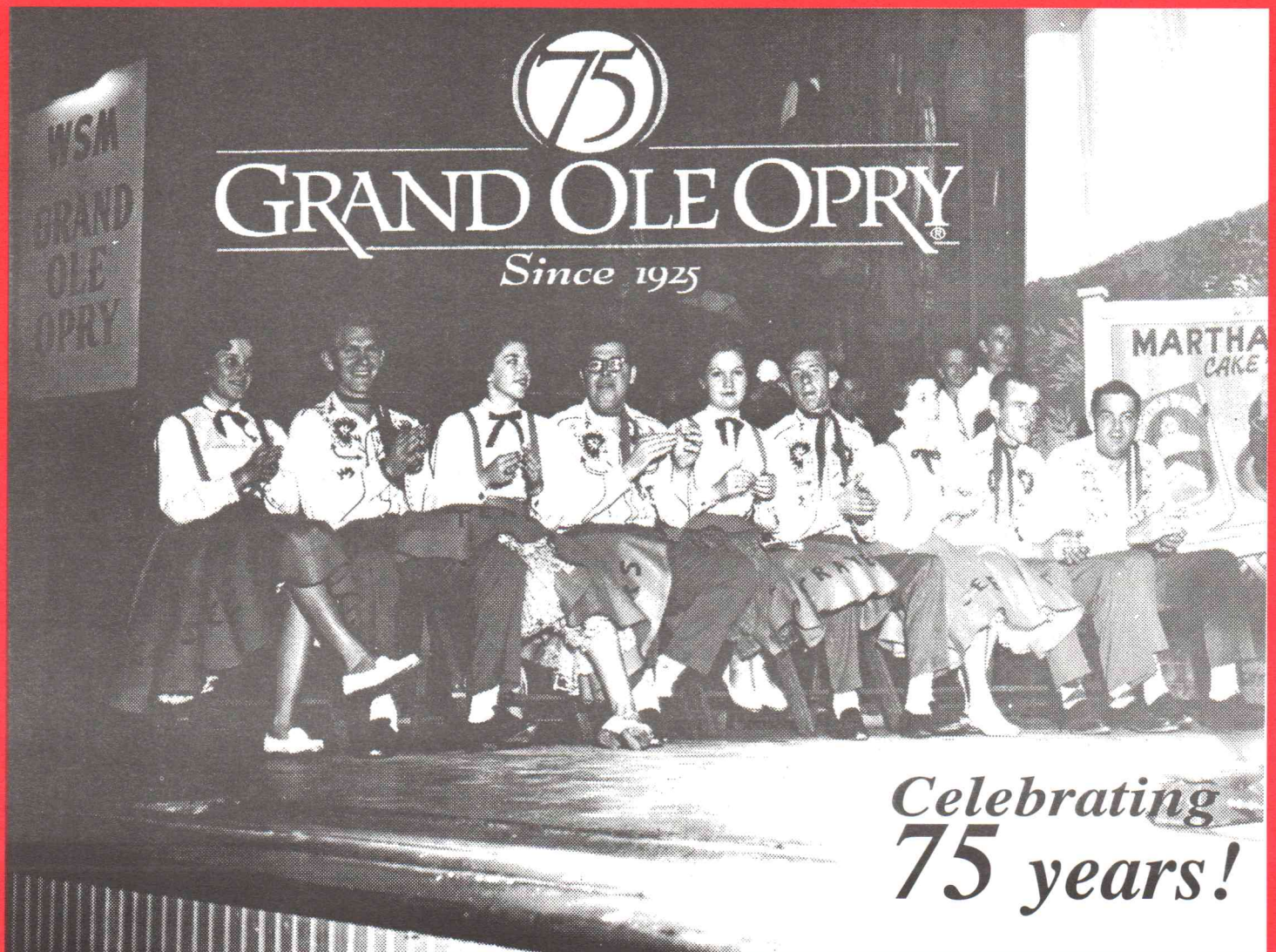

Building A Legacy



I recently had the pleasure of teaching seminars in clog dance at the ETCA (European Callers and Teachers Association) Teachers Conference near Frankfurt, Germany. In leading a session on the history of the clog dance, I was fascinated to hear that the teachers in attendance could trace the beginnings of the Appalachian clogging movement in Europe back to its earliest influences over 15 years ago. The "family tree" of sorts that results from this exercise now accounts for many of the hundreds of dancers and instructors throughout Germany, Austria, Denmark, Belgium, the Netherlands and the Czech Republic.

As a result of the meetings, ECTA's Council is now looking into the possibility of establishing a historian to document the growth of the art and maintain records for future dancers. ECTA already has an impressive archive of educational materials available for cloggers as a resource. Australia's Clogging Council has long had a historian, who has amassed a vast collection of clogging documents pertaining to the art of clogging in the land "down under."

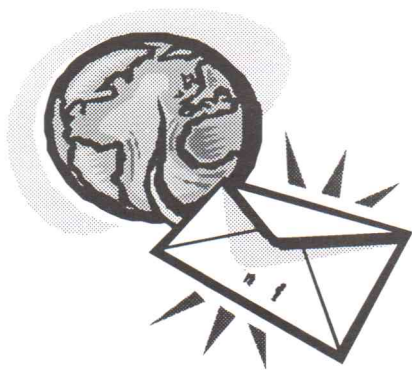
Imagine how much more we would know about clogging here in the United States if such materials were available documenting the dances earliest forms. People of vision, like Bascom Lamar Lunsford of North Carolina, and "Pappy" Lloyd Shaw of Colorado, did much to chronicle the music and dances of the mountain people, and many clogging organizations have begun to maintain a record of clogging in their respective areas.

Think of how you fit into the "family tree" of clogging. Who taught you to dance, and who -- in turn -- taught your teachers the art? How many of your dancers have gone on to teach themselves and continued to spread clogging? While this may not seem important to us now, this information will someday be beneficial to an eager generation of new dancers hungry for the history of the dance and how it evolved in their area.

Start a scrapbook with pictures, dates and names from each graduating clogging class. Keep a guestbook or memory book that chronicles your shows and performances. Include copies of your teaching materials and record lists. The legacy you build will become a valuable resource for future generations and be a wonderful project for you.

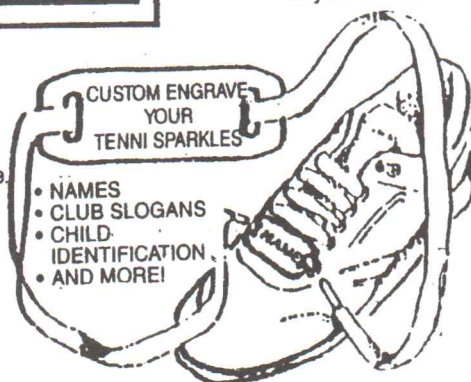

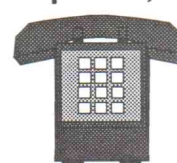

Dancers Kick Up Heels at OpryFest Grand Ole Clogging & Square Dance Festival

As part of the Grand Ole Opry's 75th Anniversary Celebration, the best dancers from around the country will come together to compete in the OpryFest Grand Ole Clogging and Square Dance Festival on July 29 and 30.

The festival promises to be strong, as it unites cloggers from two national organizations—America's Clogging Hall of Fame and Clogging Championships of America.

"OpryFest is particularly exciting because for the first time in history, dancers from both Clogging Championships of America and America's Clogging Hall of Fame will be competing against one another under the same roof," said Lynne Ogle, President of Clogging Championships of America. "With our two organizations coming together, you'll see the best of both traditional and modern dancing."

Over 25 sanctioned competitions will be held on the stage of the Grand Ole Opry House during the day on Saturday and Sunday. Outside the Opry House special guest clogging groups, including Opry member the Melvin Sloan Dancers, will be showcased on the Opry Plaza stage. The outdoor stage will also feature bluegrass and old time bands that will provide music for noncompetitive dancing.

"Anyone who has watched a Grand Ole Opry performance knows that dancers play an important role in the show," said Pete Fisher, general manager of the Grand Ole Opry. "It's a Saturday night tradition to have a

group clogging on stage when the Opry curtain rises."

The weekend's Grand Ole Opry show will also feature clogging groups, including the Melvin Sloan Dancers and winners from the OpryFest Clogging Competition.

Other activities at the Opry Plaza include the OpryFest Arts, Antiques and Crafts Fair, food and beverage

vendors, children's activities and strolling entertainment. The Opry Plaza includes the area in front of the Opry House, Acuff Theatre and Opry Museum. The times are 8 a.m. to midnight on July 29 and 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on July 30.

Spectator tickets prices are: one day festival ticket—\$10; two day festival ticket—\$15; two day festival ticket & Opry ticket—\$35; children 4-11—\$5; children under 4—free. To order tickets by mail, write Grand Ole Opry Tickets, 2802 Opryland Drive, Nashville, TN, 37214. To order by phone call Grand Ole Opry Group Customer Service at 615-889-3060. Tickets are also available on the Internet at www.opry.com.

Competition prices are: solo—\$8 per person; Duo/Duet—\$15 per duo and team—\$7 per person. Competition is sanctioned by America's Hall of Fame & Clogging Champions of America. This partnership is the first for these two great clogging organizations. Winners in their respective categories will qualify for the CCA Showdown of Champions to be held in the Gatlinburg area in the Spring and also qualify for the ACHF Dance-Off held in it's home in Maggie Valley, North Carolina.

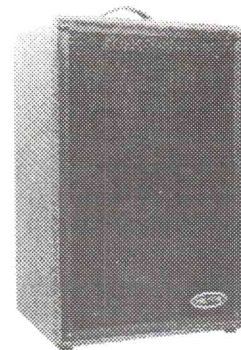

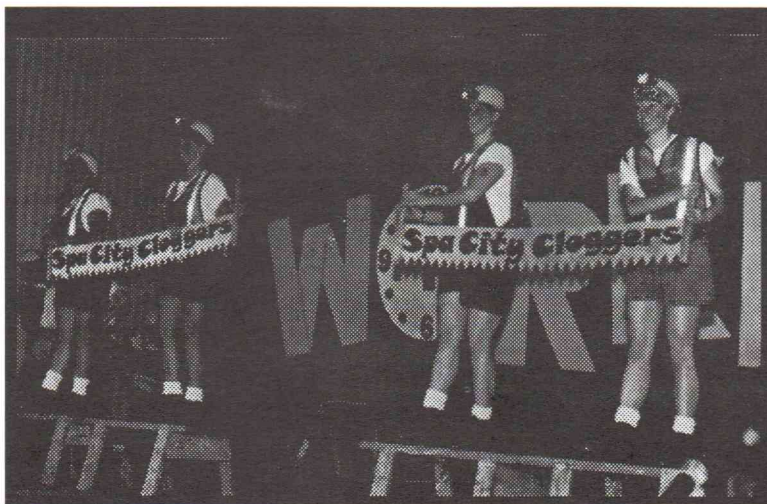

Lynne's Happy Cloggers

Florida Instructor Brings Happiness Through Clogging to Hundreds of Dancers

Lynne Voigt's first exposure to clogging was in 1963 at the National Square Dance convention held in St Paul, Minnesota. At the exhibition show there was a group of young people from Sioux Falls, So. Dakota. They were clogging as they were doing a rather hard square dance routine. They looked so impressive that she decided, right then and there that she wanted to learn to clog. There didn't seem to be any clogging classes in her area. However, she did learn to call square dances and called there quite successfully for 15 years.

In 1985, Lynne's husband, Elmer, retired and they started traveling. While in a R.V. Resort in Apache Jct, Arizona, Lynne started clogging with Elaine Steele. Voigt said that she just knew that this was her chance to really learn to clog. She also discovered another park that had classes taught by Irene Roth. Voigt went to as many classes and clogging parties as she could, taping many of them. Most were cued and they were easy for her to learn. Voigt danced to those

tapes for two hours every evening that summer. That fall, Lynne had the chance to teach a six week clogging class for the community education department in her hometown of Grand Rapids, Minnesota. As Voigt recalls, she had a mixed group of 15 men and women. It went really well and her square dance calling experience helped her. This made it easy to do the cueing. Because of the Square Dancing, she already had the sound equipment with mikes and all. When they left for Florida later that Fall they were ready to teach. The activity director at their home R.V. park, called Siesta Bay, at Fort Myers, Florida was very happy to have her start a clogging class - as it was a rather new park and they always wanted new activities. Soon, Voigt was teaching in four more parks with great success. This busy schedule continued for about 5 years. The Voigts then decided to consolidate the dancers so they would have more time to do other activities, such as golfing and tennis playing. Lynne's husband, Elmer, also clogs and does most of the setting up. He takes care of any sound problems that come up. Now, Lynne teaches in only the two largest parks, Siesta Bay

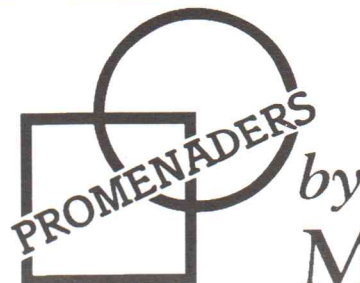

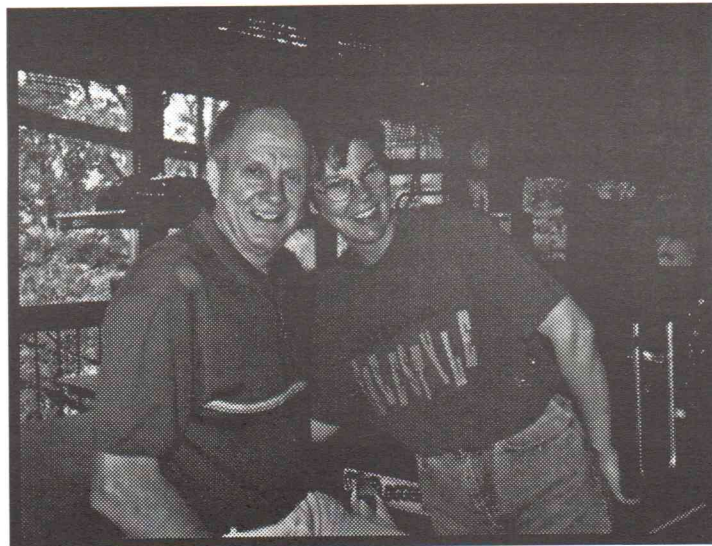

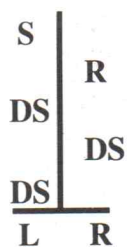


Writing a Cue Sheet

In our last issue, we showed you the information needed at the header of a cue sheet, plus two of the more popular formats for writing cue sheets. Here are some more of the many different formats that can be seen in clogging cue sheets. Decide for yourself which are the most helpful, the most clear and -- in some cases -- the most confusing!

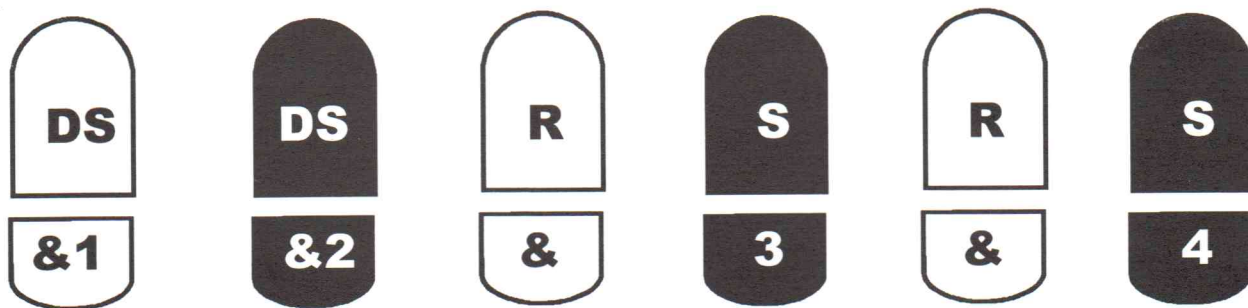
Simone Nichols Pace, of South Carolina, modified the line format of cue sheets by tilting the line vertically -- with the left side of the line indicating the left foot and the right side the right. Below is how a triple would look in the Pace format.



The L and R indicators at the bottom of the graph determine which foot the step component will occur on. If you follow the graph up from the bottom, reading left to right, the step will unfold before you. I have heard Simone describe this as if you are walking up the line and doing what each foot movement tells you to do. Try following the graph and you will see how easily the eye moves up the scale as the step unfolds. Critics have said that the method uses a great deal of paper or that it is difficult for beginners to follow. Simone has had good response to the format. Remember, as with all cue sheet formats, clarity and ease of use are important in making the choice of which format to use.

Another format which I have seen used in the earlier days of clogging is shown below. Actual foot prints were used with the outlined foot designating the left and the solid foot print denoting the right foot. Timing notations are shown in the heel of the print.

Shown below is how a Fancy Double would look using this format:



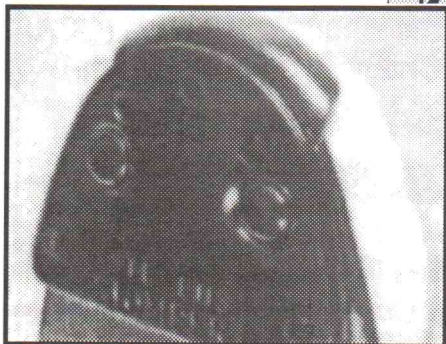
While this format is similar to those used in some ballroom dance manuals and teaching methods, the ever continuing intricacy of clog dance steps has made this format almost obsolete.

The step dance of clogging is an ever growing and changing art form, and many different ways of abbreviating and notating its movements have been tried. While there are many accepted forms of terminology and notation, remember to choose a format that you are comfortable with and which meets your dancers needs.

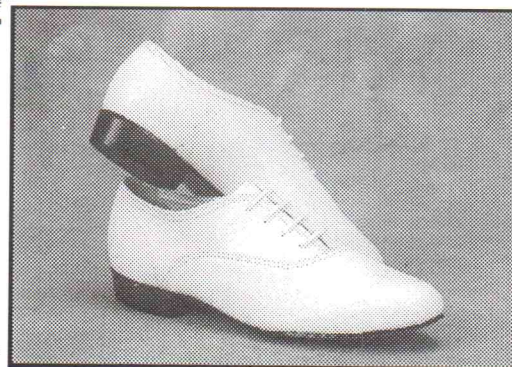
