Enjoying the Buffet



How often do you stop to realize all of the many wonderful opportunities we -- as cloggers -- get to enjoy because of this activity we love?

I jumped back in to the cycle of weekend workshops and clogging events after a restful Holiday season and found myself -- as usual -- rushing home to take care of duties before starting back to work wearily on Monday morning to do it all again the following weekend.

On this trip home from Southern Tennessee I took advantage of the opportunity to tune in WSM Radio and listen to the backstage portion of the Grand Ole Opry broadcast. My Granny was a huge country music fan. Her tastes ran from George Jones and Loretta Lynn to country music rebels like Johnny Cash. I gained from her an appreciation of both old and new country and always admired the Opry's efforts to present the best of both. This January broadcast was special. In honor of the Opry's 75th Anniversary, the program was being broadcast from the historic Ryman Auditorium, the Opry's home from 1943 to 1974.

While driving up I-75 I listened to Ricky Skaggs talk about the magic of the place and the emotions he felt standing on the stage where the pioneers of his art spread their musical wings. Ricky was joined on the air by Melvin Sloan, a Grand Ole Opry member and leader of the Melvin Sloan Dancers. Melvin's family has clogged on the Opry for decades, and he, too, shared his sense of awe and reverence at returning to perform at the Ryman.

What timing. With less than half an hour before show time, I found myself coming into the Nashville City limits. My mind fought with itself. "You have to get home," I told myself, "you have six more hours to drive." "But...", I answered in my head, "When will you get the chance to see the Grand Ole Opry at its original home?"

My car took an exit into downtown, and I found myself caught in ballgame traffic. The clock ticked away and I began convincing myself that I had made a huge mistake. I turned left to get out of the traffic log jam and cut up a sidestreet to find a way back out of town. The road I was on dead-ended and I found myself staring up at the mother church of country music, the Ryman Auditorium. The car behind me honked its horn to keep me moving and I turned into the lot to let them pass. An attendant in an orange vest waved me forward and pointed to an open spot not 25 feet from the door.

I grabbed my coat and ran in to the ticket stand. With ticket in hand I went into the Auditorium, now packed with people. The lights dimmed and I was in the dark back foyer. An attendant with a flashlight offered her assistance and we discovered that my seat was obstructed by a television camera. "Are you alone?" she asked. I followed her quietly down the center aisle as country music legend Porter Wagner came onstage and flashed his signature jacket to the crowd in welcome. "Take this seat, honey," the attendant offered and I sat down on the aisle of the fourth row, looking up at the stage filled with musicians, props, sequins and onlookers who had packed the wings to be a part of this nostalgic night.

Patrick Dennis, who wrote of his eccentric "Auntie Mame" said that life was a buffet and most poor souls (sic) are starving to death. This night I had treated myself to a trip that brought back memories of childhood and reminded me how lucky I am to do what I do. Seeing icons Earl Scruggs, Ricky Skaggs, Marty Stuart, Joe Diffie and Del McCoury join together onstage to honor Scruggs lifetime of music was magical. Seeing the crowd's thunderous reaction to the Melvin Sloan dancers made me proud to be a clogger, and hearing Vince Gill, Brad Paisley and the Opry's stars humbled to perform in this hallowed hall made me want the evening to never end.

Let your clogging travels be windows of opportunity to savor the many wonders around us. You will find the rewards to be a buffet of memories to keep for a lifetime. Happy Clogging,

The performance features the highly-acclaimed Maryland percussive dance company, *Footworks*, and Nashville’s Grammy-award nominated recording artist, *Tim O’Brien* with some of the leading lights of the kish and traditional American music scene, including Darrell Scott, Liz Carroll, Dirk Powell and Mark Schatz.

O’Brien’s 1999 recording *The Crossing* was inspired by tales of his Irish great-grandfather and tells the poignant story of Scots-kish immigration to Appalachia and throughout America, as well as O’Brien’s own journey back to Ireland.

Footworks Artistic Director Eileen Carson, choreographer for the project, was inspired by the beauty and integrity of the songs found on *The Crossing*. “The collaboration between our company and Tim O’Brien is a natural outgrowth of the themes of immigration and the connections between traditional music and dance that Footworks has always explored,” she said.

For twenty-one years, Footworks has been a pioneer

in bringing traditional dance to stages around the world. With roots in Appalachian clogging and string band music, the group has

been constantly influenced by international travels and folk festivals, and has welcomed a diverse group of dancers from different backgrounds who are comfortable presenting Irish and Canadian stepdance, tap, modern, South African and African American collegiate stepping with a high level of skill and energy. “‘The

Crossing’ is about the


experience of the kish, but I like to think of it as an immigrant story,” Carson said. “It’s like the Footworks show has always been — an American story. It’s not specific to any one culture.”

A full-time company since 1979, Footworks has delighted audiences of all ages and cultures in the United States, Canada, the United Kingdom and Japan. Most recently, Footworks thrilled audiences as guest artists in the London run of the hit show *Riverdance* and sold out its own five week tour of the UK a few months later. Footworks also drew

rave reviews on a tour sponsored by the Smithsonian Institution as one of eight groups chosen to represent

American culture in Japan. The group is delighted by the tremendous accomplishment of their artistic director, Eileen Carson, who received a two year National Endowment for the Arts Choreography Fellowship in 1994 for her creative, original work. This achievement was over twenty years in the making.

The roots of Footworks are planted deep. The year 1971 saw the formation of the Green Grass Cloggers whose love of traditional dance and music inspired them to seek out and learn from the old-time buck dancers and flatfooters of North Carolina, Virginia, and Tennessee. This group is noted for popularizing traditional Appalachian clogging, and was one of the first teams to carry the form from competition stages to performing arts venues. In 1979, three of these dancers, one of whom was Eileen Carson, went on to form The Fiddle Puppet Dancers.

The Fiddle Puppet Dancers, who changed their name to Footworks in 1994, have become renowned for respecting the integrity of traditional dance while staging it to meet professional performance standards. In search of the origins and relatives of their first love, Southern Appalachian clogging and flatfooting, Footworks went on to study with masters of many forms of traditional percussive dance, including Irish, Scottish, English, Canadian, African and African American. Footworks' performances at international festivals across North America and the United Kingdom brought them exposure to and collaboration with performers from many cultures. This resulted in their unique theatre productions presented in such venues as The Kennedy Center, The Lincoln Center, and The Glasgow Royal Concert Hall.

Today, Footworks remains true to the traditions of Southern Appalachian music and dance while celebrating all the connecting roots and branches. The company is dedicated to bringing live music and the power and joy of percussive dance to audiences the world over.

As a musical production, *The Crossing* has toured concert halls and major folk festivals across North America and the U.K. since the CD was released two years ago. Tim O'Brien, known as both "Ameri-

cana singer-songwriter" and "bluegrass multi-instrumentalist", was the co-founder and lead vocalist of Ilot Rize and Red Knuckles and the Trailblazers. His 1996 album *Red on Blonde* received a Grammy nomination and his original songs have been recorded by Kathy Matea, the Seldom Scene, New Grass Revival, Garth Brooks & Laurie Lewis.

The dance premiere of *The Crossing* is made possible by a New Initiative grant from the Maryland State Arts Council and the support of Chesapeake Center for the Creative Arts, a new, 904-seat theatre located between Baltimore and Washington. The performance is scheduled for 8 p.m. on March 3, with tickets now available through the box office (410-636-6597) at \$28-30.





INTRODUCING AMERICAN CLOGGING TO CHINA

During the Spring of 1999, I was privileged to be the first person to teach American clogging in the People's Republic of China. On April 14, after a 20-hour trip, I landed in Guangzhou (formerly Canton), in the Guangdong province of southern China.

I was graciously met at the airport with flowers and an entourage of teachers and administrators, including a translator, from the Guangdong Dance Academy. This Academy has 300 students from throughout the country with almost 100 faculty. I was quickly swept from the airport and taken for a breakfast of chrysanthemum tea, chicken feet and other exotic entrees.

Although this was my third trip to Guangzhou in ten years, in many ways it was a first-time experience: It was my first invitation to teach for the Academy, I was completely alone for the entire month instead of being with my BYU group, and I was teaching Appalachian Clogging to Chinese dance students. There was an added challenge: to prepare a choreography to be performed two months later for the school's 40th anniversary. During my stay, I lived at the school among the students and faculty. Qin Xing, a talented member of the dance faculty, was my constant companion and became a good friend although he speaks little English and I speak no Mandarin.

I was provided a translator for every class period, but outside the classroom I was on my own. The vocabulary that I learned the quickest had to do with eating and teaching. Cantonese is the regional dialect for the area, with Mandarin spoken in the schools. Tones add an additional degree of difficulty to the language. *Mi fan* (rice), *do-chao* (green beans), *yu* (steamed fish), and

hang cha (cool tea used to lower the fire in my body), were words soon common to meal-times.

Previous experience of observing Frantisek Bonus, Czech dance master, teaching with barely a spoken word inspired my own teaching in China. Demonstration was my greatest tool. The students were bright, and quick learners. The command *Yu bei!* (prepare, or ready), and 5,6,7,8 were the phrases I most used in the classroom. My students and I soon became quite efficient in communicating with one another.

Before a clogging choreography could be realized, my students first needed to learn basics. Clogging is a language filled with new vocabulary for any dancer. To be accomplished takes time, and hours of practice, and time was scarce. Knowing this, a teaching video had been sent before my arrival.

Working with the students was a pure delight. Smiling faces of dancers between the ages of 15 and 18, greeting me every single day. An over-enthusiastic schedule comprised of three 2 1/2 hour classes per day was quickly revised to 1 1/2 hours per class. My biggest challenge in the classroom was the acoustics, with only a boombox for music. The noisy shoes drowning out the music made the situation even worse. My only recourse was to teach steps without music for the first 2 1/2 weeks. I occasionally had the students dance in stocking feet so we could hear the music.

Finally, a few days before we premiered our pieces for the school, I was provided with an adequate sound system. Unfortunately, this allowed the students only a very short time to practice, and it was at first difficult for them to match their sounds correctly to the music. Beginning, or entering a musical phrase with a clog basic counted "and-a-one"

proved challenging for the students, but most quickly mastered it. Clearly, it is important to introduce music quickly in to the teaching experience. Teaching without it compromises the joy of the movement and hinders the student's ability to understand the musical phrasing.

Regardless of the challenges of time, language and music, I was able to teach many basics, including drag-slides or chugs, that separates the unique American style from other forms of step dance. I also rehearsed many combinations of double-toes or shuffles, attributed mainly

to our English ancestry. In the end, a work was completed involving two pieces: an Appalachian clog, and a Running Set and Big Set. Both were successfully performed in concert on July 25, 1999, in Guangzhou, and I heard it was a tremendous success.

Ed Austin is the artistic director of the International Folk Dance Ensemble at Brigham Young University where he has served as a member of the dance faculty since 1984. This opportunity was made possible through the work and efforts of Sara Lee Gibb, Dance Department Chair, Brigham Young University.




