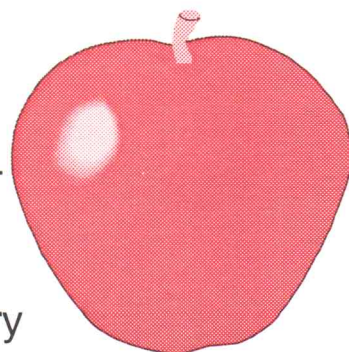

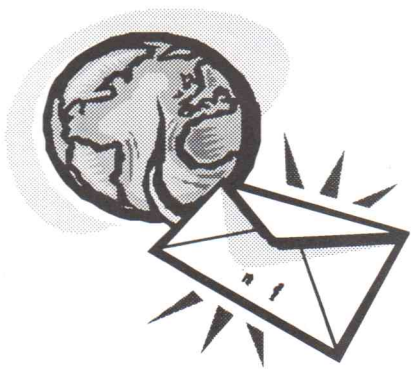

Opry History Lesson

No history of Grand Ole Opry cloggers (July issue) would be complete without including the Oxon Hill Cloggers, who first appeared on The Grand Ole Opry Float in Nixon's Second Inaugural (1969) and then went on to be the first Friday Night Opry dancers and the first Saturday matinee dancers in the history of the Opry. They performed frequently from 1969 to 1973. I have a lot of material backing up this bit of history. Interested?

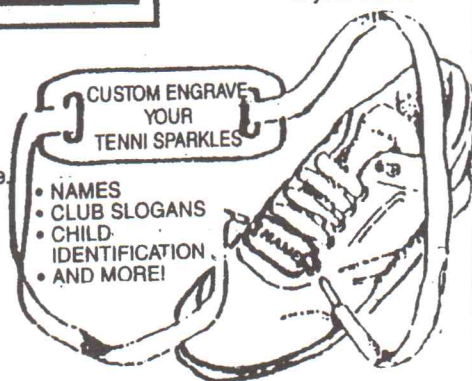

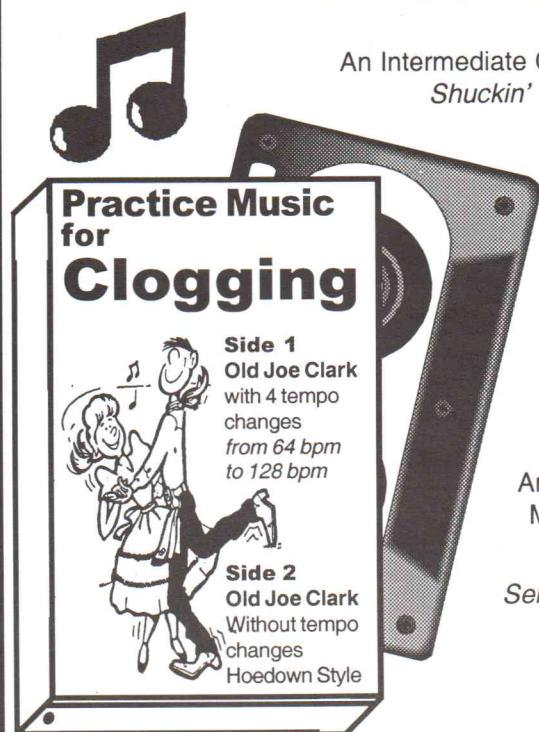

The First Lesson, The First Impression

Keeping the first night of class fun and social is key to retaining dancers and building a program

by Jeff Driggs

The first lesson is the single biggest challenge to a clogging teacher. The excitement for the dance, the fun and the fellowship that is instilled in this first effort can be the deciding factor in your dancer's choice to continue in the art form. Keeping the first lesson light, fun and social is important. Here is the outline I have used through the years in teaching beginners. I hope it will give you some ideas for your own classes.

Lesson 1

1. Welcome your students.
2. Tell a little about the class - what they will be learning.
3. Tell a little about clogging and its history.
4. Get everyone (even the spectators) out on the dancefloor. Let them make a big circle and all join hands. Do the "Countdown Dance" as a way to break the ice and get everyone acquainted.

THE COUNTDOWN DANCE

Instructions: From a big circle, all circle left. All circle right. All drop hands and go single file "Indian Style" in a circle. All join hands again and circle left. The teacher will yell out a number and dancers must huddle up in a group with that many members. When the teacher yells "FREEZE", all must stop—no new dancers taken in or stepping out. All groups with the correct number of people stay in for the next big circle and all others must step back and clap for the rest of the group. Continue for a few rounds or until there is one small group left. Congratulate the winners!

5. From the big circle, stand in the center and begin to teach, following the method outlined on the videotape.
 - a. clap hands to establish the downbeat
 - b. walk to the beat
 - c. add a kick to the step (KICK STEP, KICK STEP)
 - d. add 2 more steps (KICK STEP

STEP STEP or KICK 1 2 3)

6. Take a break while everyone is feeling good from learning this easy step.

If you'd like to, do an easy exhibition during this break to entertain the class and show them what they will be able to do as they learn.

7. Review the progression to KICK 1 2 3.

8. Congratulate everyone on having learned the groundwork for the BASIC

STEP of clogging. Encourage your students to invite their friends and family for the next class and remind them that there will be a review at the beginning of lesson two.

9. Hand out the following easy instructions for your students to review during the week, or give the students a complete "Beginners Handbook" including a brief history of clogging, lesson plans and terminology.

SAMPLE HANDOUT FOR FIRST LESSON

How to Get Started

Appalachian clogging is a rhythmic dance that accompanies the downbeat, or bass beat, of the music. Take a moment to listen to a hoedown and tap your feet or clap your hands to the downbeat of the music.

Starting with your left foot, begin stepping in place to the downbeat of the music. Don't march, just relax and step comfortably to the music as if you are a part of it. Now add a kick to your step. Keep stepping on the downbeat, but let your feet come out in front of you and kick forward before you step - like a tin soldier, but less rigid.

KICK	STEP	KICK	STEP	KICK	STEP	KICK	STEP
L	L	R	R	L	L	R	R
&	1	&	2	&	3	&	4

You're seeing this sequence as it would be written on a "Cue Sheet". A cue sheet is a diagram of the steps and timing of a step or dance. The words or abbreviations on the top line explain the foot movement, the L & R tell you on which foot you perform the movement, and the numbers along the bottom tell you on which beat of the music you will perform the step. We will learn more about cue sheets and movement notations as we go along. Cue sheets will become very important tools in remembering steps and learning new dances as you become more confident in your clogging.

Now kick forward with the left foot, then step in place three times, like the cue below describes:

KICK	STEP	STEP	STEP
L	L	R	L
&	1	&	2

It's simple, just think KICK 1, 2, 3. Kick and three steps. Remember that the first step will occur on the downbeat - or bass beat - of the music. Practice the step a few times to get the feel of it, then try KICK 1, 2, 3 on the right foot. Now alternate feet and practice with some slow music with a steady beat. KICK 1, 2, 3... KICK 1, 2, 3... Relax and feel the music.

You've just learn the beginning of the BASIC STEP of clogging!

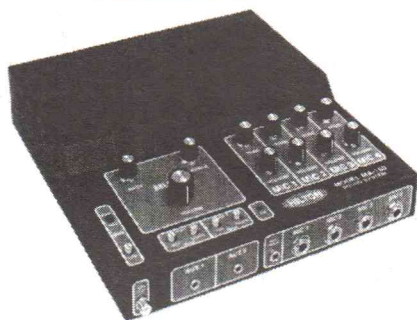

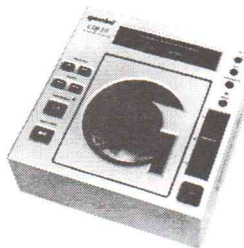

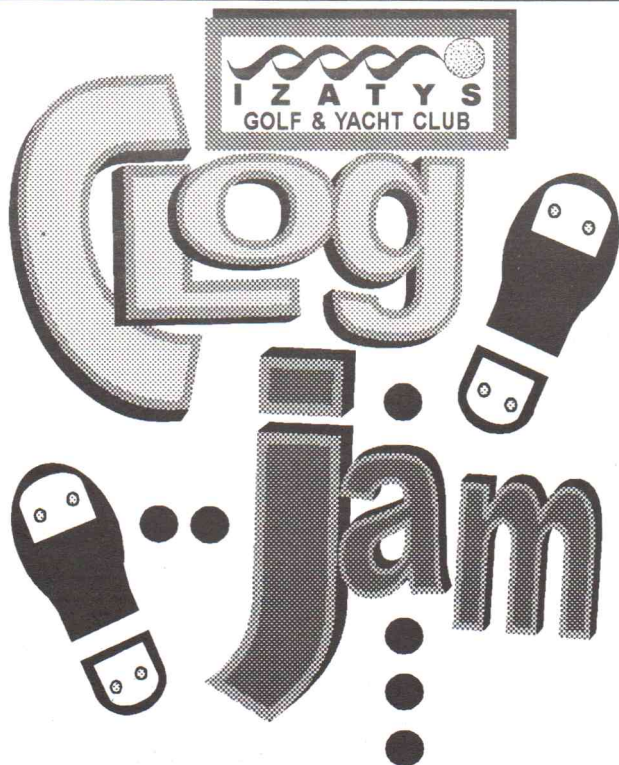

Linda then drove us to David and Ditta Dann’s home in the Blue Mountains region. This area is very beautiful and lush. We were surprised to see wild flocks of parrots and cockatoos just flying about like our native birds here at home. David and Ditta were wonderful hosts and we had a great time staying with them. They showed us the best lookouts where we were the only people around for miles. There is a three rock formation in the Blue Mountains that is called the “Three Sisters,” which we saw from every view possible (I think even David and Ditta were surprised at how much we saw in one day’s time).

On Saturday April 8th, we went back in to Sydney for a social dance to welcome me to Australia. I taught an easy routine plus went through a few other easy dances. They really love to clog and everyone had a good time. They have had clogging in Australia for around 15 years and their style is a lot like ours in the U.S.. One of the main questions we were asked by cloggers during our visit was how they compared to U.S. cloggers and we told them that we would not have known that they were not American until they spoke... ya know what I mean, mate?

Ryan and Marcie had arrived on April 9th and were staying with Jason and Leann Nicholson. Since none of us were too hip on driving on the opposite side of the car and on the opposite side of the road (plus not really knowing where we were), we did not venture into

driving ourselves. But on April 11th, Bill and I meet up with Ryan and his wife Marcie in Sydney to take a train to Canberra (where the convention was held). Canberra is the capital of Australia and is located between its two largest cities, Sydney and Melbourne. After about 4 hours on the train, we arrived in Canberra. Kathy Hedger and her committee was there to pick us up. That evening they held a wonderful traditional Australian barbecue for us that included lamb and chicken. Kathy became our “Kangaroo Hunter” verses the “Crocodile Hunter” as we ran all around Canberra chasing down kangaroos in the wild. We lived through a couple hair-raising turns at high speeds as Kathy would be driving along the highway and all of a sudden say “there’s some” and before we knew it we were turning on to a side road. It was pretty exciting... we were the “Kangaroo Hunters”!

The convention ran a lot like ours in the States, with several rooms offering different levels throughout the day. The one main addition was the morning and afternoon tea breaks. The workshop would begin at 9 a.m. and by 10:30 a.m. they would all break for tea (coffee or tea with some type of snack), then resume dancing until lunch, then come back to dancing then at 2:30 p.m. take afternoon tea and then dance until 5 p.m. After the night dance (after dinner) they would have what they call supper (which many of us might call a late night snack).

Bill and I would like to thank the Australian Clogging Association and Kathy Hedger, plus David and Ditta Dann for their hospitality and for making our trip so enjoyable.



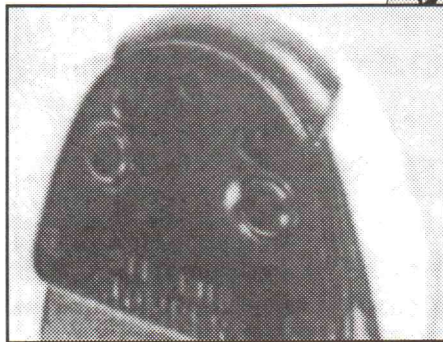

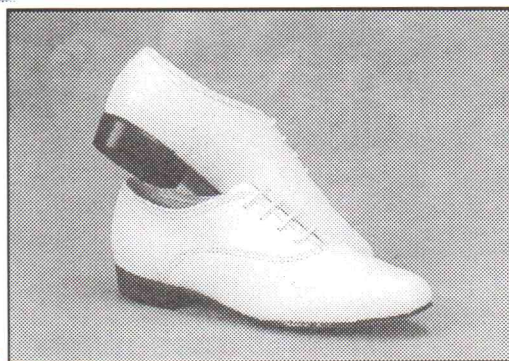

Memorial Day Dance Spectacular

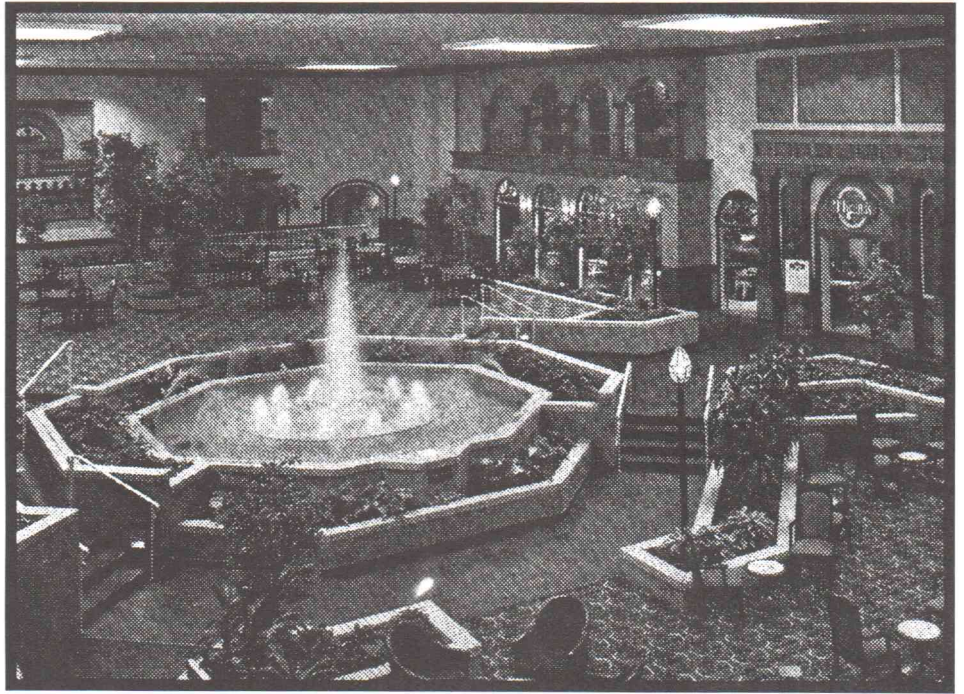
10th Annual Workshop and Competition Showcases Midwest's Finest Cloggers

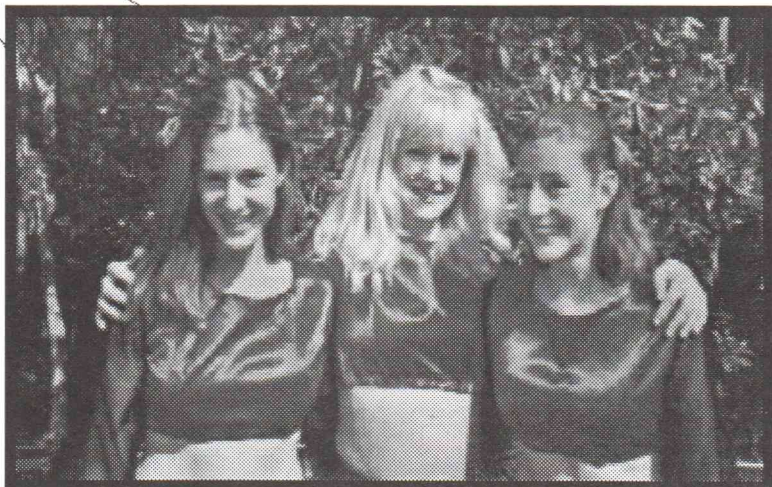
