## But How Do We Sell It?

This New Year's, cloggers will have the opportunity to be seen by the masses, as hundreds of cloggers take to field as part of the Comp USA Florida Citrus Bowl. Backed by the music of Country Music superstar Charlie Daniels, cloggers will join hundreds of dancers, flag corps and cheerleaders in a spectacular show of Americana. How will clogging be received, and how can we benefit from this important visibility for our art form?

Some feel that clog dancing is due for a much-needed boost. In other areas, reports are that classes are up and attendance at workshops is growing. As with all activities, dance classes go in cycles. Western dance and clogging certainly enjoyed a burst of enthusiasm in the 1980's during the "Urban Cowboy" phenomenon. Many say that the tremendous success of Riverdance and Lord of the Dance have boosted their classes. Others say that the slow disintegration of the country western line dance crowd is drawing these dancers to clogging in search of a challenge.

I guess it's a matter of marketing. If we encourage people to attend traditional Appalachian clogging classes using *Riverdance* as a marketing "hook", you may find your students disappointed that you are not teaching Irish dance. Using a well known image to draw attention is a

standard tool in the marketing industry. Just make sure that the product you market using this technique meets or exceeds the expectations planted in the audience's minds.

In our exclusive interview this month with Maria and Erin from the Celtic music and dance sensation Leahy, Maria answered the question "What do you feel you have gained from the dance experience?". She responded that she most appreciated the environment itself. Relating to people of all ages who share your interest. Families and children learning and laughing together. Maria said it is one of the healthiest environments she knows. The opportunity of a lifetime -- one that she wishes for her own children to share.

I think that sometimes we forget that the best thing our dance has going for it is the dance itself. People are hungry for a chance to bond with others in fun and fellowship. How many hobbies do you know that hold people for a lifetime? We must not apologize for the hominess and simplicity of the clog dance and its origins. Clogging is a vital and living art form that celebrates life and music and movement. What better marketing is there than a sea of smiling faces performing a dance they love?




#### Clogging's Is Dancer's "Cup of Tea"



#### The Celtic Music and Percussive Dance Family STEPS into the Spotlight

For most cloggers and performing clogging and percussive dance groups, the opportunity to open a concert featuring a country music superstar would be a chance of a lifetime. For Leahy, the Canadian Celtic

music and dance sensation, it has become a career.

Bolstered by numerous awards and a debut album newly certified Platinum in Canada, Leahy has garnered a highly coveted slot on superstar Shania Twain's North American Tour.

For Leahy, a family band of four brothers and five sisters from Lakefield, Ontario, the Twain gig is the latest milestone in a rapidly rising career. Combining furious Celtic fiddle music with fleet-footed percussive dancing, ravenhaired good looks, and an easygoing confidence born of having performed together since childhood, Leahy is invading the U.S.

with a vengeance. Named a Billboard Talent Pick for 1998, Leahy continues to rise through the top 20 on Billboard's world music chart. The group has gained momentum in the States with television appearances on PBS (in their own 30-minute show, Leahy in Concert, as well as Gael Force with The Cheiftans), ABC (The View), and CNN (Showbiz Today).

dancers travel to workshops and competitions every weekend. Being from that environment yourselves, where your friends cannot understand this passion we share for dance, what do you feel you have gained from the experience? Maria: One thing

Maria: One thing that I have really come to appreciate – now that we are out of that environment – is the en-

vironment itself. What an unbeleivable environment to grow up in. **Erin:** Absolutely.

Maria: To be relating to other people the

same age as you, with the same interests as you. Every weekend you are in a different place and it is usually families. It is a family thing, a community thing. To be learning to play music and dance, to hear others play, it is one of the healthiest environments. If a person is talented enough to be able to put themselves in that environment, they have been given the opportunity of a lifetime. Not everyone gets that chance. I know I would love to have my children grow up in an environment where there is constant music. Music is the focus, and you can build relationships and friendships with so many people.

**DTT:** It becomes an extended family.

Maria: Exactly. When we performed with the Steele Family Cloggers at Calgary, we got along really, really well. One of the reasons was we had so many similarities. We were able to relate to each other because dancing was a big part of our lives, and traveling. We had a bond right away.

**DTT:** There has been a Celtic explosion in our culture lately. Where do you see it going from here?

Maria: It is amazing what Riverdance and Lord of the Dance have done for Celtic music and dance. It has introduced masses to this style in a way that has never been done before. It has given other people the opportunity to express their own Celtic interests, to interpret Celtic music in different ways, and to interpret other music from a Celtic perspective and have an audience there ready and waiting to listen. I


think that newer forms of Celtic music may start to arise — different variations, different interpretations. It will allow Celtic music and dance to live on and be passed down, so that people in the future will be able to understand it from their own perspective.

styles come together, you get a very multicultural style of dance which Canada is known for.

**DTT:** Have you noticed changes in the traditional dance styles due to the increased exposure of percussive dance?

Maria: Oh, yes. It's unbelievable. There has been a huge explosion of dance, with the Spanish and other styles, which is fantastic. We are getting all of these other forms and styles of dance which are really encouraging people to be creative and innovative. As a result, more people in the general public are aware of dance.

**DTT:** Your music has been described as "ferocious and extremely energetic". They have a personality that is so unique.

Erin: Thank you.

DTT: What influences your music?

Maria: Everything from rock to classical... Erin: You said it right there. Primarily, everything. I was thinking about it today as we were preparing for the show, that they are not really classically traditional Irish tunes that we are writing. They are more like a combination of classical and rock





## Teaching Beginner's for Workshops

An Instructor Looks On "Beginner Days"

by Dee Gallina Novi, Michigan

Teaching beginners at workshops is one of my favorite things to do. I remember being a beginner and how it felt. Will I ever "get it" the way those around me are doing? All the while, I never realized that the people around me could have been dancing for months before I was.

Paula Trask-Heskett -- my first instructor -- and I are still laughing about me struggling to get through the beginner class. I traveled with my husband at the time, and was not always in class. Paula would say to me, "Get to class and the rest will be easy!" That was ten years ago this September, 1998.

I remember those beginner days, so when I teach the beginner classes at a workshop my first item on the agenda is to make those new students feel comfortable. I start with asking the class, "Who here has been dancing one year or less?" There are always a few hands that go up. Then I ask, "Who here has been dancing six months or less?" Again, a few hands will go up. I then stop and welcome these students to the workshop and state, "This must be your first workshop!" The answer is usually ves. With a smile, I let it be known that I once stood in the beginner position. suggest that the class take a deep breath, blow it out and relax. I address the whole class and state "Remember when you were there."

sure that these students get it -- we don't want them to leave!" I also announce that I have one rule in my class. You can't sit down -- no matter what (short of dying, that is!). If you sit down, then you cannot learn.

Also, ""We will be patient and make

need you as an instructor. It is not a matter of how much you teach, but how well you teach and how well your students are doing the lessons you have taught.

My experience has been that one of the biggest complaints I hear is that often times instructors show too much. We need to pay attention to Also, different parts of the this. country have different programs of lessons, so what you teach as basic beginners in one area may well be a challenge in another.

Beginners grow into intermediate dancers. If we do not nurture the beginners, you will not have intermediates to teach. Once a beginner gives up, that student -in most cases -- is gone for good. The intermediate will venture off to another instructor if they are unhappy with a situation. But when you lose a beginner dancer, you have no one to mature into an intermediate.

So my message is to remember the patience your instructor had with you. If your experience was one of a teacher who was not so, that is even more reason for you to help the new dancers enjoy the clogging world.



You will surely be hearing and seeing more of this talented young lady.







The Big Circle Dance usually starts by circling left and back to the right, swing your corner, swing your partner, then every other couple leads out to the right and faces the couple next to them. The couples with their backs to the center of the ring are usually called the traveling couple (or the odd couple). The gent has his partner on his right and the lady to his left is referred to as his corner lady (or contrary).

The small circle figures are performed and usually end with a corner, partner swing after which the traveling couple progresses to a new couple. Progression is usually executed in a counterclockwise direction around the set.

There are many ways to swing and you may use any type you prefer. You can use the right elbow swing, the two-hand swing or the ballroom swing. The swings should be done also in a counterclockwise direction.

There are many big circle figures. Described here are some of the most commonly used figures.

#### **BIG CIRCLE FIGURES**

The commands and the name of the figure are written in all capital letters, and the accompanying text describes the movements.

#### The Big Circle Dance

Big Circle Figures to Keep You Dancing Appalachian Style

#### ALLEMANDE LEFT

ALLEMANDE LEFT WITH THE OLD LEFT HAND, THEN WALK RIGHT INTO A RIGHT AND LEFT GRAND

Gents face your corner girl and join left hands. Using the joined left hands as a pivot, turn in a counterclockwise direction until you are facing your partner, Drop hands and pass left shoulders as you return back to your original place and wait for the next call.

#### **GRAND RIGHT AND LEFT**

RIGHTS AND LEFTS GO AROUND THAT RING, DON'T YOU GRAB AND DON'T YOU SWING

This movement usually follows an Allemande left. Step forward and join right hands with your partner. The gents are facing in a counter-clockwise direction and the ladies are facing clockwise. Pull by your partner passing right shoulders, giving the next person in line you meet your left hand. Then pull by passing left shoulders. Continue this movement around the ring until you return to your original partner and wait for the next call.

#### WIND THE BALL OF YARN

WIND 'EM UP LIKE A BALL OF YARN, WIND IT TIGHT IT'LL DO NO HARM, THE BIG FOOT UP AND THE LITTLE FOOT DOWN, MAKE THAT BIG FOOT JAR THE GROUND

This is a follow-the-leader figure with everyone (expect the lead gent and his corner) holding hands. The

lead gent leads the dancers into the center of the set by releasing his left hand from his corner and moving to his left, pulling the circle tighter and tighter until he reaches the center of the dance floor with all of the dancers wound around him as you would wind a ball of yarn. The lead gent (only) will turn to his left (behind his partner) and unwinds the ball of yarn, pulling the dancers back into a big circle again.

#### **LONDON BRIDGE**


OPEN UP THEM PEARLY GATES, SHAKE YOUR FEET AND DON'T BE LATE, HURRY UP CHILDREN OR YOU'LL NOT GET TO HEAVEN IF YOU GO TOO SLOW

From a promenade position, the lead couple turns individually to face opposite direction and joins inside hands to form an arch and moves over the couples until reaching the end of the line. Each couple turns back and repeats the process as they go back over the column of dancers. When the last couple passes under the arch of the lead couple, the lead couple ducks and moves forward back through the tunnel of arches with the other couples following. As couples come to the end of the tunnel this time, they follow the lead couple into a promenade and wait for the next call.


