

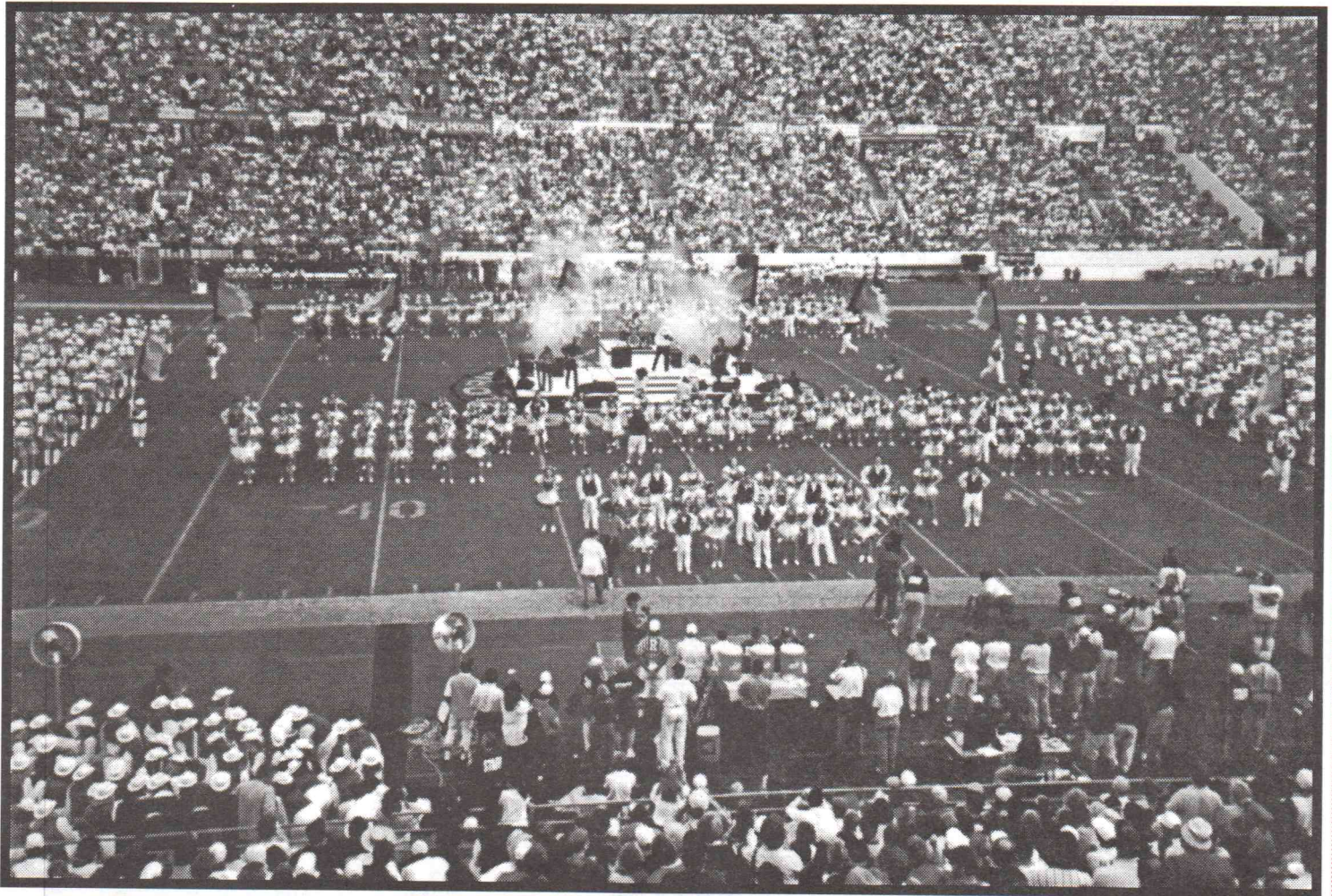

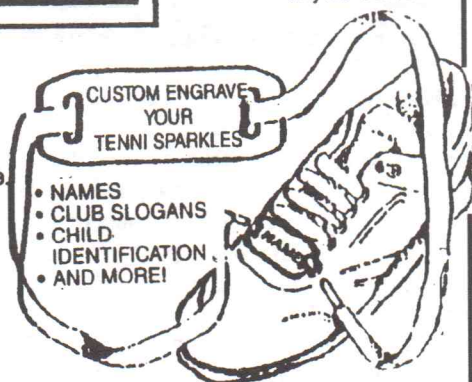

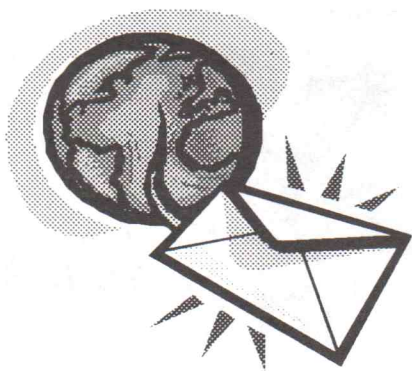

KING - ARTHUR COURT!

The Double Toe Times received this tongue-in-cheek announcement from our friend Josh King. Congratulations! Ed.

Sources have confirmed that at approximately 10:30 p.m. on December 31, 1998, Mr. Josh King of Lebanon, Tennessee (otherwise known as the ClogDog) officially proposed marriage to Miss Carolann Arthur of Goshen, Alabama. The same sources also reveal that after a brief moment during which Miss Arthur was speechless, she said "Yes!"

Mr. King said in a post-engagement interview that "the day of travel was kinda wacky! One mishap led to another." Mr. King and Ms. Arthur (hereafter referred to as 'the couple') had an afternoon flight scheduled from Montgomery, Alabama to Houston, Texas, where they were to spend New Year's Eve with Josh's parents, Steven and Jo King, Josh's brother Adam, and Stacy McWethy, Adam's girlfriend.

The flight from Montgomery was cancelled, forcing the couple to take a later stand-by flight, which would get them in to Houston at the late hour of 9:15 p.m. Luckily, they made the flight.

Citrus Bowl Sweet for Cloggers

This New Year's Day, over 200 cloggers from across the United States, Canada, and even Denmark came together as part of the CompUSA Florida Citrus Bowl Halftime Show featuring Grammy Award winning entertainer The Charlie Daniels Band, as well as 1,200 talented dancers, cheerleaders and drum majors.

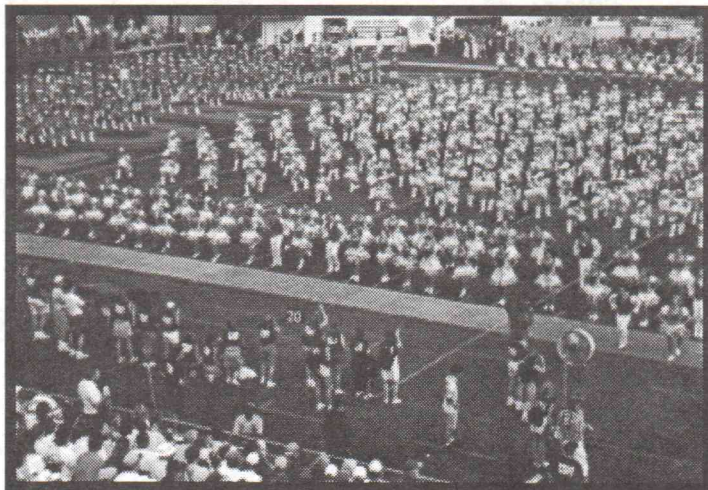
Clogging Instructor Lee Adams, of Groveport, Ohio, approached the organizers of the event last year with the idea of including cloggers in the halftime show. After months of planning, mailings, auditions and meetings, 206 lucky cloggers were included in *Fiddle Frenzy*, the energetic show produced by ESP Productions President Bruce Hart and his talented staff.

A highly professional staff of choreographers, including internationally recognized clogging instructor Jeff Driggs, gave the show its wings, working the dancers through three days of rehearsal in preparation for the show. The cloggers danced to the hit song *The Devil Went Down to Georgia*, as well as *Orange Blossom Special*. In a routine featuring line dancing, circles, jazz moves and formations, cloggers ages 7 through 72 danced together. Everyone in the show was enchanted by the energy, fun and spirit of the cloggers. Producer Bruce Hart said "the cloggers have brought the energy level of the entire show to a new level."

After almost a week of preparation and rehearsals, the day of the game arrived, and dozens of buses filed onto an empty street across from the stadium. As the hundreds of dancers waited in the stands watching the game, few could relax and enjoy the game for the mental rehearsing going on in each dancer's mind. When the clock ran out and the dancers ran on, along with The Charlie Daniels Band, fireworks began to pour from the stage in a flurry of smoke and sparks. When Charlie sang, "fire flew from his fingertips" as the cloggers stood with arms reaching to the sky, a wall of flame shot up from the stage around the dancers, bringing the crowd of 70,000 to its feet.

In addition to a tremendous performing opportunity, Showcase Camps and Productions, directed by Roni Petersen and Marilyn Rice, provided a great tour package for the dancers and their families that attended. The group enjoyed excursions to Walt Disney World, The Magic Kingdom, Epcot Center, and Disney/MGM Studios. In addition, there was an incredible New Year's Party for all the performers at Universal Studios.

The cloggers so impressed the organizers that they are working to include clogging in a future show!

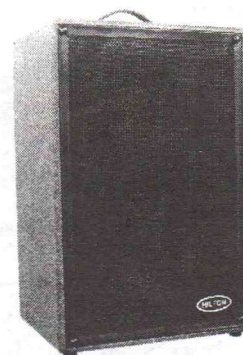

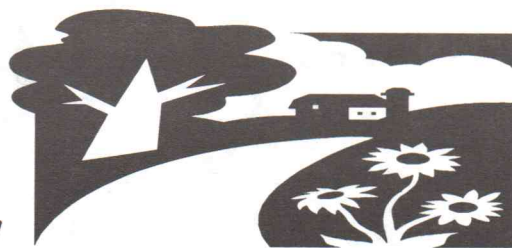

The Miner's Dance

Individual Capers

In some few instances particular dancers became legendary. There was Harry Sullivan, an Irish step-dancer, who was said to be able to out-last and out-jig any man in the west. An Elmer Pettingill, from somewhere in Vermont, often interrupted dances with an exhibition of cutting and jigging that commanded all eyes.

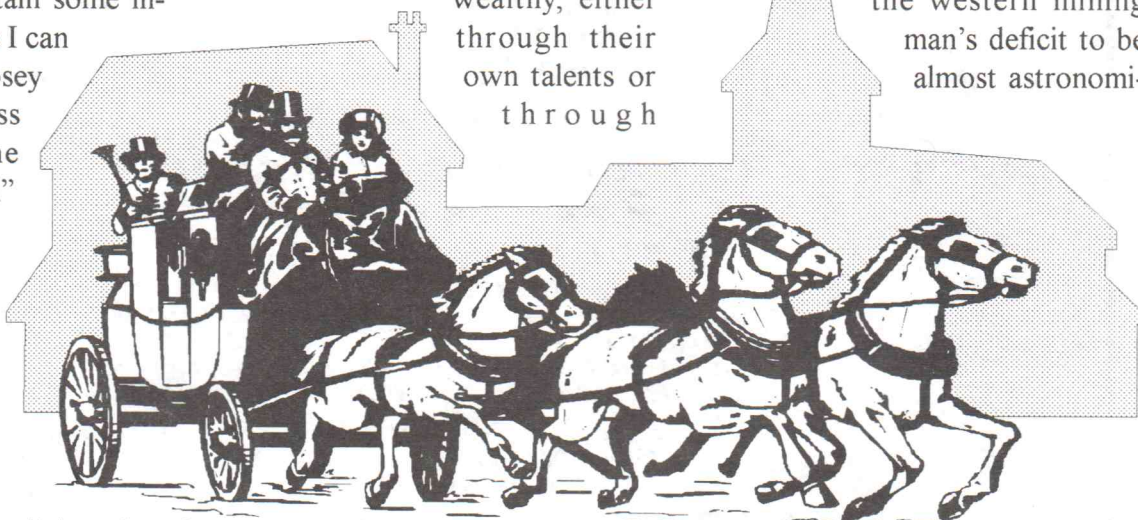
What few descriptions of the early quadrilles survive contain some interesting things. While I can find no record of a dosey doe, I have run across these: "Birdie in the Cage", "Shoot the owl" (the same as the early "Pop the Weasel"), "Pass Right Through and Balance Too), and a "Roll the Jug". Also recorded were the Grand Chain (grand right and left) and various of the New England patterns such as Ladies Change, Dos

a Dos, Gents Change, Stars by Right and Left. Curiously, there is a description of a dance in Denver in 1862 in which there seems to have been done a form of the Texas Star, this some years before the significant cattle drives from Texas took place

or the first cowboy influences appeared. No name is given to the pattern but it seems to have been a combination of the Gents Star Across and the Texas Star reverse, and I wonder if it was derived from, or related to the "Pumpkin Blossom" pattern which seems to have been done in the Midwest states as early as 1855. This a another of those tantalizing mysteries of dance evolution.

Couple dancing occurred in the dance halls too - basic waltzes, perhaps a bit of a polka, but most often a sort of stomping one-step gallop which usually led to a room upstairs. Like taxi dancers, the dance hall girls, charged a fee for a dance, keeping a percentage on this as well as on the price of drinks sold. Being B-girls and the only women on the early scene, some of them became quite wealthy, either through their own talents or through

ries have never properly been told. For each miner, prospector, con man, gambler, or manipulator who became a millionaire in the Western United States, there were easily 10,000 men who did not even make expenses. For each dollar's worth of precious metal greedily taken from the western soils, at least \$5,000 worth of materials, supplies, and equipment was expended overall. If such tangibles as human happiness, dignity, and life could be given a money value, we would find the western mining man's deficit to be almost astronomi-

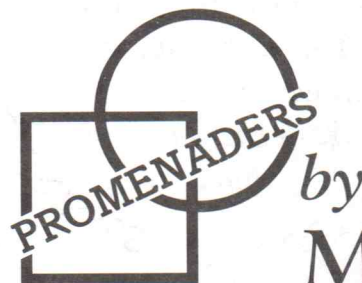

forty. An epidemic of measles or diphtheria could wipe out half the juvenile population of a district. Infant and adult mortality rates were very high, and the average income of a full time miner with family would run from \$70 to \$100 a month. But still the people danced, more and more, and the Miners Dance underwent some quite complex and fascinating developments.

As it has been true of the development of the dance in most recent western cultures, the finest dancing (and the most often preserved and performed) was done by the royalty of the period. The Minuet was never a dance of the common folk of France, nor was the Lancers (until the past few decades) a dance of the common folk of the Rocky Mountain frontier. Such dances were done by those who had the time to learn and dance them, and who had the means to dress properly, and qualify for membership in the exclusive social circles. Not even the means always won qualification, the case of Molly Brown being a prime example.

Not many of the total population of Central City and Black Hawk, for example, could afford the \$15 admission to the Masonic Ball of 1867 - nor were most of the citizens invited - at which twenty-seven dances were programmed, including quadrilles, the Lancers, waltzes, polkas, mazurkas, and scottisches. The grand balls held

at the famous hostelrys, and which we like to think of as being "typical" of the western frontier, were even more restrictive, attendance being made up largely of regional millionaires, visiting English investors, absentee owners on a quick trip from New York, or an occasional visiting celebrity or member of European royalty.

In this manner the leading popular dances of New York, and even the continent, were introduced to the mining towns, but such dancing did not become widespread nor possess any sort of universal magic which turned all of mine-town society into fine dancers. The grotesque cavorting of Debbie Reynolds as Molly Brown was often more authentic than we refined modern Westerners like to think. A man such as Haw Tabor, lacking most of even the basic social graces, despite his millions, did not take easily or gracefully to fancy dancing shoes and conduct.

Of all the segments of frontier society, that of the mining industry most quickly became respectable, stuffy, and conservative. Long before the cowboy and farmer segments began to slow down and aspire to gentility, the mining society - middle and upper classes, that is - had succumbed

to a set of Victorian standards. There was too much wealth about, much of it the "instant" sort. Men and women who had been starving paupers on Monday sometimes found themselves worth millions. *Conspicuous* is scarcely the proper word to describe the consumption by these instant millionaires. *Grotesque* would

be more accurate.

This was especially true in Colorado, despite the rough beginnings, and can largely be attributed to the appearance of more and more middle class, or aspiring middle class, women. These were a different sort than the dance hall girls - hard-working, quite religious and conservative, usually married or pledged to be married. Some had already followed their established middle-class husbands to the gold fields. Others came from the lowest economic and social segments of eastern society and so were doubly ambitious to improve themselves and their status. It could never be done in the east, but here on the frontier anyone might suddenly strike it rich.

As soon as the women began to appear in any numbers, the mining towns underwent an astonishing process of calming and refinement. In the more valuable areas, houses of brick and stone quickly appeared. Schools and churches sprang up, and the towns quickly settled down to the smug virtues and verities which prevailed in the eastern states.

The Running Set Hoedown

The Fundamentals of the Four Couple Traditional Square Dance

by Lou Maiuri
Glascow, West Virginia

The basic information for the four couple hoe-down is the English Quadrille Square. Each couple has a specific location within the square which is called their home position. Couple #1 will have their backs to the caller, couple #2 will be on the caller's right at the 1/4 point in the square, couple #3 will be facing the caller at the 1/2 point in the square, couple #4 will be on the caller's left at the 3/4 point in the square and at the completion of each figure the couple will return to this location.

The Four Couple Hoe-down has well defined parts and should be danced in that order. The order of dance is as follows:

OPENING FIGURE

All couples active. (big full circle)

OPENING FIGURE AND CLOSING FIGURE

Join hands and circle left 1/2 around the set and 1/2 back to home position. Swing corner, swing partner and prom-

enade counterclockwise once around the set and wait for next call.

BREAK FIGURE

Swing your partner twice around, allemande left your corner, go back to your partner and do a grand right and left around the set. When you meet your partner pass her by, the next time you meet, promenade her once around the set to your home position.

There are two types of visiting couple figures that can be used in the four couple square dance. The little circle figures which are performed with one couple as described earlier in the big circle dance and cumulative figures which can only be used in the four couple dance. Both types of figures may be used in the four couple hoe-down.

The figures I have described here are cumulative figures which I enjoy calling.

FIGURE #1; GRAPEVINE TWIST

The active gent takes his partner's right hand and leads her between the next couple, around the lady's back to the center of the set where he does a loop to his left (figure eight). He continues to lead his partner back between the couple, around the gent and back to the center. They join hands with this couple and circle left and perform "Dive For the Oyster" (optional). The two couples circle one time around and the lead gent drops hands with the lady on his left and repeats the figure with the third and fourth couple. "Dive For the Oyster" described earlier in the big circle dance.

FIGURE #2; BUTTERFLY WHIRL:

At the call, first couple dance and

swing and promenade the outside ring, the first couple will swing once around and promenade counterclockwise around the outside of the set one time. This is called "waltz the hall", at about the 3/4 point around the set the lead couple will put their near arms around each others waist and continue to promenade until they get back to their home position.

The lead couple goes down the middle of the set toward the third couple. While in the center they perform the "butterfly whirl" by quickly wheeling around once or twice as a couple with the gent moving forward and lady backing up. After the butterfly whirl the lead couple dances up to the opposite couple and joins their free hands with the opposite couple's free hands and draws them down center a few steps and pushes them back to place.

The first couple "divides the world" as follows: The lead gent goes out the square between the opposite couple and the couple on his left and cast off to his left and dances around to his home position. His partner does the same thing only on the other side of the set. All couples dance a right hand turn around partners, a left hand turn around corners, a do-si-do with partners passing right shoulders, a do-si-do with corners passing left shoulders. All couples swing partners and promenade their corners back to the gent's home position.

Everybody has a new partner and the figure is repeated until everybody is back with his original partner. "Waltz the Hall" is only done once at the beginning of the figure.

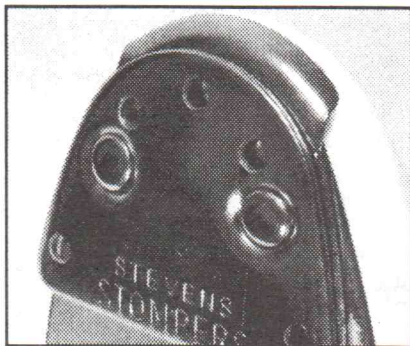

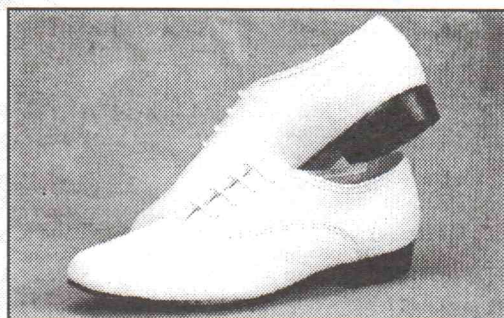

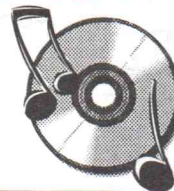
