



One of the most intriguing passages in the book comes at the conclusion of the step breakdowns. After detailing the specifics of the dance movements, the author writes:

more interesting is the fact that the book is North American and that the

"Having mastered these, he (the dancer) will readily acquire or invent new and more elaborate ones. And here let us observe, that if the student should, at any time, find it easier, or rather, <u>more natural</u>, to start a figure or step in a manner different from that herein described, he had best <u>do it by all means</u>, as he will be much more likely to achieve success in it.


Again, if, on concluding a step or figure, a graceful pose, or some grotesque attitude suggests itself, <u>always adopt it</u>, as you may, in this way, invent or discover a novelty of great value."

Clogging is a melting pot of dances, having evolved from the step dances of Europe, and influenced by Africans, Native Americans and even the gypsies. The Appalachian dance form remained relatively unchanged until the 1980's, when workshops exposed traditional cloggers to the intricate steps of Canadian Step dancing. Now, as we near a new millennium, clogging is being shaped by tap influences, Irish rhythms and a myriad of percussive styles.

While the old-time traditional Appalachian clog dance deserves to be preserved in its recognized form, the new American step dance of clogging continues to grow and change.

As the poet said "The powerful play goes on, and you may contribute a verse." Don't be afraid to experiment with different combinations of steps, rhythms or styles. Your choreography will be energized along with your imagination. Just think, all of your favorite clog steps were once the invention of a dancer trying something new. Who knows, your next practice session may be magic, and you might just "discover a novelty of great value!"

Choreographer Questions

I have always thought it would be helpful to have on hand a book of steps that is separated into categories of movement, such as steps that travel forward/backward/left/right. It would be helpful to know steps that you can turn with but probably couldn't travel with, or steps that have counts of 4, 6 or 8 beats, etc., sub-categorized so that after you've counted the music that "lights your fire" you can use the book to look up steps that your brain now suddenly refuses to remember! A book like that would give me more step choices. My routines would have more variety.

I haven't the equipment to go about gathering this kind of information and putting it together. Is there such a book available, or could your readers take the bit between their teeth and run with it?




great workshop. Debi had a packed hall for the workshops.







Developing as a Team

Young Dancers Give Mature Advice on Working Together in a Team Invironment

by Tiffany Ulbing and Janine Herring

An instructor has A LOT on his/her mind. But what can each of us as dancers do to help? Let's forget the obvious such as listening at practice, helping out with the equipment, being on time for practice and shows. There's more we can do!

The first thing we can do is to take more responsibility for ourselves. This includes not only listening to what the instructor has to say, but remembering it so she doesn't have to sound like a broken record. No one is perfect! If the instructor — or anyone else — makes a suggestion about a way you are doing a step, take it upon yourself to try your hardest to correct it; even if it means going home and practicing in front of a mirror. Don't leave it up to the instructor to constantly make suggestions for improvement. We should bring it on ourselves as a team to try to look uniform and correct our mistakes. There is nothing wrong with an occasional suggestion to a fellow dancer. I (Tiffany), up until a few months ago, was doing a simple step wrong, and didn't know that I was incorrect. The mistake was due to lack of noticing the details that can make a difference. I would have not been offended if someone would have told me. In the same aspect, I never noticed it myself, either! We need constructive criticism to come together as a team. It is not productive to put the entire burden of improvement on the instructor. It is difficult for one person to see all of the small details. There will be no improvement without fixing our flaws! As much as we would like to think the instructor is Super Woman,

Every dancer has room for improvement, from the beginner level to advanced. When we do give each other suggestions, we should do so in the same manner as we would like to receive it. Giving a suggestion does not make you better than the other dancer, and we need to be sensitive to other's feelings. This self-criticism and constant striving for improvement as a team is an important aspect of being a team. If we lack this, we will settle for less than what we can achieve as a team.

and as good as she might look in the outfit, she is not.

The second thing we can do is act more professional. With all of the clogging travel opportunities, clubs are gaining national and international exposure, and now is the time when we need to be as professional as ever. This doesn't mean that we can't have any fun, but it means we should exercise some self-discipline. Being more professional includes lining up

quietly and not having to be repeatedly told not to talk, not to talk, not to talk, not to talk... it gets repetitive and is unnecessary. Try and notice other teams when you attend other performances such as competitions, festivals and clogging conventions. Do they look professional? If they do, what makes you think that? Take those qualities and try and make them a part of your actions.

The third thing we need to have is dedication. Clogging is not just a Sunday night affair, but a lifetime dedication. How much effort you put into clogging is reflected in your attitude and performance. Dedication means always striving for more, and putting effort into every aspect of clogging.

As a team, we also need to challenge ourselves. Even though we may not always succeed, challenges are very important. Many times, if we do challenge ourselves, we will surprise ourselves at how much we accomplished. After all, how will we know what we can do if we don't challenge ourselves. An example of this happened just recently at a workshop. Janine was very hesitant to go to the advanced song because she had not been clogging in awhile due to the fact that she goes to college in Florida and only comes home in the summers. She felt that the routine looked really hard. Despite this, several of us stepped up to the challenge with her and actually succeeded!!

Lastly, we need to work on enjoying ourselves at performances. Audiences can tell if you are enjoying yourself, and

it when you make eye contact with them!!! If someone is looking at you, acknowledge that you see them! Let them know that you enjoy dancing for them. If you don't look enthused, they may ask why you are a performer. If you don't like to clog, then why do it? If you look like you're having fun, the audience will be able to tell by your SMILE (yes, I believe most of us can do this with-

out cracking our face) and your enthusiasm. They will enjoy the show if you enjoy it! This is really important because people are not looking at your feet, they are looking at your face too, believe it or not. This is especially true when we are not on a stage, because then the audience can't see your feet, so they are looking at your face. (Besides, when the audience is looking at your smiling face, they're less likely to see you make a mistake!)

All of these qualities, self-responsibility, self-discipline, acting professionally, being dedicated, and striving for challenges, are qualities found in all good teams. We have achieved so much as a team so far, we can be very proud of ourselves. We owe it to the instructor to rise to the challenges ahead of us and help her out as much as we can. After all, she isn't Super Woman. She's just her assistant!





reg-packets ready and Diana Manners, of the Columbus Clogging Company, had already begun registration with a legal pad! The cloggers in attendance took it all in





By the workshops end, dancers welcomed this fun dance to "The Lawnmower Song" that includes lots of hand moves and a friendly back rub!




Cloggers in the Spotlight



Maysville.





Old-Time Square Dancing

More figures from a great collection of Square Dances by "Jonesy"

Here is another of the fascinating figures found in a collection of square dances from the 1930's in a compilation called "Square Dances by Jonesy." I came across this find in an antique store in the small town of Lewisburg, West Virginia.

Even during the day of 78 rpm records, Irish music and dance was making an impression. This dance, called "The Irish Washerwoman" contains an interesting visiting figures which sends the gents to the right to then allemande their original partner, then reverses to send the ladies back around the set.

This dance reminds me a great deal of the first quadrilles I learned when I began square dancing -- easy to follow, repetitive but fun!

Remember that the words printed in ALL CAPS are the calls and patter that the caller says when cueing the figure. The words following the call (in upper and lower case letters) is a description of the dancer's movement.

"THE IRISH WASHERWOMAN"

WARMER UPPER:

YOU SWING HER HIGH, YOU WHIRL HER LOW. AROUND, AROUND AND AROUND YOU GO.

THE ALLEMANDE LEFT WITH THE OLD LEFT HAND,
A RIGHT TO YOUR HONEY WITH A RIGHT AND LEFT GRAND.
RIGHT AND LEFT ALL AROUND THE RING,
HAND OVER HAND WITH THE DEAR LITTLE THING.

YOU MEET YOUR HONEY AND GIVE HER A SWING, YOU PROMENADE EIGHT AROUND THE RING.

FIGURE:

NOW ALL FOUR GENTS TO THE RIGHT OF THE RING, AND WHEN YOU GET THERE YOU GIVE HER A SWING.

Four gentlemen pass to the right behind their partners, (girls move slightly in) and swing the lady on their right.

AND WHEN YOU HAVE SWUNG, REMEMBER MY CALL --AN ALLEMANDE LEFT, AND PROMENADE ALL. Treating the right hand girl you

Treating the right hand girl you were swinging as though she were your partner, do an allemande left to the girl who was originally your

partner, then a right to the girl you were swinging. Turn this girl under your right arm and promenade three quarters of the way back to the men's original home position.

Repeat this three more times until all of the men have their own partners back.

NOW ALL FOUR LADIES TO THE LEFT OF THE RING, AND WHEN YOU GET THERE GIVE HIM A SWING The four ladies pass in front of their partners to the left and swing

AND WHEN YOU HAVE SWUNG, REMEMBER MY CALL --

the left hand gent.

AN ALLEMANDE LEFT AND A PROMENADE ALL.

Treating the person who the girls were swinging with as their partners, they allemande left just one and promenade with the gents they were swinging with.

Return to the ladies home each time.

Repeat three more times until each lady is home with her original partner.


