Or would it be syllabi? Whatever... more than one of 'em. More like 300, I'd say. Why would I keep all these? Of course, for reference! I can't tell you what I *refer* to them as when I trip over the three foot pile trying to box another unworn clogging t-shirt!

Old clogging shoes

Do you know, I still have the first pair of clogging shoes I ever owned. And the second, and the third, and the twentieth. Worn and cracked, with partial taps, split sides and broken heels, I just can't seem to throw them away. I just know I'll need an extra tap someday. Of course, I've never used one in the past, but I'd better keep these just in case.

As a matter of fact, I'd better keep all these things, the shirts, the 45 records, the videos, the syllabuses and the clogging shoes. I've held onto them all this long, and -- who knows -- I might use them again some day. If nothing else, it gives me one great weekend of reminiscing each Spring.

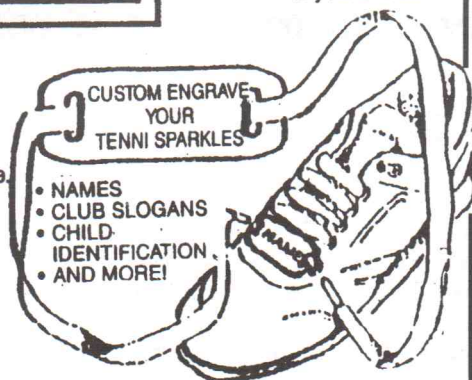

There were over 1,500 ballots cast that night for the top 8 males and females to represent the All-Pro Team. Later that night, the team was announced and were presented with backpacks and watches. The trophy was designed by CCA and made by Jeff Parrott of Parrott's Custom Trophies. Parrott's Trophy also sponsored the Novice Award and is a major sponsor of the C.C.A. circuit. The cups were awarded to the Overall Amateur and Challenge Team with money inside. Hats were donated by ET Graphics for the Overall Challenge Team. The Overall Challenge Team also was invited to open up the show at Country Tonite, in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee.

The All-Pro Director title was voted on at the same time as the All-Pro Team. The honor went to Sherry Glass – West. Ms. West, along with Delohn and Kelle were presented with warmups from Adidas with embroidery on the back.

Best Costume was awarded to Clog-

ging Sensation for their Line outfit and the Congeniality Award was awarded to Fancy Free Cloggers from Ohio, under the direction of Evie Purdin.

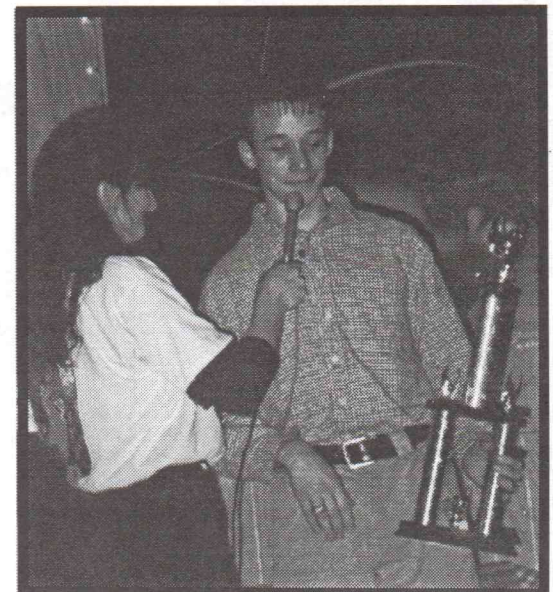

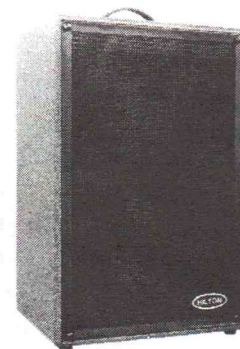

Other places were large enough, but carpet doesn't mix with clogging, unless you'd like to spend a small fortune (and a lot of time) to put down something that you can dance on and make sure it doesn't slip and slide. Finally we decide on the National Guard Armory, but we needed

a firm date. Oops... they don't have air conditioning, so it has to be in cool weather, but not too cold. That would cut down on participation. February would be perfect, hopefully.

Each one we asked graciously accepted our invitation and we were on our way -- to a lot of hard work and a lot of fun. Now, we needed to raise money to cover the expenses. 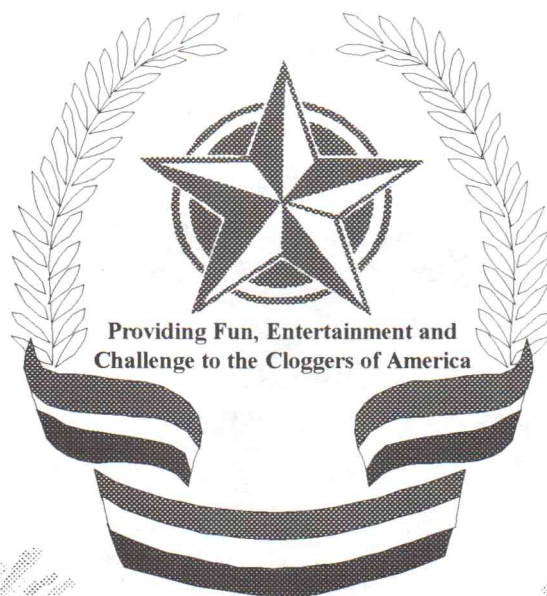

Bowling, Rita Watson, Tim Spivey, and Kimberly Clark (one of our own, it was her first opportunity to teach at a workshop and she did a great job). All of these people did a great job for us and made it all worthwhile. Thanks again to each of them. So, our advice would be... if you've never tried to put on a workshop before, you should give it a try. It is a lot of fun when everyone pitches in and works together. Heck, we might even do it again next year!

A woman who knew how to "hunker down"

The score to Marilyn Hansen's life was the joyful sound of dancing feet

A bluegrass festival in Mira Loma changed Marilyn Hansen's life.

She'd always had an ear for country music, had always like to dance. And then she saw the cloggers.

They were up on the stage with their jingling, double-tap shoes, hooting and hollering and having the best ol' time. Whatever that was, Marilyn wanted to be part of it. She stayed until late that night, learning about the dance and where and when she could start.

From her first lesson 22 years ago, she was hooked.

She took classes and she taught classes, keeping, literally, one step ahead of her students. She became a cuer, clogging's equivalent of a square-dance caller. And she met Lee Schmidt.

Lee, a square dance caller, became Marilyn's second husband in 1987. Marilyn, a divorcee with three children, became his Poopsybear. Their life together became a whirl of dancing and laughing and friendships.

Together they organized and sponsored clogging RV camping trips, clogging cross-country trips, clogging ski trips to Canada and clogging cruises. They started a clogging and square dance school in Garden Grove called Schmidt-Kickers, then a clogging school called Apple Creek Cloggers. Marilyn started national clogging organizations in Canada and the United States.

And what the heck *is* clogging, you ask? It's an energetic Appalachian dance, the origins of which undoubtedly involved wooden clogs, but that is now danced with double tapped shoes that sort of jungle as they tap.

They were the soundtrack to Marilyn's life. Her license plate said CLOGN QR.

When she cued and wanted to get her dancers really whipped up, she'd holler, "Hunker down!"

Marilyn was 50 when she died Monday at Western Medical Center Hospital Anaheim. Although she was being treated for colon cancer, doctors aren't sure what caused her

sudden and unexpected death.

Born Marilyn Derry in Los Angeles, she graduated from St. Michael's High School and went to Cerritos Community College. She worked for the phone company and married Steven Hansen in 1969.

They lived in Utah, then in Norco. When they divorced in 1981, Marilyn and the children moved to Garden Grove.

Life with Marilyn was never dull. Her house was the hub for friends and family, heaped with a little of everything - a cow collection of 500 or more items, and just as many angels; craft projects in various stages of completion; floral arrangements and every gift she'd ever received, carefully displayed.

She could organize clogging festivals and cruises, but her house gave testimony to, as her kids say, "an organization style that only she understood."

She loved a practical joke - and better yet, loved getting even.

A Realtor friend once sent her a phony letter announcing that her condo was going to be torn down. If you have questions, the letter said, call Mr. Lion. The number was that of the San Diego Zoo.

So when a costume party came up, Marilyn offered to make the costumes. They'd all go as pizza slices. The Realtor, however, found himself dressed as a giant anchovy.

Marilyn's long white-gray hair was her signature. It hung, thick, curly and wild, to her hips. She'd started turning gray as a teen-ager and refused ever to color it artificially. She was right. It was stunning. And she was proud of it.

When she began cancer treatment, she couldn't bear the thought of those long strands falling out, so she had it cut short.

And as it turned out, she never did lose her hair.

Her family imagines her now clogging and fuming. "Dang! Why did I cut my hair!"

It is said the measure of a friend is how much they give of themselves to others. Marilyn Hansen was a true friend. She always had a smile and kind words. She looked people in the eye and listened, truly listened. She encouraged others and practiced the fine art of making others feel like they belonged. Whether you were in the middle of things or watching from the sidelines there was a story to tell later!

To her husband, Lee Schmidt, daughters Krissie and Kathy, son Steve and family - thanks for sharing your treasure. We share your deep loss.

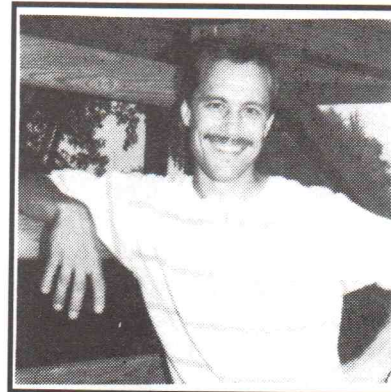

They only planned to stay a few days in Atlanta and then move on to their next stop. Instead, I moved in with them in the motorhome and we stayed for three days at a campground on Lake Lanier, then three more days at Lake Hartwell!

We had the best time... swimming, eating and chatting about everyone in the clogging world. At our campsite at Lake Hartwell, we found an old tree swing that went out over the water. I swung out with no problem, but when Marilyn did, she didn't grab the rope high enough and scrapped her bottom on the dirt as she swung out into the lake!

Later in the trip, we rented a pontoon boat and spent an afternoon riding around the lake. We brought a lunch and a watermelon along to tide us over until dinner. The watermelon was so juicy that we had to jump in the lake to get all of the sticky mess washed off. Somehow, the watermelon ended up in the water, and we were swimming around with watermelon hats on our heads!

Even though I lived on the totally opposite side of the country from Marilyn, we always felt very close and had a great time together. I can't even count how many times we shared a room at convention. You know how cloggers are -- everybody just piles in! It got to the point that I would pack my coffee carafe along for Marilyn since it was so expensive to order coffee in a hotel.

I will miss my friend Marilyn. She was truly one of a kind, and a true friend.

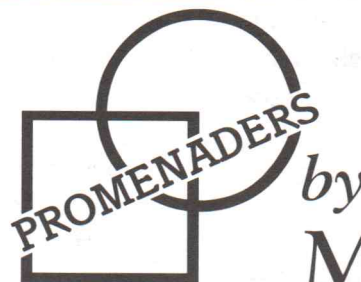

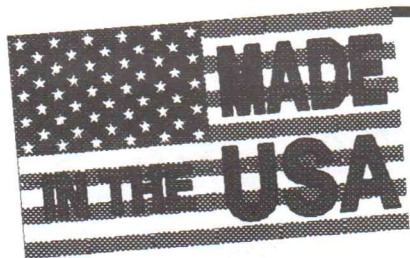

Hoedown "Patter" Calls

Catchy phrases to spice up your Traditional Square Dance calling

by Jeff Driggs, Editor

Command calls direct a dancer to perform a specific movement, such as "circle left" or "swing". Patter accompanies or follows a command and adds flavor to the call. Patter can also be used to fill in while a lengthy call is being executed, such as a Right and Left Grand.

CIRCLE LEFT PATER

Join your hands and circle South, put a little moonshine in your mouth.

First you whistle, then you sing. Join your hands and make a little ring.

All join hands in a great big ring. Circle left with your pretty little thing.

PROMENADE PATER

(From a quadrille set)

Get your honey and promenade eight. Promenade eight 'til you get straight.

Promenade eight and promenade all, promenade around the hall. Promenade that lady fair. Promenade around the square.

(From a big circle)

Get your gal and salute your Sue. Now take that girl with the run-down

shoe and promenade go two by two. and don't be late.

Promenade - go two by two and walk 'em home like you used to do.

Meet your gal with a great big smile and promenade that gal awhile.

Get your taw and promenade 'round like a Jaybird walkin' on frozen ground.

Greet your honey with a great big twirl and promenade the dear little girl.

Get your honey - don't be afraid - to take that lady and promenade.

Promenade, go 'round the ring 'til the roosters crow and the birdies sing.

Tap your heel and save your toe, chicken in the breadpan - scratchin' out dough. Meet your gal in calico and promenade go 'round the row.

Big foot high and the little foot low, take your lady and promeno.

Meet your honey and pat her on the head. If she don't like biscuits, feed her cornbread and promenade her just like I said.

Ace of Diamonds, Jack of Spades, Take your lady and promenade.

Barbed-wire fence and a broken down gate, walk with your gal 'til you get straight.

Two, four, six, eight, promenade

Promenade high, promenade low, walk your gal with a heel and a toe.

RIGHT AND LEFT GRAND PATER

Go right and left with a heel and a toe, around that ring and away you go.

Turn to your corner with a left allemande, now back to your own with a right and left grand.

Rights and left around you go, with a "Hi there, Mary," and a "Hello, Joe."

Allemande your corners all, now rights and left go round the hall. Rights and lefts go 'round the ring, don't ya stop and don't ya swing!

Meet your own with a right and left grand, hand over hand over hand over hand.

First with a right, next with a left, then with a right - you're not through yet. 'When you meet your gal, promenade your pet.

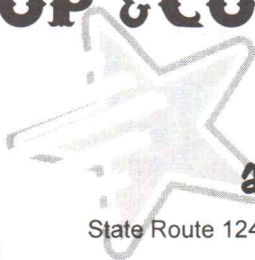
