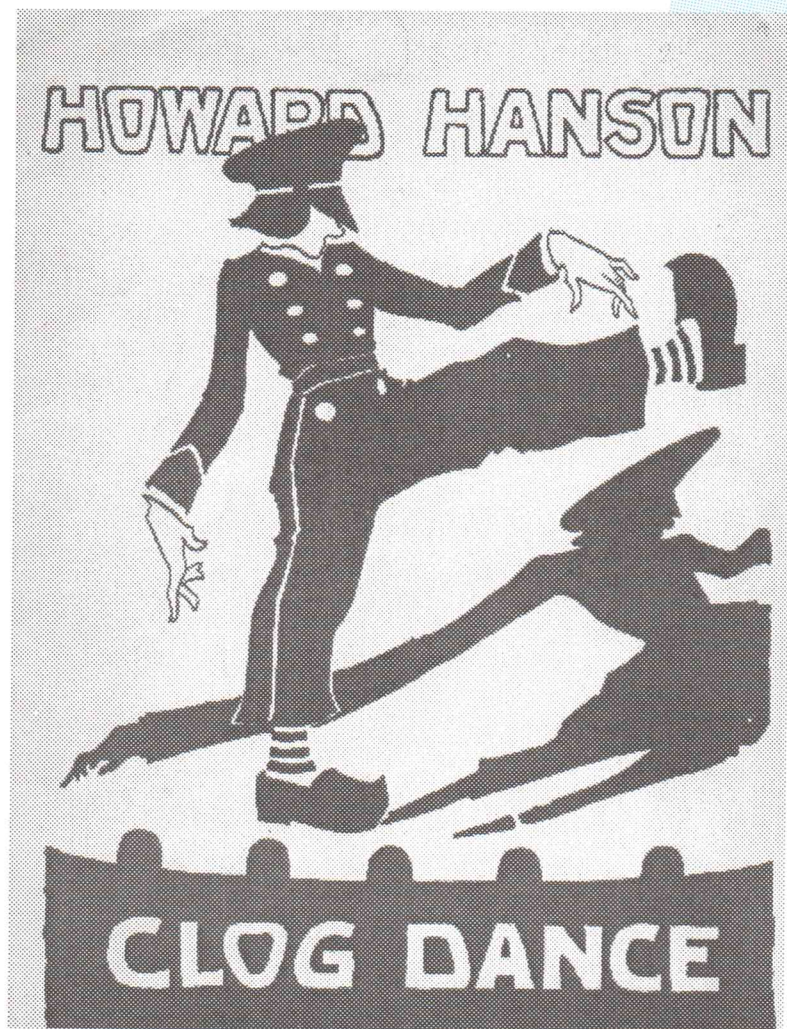

Looking back, I was overpaid. What a privilege it is to have the chance to use the talents God has given us to help a worthy cause. Take a close look at that next benefit show opportunity. You may find the payment to be greater than gold.

Old Clogging Instruction Books

I just got the October Issue of DTT and, as usual, started reading cover to cover. I enjoyed your editorial regarding old clogging books.

There is a great deal of information about old clogging books on the internet. You can actually view and print photographs (archival grayscale JPG images) of the pages of these books starting at:

<http://memory.loc.gov/ammem/dihtml/dihome.html>

This will get a listing of dance instruction manuals from 1490 to 1920. Then search for "clog" as a keyword and it brings up 2 books.

The first is "Jig, Clog and Break-down Dancing Made Easy, with Sketches of Noted Jig Dancers" published by Ed James in 1873.

The second is the book "Dancing Clogs" by Henry Tucker that you discussed in the editorial.

While the Jig, etc. book first describes Jig Steps, it then states "The above jig dancing step are equally applicable for Clog Dancing by simply introducing the "Clog Break" to finish the eight bars of music.

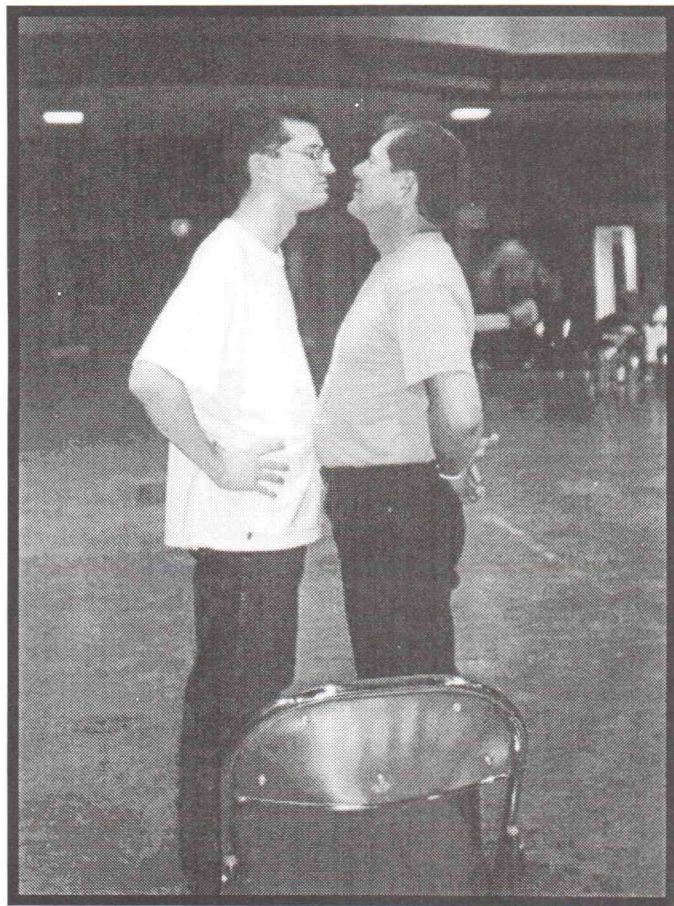

Carrying on a "Grand Ole" Tradition

How many times have you heard the cliché "The proof is in the pudding?"

In the March 1998 issue of the Double Toe Times, I wrote an article about the Melvin Sloan Dancers. Carrying on a grand tradition in the Sloan Family, the Melvin Sloan Dancers entertain thousands of people each year with their spirited dancing on the stage of the Grand Ole Opry in Nashville, Tennessee. In addition to their dancing, many of the family are accomplished musicians as well.

On September 18 of this year, Melvin Sloan and the Sloan Family Dancers were featured on the syndicated program "Backstage at the Opry." Melvin was very gracious to mention his involvement with America's Clogging Hall of Fame and our home at the world famous Stompin' Ground in Maggie Valley, North Carolina. In addition to Melvin Sloan, fiddlers Cheryl Chunn and Heather Brown were interviewed and singled out during the live portion of the Grand Ole Opry broadcast.

This particular night, the big red curtain was not raised as the stage was being readied for the CMA Awards broadcast to be held the following Wednesday. On the apron of the Grand stage, the Melvin Sloan dancers opened the live TV show with a lively square dance. After a short break, the team returned to join Cheryl Chunn and Heather Brown onstage as they performed the most beautiful rendition of "Orange Blossom Special" I have ever heard. With bluegrass music filling the hall, the dancers broke out into a rousing freestyle. Even Melvin couldn't keep

his feet still! These talented performers brought the Opry crowd to its feet and made the rafters on the Opry House ring.

Cheryl and Heather are no "fly by night" fiddlers. As a matter of fact, each of the Sloan Dancers (all 12 of them) are accomplished musicians in their own right. Cheryl's husband, Pokey Chunn, also dances with the Sloan Family as well as playing guitar and mandolin and hosting a live radio show each Saturday on WGSF AM 100, where pickers and singers drop by to entertain the radio audience.

Heather Brown has already set her sights on a country music future. "I want to attend college and then be an on-the-road musician playing for the country music singers of tomorrow," she told me. "I am in awe of Vince Gill. Look what he has done for country music. Every time he is on stage, I stand off to the side and watch him perform."

America's Clogging Hall of Fame was well represented that night as Brent Herron, a 1997 International Clogging Team member and official Sloan Family Cloggers member, made good use of his swift feet in a solo performance.

Not a bad night to watch the Grand Ole Opry. It sort of brought a big lump to my throat. There on stage are cloggers that you know on a first name basis, and the director of a team that has graced the stage of the Grand Ole Opry since way back in 1952.

Melvin, what can I say! Thanks for remembering America's Clogging Hall of Fame and for keeping true Southern Appalachian Dancing alive for all to enjoy!

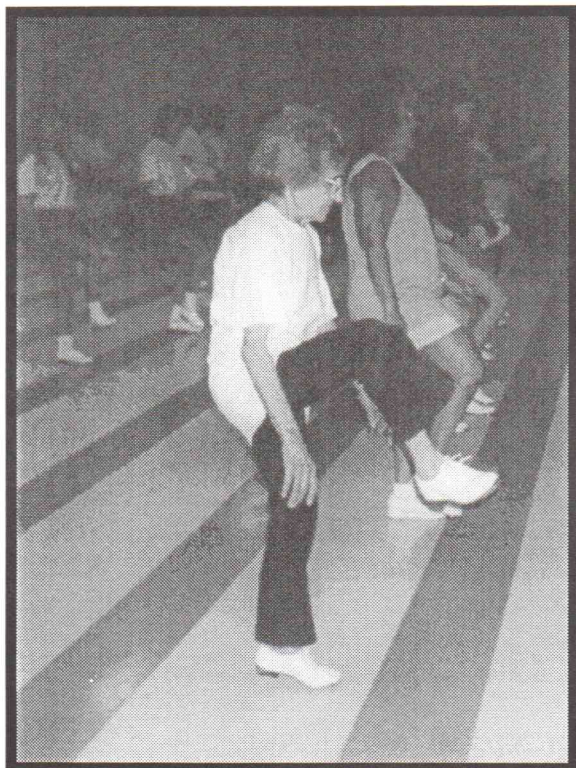

Clogging:

Giving Thanks for the Gift of the Clogging Family

Now halfway into a second decade of clogging I have reflected on what a variety of benefits I have enjoyed as a result of this avocation. As a kid I was dragged to the dance recitals of my mother's best friend's daughter. The tap was kind of interesting but when I asked to take tap mom looked at me like I was crazy. I waited until I was forty-two to take the plunge into clogging.

In the beginning, the sheer satisfaction of being rhythmic and percussive was satisfaction enough. I later learned a great deal more and had the opportunity to teach locally and around the U.S. and Canada. A group I taught in Florida over the course of 8 years took me to Europe with them and venues in five countries. Twice before they had taken my routines to both main line China and the now former Soviet Union.

But the **people**, the friendships and connections are of at least equal value in this clogging connection. It has become extended family for me and most other cloggers who remain involved. Every where I go in the U.S. and Canada I meet both old and new friends. We pick up as if no time at all has passed. Even as the father of eleven adopted children and three home made, I have added adult friends, brothers and sisters, children and grandchildren to my life. My life has been enriched not only in the constantly growing skill level of clogging and the sheer joy of dance, but in the life experience that contributes to my personal, social and spiritual growth.

In clogging I have met men, woman, boys and girls whom I have come to love dearly and I experience the same from them. I have engaged in comical interchanges of some duration and in philosophic and spiritual discourse that has been very beneficial to my ongoing personal development.

As a United Methodist clergyman and career Child Welfare Administrator, I have both married and buried cloggers and the children of cloggers. It has been a connection not replicated in my life. When I have faced personal hardships it was the clogging community much ahead of the church or child welfare community that was there for me. It was not only local cloggers in Western New York, but calls late at night from a clogging friend in Kentucky and a visit by clogging friends from Michigan. Maybe stamp collectors and motor cyclists have bonding going on too, I hope so. But none will ever exceed the opportunity and reality of our clogging community. I once wondered if clogging caused some of the personal problems participants face. I have come to believe that clogging and the clogging community heals them.

Old-Time Square Dancing

More figures from a great collection of Square Dances by "Jonesy"

by Jeff Driggs, Editor

To follow is another square from our series of old time square dance calls by Fenton "Jonesy" Jones. These calls are found on a 78 rpm collection of records by the MacGregor label that includes hand-typed sheets of the calls for each dance.

The calls from this dance are noted exactly as called by "Jonesy", and carry a western flavor in their delivery and patter. The figure pattern is attributed to caller Paul Phillips of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

Remember that the words printed in ALL CAPS are the calls and patter that the caller says when cueing the figure. The words following the call (in upper and lower case letters) is a description of the dancer's movement.

"YOU CALL EVERYBODY DARLIN"

WARMER UPPER:

(As called by Fenton "Jonesy" Jones)

YOU DO-SA 'ROUND YOU CORNER, SHE'S A DARLING. SWING WITH YOUR LITTLE HONEY DO.

Passing right shoulders back to back, gents walk around their left hand ladies, return to partners and swing.

NOW ALLEMANDE LEFT WITH THE CORNER GAL (or LADY)

RIGHT HAND 'ROUND YOUR OWN (or PRETTY) LITTLE PAL (or BABY)

Gents extend left hands to the left hands of their corner ladies and walk around them (CCW), give right hands to partners and walk around partners (CW)

ALLEMANDE LEFT WITH THE OLD LEFT HAND, RIGHT TO YOUR HONEY, IT'S A RIGHT AND LEFT GRAND.

Gents repeat the allemande left then give right hand to partners, left hand to the next lady, right to the next in a grande right and left.

NOW PROMENADE THOSE PRETTY LADIES HOME.

NOW YOU STEP RIGHT BACK AND WATCH HER SMILE, YOU STEP RIGHT UP AND SWING 'ER A WHILE OR SHE WON'T BE YOUR DARLING ANYMORE.

FIGURE:

(Original call by Paul Phillips of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma)

NOW THE FIRST AND THIRD OUT TO THE RIGHT YOU CIRCLE, TWICE AROUND IN A PRETTY LITTLE RING YOU GO.

The first and third couples walk to the couples on their right. They join hands and circle to the left (twice around).

NOW YOU STAND IN LINE WITH THE DEAR LITTLE THING.

#1 and #3 gents drop hands with the lady on their left and they form a

straight line of four, facing each other across the set.

NOW FORWARD EIGHT AND BACK TO THE RING.

The four in line step forward three steps and back three steps.

FORWARD AGAIN WITH A RIGHT AND LEFT THRU, AND DON'T YOU BOYS BE SLOW.

Gents extend right to right hands of ladies opposite them passing right shoulders they cross to the opposite side of the square, taking partners' left hands in their left hands and the gents place the right hand in the small of partners' back and turn the ladies to face the center of the set.

A RIGHT AND LEFT BACK WITH YOUR DARLING.

Same execution as above.

NOW YOU CHAIN THOSE LADIES ONCE RIGHT DOWN THE LINE.

The gents turn the ladies as in right and left thru, then the ladies touch right hands, pass right shoulders and extend left hands to left hands of gents directly opposite.

AND YOU PROMENADE AROUND THAT NEW LITTLE GAL YOU'VE FOUND OR SHE WON'T BE YOUR DARLING ANYMORE.

The gents turn their new partner as explained above and promenade to gents' home position.

Repeat for #2 and #4 couples.

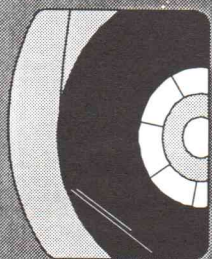

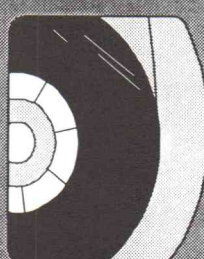

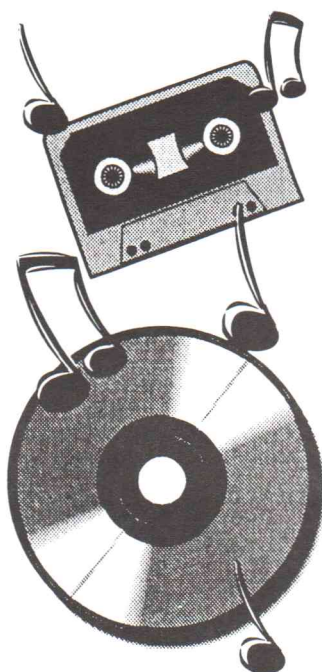
