FRONT AND CENTER

That "Real Play Spirit"

American author Sherwood Anderson (1876 - 1941) was known for his short stories that dealt with the instinctive, though often underestimated, ability of people to assert their individuality in the face of standardization. In the course of his travels he met a clogging historian and pioneer named "Pappy" Lloyd Shaw who had been teaching young people the art of mountain dancing for years at his Cheyenne Mountain School in Colorado. So taken by the exuberance of the program he found Shaw directing, he began a long relationship with the author that included several trips to his Mountain School.

When Shaw published his book "Cowboy Dances" in 1939, it was his friend Anderson that he asked to contribute the foreword. In part, Anderson wrote, "I came to see your dancers, and they seemed to me very real and very much a part of America. There was a kind of rough grace, sincerity, feeling of fun, joy in living. We have had so much, in our romantic literature, of the cowboys shooting up towns, saving fair virgins, being always so faultlessly noble under a rough exterior that I was very thankful to see something of a more authentic old western life brought back in these dances. In it I think there was something the feeling of an early America and its joy in a huge new land, something really virginal, joyous, good. I felt real play spirit. I wanted to stay, take it in, see more and more of it. I think indeed that you have done something very real. The feeling of fun, some joy in living, is too much gone out of most of us. You seem to be keeping it alive in these dances."

Shaw had found in his teaching and his school the ingredient that made these dances a vital part of American culture, and Anderson was so taken by the living laboratory of culture he had built that he returned many times to breathe in the renewing spirit he found there.

I often find myself looking for the ingredient that makes clogging so alive for me and how to try to instill in others that same joy. Sometimes we get so caught up in the technique of teaching and the expectations of our outcome that we fail to make the experience one that is both fun and fruitful.

Even in the most advanced of classes one can build an atmosphere of learning that has a "real play spirit." One of the best compliments that I have had as an instructor is when someone says that I have made them feel comfortable. When you build an atmosphere of learning that is relaxed, people tend to push themselves to try new things and be challenged. Our earliest settlers treasured the simple, good joy of dance and the spirit that it brought. Work to bring that same simple joy in living that is "too much gone in most of us" to your teaching and your students will repay you by giving you the best of themselves.




Saturday morning came bright and early at 8am, and a Mardi Gras party kicked off the Opening Ceremonies. Mardi Gras masks and beads surrounded the



Clog Dancing Keeps 80-year-old Busy

He started clogging at age 65, and Howard Hummer has no plans to retire any time soon.

Now 80, Hummer, of Hemet, California, is still actively competing in a dance form where dancers wear heavy, thick-soled shoes that could easily wear out many 50-year-olds.

"I went to the doctor last week," said Hummer, who started the Hemet Social Security Stompers clogging group, "and he said everything is fine and that I should continue my exercise."

A retired contract pricer for such aerospace firms as Boeing, Northrop and Lockheed, Hummer attended Pasadena City College and played in the band that led off the Rose Parade for two years. He later graduated from the University of Arizona in Tucson where his classmates included former Sen. Bob Dole and former Secretary of the Interior Stewart Udall. Hummer also did some substitute teach before entering the aerospace field. While temporarily on the back burner, show biz always had special place in his heart. He saw his first dogging exhibition at the Los Angeles County Fair In Pomona in 1984.

"I was mesmerized," he said.
"I had always thought I'd like to be a tap dancer, so I started clogging."

According to Jerry Duke, author of "Clog Dance In the Appalachians," clogging is a kind of frenzied tap dance, done to bluegrass music. It originated in the Appalachian Mountains. In an April 1999 article in the New York Times, Duke stated further that the dance evolved from Irish

and Scottish jigs, Czechoslovakian polkas and the flat-footed African American dance. The name derives from the wooden clog shoes many immigrants originally wore for dancing. Hummer added that they now dance in leather shoes with special clogging taps fastened onto the soles. The taps sort of flap around giving the typical castanet-like sound spectators hear during a performance.

As a member of the Social Security Stompers, Hummer performs with Claretta Gear, Brenda Garison, Dee Holman, and Dorothy Pospisil. He also dances freestyle executing his own

routines. He said he is often billed as the oldest competitive clogger in the world. His dancing has been very successful, and he has a room full of trophies to show for it. He has performed and competed all over the country. On several occasions, he appeared on national television.

"CNN was taping a clogging competition in Torrance," said Hummer, "and that tape was shown in 53 countries."

In Las Vegas, he was interviewed by Kathy Martingale for TNN at the Sands Hotel. He said it was kind of fun to dance in the Copa Room at the Sands on the same stage the "Rat Pack" had used.

"And," added Hummer, "I was on the Gong Show and didn't get gonged."

As a result of his dancing, Hummer was signed to appear in two movies, "Private Debts" and "Horses and Champions." He received a Star Sapphire Halo Award from the Southern California Motion Picture Council for his work.

An additional bonus that resulted from his dancing celebrity came when he was featured in a California Farmer magazine article.

"A guy called me up and said his name was also Howard Hummer. It turns out we had the same great-grandfather." He said that since meeting the other Howard Hummer, he has attended family reunions in Walnut and evencontributed a huge Hummer Family Reunion banner.

Hummer said that while the Social Security Stompers average one to two perfor-

mances a month, they probably could be busy every weekend. They perform for a variety of retirement homes, fraternal organizations and many schools. Sometimes Hummer teaches members of his audience a few of the dance steps. His own teacher is Linda Shields, who has just started a new clogging class at Valley-Wide Recreation In San Jacinto. He said the Stompers perform every third Sunday at Valley-Wide, and the public is invited to attend.

Hummer summed up his clogging career by saying, "I feel that when I dance, I can lift the hearts of people. I have fun and try to make people happy. That's what it's all about."
