he year 1990 yields to a clean new slate as yet unmarked by highs and lows, goods and bads, wins and losses.

Our Clog Dance was, at it's inception, simply a regional shared-by-imitation wonderfully delightful dance for


Today it is still an intriguing, lively, dance (with many variations) still for anyone providing they are not intimidated anyone, young or old.

by youth, expertise, video-cameras and bright lights.

The year 1990, in retrospect, was a year of phenomenal growth in some sections of the U.S. and Canada in sheer numbers of new dancers. The many times repeated "I saw Cloggers at the County Fair and just had to learn how to do it!" is heard from coast to coast. Performances and Competitions charge up the adrenaline of both the dancers and the audience. There are those whose total clogging commitment is one class night a week and others who would clog seven nights (and days) a week, given the opportunity.

Our Choreographers and Instructors have added Canadian Step Dancing, Tap, Jazz moves, lifts and stunts, and cheerleading body movements to disco, rock-n-roll, reggae, hard-rock and rap music. The often repeated phrase "we

have to do this to keep the young people interested" is also heard from coast to coast.

Michigan Clogging Groups Joins in Ohio Festival

About three years ago I received word of the Bob Evans Farm Festival in Rio Grande,OH 12 miles from West Virginia on Hwy 35. This is the last festival of the year for

the Bob Evans Farms. The first year I looked at the information I received from Lee Adams and wondered what it was about. (Lee Adams is the coordinator for the Ohio cloggers at the Ohio State Fair.) The second year we wanted to go but the trip had to be put off for another year.

We set the thoughts of the trip aside and worked the next year building The THUNDER FLOOR CLOGGERS organization. As October 12th drew close seven of The THUNDER FLOOR CLOGGERS had decided to go and we made reservations at the Days Inn in Jackson, OH. The dancers going were Bill and Neva Jones of Battle Creek, MI: Karen Moore of Goebels, MI: Nancy Beckwith of Hastings, MI: Lois Jackson, Bob and Lynda Warner of Lake Odessa, MI. We had performance class that Thursday night in our barn and left Friday morning about 3 am in the rain.

We all agreed that this weekend was very enriching and what happened for us and other people confirmed our convictions that God is a clogger.

On our way east I was leading down I-94 as we took two vehicles. Bill, Neva and Lois were behind us. It was raining cats and dogs and I missed the US-23 South exit off of I-94. I didn't realize I had missed it, but I knew Bill was not behind me. A little later I saw a sign

that said 275 South-Toledo. I took that exit and I realised that Bill turned south on US-23.




After a while we went to a big porch


Bottom: Throught the event, musicians and cloggers take the stage to perform for thousands of eager festival-goers.



Michigan Cloggers Perform in Bob Evans Festival

swing dancers. They told us they were from Columbus, OH. He was a retired teacher and she did crafts. She was set up at Bob Evans Farms. I asked her how long it took to get into the crafts show at the Bob Evans Farm Festival and she said, "15 years". We danced Shortenin' Bread on one side of the fence and they danced to it on the other side of the fence. They looked nice and I saw some moves we could incorporate into our clogging.

The next morning, Saturday, we arrived at the farm about 10am. The cloggers started at 10am. After walking through the cow shute that is under Hwy 35 from the parking lot, we saw some of the Katy Did Cloggers from Heartland, MI. By the amount of perspiration dripping off of them they must have put on a good show. As far as I know, The Katy Did Cloggers and The THUNDER FLOOR CLOGGERS were the only Michigan teams represented.

It didn't take long for the high to set in for us. We found the Katy Did Cloggers went on at 10am. We were slated for 12:20pm. By the time we were ready to go onstage there was shoulder to shoulder people for a long ways. The colors on the trees were at their peak. Bob Evans Farms, nestled in the hills of color with 1500 camper's occupied rigs that spread out west through the valley, a long ways lined up as if they were for sale. West of the campground was the stage the bands played on back in a hollow for campers and people in general. 3000 people would be sitting on the sides of the hills Friday and Saturday nights.

During the day the cloggers danced on a stage that was about 40x40 feet. North of that stage was a stage for the bluegrass, country and gospel performers used at the same time. Beside that stage were dozens of children sliding downhill on cardboard boxes. I guess

I'll take a mini-boggin down with us next year. God says we are children. It was fun.

While it rained in Michigan on Saturday, the temperature was 80 degrees and the sun shone down at Bob Evans Farm. Some folks we know from Lake Odessa and Woodland, Jerry & Carol Engle and Ron & Norien Enz, who are clogging fans, came down to Bob Evans to take in the festivities and see one of the biggest and best craft shows going. Plus watching us.

Another odd thing happened. I was bending over putting some things in our bag and I saw some feet beside me and a woman's voice say, "We wondered if you guys would be here, Bob". I stood up and a woman who was about as tall as I am stood there. I knew her but I couldn't say her name. I was shocked. She got a big hug from me. Just then I heard my wife say, "Who's that woman hugging my husband". Jeannette Miller of Caledonia and Lynda were friends in high school. Jeannette and Eldon were at Bob Evans Farm sort of by accident.

Lee Adams, who organized the clogging portion of the festival, told me that the crafters hug her with tears in their eyes because the cloggers attract so many people. And she is right. Cloggers attract audiences. There were 18 teams on Friday, 18 teams on Saturday and 18 teams on Sunday. 60,000 people went through the farm that weekend. I beleive that as long as Bob Evans has cloggers at the farm fest, Bob Evans and everyone associated with Bob Evans will be blessed. For God's a clogger.

Towards 5pm on Saturday Lee Adams called all cloggers to join her group on the stage. She called Lynda and I up there and we stood in back.




Photo: The Bob Evans Farm in Rio Grande is the original home of the Bob Evans chain of family restaurants and the site of the Fall Festival.

While we stood there a couple of fella's started to do flatfoot clog. I thought to myself that if I was going to get up there I'd better start moving my feet. I started clogging in the back row and the ladies pushed me up to the front. It was wonderful. It was fun.


Then Lee directed Lynda and I to the front and we all danced to Ida Red. Again-it was fun. Lee Adams then asked if we knew Rocky top. Of course, we said, "Yes". But Lynda then told her that we knew a different one. Lee said, "It doesn't matter-stay right in front." Lynda and I danced the routine by Darl Morland and the Ohio cloggers did the one by JoAnn Gibbs.

All of us from Ohio, Virginia, Pennsylvania, Kentucky and Michigan who participated learned so much. It would be impossible to learn in a workshop or a school what we drank in with the eyes that weekend. Besides the clogging, there was the food booths, the crafts, and a lot of exhibits and demonstrations in old time work and play by local families. It not only was enriching and fun but the words are 'Incredibly Worth It".

When I see a festival such as this I get a feeling for what can be done. We are in the process of planning the 2nd Annual Mid-Winter Hot Dog Clog Hog for January 12th and 13th 2002. This is a festival open to the public and clogging teams of Michigan and the surrounding states. The event will be centered at the Lakeside Grange west of Lake Odessa, MI on M-50. We hope to see you or somewhere out on the clogging floor!







Choreographer's Corner

Many of you have written to ask for more advanced routines in our Choreographer's Corner.

This issue's choreography is by Michele Millier-Hill of California. Michele has been a favorite at workshops and festivals for years and in addition to being an excellent choreographer and dancer is one of the finest cuers you will ever hear.

Here are the step breakdowns for her advanced routine to "These Flowers" featured on page 20.

Step Descriptions for 'These Flowers'

Kick Touch Hop Turn (roll L)






