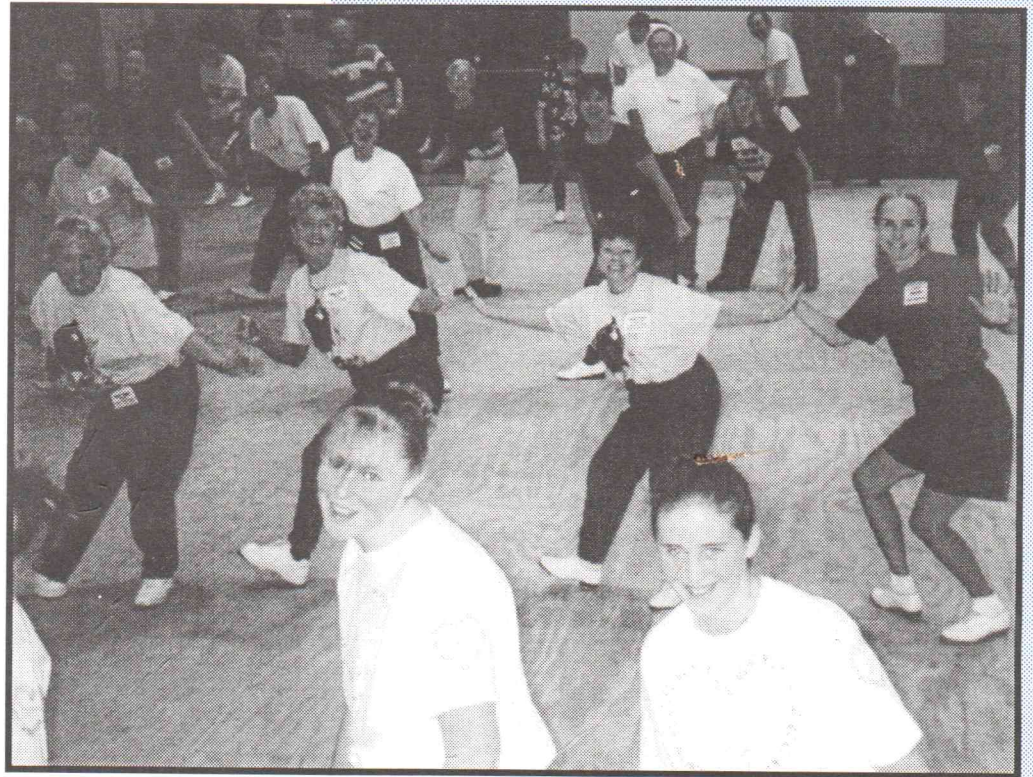

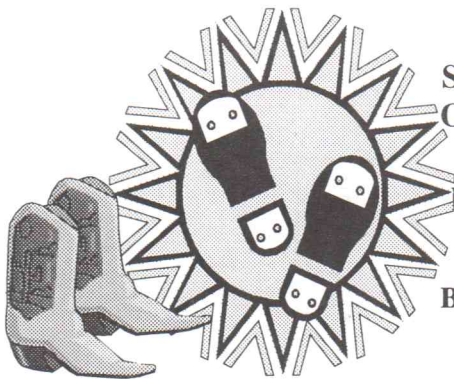

# Y2Klog - A Look Into the New Millenium



**Y**2K... Despite the predictions, the hysteria and the hype, we made it to the year 2000. Now we stand at the dawn of a new millennium. Our beloved clog dance -- as we know it today -- is poised to enter the new age. How does the future look?

While it is made up of many early step forms, the modern American step dance of clogging is very new. Lloyd "Pappy" Shaw first published "Cowboy Dances" in 1939. The International Association of Square Dance Callers didn't organize themselves as "Callerlab" until 1974, and didn't include clogging in their programs until 1977. Clogging workshops didn't become popular until the late 1970's and early 1980's. With the advent of these workshops, different step dance styles, from Appalachian to Buck to Canadian and Irish, have fused to give us the American Step dance we now see at workshops and in competition. It is safe to say, then, that the step dance form we now teach in our classes and workshops has developed within the last twenty years. Because of this rapid growth, to ensure the future of this dance we must strive to accept and nurture not only the form our dance has grown into, but also the many purer forms from which it developed.

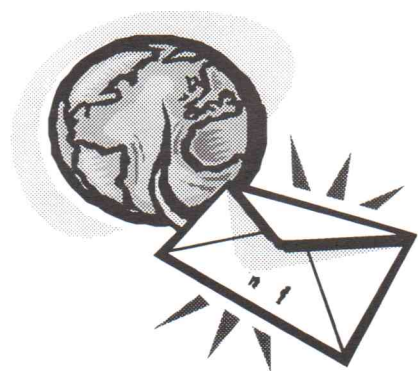
In some parts of the clogging world, the line dance has become the only means of clogging expression. Any dances which include body contact, coupling, or mixing are scoffed at and ridiculed. In this environment, there is no room for personal expression. Freestyle has died, and the social dances and play party jigs that gave birth to our art are considered trivial and embarrassing. When cuers offer easy dances to give outside dancers the opportunity to become involved, some in the cued-crowd demand more challenge. We must learn from the mistakes of others. Creating a "niche" within a dance form that caters exclusively to that niche -- to the exclusion of others -- will only succeed until the the niche divides and dwindles, and so does the dance form. Cued line dancing is a great, and the areas that have made it a success are to be applauded, but cuers please teach your dancers tolerance to the MANY forms of clogging.

Also, in this tremendous period of clogging growth, some individuals and organizations have attempted to set themselves and their groups up as the "one and only" purveyor of clogging. Any person, organization or event that does not fall in step, or attempts to work independently, is an enemy to be dealt with and stymied at any cost. Clogging is a vast art form -- one certainly large enough to support a varied number of events, organizations, teachers, suppliers and publications. While we may not always agree philosophically, it is always in the best interest of the clog dance to encourage all activities, events and organizations that present themselves with honesty and integrity.

Inclusion. Tolerance. Fellowship. They could apply to anything in our lives. We choose to clog, and we can make the dance we revel in a joy for the next millennium.

# Big Shoes to Fill

## America's Clogging Hall of Fame Inducts Three Clogging Leaders During Its Fall Meeting in Maggie Valley, NC

Three well-respected innovators and preservationists in the clogging world were recognized by induction into the prestigious America's Clogging Hall of Fame in Maggie Valley, North Carolina during the organizations Fall Meeting in October. The Inductees were Betsy Farlow, Edwin Woodrow Shope and Barbara Stalcup.

### Betsy Farlow

Betsy Farlow's desire to dance was started at a very early age when she learned to "shag" and "jitterbug" with her schoolmates. At that same time she began taking private dance classes in tap, ballet and acrobatic dancing. In 1954, Farlow entered the business world and married Earl, her husband of 45 years. Together, they have raised three sons, had eight grandchildren, and founded and op-

erated Farlow Electric, Inc. They have worked together to build their business, traveled in their motor home with the Winnebago International Travelers, bowled weekly, and -- of course -- danced, danced, danced.

Betsy received her Western Square Dance diploma in 1966, and her Round dance diploma in 1967. She began clogging and from 1969 to 1984 helped to cofound the "Click-N-Cloggers." In 1984, she helped found the "Carolina Heartland Cloggers". As a charter member of the National Clogging and Hoedown Council (NCHC), she has served as the organization's President, as well as a Certified Judge, Co-Editor of the NCHC Clog Dance Book, and NCHC Rules Official and Competition Committee Chairperson.

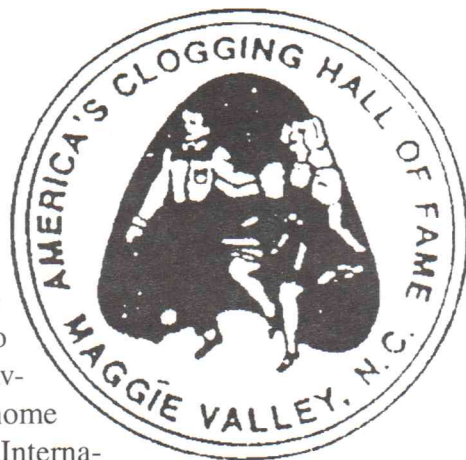
Betsy has taught traditional clogging at the CLOG Organization's National Convention for over 10 years and has been Chairperson for the Clogging Hall at the National Square Dance Convention, as well as coordinating dancers fro the opening of the Special Olympics.

Betsy Farlow has been a dancer, teacher, director, judge and official, and has taught in almost all of the United States and Europe. Farlow says that as a result of her clogging she has won many individual and team awards "But my most cherished rewards are the many friendships made while at the same time preserving and promoting the art of clogging."

### Edwin Woodrow Shope

Edwin Woodrow Shope was born in Macon County, North Carolina in 1913. He began his love for Southern Appalachian Square Dancing as a very young boy. He remembers Sam Queen from Haywood County coming to his hometown of Franklin, North Carolina, to teach old time square dancing. Shope remembers fondly the community get-togethers these square dances brought. From the Saturday night dances in the Patton community, to the home of "Doc" Mitchell's, the local VFW, Helen's Barn, the Mountain City Playhouse in Mountain City, Georgia, the musical Mill, the Otto Elementary School and the Slagle

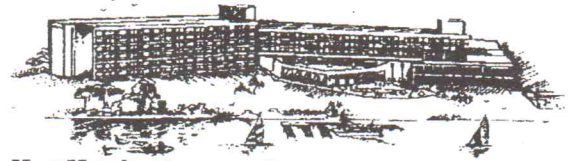

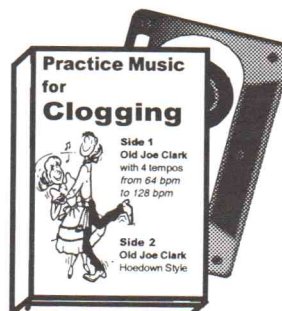

Memorial Building, Shope danced and loved them all. "I have called square dances since I was old enough to talk," Shope said. "Way back in the late 1940's and 1950's I was calling dances every Wednesday and Saturday at Helen's Barn or the Mountain City Playhouse."

Shope's love of dance is felt deep within his soul. "Like most mountain-born Western North Carolinians, when I hear the sound of a good banjo and fiddle making music I just have to get out on the floor and cut a few steps," Shope said.

Edwin is featured in one of the famous Foxfire books building a smoke house out of logs. His workmanship with wood has been another of his hobbies for many years. For 51 years, he has shared his life with wife Dorothy. They have five children, four grandchildren and one great-grandchild. Shope retired from the United States Forest Service in 1972 after 32 years of faithful service. His faithful service to, and his love for clogging continue to this day.

## Barbara Stalcup

Barbara C. Stalcup, (known as Bobbie), director of the Carolina

Sweethearts of Murphy, North Carolina, needs no introduction to the thousands she has touched with her good old-fashioned mountain clogging. This beautiful redheaded great-grandmother's accomplishments with the Sweethearts must be shared and honored.

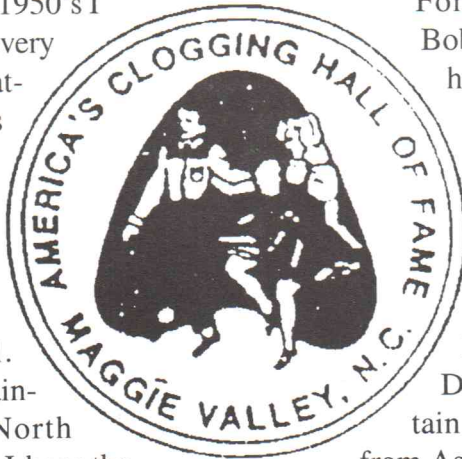
For seventeen years Bobbie led the Sweethearts. Her work began in 1957 while helping her daughter's second grade teacher prepare for a May Day Program. The late Hubert Hayes, Director of "Mountain Youth Jamboree,"

from Asheville, NC, was in the area scouting for talent for his program. Mr. Hayes watched the class and invited them to be a part of his program. Bobbie and Mrs. Constance West worked with the stu-

dents until Mrs. West was seriously injured in an accident. She asked Bobbie not to let their work die. This is when Bobbie began the many years of promoting the Carolina Sweethearts.

In September, 1957, the dance team won "The Most Outstanding Award" at the Apple Festival in Hendersonville, NC. While there, they met the NC Cloggers from Hendersonville. Several members of their team showed the Sweethearts their dance steps to begin their clogging. One member called them "The Little Sweethearts". Since this time the NC Sweethearts have won some 75 trophies as well as untold individual trophies. These awards represent competition in such contests as the "Hubert Hayes Mountain Youth Jamboree" in Asheville, NC, "The Mountain Folk and Dance Festival", directed by Bascom Lamar Lunsford in Asheville, NC, "The North Caro-

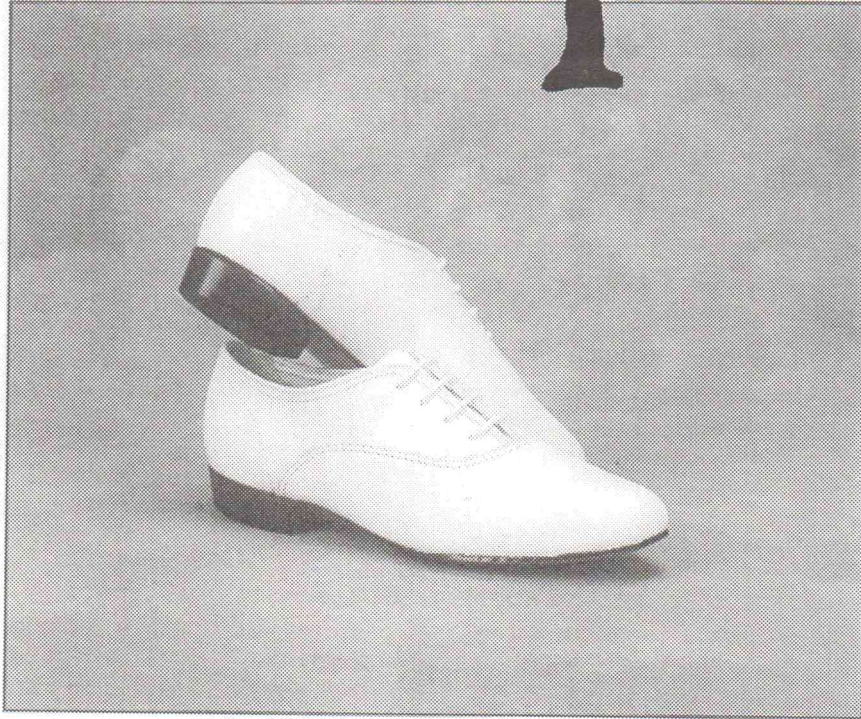

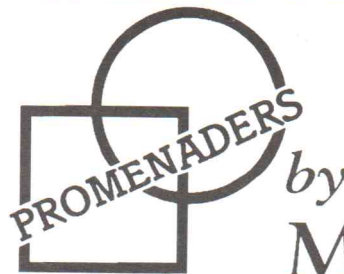

lina Apple Festival" in Hendersonville, NC, "The Cherokee Indian Folk and Dance Festival" in Gatlinburg, Tenn. If there was a clogger's convention anywhere in NC, GA., TN, KY or FL, they were there.

The Sweethearts appeared on television in Asheville, Chattanooga, Knoxville, Atlanta, Greensboro, Tampa and Miami. They have performed on such programs as "The Stars of Tomorrow" with Freddie Miller, "The Alex and Elmer Show", "Today in Tennessee", "Top Ten Dance Party", and "Showcase of Stars". They appeared with Roy Clark and his group on the Chattanooga March of Dimes Telethon for a couple of years, "The Bill Anderson Show" in Miami, Fla., "Tom T. Hall Show" in Gatlinburg, Tenn., and several other known performers..

The dance team did command performances for numerous Congressmen and Senators as well as Governors: Terry Sanford, Moore and Bob Scott of North Carolina; Lester Mattox and Jimmy Carter of Georgia.

One team was filmed by the government for distribution in the West Germany Schools for educational purposes. Films have been placed in libraries at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro, Duke University, and Mars Hill College as records of the preservation of the old way of mountain life; One film was taken at "The Mountain Folk and Dance Festival" in Asheville, for the "International Folk Festival" in England.

The teams danced the traditional figures, but sometimes would add imaginative gestures or steps that audiences and judges seemed to enjoy. In 1958, with the help of a local skate teacher, they presented their clogging in a highly original number on roller skates, winning wide acclaim.

Their practice of giving benefit performances for local groups, clubs, and fund raising organizations are too many to mention. One would think that with all these accomplishments, Stalcup would have little time for anything else. That is not the case. Stalcup retired three years ago from the Cherokee County Board of Education. She has three children seven grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren. Her dear husband, a former police chief, is now deceased. Together, they and their family have many pleasant memories of their life in clogging.

Barabara Stalcup has given of herself timelessly to her family, her community and to the world of clogging, yet to hear her speak she has been given back more than she gave. Her family, dancers and friends throughout the years all share the deepest admiration and love for their "Carolina Sweetheart."

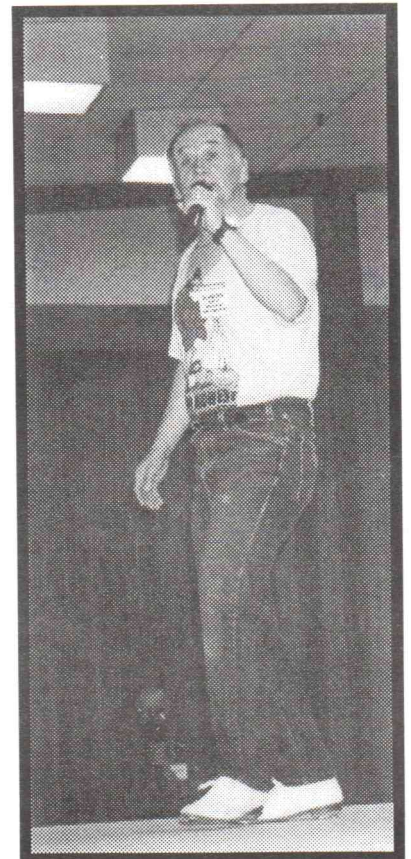

# Old-Time Square Dancing

Appalachian Small Circle Figures For You to Learn and Call

by Jeff Driggs, Editor

To facilitate the action in a square dance, a member of the group will lead the group by cuing the calls for figures. This does not necessarily have to be a dancer. Calling can be done from within the set or by a person outside the set.

There are two types of calls outlined in this booklet. The first being command calls and the second called patter calls. Each has its own purpose and presentation, and a good caller is adept at mixing the two for an easy to follow and fun square dance.

**Command calls** instruct a dancer to perform a certain task, such as "Circle to the left — circle South." In this case, a circle of dancers is instructed to join hands and move the circle in a clockwise direction.

**Patter calls** often accompany a command call and add flavor to the call. "Circle left — circle South. Put a little moonshine in your mouth." Here, the caller is certainly not telling the dancers to stop for a nip; He is adding a little fun mountain patter. Patter may also tell a story and be done during the execution of lengthy figures such as *Wind the Ball of Yarn* or *Shoo Fly Swing* when the caller has a great deal of time to fill.

Make sure when calling to give more emphasis to command calls

than patter. The important thing is for the dancers to hear and understand the figures of the dance. The gift of patter will come with practice, and will shape your personality as a caller.

When using this text, note that passages written in **ALL CAPITAL LETTERS** are the commands and patter you will use when calling each figure. The notations in **Upper and Lower Case** describe the movements the dancers will use when executing the figures.

## SOW THE WHEAT

**CUE:**

SOW THE WHEAT, MOW THE CLOVER.

Odd couple arches over the even couple. Even couples make an arch and move apart, letting the odd couple back up under the arch and return to home positions.

WHEN YOU GET DONE, DO IT ALL OVER.

Repeat sequence.

## PEEK-A-BOO OVER

PEEK-A-BOO OVER AND PEEK-A-BOO BACK, PEEK-A-BOO 'ROUND THE SAME OLD TRACK

EVERYBODY DANCE, EVERYBODY SWING, EVERYBODY DOING THE SAME OLD THING.

All partners swing.

## SWING YOUR MA

All drop hands. Odd man swings his corner halfway around clockwise with a two-hand swing (change positions).

SWING YOUR PA

Odd gent swings even gent with a two-hand swing.

SWING THE GIRL FROM ARKANSAS

Odd gent swings partner with a two-hand swing half way around.

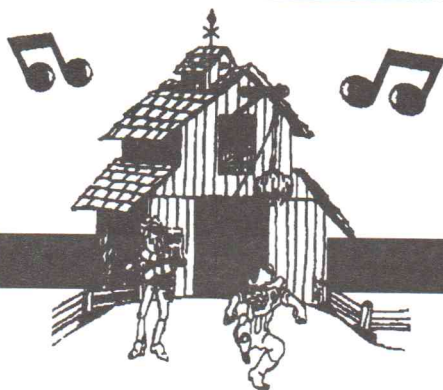
