The Silver Dollar City Cloggers go to Spain

Dancers represent United States at International Festival

As we sit here in our home in California on Sunday, October 6th 2001 and think about the current state of affairs here in the United States, it is hard to believe that little more than 60 days ago our lives were filled with anticipation of a clogging trip to Ourense, Galicia, Spain. Under today's circumstances we probably could not have taken the opportunity to dance at this wonderful festival.

Maryann and Darl Moreland together with Nick and Hannah Bailey gathered a total of 18 dancers from Indiana, Colorado, and Wyoming. This group of dancers were invited to perform at the "Xornadas de Folklore" in Galicia, a Spanish province, and would represent the first clogging group to perform at this prestigious European Festival.

The first order of business was to call Dieter Brown who works at 5th Avenue Travel in Ashville, North Carolina and start the process of getting our trip together. Dieter would understand exactly what our travel needs would require, which would not be an easy process for a 40 person group from multiple states, but Dieter pulled it off without a hitch...Thanks Dieter!!!!

Because of the distance between the groups a lot of the routines were choreographed and learned by the dancers from video tape. Prior to our Spain trip the two groups met only once in Lincoln Nebraska and practiced at the "Capitol City Dance Studio" which is owned by Joel Harrison. We would like to express a special note of thanks to the Whiplash team and Joel for their hospitality. This practice went very well and all of the routines except the "closer" were written and practiced.

Finally on Saturday, August 4th the anticipated date arrived. The entire group of directors, dancers, and parents all arrived at the Chicago O'Hare Airport for our departure to Spain. After eating lunch together and saying our tearful good byes, we boarded our jet for a 9 hour flight to Spain. The trip itinerary was for the group to fly to Madrid, then to Vigo and then to travel by bus to Ourense. (pronounced Aur-ren-say) When we

arrived in Madrid we met up with Rex Burdett from Silver Dollar City, a good friend to cloggers everywhere and a great traveling companion. When we arrived in Vigo we were met by our host Diego, he guided us to our bus and introduced us to our bus driver Pepe and we were on our way to Ourense. For the next 10 days Diego and Pepe would be our lifelines.

We arrived at our accommodations at the "Universidad de Laboral" a sort of trade school for boys. We were met with a joyful greeting by Julio Fernandez Senra, director of the "Xornadas de Folklore" along with his assistant festival director Xavier Alvarez. The accommodations were like a College Dormitory with shared bathrooms and showers along with a do-it-yourself Laundromat, where we hand scrubbed our clothes in a deep sink with a scrub board like surface and then hung them outside to dry, the dancers had a blast with this, go figure!. All in all, it worked our very well.

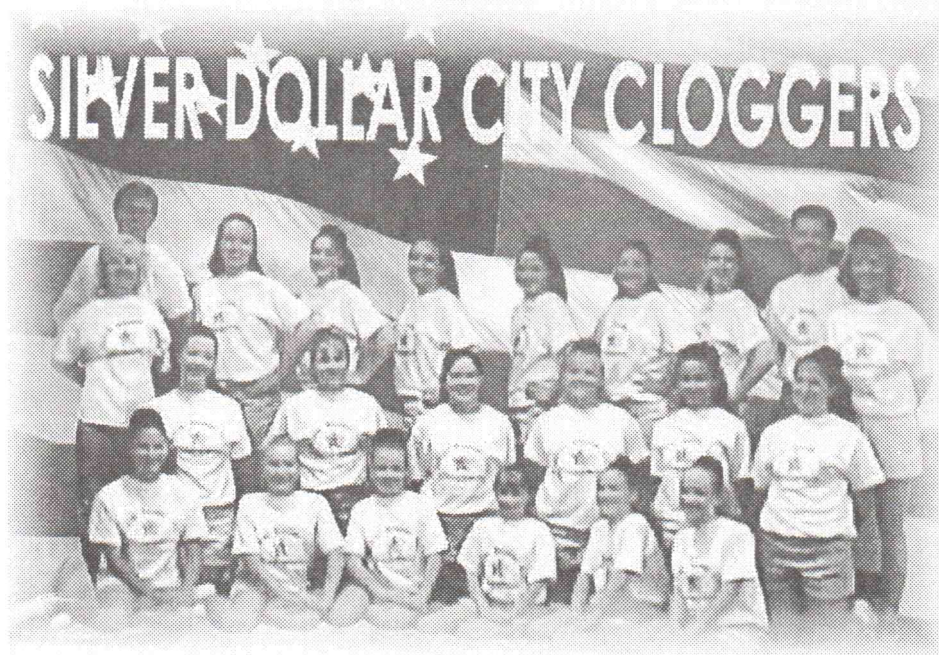
Immediately upon arrival the dancers met the group from Taiwan, one of the other twelve groups performing at the festival. They would remain nearly inseparable throughout the rest of the Festival.

The first night of the festival was the opening ceremony, which was held in a really neat European style Opera Theater. Each group was introduced, and it was exciting for our group to represent the United States. Other participants included Taiwan, Hungaria, New Zealand, India, Daguestan, Russia-Silverko, Puerto Rico, Peru, Mexico, Burundi and the Philippines.

The dancing arrangements for this

festival were for each team to perform at a different town in Galicia each night. Our group performed in Monforte, Chaves, Bande, A Rua, Ourense, Xinzo, Entrimo, and we were rained out at Trives, additionally the dancing arrangements were a little strange for Americans as most of the shows started at 11:00pm and would not end before 1:30am, therefore each day we would arise around 11:00am which was normal since we didn't get to bed until 3:00am in the morning. Breakfast and lunch were served each day in the dorm cafeteria, it was usual to see Red and White Wine served along with lunch and most of our evening meals were served in the town where we were performing. We had most of the day to go shopping or swimming or just

reading and relaxing until it was time to get dressed in our costumes for our evening show. Dancing Through Distraction

Coping With Attention Deficit Disorder Adds Challenge to Clogging

I realize it is not always easy to learn new routines for exhibition or competition even under the most normal of circumstances. We have all experienced difficulty from time to time. But, have you ever thought about how it might be for someone who has a learning disability and struggles over most every routine and a lot of the steps? Someone who loves to clog, yet seems to take forever to get the routine down? Of someone who seems to have a genuine problem with focus and the learning process itself? I would like to share one such someone with you. It is my hope you will better understand why a few unique people may take a lot longer than what you feel is normal to learn something new. And why, when the average person would have given up after so much time being spent, these unique ones still persist until the task is successfully complete.

We have all heard about ADD and ADHD (Attention Deficit Disorder with or without hyperactivity) in the classrooms at school.....probably to the point that many non-ADDers feel it is either highly exaggerated or does not even exist. But, believe me, it is a very real problem. I deal with kids in the classroom all day long and I see the individual struggles these kids go through and continue to go through as they go into adulthood.

So what exactly is this affliction we hear so much about and understand so little? In a nutshell, ADD/ADHD

is a disorder of the central nervous system characterized by disturbances in the areas of attention, impulsiveness and hyperactivity. Can you catch it like a disease? No, a person is born with it. Is it curable? No, but with effort and determination it is manageable. Can you outgrow it? No, it follows children into their adulthood. Are ADDers lazy, stupid or crazy? Absolutely not and if you believe they are then you could not be more wrong or more misinformed. An ADDer is neither stupid nor oppositional, he/she just needs to learn and to demonstrate what they have learned differently than others do.

So what in the heck does all of this really have to do with clogging? More than you might think to the ADDer. What may seem like stupidity or inability to think or learn to a non-ADDER is – simply put – an inability for the ADDer to hold attention for long periods of time. An ADDer often has a remarkably unreliable temporary memory that regularly loses power and data. He begins the first step in solving a complex problem (in the case of clogging perhaps adding hand moves to steps or maybe a difficult sequence of footwork) only to lose it as he undertakes the second step. The “jigsaw pieces” keep falling off the table before he can put the whole puzzle together.

This gloomy picture some of you may have about an ADDer really isn't as totally gloomy as some might be making it out to be. Many ADD children (and later adults) lead productive lives by using their particular

strengths. Deficits can and do become assets. Hyperactivity can translate into incredible productivity and/or creative sparkle. Impulsivity can translate into a strong need to get the job finished by the deadline, or in clogging to go over and over a routine with amazing determination until it is learned. In the form of clogging, a person who has spent their school years in a fantasy land can learn to transfer their mental free flight in the direction of creative dance.

The person in this story is a classic ADDer with all the focus difficulties and memory shut downs that go with it. It is difficult for her to learn a clogging routine in the same amount of time that most non-ADDers would because one step just learned might be lost in the sequential process of the next step (or part) being introduced. It is the way in which the brain processes information. Too much info at one time for an ADDer can cause memory shut down. But, the excitement of dance (and in most cases raw determination to get it right) aides this particular person in achieving the goal of a finished routine that is performed well. Although it is a struggle to get from “Intro to Ending”, it is nevertheless a route this person chooses to take because of her love of the creativeness and freedom of expression clogging gives. Clogging is a joy that burns in this person's blood and giving up on a routine is not something this ADDer much thinks about. The goal is achieving beginning to end no matter how long it takes or what special mea

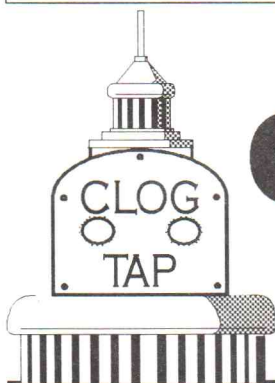

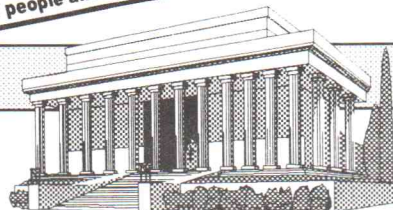

asures may need to be taken as an ADDer to get there.

For those of you who are lucky enough to get a step or routine without struggle (or at least without abnormal struggle) the process of an ADDer trying to achieve success may seem like too much effort or ridiculous to the extreme in your eyes. But, it is a process to get to an end, or set goal if you will.

This ADD dancer will write down the steps demonstrated just as soon as possible if a cue sheet is not available. Notes will be written all over the page that are of significance to her individual learning process. For example, a triple left to many of you may be written as DS-DS-DSRS and you've got it. This ADD person will need to fill in the details of it as DS-DS(xif)-DS(ots)-R(ib)-S – giving her the visual in her mind as to where exactly the feet need to be. Also, an instructor may say triple left and most students will just do it. An ADDer will probably have to entirely say in his/her mind each part of the step as she is doing it.

A high horse is another example of the difference in thought process. The ADDer may have to be thinking out DS-DBl Over-DBl Out-RS-S/Slide-DS-DS-RS. You may be thinking well that's nothing, all teachers teach it that way anyway. This is true, but once learned most dancers will take up what I like to call muscle memory and the body just does it when "high horse" is called out. Not the ADDer in this particular story. To this day she will still mentally say the step breakdown in her head. Why? Because that is what she had to do over and over again to learn it and to now retain it.

Step sequence to this person is difficult to attain, but possible. How does she manage that? She will take the tape of music (first at slow speed then faster) in her car and go over the steps to the tune several times – visually seeing it happen. And I do mean over and over! This person has been known to travel by car as many as four hours at a time and have the same tape going on all the way. Does it sound crazy? Not to her. This is how she learns it. Does it sound boring? Again, not to her because she has one goal in mind – to get it down in the mind no matter how long it takes.

On sleepless nights she will close her eyes and visually run through the routine thus setting it to muscle memory in a different sort of way – taking each step apart – and in her mind dancing out slowly then faster the steps until it all comes together. A lot of work? You bet. Worth it? Absolutely!

You might like to know what outside forces help her. Instructors who are willing to go over the steps slowly and repeatedly until the students get it is a big part of the success. Two extremely good instructors at this are Missy Shinoski and Scotty Bilz. I have noticed that when students are not getting the step, these two teachers will stop and repeat and repeat and repeat! For the ADDer who wants to get the step to mind this is crucial. There are other instructors who are good at this as well, but these two jumped immediately into my mind as I was thinking about examples. Of course, videotaping helps as well because you can repeat all you want with the mere click of the rewind button!

Another outside help is being with a team or club who is aware of the difficulty and adjusts to the

ADDer's individual differences in how they learn. I'm not saying they need to "baby" the dancer. Not at all, but they do need to be aware of the difference and supportive of the fact that it will take this person longer to pick up on the routine. To dance with a supportive group that accepts the added length of time it may take the ADDer is essential for the success of the whole team. The ADDer will get it and look just the same as everyone else, it just takes longer. How much longer? That really depends on the motivation of the ADDer coupled with the support of her dancing teammates.

Some of you know the person this story is about. She struggles with her focus but never-the-less meets the goals she sets in motion to achieve performance status. She is fortunate to dance with a team who is aware of the disability. It is not something that is truly talked about – just something they are aware of so they realize it may take this person longer to learn.

Some of you may still be wondering why an article like this is in a clogging newsletter. It is one I have wanted to write for quite awhile to explain that disabilities – whether mental or physical – can be adjusted to so that even people with differences in learning or mobility can learn to clog. It is meant as an awareness to everyone that differences can be good and can most always be worked around. How do I know this? I know because I am the person who is in this story and I dance with a wonderful group of cloggers (KC Klogghoppers) who allow me my space to learn the way that is best for me. I hope that my story will help others to understand a bit more what ADD/ADHD really is and realize that it can be managed and worked around just as every disability should be.
