South 40 Express Clogging and Country Line Workshop and Competition

The 1st Annual South 40 Express Clogging and Country Line Dance Workshop and Competition was held June 3 - 6, 1998, in Hillsboro, Ohio. Dancers from throughout the area attended and we'd like to thank everyone who came and made our event a success.

Jack House, a great country line dance instructor, kicked off the program on Wednesday with some fun line dances. On Thursday, world-renowned Irish dancer Karl Drake, from Dublin, wowed the participants with some amazing footwork. Also on Thursday, country line dance teachers Barry and Doria Ann Amato, from the TNN television program "The Wild Horse Saloon", lead the crowd through some line and couple dances. Their easy to follow style put everyone at ease and everyone learned a great deal from this talented twosome. During the lunch and supper breaks, the crowd was entertained by the music of Marcus and Megan Mullions, a talented young group from Indiana. The Mullions fiddle playing and singing was a perfect compliment to the days activities and had everyone's hands clappin' and feet tappin'. During their sets of classic country and bluegrass, the floor was packed with dancers eager to step to the lively music.

In addition to the fine workshops by the international instructor, each day of events also featured a dance competition. Thousands of dollars in trophies were offered in a variety of dance categories for both cloggers and country western dancers. The first day's events recognized the best in clogging duos and duets and country western couples. The following days saw competitions in clogging and country western teams and clogging solos.

The clogging program continued with a great workshop of advanced competition steps by Brian Staggs, of Ohio. Brian has

learned from many of clogging's best freestylers and he is also a champion competitor. Barry and Daria Ann Amato continued through the weekend -- along with Karl Drake -- to share their vast knowledge of dance, and several local clogging and line dance instructors also joined in to lead the crowd through new material. Sara Wallen, of Greenfield, Ohio, taught an easy intermediate clogging line dance that was a hit with the dancers.

Plans are already underway for the next South 40 Express Workshop and Competition in June, 1999.

Morehead State University Flying Eagles Give Final Performances

The Morehead State University American Folk Dance and Clogging Team known as the Flying Eagles gave their final performances in May, 1998. They ended the season at Grayson Memory Days in Kentucky on May 21st, and performed as the opening act for the country western group "Exile" on May 14, at the Grayson Rural Electric Co-op's Annual Meeting.

The Folk Dance and Clogging group was formed at Morehead State University in Morehead, Kentucky more than ten years ago -- under the direction of Scott McKee -- to exhibit and teach the heritage of Appalachian dancing. The group performed at university functions, local charitable events and festivals, schools and nursing homes. The group also participated in dance competitions and has received numerous trophies and honors.

Due to budget constraints at the University, the folk dance and clogging team has been disbanded and will no longer be performing. The current co-directors, Bill Robinsn abd Kathy Staffard, and the entire team would like to thank all of the people that have support the Flying Eagles throughout the years.

The Planning Committee provided a generous 6 1/2 hours of programmed clogging at the Square Dance Convention. This allowed us to program short teaching workshops of the newest additions to the national dance list. Thank you also, to the wonderful cuers and teachers who made the sessions not only informative but also a whole lot of fun. Finally a big thank you to the dancers from all over Australia and New Zealand. It was your enthusiastic participation that made the sessions so enjoyable and worthwhile.

The Minilab '98, a seminar for teachers of Square Dancing, Round Dancing and Clogging was held in the luxurious Stamford Grand Hotel overlooking the beach in Glenelg. Minilab certainly lived up to its theme: "Learning To Teach."

Despite the modesty of some Aussie presenters, we learned so much from each other. Edith Sandy's presentation on the history of clogging was fantastic. We are fortunate to have someone record the history of clogging in this country.

We really must do something to continue the education of our teachers at workshops like this. Where's the next one?

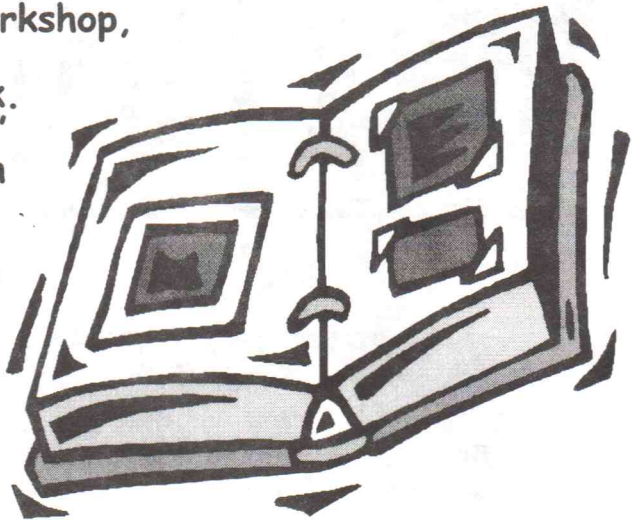

Many craft stores now carry scrapbooking kits; you can also create your own combinations by buying papers, stickers and "photo mates" a la carte.

To learn more, classes and scrapbooking workshops are popping up all over the country; ask about them at craft and memory album supply stores in your area.

Have fun with your project and share it with your clogging friends!



To get you started, here are tips from hot off the press, from manufacturers of scrapbooking kits and products:

1. Spread your photos out and put them in groups. Label the back of each photo with an acid-free pen.

2. If you want to put more than one photo on a page, be sure there's a common theme connecting your choices. Don't be afraid to edit - just because you took two rolls of film at your show doesn't mean you need to save and preserve every last one.

Patterned papers add instant color and depth to the page. Choose a pattern that enhances your theme, like metallic stars for winning competition shots. To keep the pattern from overwhelming your photos, mat them with paper in a coordinating solid color.

3. If you want to include newspaper articles or announcements in your memory album, photocopy them onto acid-free, lignin-free paper to prevent the brittleness and discoloration that occurs over time (for an "authentic look" shop for off-white paper that resembles newsprint).

4. As you finish each memory album page, slip it into a clear sheet protector, then into your three-ring-binder.

be there to appreciate it" acts.

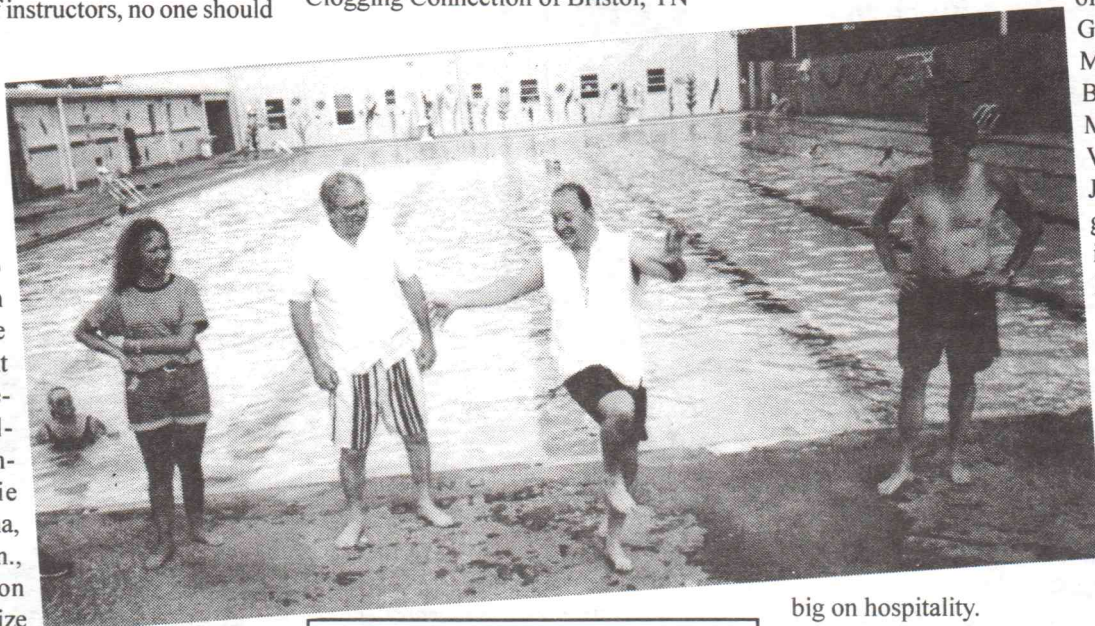
