

Slump Days



Is clogging in a slump? That's what I've heard in certain areas of the country from teachers who have been involved in the activity for years.

There is no question that clogging, like all activities, goes through periods when classes may be down and interest is harder to generate. Trends can certainly effect the perception of clogging as an activity, and there is no question that today's families have a plethora of options to choose from in entertainment. Some folks say that people are just staying home more, and some studies are showing that is the case.

National trends can certainly bear on the ability to market clogging effectively. Those who have been clogging for years remember the "Urban Cowboy" days, when going country was "cool" and classes were bolstered by the national interest in things country. Many teachers have said that the "Riverdance" craze of the past years saw an initial increase in their class numbers, but as the craze waned, so did attendance.

In the early nineties, the country line dance craze came along and many teachers saw their cloggers unlace their shoes to put on boots and Ropers. "Rocky Top" was traded for "Achy Breaky Heart", but not for long. In most areas of the country, the country dance craze has subsided, or given way to swing and a renewed interest in ballroom dancing.


So where are we today? Response to clogging competitions and workshops have been tremendous in many areas of the country, and the success of Novice and Amateur divisions shows that there are a lot of new cloggers out there.

Maybe clogging isn't in a slump. Maybe we are. Take time to look at how you are marketing your classes. Then look into the program you are using. Can you add some new beginner dances or add some fun social dances to get new students excited. Is there an outlet for cloggers in your area to get together every month or so to just dance and have fun? Maybe you can be the catalyst to bring people together in the spirit of fun, fellowship and -- above all -- CLOGGING!

Sure, there will be feast and famine as a clogging instructor. I can guarantee that as a team director you will one day deal with a team split or dancers leaving for any number of reasons. Times change. Trends change.

But, thank goodness, the basics of clogging remain the same simple, rhythmic steps that delighted our ancestors. Our dance has grown and changed throughout the years and offers a variety of levels and avenues for participation. Just sharing those basics with someone opens doors for them and helps to continue this important heritage. Beginner classes can be a challenge, but they are the most vital link in the continuance of our art. Renew and refresh yourself and have a great Summer session and performances!

To Everything: Turn, Turn, Turn

Our self-governing clogging group, the Double-Down Cloggers, recently had a question on which direction to turn a "High Horse".

One member of the group feels that a step turns in the direction of the free foot as a standard rule of clogging. I didn't think that there was a rule about turns, but I have noticed that the other dancers have had to concentrate to turn this step to the left, as the natural tendency is to turn the step to the right.

Is there a rule in clogging about which direction steps should turn?

Dear Lynn:

While I am not aware of any documented "rules" for choreography in clogging, there are many accepted ways of thinking when it comes to the presentation of certain steps, movements and notations.

The "High Horse" step, which was popularized by instructor Steve Smith, of Georgetown, Kentucky, was originally presented in his choreography of the same name with no turn. Other choreographers who have used the step in their own sequences have since added a turn to the step.

For the most part, a turn in any given direction is dictated by the intent of the choreographer. Many dance instructors feel that turning in

the direction of the free foot makes it easier to remember. I find that my own choreography usually turns in the direction of the free foot.

However, in some cases, I like to turn in the opposite direction to add some variety or a new look to a step.

If you begin turning the High Horse at the beginning of the step, which is on the left foot, then it would gather that turning to the left would be more natural. If you begin the turn after the doubletoe across and back in front -- using the three steps to turn -- because you are now on the right foot lead, you may find it easier to turn to the right.

Also, if you learn a step turning in one direction, then see it presented turning the opposite, it will be quite awkward.

Choreographers hold the cards when it comes to dictating which way their dancers turn.







Hall of Fame Spring Meeting A Great Success

Every year, in April, the American Clogging Hall of Fame conducts workshops for teams interested in learning traditional dance styles and forms. This years instructors were Jim Loveless of MD, Ray Hattaway of NC, Lou Maiuri of WV, Garland Steele of WV, Christine Morris of OH, Vicky Barnes of SC, Gwen Drake of SC, and Sonja Wiseman of TN.



All areas of traditional style competition were covered as well as competition guidelines for the categories. categories covered were smooth mountain square dance, country hoedown, running set hoedown, and southern appalachian. Line dances and competition steps were also taught, as well as, appalachian style flatfoot dancing.

The workshop began Saturday morning with traditional categories and ended with flat foot instruction by 3:00 p.m. Five instructors/judges demonstrated the flat foot style of dance which has become popular and is now

offered as a category at many competitions. Christine Morris gave instruction in the Appalachian style flat foot dancing after the demonstration.

A solo competition was held after the workshop and Mark Clifford won Male Grand Champion and Heather Poteat won Female Grand Champion. A flatfoot competition was also held and Nicole, from the Electric City Clogging Team, won the flat foot grand championship.



Soon, word spread through the clogging community of Juanita's very special group, and invitations to attend and perform at workshops began. Doing A Clogging “Open House”

A clogging “Open House” — also known as a Round-Up — is a great opportunity to show the public what clogging is and give them the chance to experience the fun of clogging in the hopes of bringing them back for a series of classes.

The purpose of the open house is to promote upcoming clogging classes, or to introduce clogging to a new area or facility. Many instructors begin each new series of classes with an open house that is free of charge. Attendees may sign up for the rest of the series during the evening, and invitations are given for those in attendance to bring friends the following week for the beginning of the classes, when you will start teaching from scratch.

One of the most important things to remember when planning the program for your open house is to keep it social. Making those in attendance feel as though they are joining a group of new friends is a powerful incentive to return. When I do an open house, the first thing I do is get everyone on the floor for a simple social mixer which has no footwork whatsoever. Just having the group join hands and do a few very easy movements is a very bonding experience. Studies show that touch is a very important tool in establishing relationships. Beginning with a circle will break the ice and make everyone feel at ease. A good first circle dance is the “Countdown Circle Dance.”

Once you have done an opening circle, you can have the attendees of your open house have a seat and enjoy an exhibition by your group or you can do a short routine to show them what clogging looks like. Keep this exhibition very simple and energetic. The purpose is to show how much fun clogging is. Do not intimidate the participants with footwork that will leave them feeling that they will never be able to do what you are doing. There will be plenty of time to shine for your dancers as you go.

Next, get everyone back on the floor and in a circle. Have everyone turn 1/4 to the right and follow each other in a promenade by starting on the left foot and walking in the circle. Left, Right, Left, Right. Play a little clogging music and let the dancers clap their hands to the music. Now start them on the left foot and have them walk in time to the music. Next, add a slight kick to the walk so that all are doing Kick, Step, Kick, Step. Repeat this in the circle. Now have the dancers count to three and tell them that once they kick they just do three steps. Kick, One, Two, Three, Kick, One Two, Three. This movement is very similar to

the clogging basic step and will help you build a foundation for your students that is very easy to build upon. Work on this progression from walk to kick, step to kick, one, two, three until everyone is dancing comfortably. Let the participants know they have just learned their first clogging step! While everyone is excited and feeling good about their achievement, take a break and give everyone a chance to socialize and meet other open house guests and club members.

Refreshments add a nice touch to your open house and provide a common area for people to gather. Have some of your dancers help with the refreshments and have them man the tables and greet attendees as they come through the line or to the table.

After the break, while people are finishing their refreshments, tell the class the brief history of clogging. Now that the dancers have tried a very easy walk-


ing step, they are more in tune to appreciate the story of how the step dances of our ancestors melted into the modern clog dance.


Invite everyone back up on the floor and review the easy basic (kick, one, two, three). Using this as a basic, add a few very easy moves (non-clogging moves are fine) until you have a simple dance. Old Time Rock and Roll is a great first dance that includes very simple moves and is very easy to teach and learn. Having the dancers feel that they have accomplished learning a complete dance already will make them feel that they will be successful with clogging and will encourage them to sign up for the full set of classes.

Now have the group perform another routine, or show the class some of the steps that they would learn as part of the clogging class. Seeing more dancing reinforces the impact of the evening.

End your open house with another circle dance or simple mixer that has the group joining hands or touching. Once again you are establishing a personal connection with the attendees and they are doing the same with each other. Ending on this high note will bring a comfortable and social finish to a great evening. Be sure to make the rounds and thank each guest personally for attending and invite them back for the full set of classes. Have your dancers in attendance do the same.

Be sure to have handouts about the classes for attendees to share with their friends through the week. I hope that these easy tips will help you to make your open house a success and a great advertisement for your classes or club.



Writing a Cue Sheet

Now that you've choreographed a clogging routine, you need to put it in a format that will be easy to understand for your students and other teachers who may wish to learn and remember your routine. A cue sheet is the written notation of the steps and sequence of a dance.

To give you an example of how a more intricate dance might be recorder on a cue sheet, to follow are two cue sheet formats for you to follow as an example.

The top of the cue sheet identifies the name of the routine, which is usually the same as the song to which the routine is written. Next is information about the song, the artist and any information which may be helpful for the dancer in finding the music. Lastly, the heading gives the name and contact information for the choreographer.

This provides the same information, but is formatted differently. A line is drawn through the step, with the L foot designator on top of the line and the R foot designator below the line. Movements done on the left foot appear above the line, those performed on the right below, and movements which occur on both feet simultaneously appear one on top of the other. This method is sometimes used in advanced dances when a great number of steps require simultaneous footwork.


