logging is -- by nature -- a competitive artform. Even in a fun club atmosphere, dancers strive to be as good as their peers. Some have aspirations that reach beyond the exhibition team or the classroom. Even those who insist that they have no desire to enter competition must acknowledge that they are constantly being judged by their instructor, their fellow dancers and the audience.

Judging excellence in dance is so much more subjective than other sports because the adjudicators must interpret the individual styling and subtle movments of the dance that cannot be measured as precisely as we would a distance a jump or time the finish of a race.

Competition within our dance program, and within the competition circuit, provides valuable lessons that impact well beyond the dance floor. The importance of being humble, of working together and striving to be your best are all gleaned from the competitive spirit. Through personal growth you can feel a sense of pride and accomplishment in your efforts -- regardless of the results.

As a dancer who never personally excelled in competition dancing, I found that the environment nurtured me to develop my dance skills in other ways. While I could not compete skillwise with many of the younger dancers, my ability to explain steps and choreograph was often complimented. This encouragement helped me to steer my energies into teaching. Experience will show you that many of the art's best dancers are not necessarily the best teachers. Likewise, many of the best teachers are not competition level dancers.

Take the lessons to be learned from competition and apply them to your goals in clogging. From drills to strenthem your dance skills, to reading and study to better understand our art, helped to instill in your students -- and yourself -- the drive to be the best. There is a difference between competition and rivalry. Provide opportunites for your dancers that allow them to grow in a healthy and spirited environment.

Most of all, remember that you are a winner just by being involved in clogging. From mind, to body, to spirit, the dance fills us and gives us a joy that no trophy can.



Three Groups of Ohio Cloggers Join Forces for a Week of Performances and Sightseeing

Think of the challenge, the innumerable details big and small- a clogging show touring with 80 dancers- the enticing potential of traveling and performing in Austria. Imagine being a part of your 'regular' team practicing for your current and future demos. Now, add to that being a part of another group/ team planning to travel overseas... new dances to learn, new routines, extra practices... five performances, ten days.... Whether you're a dancer, instructor, helper, or the organizer/direc-

sightseeing trip. We were part of the American Celebration of Music there. Organizer/director for the tour/show (and working in conjunction with Music Celebrations International) was Lee Adams, who also is the director of the Clog 4 U and All Ohio Cloggers. Joining these two groups were the Cedar

Ohio. Their director is Jeannie

Our three buses traveled several hours on the autobahn from Munich, Germany to Austria. This gave us the opportunity to see the countryside. It was May, and while our trees and yards were turning green here in Ohio, we found Austria to be lush, green, and beautiful. (Some farmers were cutting hay.) Our first destination -- Vienna -- and our first two shows. We performed at the Vienna

Our second day in Salzburg, Austria (Day 7) saw our fourth performance. This time we were indoors at a school. They constructed a stage for us, sturdy and nice! The surface was great with plenty of room. We all had a good time with this show. Two Austrian

graph. Theater an Der Sill in Innsbruck (Day 9) was our last performance. This was a cute, little theater. We adjusted to the small stage and gave it our best.

As I reflect back, one of the striking memories was how we all adapted. With each performance, each setting, challenges and small changes presented themselves, and the groups rose to the occasion. While the dances didn't change, our presentation of walking on and off stage did, for example. Sometimes this meant reversing the lineup to (Continued on page 10)

park with lots of trees and gardens. Our good weather stayed with us during these outdoor performances (Days 3 & 4). It was hot, with lots of sun. That first performance I think we gelled as a group, because the next day held a more confident tone in our dancing. Line - Southland Express, Exhibition - Comer Cloggers and Line Formations - Southern Junction Cloggers.


Our Grand Champion Solo Female- Crystal Loftin & Solo Male Mark Clifford.

ECTA Teachers Conference in Oberreiffenberg, Germany

European Clogging Leaders Join Square and Round Dance Instructors in June Conference

The Family Relaxation Center in Oberreiffenberg provided the backdrop and facilities for the Annual Convention of the European Callers and Teachers Association (ECTA). Nestled in the Taunus mountains above Frankfurt, Germany, this year's convention for ECTA Square Dance Callers, Round Dance Cuers, Clogging Instructors, and Contra Prompters featured two internationally well known professional leaders Don Beck (Square Dance), and Jeff Driggs (Clogging) from the USA By popular request, Jeanne Conrad was invited back to present her very important seminar on Voice Training - for Everyone!

The four day training conference was opened by ECTA President Martin Kromer with the Welcome Session which expressed topics about the direction of ECTA and introduced the featured guest speakers. Challenging the ECTA callers was Don Beck, Martha's Vineyard, MA., (Continued on page 16)











Do's For Dancers

by Ed Durlacher

"When in Rome, do as the Romans do" is about the only way to describe the way square dancing should be done when visiting

other sections of the country.

If variety is the spice of life, then the many variations of figures used in squares is the reason why square dancing was, is, and will ever be popular.

There are a number of very important DO's for dancers:

DO:

Wear comfortable clothes. Wear low-heeled shoes.

Keep in step with the tempo of the music by walking rather than hopping, skipping or jumping.

Watch something on your partner's shoulder when you are swinging to avoid becoming dizzy.

Feel free at a square dance to ask those of the opposite sex to dance. This applies to the ladies as well as the gents.

Stay in the dance until the caller retires the dancers from the floor. To leave a set prior to this is an act of bad manners.

Be patient with new dancers in your set. Remember you too were a novice at some time and the other dancers had to help you.

Make sure that you take only your own allotted space on the floor so others will also have room.

Thank other couples in the set after each set of dances.

Be quiet when the instructions for the dance are being given.

Remember that you will be dancing with three or more people and that one person may spoil the fun for everyone by being ill-mannered.

As one travels from town to town, or across the country, the dances keep changing and the styles with them. The fundamentals, however, remain the same.

There are just a few things to remember when dancing away from home. These are set down as a warning for those who wish to take heed.

ALWAYS:

Take any position but First Couple.

Allow one of the home folks to tell you what to do.

Listen to the caller before it comes to your turn to lead out.

Be sure you respect the way the home folks do the dance.

Compliment them on their caller and the musicians.

One last DO for the dancer is about the most important of all . . . DO HAVE A GOOD TIME!






