





## **Grand Island Festival Offers Great Workshops and Spectacular Show**







## **Anna Wells - Flatfoot Champion**

## Virginia Woman Wins Honor at America's Cloggin Hall of Fame Spring Workshop

by Ray Wells - Norton, Virginia

The Stompin' Grounds in Maggie Valley, North Carolina, during the weekend of April 27-28, 2001, was the place to be if you clog dance, flat foot, line dance, square dance or any other style of mountain dance. The Stompin' Grounds is the home of the American Clogging Hall of Fame. We have been attending this workshop for a few years and we feel it

is one of the few workshops which promotes and teaches the true and original old-time dance.

Anna Wells is a seasoned clogger and flatfooter. She flatfooted growing up at home in the 50's to the music of her parents before she learned to clog. Over the years she has worked hard helping others and watching others flatfloot dance. She has taught thousands her personal flatfoot style as well as clogging.

Growing up in the mountains of southwestern Virginia, Anna learned a lot while listening and dancing to the tunes of her father, Vilas Williams, who was an accomplished guitar and banjo player. Her mother Ella, was also an adept musician and dancer, often backing Anna's dad with flattop rhythm guitar. She was known to "hit a few old-time Charleston steps" with Anna and her two older sisters while working around the house. I guess this could explain one reason why Anna has grown up with "music in her soul and bones."

As she often comments, "I was a baby boomer, listening and dancing to the music of Elvis, Ricky Nelson,

Fabian, and the Beatles, while my Dad played his old-time and bluegrass music. As I grew older, I began to pay attention to Daddy's music and my feet began to tap to the old time sound. I guess somewhere in all this I realized that it was a part of my heritage that became important to me."

In 1977 her family became involved in the community hosting weekend music jam sessions at a local log cabin. It was here that she found that the music and dance complemented one another. She and a neighbor girlfriend found a teacher who gave them their first lessons in mountain-style square dancing and clogging. They found a clogging work-

shop in Fontana Village, NC, where they were well on their way to becoming contagiously afflicted with this disease called, "clogging."

Many changes have been made through the 24 1/2 years in which Anna has been dancing traditional Appalachian dance. Her original girlfriend partner left shortly after they started the Virginia Sugarcane Cloggers in Norton, but Anna continued to teach and perform the traditional Appala-

chian mountain style dance. In 1983, Anna entered her first and last clogging competition with her clog team, the Virginia Sugarcane Cloggers, in the Universal Clog Championships held at Fontana Village, NC. Their efforts brought home 7 second-place trophies - 6 for duets and 1 for the team. She says that, although it was very exciting, it was so stressful that it takes the fun out of dancing, so she does not enter team competition any more. However, solo competitions are a little different.

This year was her second year to enter the solo flatfoot competitions in Maggie Valley, NC. Last year, she competed and came in second overall in the flatfoot competition. This year, she decided to try again, and won the grand prize, the 2001 American Clogging Hall of Fame Flatfoot Championship. What a thrill and honor after having been in the dance for nearly 25 years. This was her first BIG trophy, and "it feels good", she says. Anna says of her winning experience, "I

really did not allow myself to think of competing with others or trying to out-dance them - when I hear good, flat foot music, I just allow the music to move me and listen to the rhythmic patterns to which I can move my feet. I don't think of any "steps" that I want to do or have anything "choreographed" or "memorized".

I believe dancing to the rhythm of the music is a natural, God-given talent, and I credit my talents to the Lord. I teach my students a simple logo which applies perfectly to flat-footers and free-stylers. It says, "music creates spirit, and spirit makes the feet move."



## Dos and don'ts for vocal performers

The following dos and don'ts were prepared by two New York speech/language pathologists, Lynda A. Marvin and Shirley Tennyson, for the New York area speech recognition users group. Dr. Marvin noted in addressing the group, which is part of the NYPC users group, that professional voice users and need to take care of their voices just as actors, singers and other vocal performers do.

## Don't

Don't yell, scream, shout, laugh (or weep) raucously.

Don't clear throat or cough violently and repeatedly.

Don't compete vocally with loud background noise of any kind, including traffic, planes, trains, music, TV, loud conversation.

Don't speak for prolonged periods outside of your comfortable pitch and loudness range.

Don't make odd vocal sounds, such as imitating machinery, animal noises, "funny" voices.

Don't use a "stage whisper" to save your voice.

Don't use your voice unnecessarily when suffering from upper respiratory illness or extreme fatigue.

Don't smoke anything!

Don't linger in dusty, smoky or fume-filled areas.

Don't take over-the-counter antihistamines, decongestants or aspirin before professional voice use without consulting your physician.

Don't use heavily mentholated throat lozenges (glycerine is preferable).

Don't hold your breath or grunt while engaging in strenuous activity such as lifting, pushing, pulling.

Don't eat a heavy or spicy meal shortly before retiring.

## Do

Do use your voice sparingly, especially on days of heavy rehearsal or performance.

Do cool your voice down after performance or heavy use.

Do get adequate rest, nutrition and exercise even (and especially) when traveling or on tour.

Do drink plenty of fluids, particularly water, before and during professional voice use.

Do limit your intake of caffeine and avoid alcohol when rehearsing or performing.

Do humidify your environment.

Do maintain good posture and learn to detect and release excessive tension in face, throat, neck and shoulder muscles as you speak (check out your telephone posture, too).

Do, when speaking, replenish your breath often enough so that you are not straining by the end of a phrase.

Do use legato (connected) speech: learn to speak smoothly without hard onset of vowels and link your words together as in singing.

Do vary speech rate and inflection (pauses) rather than increasing loudness to gain and hold attention.

*Do*, if possible, use nonverbal "attention getters" like waving, clapping, tapping someone, etc., rather than your voice.

Do become a better listener; encourage others to speak and increase your ratio of listening to talking.

Do, when listening, keep your teeth slightly separated, with a slight lip opening, and avoid extending neck and jaw.


Do attend to emotional problems that cause tension and anxiety.

Do seek appropriate professional help for problems that threaten your vocal health.




