

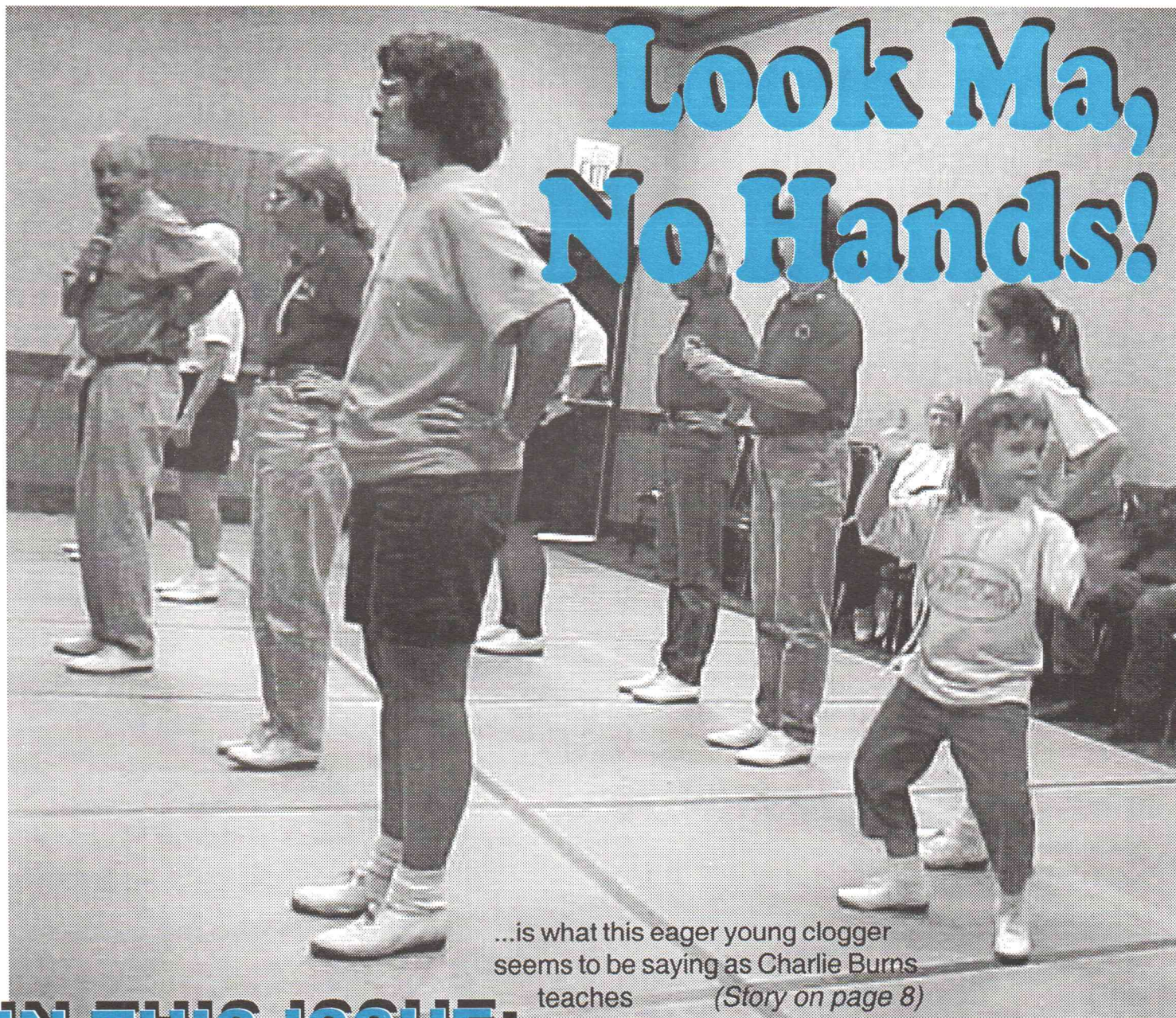

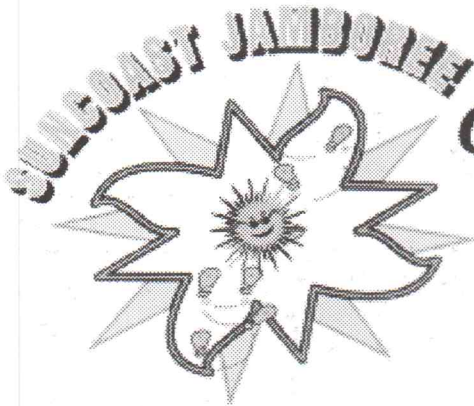

FRONT AND CENTER

Class Warfare...



It's that time of year again... time for Fall classes to begin. After a long vacation from nightly teaching to devote more time to my business, I am joining many of you in the task of preparing for a set of classes.

That's where the battle begins. What do I teach? Who will come? How many classes am I prepared to undertake, and is it fair to start teaching again knowing that I may once again find that I do not want to be tied down on every week-night. "You've been through burnout before," that little voice inside my head tells me. "What makes you think this time will be any different?"

I started my first clogging classes at an auction barn near Winfield, WV back in 1982. I was dancing with a local traditional team and spending every Saturday night at the bluegrass barn freestyling and old-time square dancing for hours. Each week after college classes, I loaded up the car to teach my public classes. Every Monday, Tuesday and Thursday I taught private lessons in the small studio I had made in my parents workshop. For more than 10 years I taught 12 classes a week, on four nights a week. By the late 1980's, every Friday I was packing up the car to head off to teach a workshop or heading to the airport, and every Monday morning I hurt getting out of bed to do it all again. Somewhere, I managed to squeeze a 40 hour work week in with jobs ranging from Advertising Manager for a Senator to a charity fund-raiser.

When burn out came, it hit hard. I dropped all of my classes and diverted the students to area clubs or teams. Most of my private students moved on to compete or teach on their own. I pledged then that I would never find myself in that position again. So why, after almost a ten year lapse for daily classes would I jump back into a series of clogging classes?

The answer is simple... I miss teaching. Workshops aren't the same as that feeling that comes from seeing a dancer do their first drag-slide. I miss the lessons I learn from being around people who are discovering the magic of clogging that I first felt 20 years ago. It would be noble to say that I want to teach this class for what it offers others. But this time around, I am teaching for what it offers me... a moment of grace.

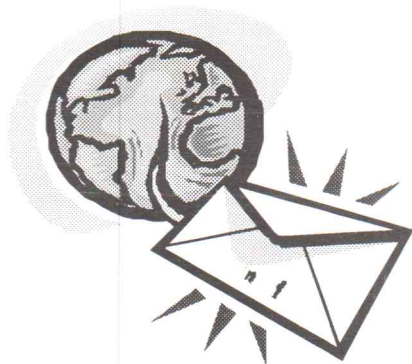

CLOGGERS ON A MISSION
Bob and Lynda Warner, instructors and directors of The THUNDER FLOOR CLOGGERS based in Lake Odessa, MI have a mission in mind. For almost nine months they have been working on fund raisers to build a portable stage. It all started with a workshop type endeavor called The 1st Annual Mid-Winter Hot Dog Clog Hog in

Lake Odessa last January. This was open for the public to enjoy the American Step Dance and included cloggers from 33 communities in mid Michigan. They plan on having the 2nd Annual Mid-Winter Hot Dog Clog Hog this January 12-13th. The event has been opened to teams from other states besides the public. It will also include a dance on Saturday night to live music, a sleep over that night and breakfast on Sunday morning with a gospel sing-a-long.

Bob remarked that he believes the saying of the Romans of old is still true today. "When a man acts with confidence and action, the gods join in." Bob also points out that scripture calls humans 'gods'. This philosophy unmistakably is what drives him on with that confidence and faith in his Creator and Sustainer.

"I guess I do have faith", Bob said, "but it is not of myself. I do not have it myself. Every step in this mission of ours has been laid out before us. 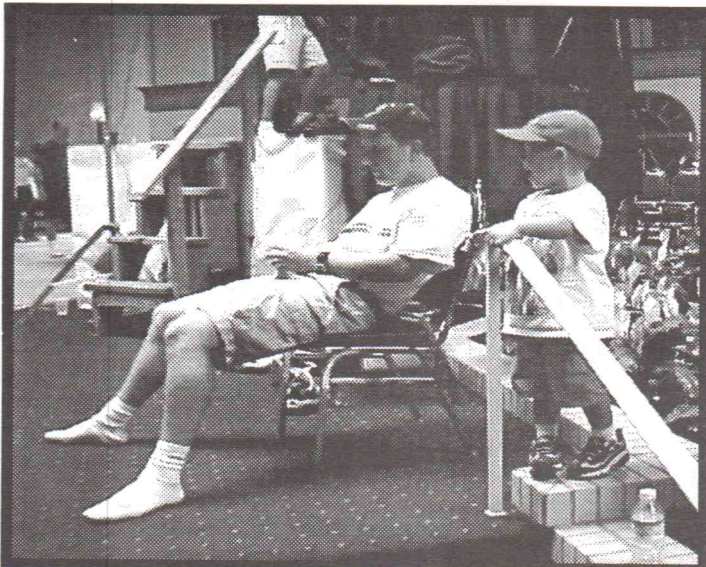

Angels Among Us

Club Members Can be a Valuable Teaching Tool

Reprinted and edited from the September 1993 *Times Squared*, the newsletter of the Times Squares Square Dance Club.

Is your halo on straight? (You should excuse the expression.) It is important that as many of our club members as possible come to the Beginner class as "angels". What are angels? They are the wonderful people who volunteer their time to ensure that a class has the best possible learning experience.

Angels provide the new class members with their first real look at the club (since class members don't generally see the instructor as a club member until after graduation). How angels behave and treat the new dancers, other angels, and visitors will affect class members' decisions whether or not to join our club. Angels are also role models. No matter what the instructor and club try to communicate to the students concerning etiquette, attitudes, or styling, class members inevitably take their cues from what they see the angels doing. So it is important that angels be extra careful to provide good role models. Smile, be enthusiastic, and enjoy the dancing. Be friendly, courteous, and gentle. This is sometimes easier to say than to do, especially if it has been a long day. And, let's be honest, some of us have personal agendas, perhaps

disagreements with club policies or less-than-cordial relations with specific club members, that are out of place here and must be put aside.

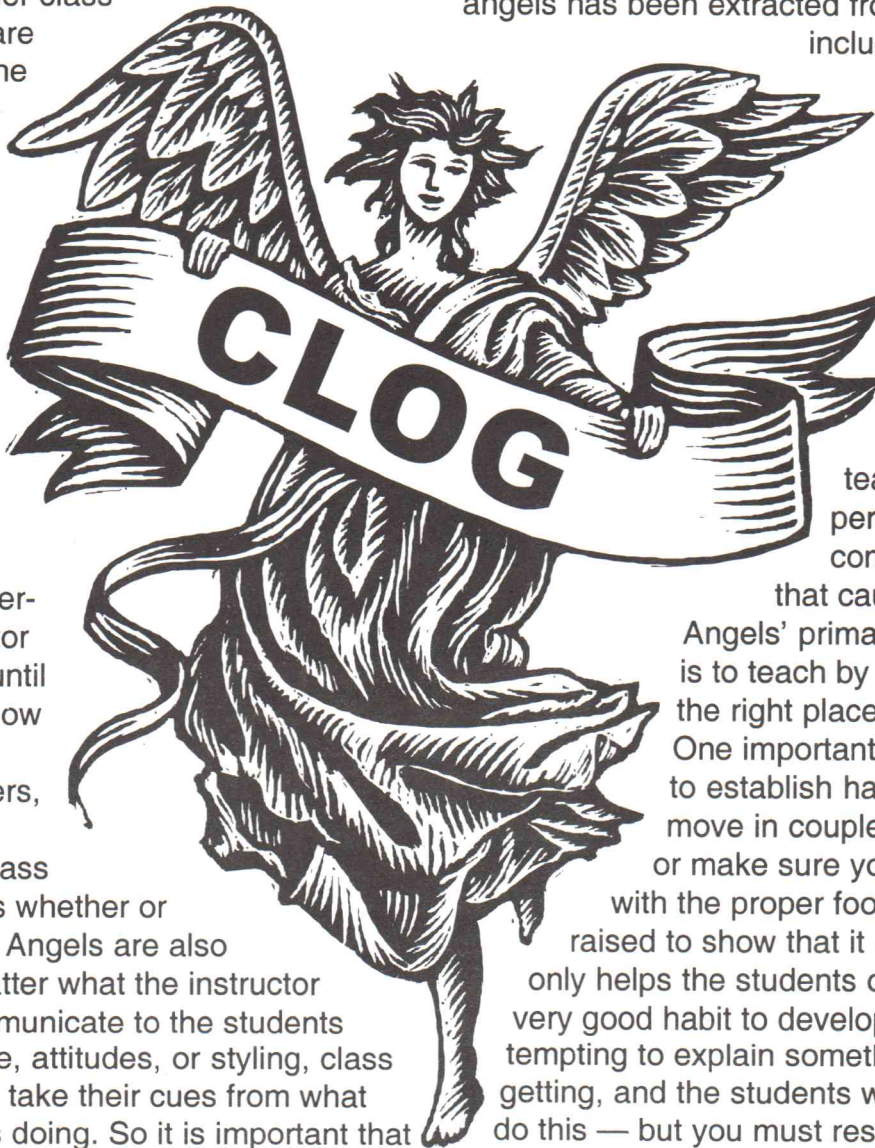
Although most of us do the right things instinctively, at least most of the time, it can't hurt to reiterate certain points. The following advice for angels has been extracted from several sources, including articles in

dance magazines and handouts prepared for other clubs. Thanks go to Betsy Gotta and Nick Martellacci for providing some of these articles.

Angels are not teachers. This is perhaps the most common misconception that causes problems.

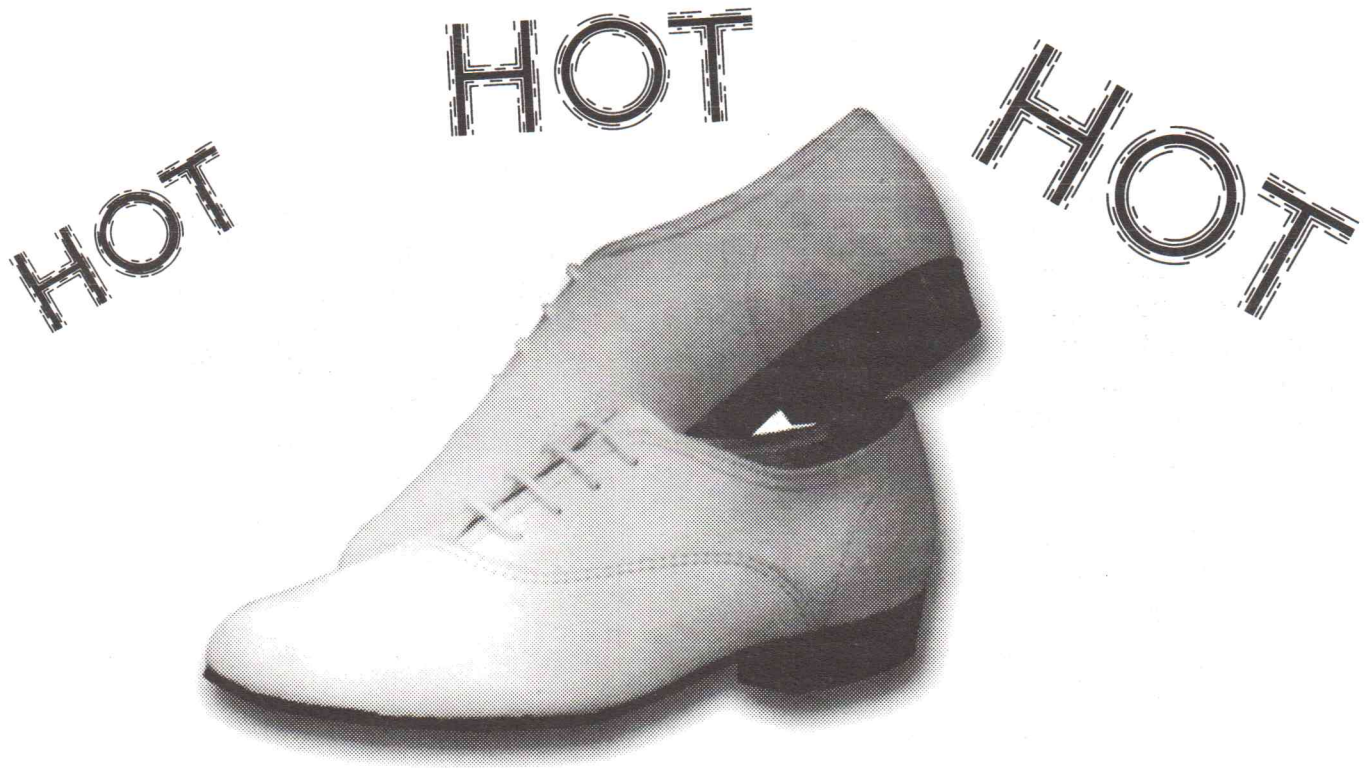
Angels' primary teaching function is to teach by example — to be in the right place at the right time. One important thing you can do is to establish hand-holds after every move in coupled or circle dances or make sure you are facing front with the proper foot free and the heel raised to show that it is ready. This not only helps the students on the floor, it is a very good habit to develop. It is always tempting to explain something others are not getting, and the students will often ask you to do this — but you must resist. It diverts the students' attention from the teacher, and one of the most important things to learn in beginner class is to listen to the teacher/caller. Sometimes you can clarify a simple point for students between teaching sessions; this is fine, but not

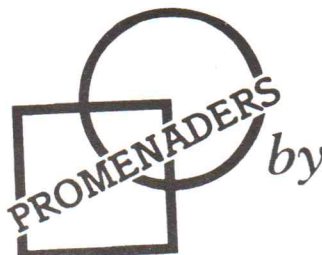

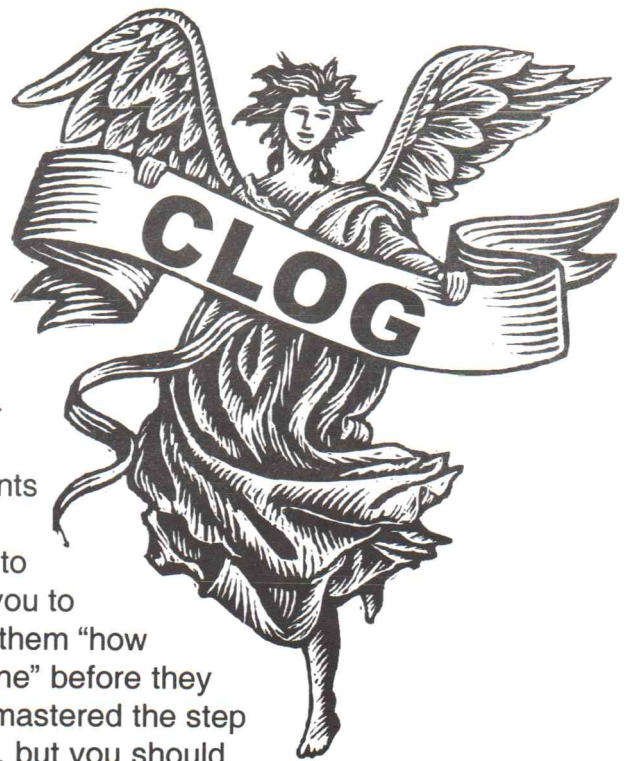

while the teacher or caller is at the microphone.

Another difficult point is just how much "help" you should give in getting dancers into the right place or to do the right step. Dancers, after all, must learn to do the moves on their own. To gently guide someone through a maneuver if they have a momentary lapse of memory might be okay, and sometimes one can help by indicating nonverbally where a person should go, but we accomplish little by pushing or pulling a dancer through an action when he or she doesn't know what was supposed to have been done. It is better to let a circle or square break down rather than to use too much force getting people into the right place. When square dancing or learning coupled or interactive dances, broken down formations are an indication to the instructor that the dancers are having problems. Do be sure the teacher is aware of problems; raise your hand if necessary and ask the teacher to explain something if you see that dancers are having trouble. Be careful, however, not to embarrass any dancer by the way you ask for help. For example, say "We're not getting this or that" not "He (or she) is having trouble." Do encourage students; let them know that all beginners make mistakes and that things get better with practice. Also, angels do sometimes make mistakes, too, and it is good to admit to them cheerfully; it makes the students less tense about their own mistakes.

Styling is always a third major source of contention. It is important that beginners learn the clogging steps or dance calls with standard styling, that is, without the flourishes or fancy footwork we like so much. The teacher will introduce our club styling at appropriate times after the steps or calls are mastered. Angels must use only the styling which has been taught to the class. This is not always easy. How many cloggers automatically add buck to a step? How many of us even remember how to do a do-sa-do without a Highland fling? But it really is very



important.

Students are going to want you to teach them "how it's done" before they have mastered the step or call, but you should resist the temptation. (In fact, it helps the angels to be reminded how the calls are really supposed to be done; some of our styling causes havoc when a teacher says, for example, do-sa-do once and a half or ferris wheel and roll.)

And some random additional advice:

Get on the floor with everyone, not just a few friends. Seek out the weaker students and dance with or near. Make sure that students are not sitting out because angels are dancing.

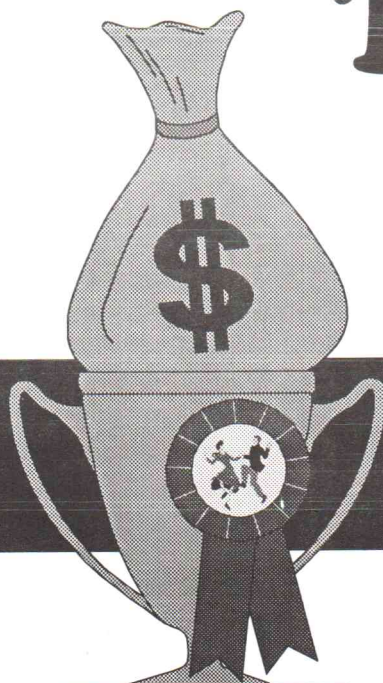
End conversations promptly when the teacher begins class. If you are not dancing, keep your conversations far away from the dance area.

Lend a hand cheerfully if you are asked to help set up or take down sound equipment, to help with refreshments, or to take attendance. Keep an eye out for security problems, accidents, and dangerous situations like spills or debris on the floor.

Let the instructor know if there are problems with the sound.

Don't complain about the hall, the floor, the caller. Don't criticize students or other angels.

Remember to wear your name badge or a tag.

Clogging on the Mountain Top and Below

Wisconsin Cloggers Bring the Austrian Hills Alive with the Sound of Clogging

Ever clogged on a mountain top before? How about in the valley of a mountain range? It is an experience of a lifetime. Let me take you on a journey across the ocean to the Austrian Alps. Austria is a beautiful country with breathtaking mountains covered with thick green trees and others topped with snow.

Just imagine a quaint town tucked away in the valley of the Alps. Can you hear your taps on the cobblestone street as you enter the Town Square for your performance? The glorious sound of your national anthem plays after the Austrian Mayor welcomes the American cloggers to his town and festival.

Picture yourself jumping on a cable car that will take you up over 4000 feet to your performance of "Fire on the Mountain." The mountain top air is brisk that night, but you sip your hot chocolate and capture the experience. You watch the other performers with anticipation and observe the locals' facial expressions. It is your turn to perform. Your body and feet are cold, but your blood begins to pump faster with excitement.

Standing on the small plywood stage, waiting for the music to start, you gaze over the lit town in the valley and see many bonfires on the surrounding mountains. At that moment you realize this will be a memory you will have forever.

The music begins and a huge grin comes to your

face. The music, stompin' and whoopin' immediately catch the crowd's attention. The crowd begins to clap and yell. Locals come out from the restaurant onto the cold terrace to watch. The crowd grows and you smile big and step as high as you can. You notice your breath becoming short because of the altitude level. Your adrenaline is high because you're having the time of your life and the crowd loves you. You realize this is a once in a lifetime performance, so you clog your best and a little extra, and give Austria a show it will remember.

The Milwaukee Cream City Clogging Company performed in four cities for the Austrian Alps Performing Arts Festival. The wonderful Austrian Alps tour began in Kitzbuhel, a quaint town surrounded by majestic mountains. Kitzbuhel is known for gams (small mountain goats) because they were abundant in that area. Baby gams are called kitz, hence the name Kitzbuhel. In Kitzbuhel we performed in the Town Square and on the mountain top.

Throughout the performing tour we were able to take day trips and visit other cities. A must see is the historical city of Salzburg, commonly known for the filming of Sound of Music and the birthplace of Mozart. Salzburg is almost the center of Austria with 140,000 people and 1041 feet above sea level.

The second city we performed at was Innsbruck. Inn means river and bruck means bridge, so Innsbruck is the "bridge over the river." Innsbruck is a major city and the Olympics were held there in 1976. Innsbruck also has 25,000 students due to the free tuition.

We performed on an eight-foot stage on the street below the "Golden Roof" (the golden roof was the balcony of Maximilian). Locals gathered in the street and hung out their apartment windows to watch. Even the next day, while shopping throughout town, locals would remember you and praise your performance.
