As the lights center in the stage in an arena somewhere in Australia, the audience quiets. Then, a four-foot eleven inch woman walks onto the stage. She then leads the crowd in a series of high energy dance steps known as clogging. Soon several thousand people are clogging along at her direction. Many of the dancers tire quickly, but their leader -- like the Energizer Bunny -- keeps going and going and going.

The journey from a childhood in Lancaster County to the stage in Australia was an interesting one for Elaine Steele. She enjoyed childhood ballet lessons. After high school, she majored in physical education at West Chester State. Her first love, though, was dancing. It wasn't until she was an adult that she was first introduced to square dancing. Then a beginners clogging class took her interest. As she became more of an expert, she began to teach others clogging. In addition, she also taught aerobics. These two activities occupied her about thirty to forty hours each week, plus more hours for her preparation time.

Soon, Elaine was invited to teach clogging at local, state and national conventions and workshops. She taught at

mountain retreats in the summer and sun belt resorts in the winter. She has had some of her cueing and choreography printed in booklets and clogging magazines. A publication outside of print was her own record.

And who is this person? Well, someone who may fit this description is an athletic trainer in her twenties. That would be a good guess, but incorrect in this case. Elaine Steele is my Grandmother who started to clog in her sixties and continues to teach today in her seventies.

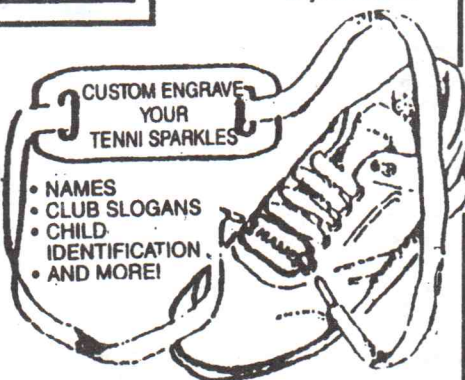

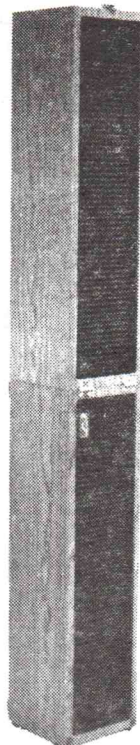

# Clogging at the Kennedy Center

## All Ohio Team Joins Forces to Perform in Nation's Capital

One of the 'kicks' in my life has been 13 years of clogging. As a dancer, instructor, and co-sponsor of clogging dances, I have been privileged to be a part of many special experiences. Music and this kind of dancing reaches beyond my heart, touching my soul in a very personal way. It has been my joy to choreograph dances just because the music 'hit' me, watch my beginners finally 'get it,' and meet other folks who enjoy this as much as I do. Recently, my wealth of experiences was increased by participating in a performance of a very unique kind.

For me, this began with an invitation in early March from the London Starlight Cloggers, to join them in a clogging performance, to share a motel room to save money. For Lee Adams, coordinator/director of the project, it had begun a scant four weeks earlier. She and her senior Clog 4 U team had been invited by Congressional Representative Deborah Pryce (from Columbus) to submit a proposal to represent Ohio to perform at the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts in Washington, D.C. Having submitted her ideas, per protocol, the proposal was then forwarded to Senator George Voinovich's office. In a nutshell, the proposal was approved. The schedule was set for us to perform on the Millennium Stage on May 19.

Lee's energy pulled together two groups for this occasion. One was her own senior Clog 4 U Team. The other—an all Ohio group not yet formed, never having practiced together, and with very little in the way of repertoire. At her invitation, directors and dancers representing 12 Ohio teams (plus a few extras) joined together to form the "All Ohio Cloggers," 44 dancers in all. For the hour long show, Lee chose a patri-

otic theme, a tribute to rock and roll, and other country music. Keep in mind, from the time this proposal was accepted to May 19, there were only 13 weeks to pull this together, make travel arrangements, create the show, etc.!

While Lee's team practiced weekly, the All Ohio group was scheduled for only two team practices! We're talking about long afternoons to get measured for costumes, review new dances, arrange lineups, and design moves for a stage that was supposed to be 28' x 32'. Between the first and second practices Lee traveled to The Kennedy Center to check the details. It's a good thing she did. The stage had been rebuilt- 24' x 24', and she hadn't been informed. So, our second practice, which included the seniors, was characterized by redesigning lineups and moves, as well as 'simple' things like exiting the stage orderly but very quick and quietly changing lineup in a two foot wide area that would exist behind the stage. It was no surprise when folks started requesting a third practice. (Thank heaven!) This one was scheduled two days before we left.

It needs to be mentioned here that there were a lot of 'unofficial' practices occurring in the home areas of the various teams. This is a tribute to the commitments of the team directors and their participating dancers. On a number of evenings I practiced in front of the television with the videotape or cassette tape, and I'm sure I wasn't the only one. The day finally came for us to leave, two busloads, 84 dancers forming two groups, on a very early Tuesday morning at 7:30 am. Our trip to and from Washington, D.C. was a safe one, with

beautiful sunny weather all week. When we weren't reading or catching up on our sleep, we were playing Bingo or watching movies. (Yes, buses now have VCR's and viewing screens. I had no idea.) As we reached the city, riding ever closer to our destination, the excitement rose, and straining eyes began recognizing landmarks in the distance- the Washington Monument, Jefferson Memorial,....

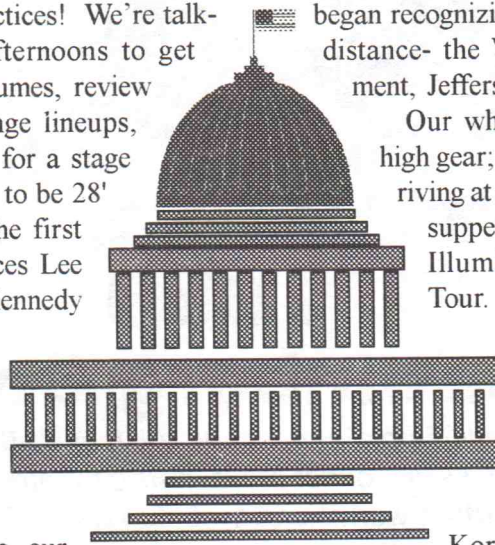
Our whirlwind turned into high gear; 45 minutes after arriving at our hotel, we left for supper and a guided Night Illumination Monument Tour. For many of us this

was our first time visiting our nation's capital and its numerous historical markers. At dusk, the

Korean War Memorial was awesome- a column of sculptured foot soldiers and a mural etched with photo images. The Lincoln Memorial was next. It was dark now, yet still so many tourists, adults and children both. We continued walking to 'The Wall', the Vietnam Veterans Memorial. It is so long, bigger than I ever imagined. After briefly seeing two more nearby sculptures, three Vietnam servicemen and the Vietnam Women's Memorial, we traveled back to our hotel. Another day, *the day*, awaited us.

Wednesday morning was spent touring Mt. Vernon, George Washington's beautiful home overlooking the Potomac River. Two to three hours were spent touring this estate, and just walking around the grounds. Arriving back at the hotel, we dressed for our Kennedy Center performance, leaving at mid-afternoon for our 6:00 pm show. Getting ready, though, meant not only costumes

and make-up. There were those momentary practices in our hotel room and reviews in my mind of certain spots in the dances. Even waiting for our buses gave Louise Pitcher and her cloggers time to practice in the hotel hallway. On the way Lee's staff played a cassette tape of our music. Here we all were, sitting in bus seats, our feet vaguely moving through the steps, clapping in the right spots, ... reinforcing our memories, and calming our nerves.

At this point I could cut to our show's end and tell you, "Yes, we 'done' good! Ohio can be proud of these two teams." However, you would miss the awe and wonder of stepping into this beautiful building, walking down a long, tall hallway lined with numerous flags on either side (the Hall of Nations), arriving at a huge open lobby area, where two stages were constructed at opposite ends of the Center. Our Millennium Stage was in the right corner. During our practice and sound check, we couldn't hear the music. You cloggers out there know what that does to butterflies, and talk about rushing the music! Needless to say, with two monitors added, that was corrected, but we still had only a two foot wide area behind the stage in which to re-line ourselves in between dances, while keeping our taps quiet on the metal stage framework during the other group's performance.

The Kennedy Center is home to six concert, opera, drama, and cinema halls. Our two groups' performances were part of its State of the State Series. We represented Ohio on this particular evening. An hour after we began, it was all over. From "Locomotion" and the tribute to Elvis Presley by the Clog 4 U Team, to the All Ohio's "Devil Went Down to

Georgia" and "Star Spangled Special." The time flew by, and it was fun. Every time I exited the stage I smiled, realizing I had made it through another dance. I really wasn't aware of the audience's reaction to the All Ohio's dancing- I was too busy getting off stage. However, from listening behind stage, they had a good time. It was the best kind of audience, involved and appreciative, letting

us know how much they enjoyed our clogging. At one point, they sang along in their participatory sections in "You're The One That I Want," danced by the Clog 4 U folks. (At Dayton Clog Dance and in my classes we call this the 'woo-woo song'; listen to the music, you'll understand.) My personal favorite was "Stormin' Norman," done in military style / precision, with moves to change formations and rows. The other half of the All Ohio performed "Boogie Woogie Bugle Boy," and six teens/young adults performed "Yankee Doodle Boy," bringing the house down.

The dancing may have been done; our experiences weren't. Cloggers received compliments from members of the audience. I heard that Representative Pryce's office was loaded with calls from Kennedy Center staff and the public saying they enjoyed our show. We also had our pictures taken with her on

the Capitol steps the next morning. Even afterward roaming through the Kennedy Center, we took in its beauty, the view of the Potomac and city landmarks from its upper outside deck that surrounds the building. On Thursday we packed in a full day of touring- the Capitol, Jefferson Memorial, Arlington National Cemetery, Pentagon City, driving by numerous government buildings, the White House, Iwo Jima statue, Washington Monument, the Pentagon, and more... We returned home on Friday.

The most solemn moments came in watching the changing of the guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. I can tell you about the guards' precision and mention the honor they bestow on their fallen comrades of the past. However, words fail to describe the feelings, the reverence in witnessing such a tribute. The most touching moment evolved at the Women in Military Service for America Memorial (at Arlington National Cemetery). Edna Strickler found her registration of military service as a WAVE during World War II. The computerized entry with her picture appeared on the

small screen above the keyboard, and then on a larger screen in the main hallway. Edna returned home with a copy in hand.

If you asked all of us what was most memorable about this trip you would hear many common answers, yet individual, personal ones as well. A trip of this sort isn't just the performance at the Kennedy Center, the honor and privilege, as if that's not enough. Memories are made of people interacting, the sights and sounds of new places, and experiences which touch us uniquely. I was taken with the physical beauty of this area- hills, lots of trees, and no skyscrapers- and impressed with its historical significance.

For me the memories are smiles. I danced at the Kennedy Center, saw a bit of history, and visited a college friend I hadn't seen in over 24 years. The trip, well, it was a 'hoot'!

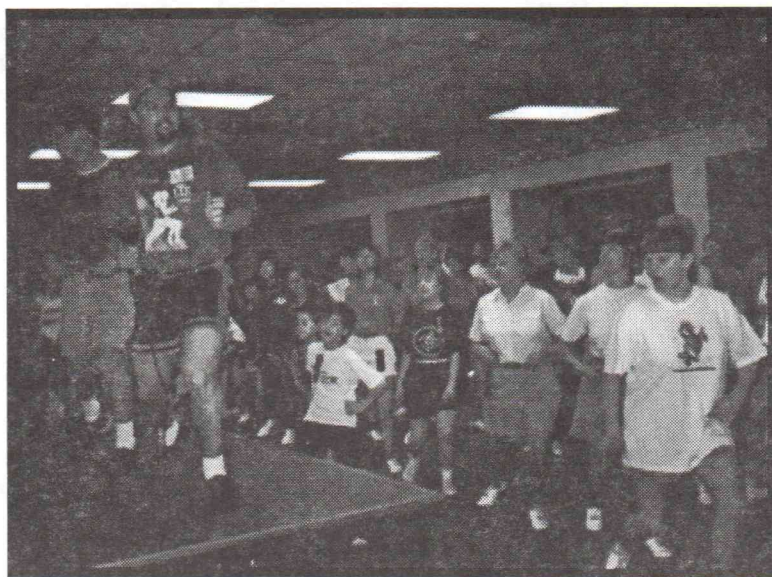

# Dieter's Clogging Beach Jam '99

## New Competition **HEATS UP** the Beach

On June 24, 25 and 26, 1999 hundreds of competitive cloggers and their families converged on Myrtle Beach, South Carolina for the first annual "Dieter's Clogging Beach Jam '99", a Clogging Champions of America qualifying event. The clogging competition, hosted by Dieter Brown and Steve Lanning, was held on Thursday and on Friday at the beautiful state-of-the-art Alabama Theatre. On Friday (by a twist if fate) the competition moved to a local sports bar called *Yesterday's*. The judges for the event were Missy Shinoski (MO), Dale Helms (NC), Grayce Bice (CA), Kevin Parries (NC) and Jeff Parrott (KY). Susan Joyal (ME) did the scorekeeping and David Spencer (NC) worked the sound.

Beach Jam '99 started on Wednesday evening with a reception for the team directors, judges and the staff of Beach Jam. This reception gave the team directors a chance to meet all of the judges and ask any last minute questions.

The competition got started bright and early on Thursday morning at the Alabama Theatre with the categories Standing Line, Hoedown and Artistic Expression. The Tennessee Hoedowners (TN) won Overall Challenge Standing Line. The Dynamite Dolls (GA) won Overall Amateur Standing Line. Unlimited Power (GA) won Overall Hoedown and Clog'n FX (GA) won Overall Artistic Expression. By two o'clock in the afternoon, the competition was completed for the day and the cloggers hit the beach.

Friday presented a challenge to the staff of Beach Jam '99. The competition was originally scheduled to be held at

On Saturday, it was business as usual, as Beach Jam was back at the Alabama

Theatre with the running of the Open Line and Precision categories. There was a tie between Unlimited Power (GA) and the Tennessee Hoedowners (TN) for Overall Challenge Open Line. The Southern Gals (SC) won Overall Amateur Open Line. The Precision Category was won by Unlimited Power (GA). The Overall Grand Champion Challenge Team was the Tennessee Hoedowners (TN), and the Overall Grand Champion Amateur Team was the Dynamite Dolls (GA). Both teams and the Overall Duo/Duet had the opportunity to perform for the pre-show at the Alabama Theatre on Saturday night. Following the dance-off, all of the contestants in the Miss American Clogger Pageant were able to perform their talent on the stage of the Alabama Theatre.

Not only did the Tennessee Hoedowners win Overall Team, but they also performed on television for TNN's "Crook and Chase" show. The taping of the TV show was on Tuesday morning, so the Tennessee Hoedowners had to be ready very early in the morning. It was more like "hurry up and wait."

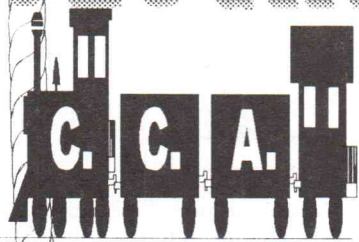

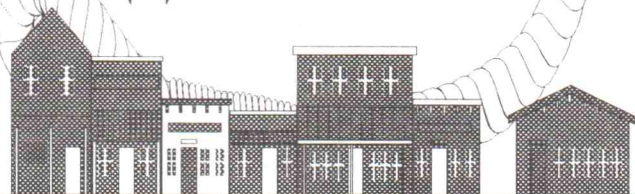

It is obvious from the choice of figures and progressions that the records predate some of the Callerlab designations for square dancing.

Here is a sample of the calls from this fun find.

### OCEAN WAVE (Eight in Line)

#### WARMER UPPER:

NOW IT'S EVERYBODY SWING,  
YOU SWING HER HIGH AND LOW.  
THE ALLEMANDE LEFT WITH

On a recent vacation trip in my own  
beautiful state of West Virginia, I hap-  
pened across one of those antique  
shops that dot the Blue Ridge Moun-  
tains, filled with treasures from by-  
gone days.

My good friend Tandy Barrett, from  
Atlanta, Georgia, had stopped in for a  
visit, and -- as a break from the clean  
mountain air and breathtaking views  
-- we sorted through the china, furni-  
ture and knickknacks that filled the  
restored shop.

As Tandy looked through the an-  
tique salt and pepper shakers for an  
addition to her daughter's collection,  
I leafed through an old box filled with  
78 records, books and papers. Laid  
in among the tattered papers and  
musty record boxes was a box of  
records simply titled "Old-Time  
Square Dances by Jonesy." Upon  
opening the box, I found a collection  
of 78 records of Fenton "Jonesy"  
Jones" with music by Stan James and  
the Valley Boys. At the bottom of  
the box was a stack of hand-typed cues  
for the songs on yellowed, almost

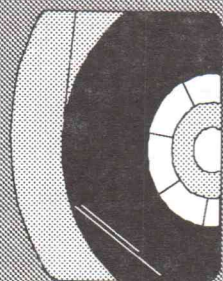

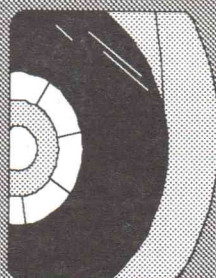
