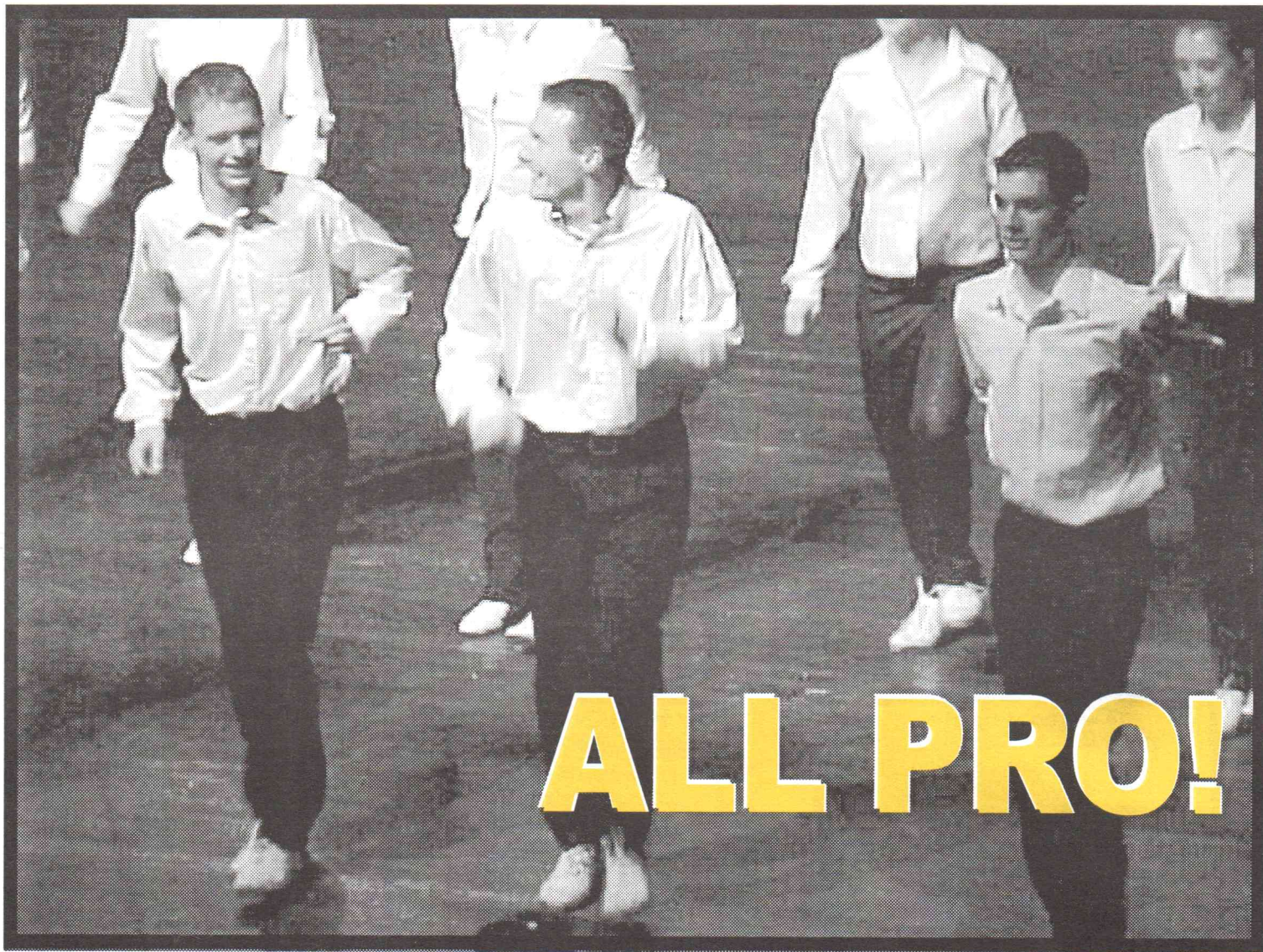

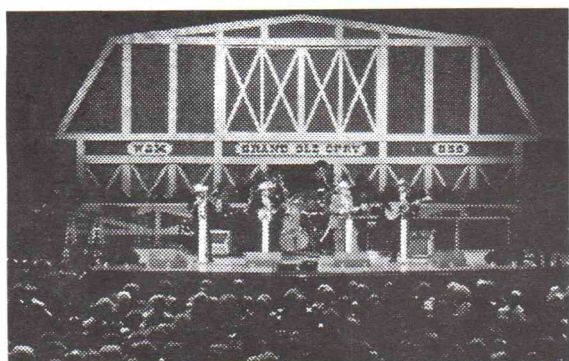

On a recent airline flight home from a clogging workshop, the in-flight movie was "Billy Elliott", Stephen Daldry's academy award nominated movie from last year about a young boy from an English mining town that gives up boxing in favor of dancing.

The movie lived up to all of it's publicity. Jamie Bell was extraordinary as Billy, showing vulnerability, depth and amazing talent. The dance sequences showcased a mixture of percussive dance, jazz, movement and ballet that was electric. Expecting a Flashdance-like story about an unlikely dancer struggling to make it in a classical world, I was surprised to find the movie's story about family touched me very deeply.

In the height of the mine strike, Billy's widowed father and tough as nails brother will not stand to see their little Billy involved in something as unmanly as ballet. It's not until the father catches Billy practicing and the boy performs a dance of defiance that he sees the depth of the boy's talent. The father spends the remainder of the film working to give his son the chance to follow his dream.

I think of my own family and the sacrifices they have made for me and my five brothers. I see the families that come to clogging workshops and competitions, and watch parents of modest means who spend more for their children's clogging costumes than they spend on their own wardrobe. I've seen families at workshops who gather outside with picnic lunches of homemade sandwiches while groups pile into vans to head to the nearest restaurants.

Dance is a privilege. It's a gift that were are given and that we also give. Take the time to thank those who not only gave you the gift of dance, but those who worked to give you the time to let your feet dance and the freedom to let your heart dance.

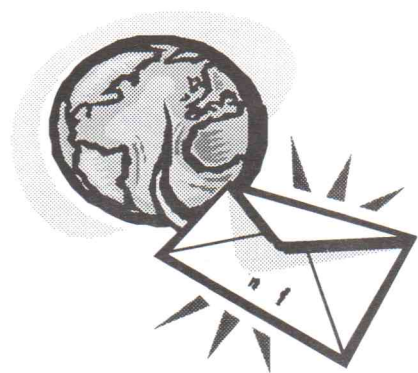

We drove four hours to get to the performance and it was worth every minute of the drive. I would encourage your readers to find out if they are going to be anywhere near and make the effort to attend.

Back in January 2001 Heidi Kulas, a dancer from Footworks, came to our barn in Michigan with her mom-Rose Lee, and her grandmother Betty Updike. Footworks is a crack percussion dance ensemble from the State of Maryland. Dancing by invitation in the show Riverdance, performing in Europe, Japan, Canada and all over America to their own band, they bring the audiences to their feet wherever they go. This was not the first time Heidi has been at The THUNDER FLOOR CLOGGERS barn here in Lake Odessa. She comes here at least a couple of times a year to dance with us. Her Grandmother

dances every week in a couple of classes. It is open arms time whenever Heidi is here. Everyone likes it when she arrives at our door. She told us that a Footworks show was afoot. No play on words here. At that time she thought it might be in the Community Center at Greenville, MI. I called the man at the Community Center about tickets. At that time they didn't even know how much they were going to be. He said for me to call back in about a month. I got to work and started to spread the word that there was going to be a show. I called somewhere around February 1st but Gregg still didn't know much to tell me. I called a couple of weeks later and found that it was going to be in the high school auditorium. I really started to talk then. We were really excited when we knew the tickets were only 10.00 a piece instead of the usual 30.00.

The date finally arrived for the show. Sunday night March 11th 2001. Footworks had already put on four two hour shows up at Petosky, MI for their Arts Commission that weekend. My wife Lynda and I had brought one of our clogging grandsons with us who is 7 years old. My grandson Kody, who incidentally is named after William Bill Cody, sat on my wife's right. My mother, Alvina Warner, who is 88 and a young woman, sat on Lynda's left and I sat on my mother's left. On my left was one of our young students, Shekinah Reser, who is 11 years old. When the show started these two youngsters were on the edge of their chairs. And their eyes never

left the stage all during the performance. There was a sell out. There were 700 seats in all and not a bad seat in the auditorium. We were instrumental in getting over 100 people to that show and they knew we were there. The majority of us sat on the left of center. The Gull Creek Cloggers of Richland, MI, the Corn Cob Cloggers of Grand Ledge, MI, and The THUNDER FLOOR CLOGGERS, based in Lake Odessa, MI were extremely happy and honored to be able to see this ensemble perform.

It was all about American step dance — English, Irish and Scottish roots. Clogging barefoot, English clog, clogging in big farmer boots, hand juba, flatfoot with taps, flatfoot without taps, sneaker clog, jigs, Appalachian squares, buck and Canadian step dance (notice the e?, there is a difference you know), a tribute to the Cherokee, sword dancing, Irish soft and hard shoe, modern clogging, Maureen Berry doing a modern dance in a beautiful flowing red dress, and a crazy plastic bottle percussion challenge by Hiedi Kulas and Eileen Carson, one of the founders of The FIDDLE PUPPET DANCERS whose group performing name was changed to Footworks in 1994.

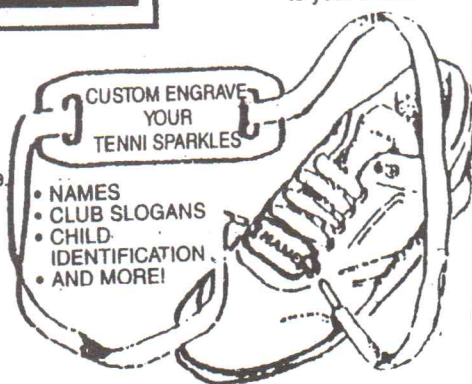
The band was terrific. Playing bluegrass and old time were Mark Shatz on banjo, stand up base, and mandolin and dancer; Jon Glik on fiddle; Sheridan Minnick of Delaware on Guitar. These musicians are top notch. It is so wonderful to hear mature music instead of the

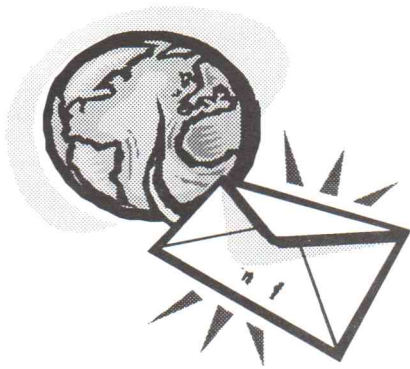

The first time I recall meeting Sherry and her family was at my workshop that I organized at Clinch Valley College in 1982 called the CLOG CAMPUS. I was an employee of the college and I still remember getting the dance registrations from them -- all of them -- Terry, JoAnne, Melissa, Sherry and Shannon. They called themselves the *No Name Now Cloggers* and I was thrilled to have them attend.

Terry brought a video camera and was a big help to our workshop in providing the videography for the workshop itself. They attended our CLOG CAMPUS workshop for several years after that and met other instructors who were still "budding" at that time such as Nancy Bradley Riddle from NC and Barry Fayne also from Va. As I have been involved in clogging for nearly 25 years and watched Sherry grow and succeed in the world of clogging, her accomplishments make me VERY proud that I have met her and her family, and perhaps, in some small way, helped her on her way to her championship in her early years. The family has supported most of my clogging endeavors through both attending

and instructing at my workshop which changed to the Sugarcane Mountain Dance Workshop in 1993. My troupe, the Virginia Sugarcane Cloggers, have also reciprocated a few times by "scratching Sherry's back" with performances at the Heritage Days Festival in Rogersville, Tn. I can say that over the years, each time we meet somewhere, Sherry and the entire family have always greeted me in the same friendly and familiar way as old friends do. I consider Sherry and the entire Glass family genuine friends who go way back together in clogging, and I can only say to Sherry, "God has given you a born talent and has blessed you with great health to enjoy this wonderful dance of our heritage. You're not getting older, just better!" Way to go, girl!

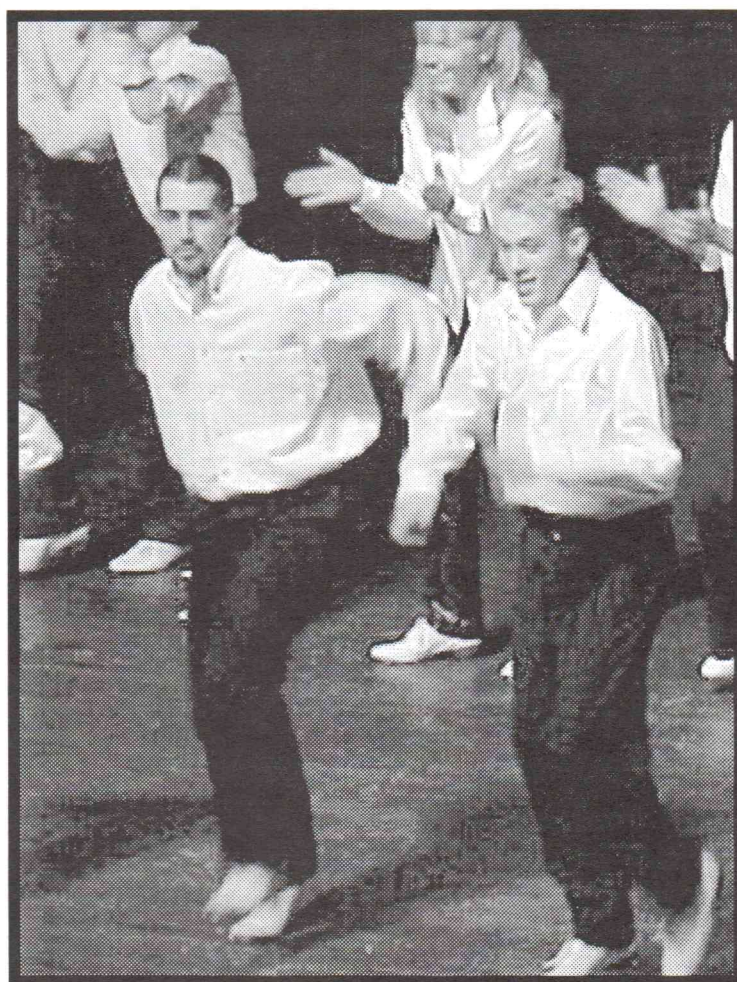

America's Clogging Hall of Fame Honors Three Dance Leaders by Induction into Hall of Fame in Maggie Valley, North Carolina

The America's Clogging Hall of Fame organization inducted three new members to its prestigious ranks during its annual Grand Championships on October 28 and 29th, 2000 at the world famous Stompin' Ground in Maggie Valley North Carolina.

Hundreds of dancers from across the United States attended the two day festival crowning the grand champions from the year's qualifying competitions, recognizing new inductees into the Hall of Fame, and offering many other awards, scholarships and prizes.

The A.C.H.F. is proud to welcome the following new members to the America's Clogging Hall of Fame:

Ellis and Audrey Perry

The first and second persons inducted into the Hall of Fame in October were presented together. In fact, they are together everywhere. They are a clogging couple who travel all over the country thanks to the dance; it

seems they love it. Even when they are not involved in a festival or a competition they still love traveling -- especially to Myrtle Beach and to Las Vegas.

Audrey Perry was born in Buncombe County, North Carolina and Ellis Perry was born in Franklin County, North Carolina. From there it was on to western square dancing in the 60's and a clogging team in the 70's. The Click 'n' Cloggers was their team then and they still dance with a group they co-founded, the Carolina Heartland Cloggers. During their years of clogging Audrey has been Treasurer of the National Clogging and Hoedown Council, and has taught smooth dance at the C.L.O.G. national convention. Both Ellis and Audrey are certified judges and work very closely with the Folk Festival at the NC State Fair. And now after retirement, they still teach clogging in a dance studio.

Through all of these years being busy with clogging, this couple has had time to be married for 46 years, have two wonderful children: a son Van, and a daughter Kim, who is providing them with a grandchild very soon. Also they have a very special cat named Dodger who sometimes accompanies them on the road.

Their induction into the Hall of Fame marks another high point in lives dedicated to preserving our great clog dance heritage.

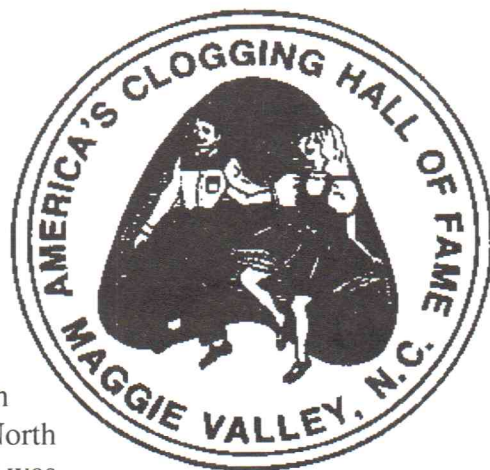
Evelyn Hope Smith
