm-up

(Scottish), Zorya (Ukrainian Dancers), Texas Klompendancers (Dutch). This year we even expanded to include some "stray" musician/dancers from the Ledbetters (bluegrass band) as well as the San Antonio Pipes and Drums (Scottish band) This year at Folklife we featured the regular performance team plus the newly formed junior team (ages 9 to 13). At the end of that weekend I considered Folklife a success and looked forward to recuperating from doing ten shows in four days.

HOWEVER, two days after Folklife the telephone rang. My contact with the San Antonio Symphony informed me, "We have the music ready for you to pick up." I roused my weary body and chugged downtown because I was anxious to hear this lovely tune. It turned out that we would perform a live show with our friends the Tennessee Valley Authority bluegrass band in front of the Majestic Theater for thirty minutes before the concert actually started. During the Pops Concert itself we would do only one routine on stage with the symphony, so it wouldn't really be that tough. I'd pick up the cassette, listen to the music and rearrange a few steps in one of our old numbers to fit this new tune. HA HA Ha Ha ha ha hhhhaaa. I popped the cassette into the tape deck of our van to listen to it on my way home.





"This shouldn't be too difficult," I chortled. My mouth fell open as I listened ... and listened ... and listened. Seven and a half minutes later I realized that I was in pretty deep This medley contained many different songs (from Soldier's Joy to Turkey in the Straw to some Irish tune I'd heard before, but I couldn't remember the name of, to Pop Goes the Weasel, plus more), all done in a manner of what I called "symphonic bluegrass." The instruments themselves, the extra sound effects, and the fact that it was a medley, made it impossible for me to fit this tune accurately to any of our normal routines. I'm grateful that the good Lord gave me the gift of being able to fit steps to music because it looked like I really had my job cut out for me. I did pass about 64 beats of that unidentifiable Irish music on to Cindy Campbell, one of our dancers, who did an excellent job with it. That part sounded very dainty and the men's big feet didn't seem to fit the music. I told her where the women would start and where they needed to end up on the stage and turned her loose. The twelve dancers who participated _3_

really pulled together to accomplish this difficult goal because we actually had only five weeks in which to learn both steps and figures for a six couple precision routine (not to mention smoothing out the rough edges). It really went down to the wire. I was teaching them the first portion of the routine before I had finished writing the next section. The routine had at least fifteen different figures (columns, tunnels, windows, polka style in a circle, women threading the needle while the men made arches, alamo style circle, men down on one knee while women do figures, etc.) plus mountain figures. Finally, we formed a column and did a few more turns and hurrahs. Then came the big finale ending step, where we smiled and stomped around to find the beat and end the routine. Just kidding.

We arrived at the Majestic Theatre for the first rehearsal. It was to be just us and the conductor. The program for the Pops Concert read, "America's busiest pops conductor, superstar Erich Kunzel appears regularly on nationwide television programs, records exclusively on the Telarc Records label, and performs annually on the podiums of virtually every major orchestra in North America." Kunzel, it continued, "holds degrees from Dartmouth, Harvard and Brown Universities" and has "served on the faculties of Brown University and University of Cincinnati College." Nevertheless, the maestro endeared himself to us by his droll remarks and down-home sense of humor. He was to watch us "perform"

our routine to taped music the first night. We would return the next night in order to rehearse with the entire orchestra. My eleven dancers lined up backstage while I came forward and expressed my concern that we would not be able to hear the music from the overhead speakers. The sound technician was told to turn up the volume and then start the music. The maestro stood in the middle of the center aisle with his arms crossed. The taps crashed and the herd thundered across the stage. "Louder," I calmly yelled in the direction of this silent gentleman. He turned and called something to the soundman at the back of the theater and the music seemed to be a little more intelligible. I commanded our mighty footed group to "slow down" numerous times, but to no avail. As we finished the seven and a half minute routine Kunzel had his hands on his hips and was walking toward the stage. I was apologizing all over myself, saying things like, "we are used to dancing faster than this music" and "we really couldn't hear" plus other inept dialog. Herr Kunzel looked me over and asked, "Did you cho-


reograph the routine?" I admitted my responsibility and looked back toward the dancers. "D—n good, isn't she?" Kunzel asked the cloggers. They nodded as I pointed at Cindy Campbell to incriminate her for the Irish steps in the routine. The conductor grinned and said that everything would be fine the next day because the orchestra would be REALLY LOUD.

Well, they were really loud and it was certainly a challenge and a thrill to perform this endeavor. The following is an essay which our twelve year old daughter, Sarah, wrote for her 7th grade English class when instructed to write about an exciting event in her life. Here is the *rest of the story:*

"It was a lovely day on a Sunday one week ago. My mom, Dad, and I got up at eight o'clock and then we went to church. After church, we went home and changed into our Fire-on-the-Mountain Clogger costumes. Then we picked up my grandparents and drove downtown. My grandparents went to the front of the Majestic Theatre and the rest of us went in the back entrance. We went down two flights of stairs and down two halls, took a left and arrived at the lovely accommodations they had made for us. We were not the first ones there. In about fifteen minutes all twelve of us were gathered in the small room.

We made a special preview performance outside the Majestic just before the doors opened and the San Antonio Pops Concert began. The twelve of us danced to a live bluegrass band, called the Tennessee Valley Authority, who are friends of ours.

After our performance we trooped back all the way through the Majestic down the stairs, through the halls, and to the left. We arrived back at the "dressing room" just in time to change back into our street shoes and scurry back the way we came and creep into the darkened theater. My mom, Dad, several other dancers, and I watched from the very edge of the left side of the theater. We watched the show until the intermission. Then we fled down the stairs, through the halls, and to the left. We hurriedly took off our street shoes, picked up our tap shoes and tiptoed in our stocking feet to the backstage area.




Sam Nobles proves he can make two limberjacks dance at the same time.

My heart was pounding in my ears as the conductor announced us. As we walked onto the stage, I stuck a huge smile on my face. It stayed there throughout the seven and a half minute long performance. The twelve of us twirled, polkaed and danced ourselves silly. We were so excited to be on the stage of the Majestic Theatre!

After our performance was finished, the audience roared! We turned around and clapped for the orchestra members who had scorched their bowstrings and run out of breath trying to make the music fast enough for us. After the entire show was through all of its participants gathered on or below the stage and the audience once more made me afraid the roof was going to fall on us like the walls of Jericho. When the audience stopped cheering the performers all scattered everywhere. My mom, dad, and I went and found my grandparents and we walked back to our car. As we drove home I couldn't forget the exhilaration of being on the stage of the Majestic Theatre. All of the excitement made me want to go back and do it all over again. I am sure this is an experience that I will never, ever forget, even if I live to be one hundred years old!"



involving much bending and stretching. It was a far cry from the previous night when he had watched our cats sprawled in front of the fire and commented that he would prefer to warm up that way! His later workshop in jazz and rhythm tap was far more energetic and put his students to the test for fitness and agility.

Beginners Appalachian was Claire's first venture into a formal teaching role. A comfortable sized group of about 20 were **brought in** at the most basic level, working up from a walking step, through singles and doubles to about eight steps all put together in a simple "taster" routine within the 90 minute session.

Whilst parents - admittedly mainly mums - were busy elsewhere, Sara Marshall from Bristol team "Applejacks" took about a dozen youngsters for a clogging session and expanded it later into a "make a dance" class. Clogger and local dance teacher Niki McCretton kept 16 youngsters between 7 & 11 years old busy with a lively and popular "street dance" class, something she has successfully taken to various local schools. Many of the children had never danced before, let alone tried this high energy dance form. Interestingly, the class was mainly made up of boys.

The Irish stepping instruction was provided by local teacher Catherine Bartlett, covering a selection of jig, reel and hornpipe steps in both soft and hard shoe. With the time allotted and such a range she could only provide suitable inspiration, but no doubt added a few members to her regular classes. Anne Smith from local team "Beetlecrushers" showed her varied clogging expertise by teaching French Canadian stepping to a studious group.


The absence of Ross Allen to take the Intermediate Appalachian group gave rise to an impromptu session by Mike Highfield and Chris Rudd, current and former members respectively of local team Hotfoot. Faced with a room full of enthusiastic feet, they taught the untraditionally named 'Easter Bunny' from the Hotfoot repertoire, being a conveniently not too complicated couple dance which for most of the attendees introduced a number of new steps including a "creation" of Mike's, called in the best traditional style - the "Highfield Kick"!

12:30 brought the arrival of the very harassed remainder of Dance AV and a very rapid rescheduling of events for the afternoon while everyone else caught up on their lunch.

Ross Allen finally managed to take his flatfooting class with about 35 participants, teaching a lovely sequence he had written especially for the event. He used steps many people were familiar with interspersed with some tricky pick-up steps and others that crossed the music. Food for both the brain and the feet! Ross is one of the better known UK practitioners, being a member of Broken Ankles (one of the UKs first and highly respected clogging teams, led by his mother, Penny) and a solo performer in his own right, well versed in various clogging styles including English and French Canadian. He also managed to sneak an extra intermediate workshop during the afternoon for those who had missed out in the morning and still had time and energy.

Gary Pell ran two successive rhythm tap workshops, first beginners then expanding to more advanced dancers, trying to show differences between the American style and that danced here. Despite his youth—not yet 18—he had no trouble teaching a selection of basic steps with a simple routine then expanding it by adding extra "sounds" and increasing the speed. The larger proportion of his students were from local dance schools who were used to tap but a modest number of cloggers kept up with him despite finding so much dancing "across" the music a little unusual.



1997 Camp Clog Workshop and Competition

Over 125 dancers from 7 states met at the brand new Cliffview Resort, near Slade, Kentucky for the 9th Annual CAMP CLOG Workshop on July 12, 1997 hosted by Jeff Driggs and Jeff Parrott. The two Jeff's special guest instructors this year were Sherry Glass-West of Tennessee and Jon Hasler of Indiana. The all-star staff taught a variety of material throughout the day using all musical styles. In addition, Christy Seng, of Illinois, joined Jeff Driggs on stage to teach a routine they choreographed together, "Who's Cheatin' Who"

Saturday evening brought everyone back to Cliffview for a "Steak and Bake" dinner hosted by the resort's owners Dick and Valerie White. Following the dinner a dance was held, and then everyone went out on the large front porch of the center to enjoy live bluegrass music by the "Friends of Bluegrass" from Middletown, Ohio. Two of the players in this musical group are no strangers to clogging, the guitar player is Jimmy Montgomery, whose son Brent has been a champion team and solo dancer, and the fiddler is Harold Staggs, whose son Brian has danced on the Ultimate Dance Force and Power and Precision.

Cliffview Resort is truly an amazingly beautiful place. Nestled in the Kentucky mountains just east of Lexington, cloggers have been coming to this area for years to enjoy the weekly summer dances at Natural Bridge State Park. Valerie White says that she and her husband had always envisioned owning and running a bed and breakfast and scenic resort, but after seeing the CAMP CLOG competition the year before they decided to add a Dance Pavilion and Activities Center to the plans. Boy, did they ever build! The all-Kentucky-hardwood center is a spacious building with lots of room for the workshop. Valerie even added dressing rooms to the plans for the dancers to change clothes. As the date for the workshop neared, Jeff and Jeff began to worry that the resort would not be finished in time. Dick and Valerie promised a working center,

and the building was ready just in time for the workshop. The only part of the structure not yet finished was the air conditioning. Things were fine for the workshop Saturday, but the crowd was so large for the Sunday Competition that the large fans could not keep up and the floor began to sweat. The first few categories were more like an ice skating contest than a clogging one. But cloggers are a forgiving bunch, and the problem was corrected with a little corn meal and a dust mop without any bruised bottoms! Next year's CAMP CLOG will enjoy the center fully completed—air conditioning and all! Once fully completed, Cliffview resort will be one of the largest resorts in the state.

The Natural Bridge Clogging Championships held on Sunday, July 13 was the biggest to date. There were over 50 team entries and over 200 solo entries in the day long event held at Cliffview. The judges for the day were Jeff Driggs, Jeff Parrott, Tandy Barrett and Emilee Parrott. The scorekeeper was Missy Fuller, who always does a super job. Harold and Lea Ann Ward and their daughter, Laura, have become an invaluable part of the CAMP CLOG family. They run the registration for both the workshop and the competition, and are always organized and ready to go.





The Big Picture

By Ed Foote, Pittsburg, Pennyslvania (Reprinted From Footnotes, Volume 4, Number 5, January 1998)

All of us have read articles in recent years regarding the decline in square dancing, but after a while all the words and thoughts become jumbled, so that today if the average dancer is asked why square dancing is in decline, the likely response is: "I don't know." Some criticize the activity and say that the product, which has been successful for 25 years, is the reason for the decline, so the product needs to be changed by shortening or combining lists.

It might be helpful to step back and look at the big picture of what is happening in this country without discussing square dancing at all. Once we see the big picture, it will be easy to understand how this affects square dancing.

- 1. All Group Activities Are Down. According to Psychology Today Magazine, group activities started to decline in the late 1980's, and have been in a free fall for the past 5 years. Bowling was once trumpeted as the model which square dancing should follow. Last year a major television network did a feature about the sharp decline of bowling leagues. In the past year, 3 bowling alleys closed in the Pittsburgh area. Why are group activities down?
 - A. Staying at home has become much more popular. According to a Newsweek/Gallup poll, as far back as 1989, 70% of all adults said that staying at home is their favorite method of relaxation. In 1986 it was only about 25%. Why is staying at home so popular? 3 reasons:
 - A safe haven from life's pressures. According to Psychology Today Magazine: "Many people in the 60's and 70's viewed it (staying at home) as a trap, an infringement on their freedom to discover and express themselves. Now it is a refuge from the pressured life and tough times outside."
 - Video cassettes. The convenience of renting movies to watch at home became big business in the second half of the 1980's.
 - 3) Home computers. With the advent of the Internet around 1993-94, people now prefer to sit home and work with their computer. This has contributed significantly to the free fall decline in group activities in the past 5 years.
 - B. There is more emphasis on individual activity. "Do your own thing" has become the watchword in recent years. According to Psychology Today, activities requiring only individual participation, such as crafts, using a computer, walking, working out in a gym, and taking courses at local colleges, are all flourishing. Group activities are floundering. One psychologist noted that any organization trying to sell the public

on a group activity had better emphasize the individual benefits to be gained by participating.

 We Have Less Leisure Time. According to the previously mentioned Newsweek/Gallup poll, in 1990 Americans said they were working 6 hours more per week than in 1973, and they had 10 fewer hours of leisure time per week.

With the heavy emphasis on corporate downsizing in the 1990's, it is likely that those still working for corporations are working even longer hours today and have even less free time. Those ousted in corporate downsizing sometimes are working 2 jobs now.

3. Adults Are Seeking A Wide Range Of Experiences. According to Psychology Today, people are not satisfied with only experiencing a few recreational activities they want to experience as many as they can. This probably explains why so many people complete a square dance beginners class and then drop out after 1 or 2 years. It is not that they do not like the activity of square dancing or that it is too difficult, it is simply that they have spent time doing square dancing and now they want to do something else.

Summary:

All this means the following for square dancing:

- Many people will want to stay home and watch videos or use their computer and thus not join a beginners class. This does not mean there is anything wrong with our activity, it just means that people want to stay home.
- To get some of these people into beginners class, our advertising will have to emphasize the individual benefits of square dancing, such as exercise and maintaining mental alertness.
- 3. When people do come to beginners class, it will make no difference whether they have to learn 25 calls or 100 calls. They are in this for the experience, and they will leave after a certain length of time (probably 2 years) because they want to try something new. Thus, all the talk about shuffling lists or combining lists is futile; list changing will have little effect on the underlying causes for the decline in square dancing and could cause damage to the structure of the activity, thereby adversely affecting those who are currently in square dancing for the long haul.
- 4. What will be needed is large-scale recruiting efforts which, even if successful, will have to be ongoing in order to replace those who drop out each year simply because they want to experience another activity.




