



Dancing on Holy Ground

horeographer Martha Graham said "Wherever a dancer stands is holy ground."

The dance world is full of quotes. Holy ground? Maybe the stage of Carnegie Hall or the Kennedy Center for the Arts might be thought of as holy ground, but "wherever?"

As a young clogging instructor who was teaching dancers privately in a small studio made from a converted garage over fifteen years ago, I found myself face to face with a very spirited young lady who refused to dance on a certain spot on the floor. She made quite a detour during lessons to avoid the well-worn spot that many students had clogged on for the years I spent teaching in the small space.

After a few minutes of this distraction, I stopped the music and asked her why she was not clogging on that part of the floor. Her reply was that another girl she knew took lessons from me and she stood on that spot and she didn't want to touch the same place as her. It seems they both liked the same boy and she didn't even want to stand in the same spot she knew the other girl had been on. That well-worn dance floor reminded her of someone she had no respect for.

Growing up in a house with all brothers, I didn't have many opportunities to deal with the eye-rolling you experience teaching teenage girls. Although a house of guys certainly has it's share of drama, I was learning as I went to deal with the almost counselor-like responsibilities that accompany a teaching position involving teens.

"Instead of thinking about her," I told my headstrong student, "why not think of all the great cloggers that have danced in this same room." I began to list some of my clogging friends who had made visits to the studio and pointed out some of the pictures on the wall. Her attitude softened when she thought that she was treading in the path of some of her dance idols.

When I left that small studio to teach in a bigger hall and then closed it completely to lessons to be filled with storage, I couldn't help but feel guilty about the memories I was locking away in that space. The room and the floor had taken on a meaning that saddened me to see end. The memories of many dancing eves and routines written and steps shared come to mind each time I think of that place, just as so many halls and floors I know and have shared with a host of wonderful friends. To me those places have become holy ground. Now I understand.



Britney Lets Her Hands Do The Dancing

Brave Indiana Girl Doesn't Let Spina Bifida Stop Her From Enjoying Clogging

Brittney Martin, 7, really wanted to clog dance.

So, Becky Hochstetler, her grandmother who directs a group of local cloggers, started teaching her the basic steps in May.

Now, Brittney's mastered a "Play That Funky

Music" routine which she performs right along with the rest of Heartland Country Cloggers.

Like the other cloggers, Brittany lets her shoes do the work. But, it's her hands rather than her feet that guide the shoes in the rhythmic and percussive sounds. A tray placed in front of her is her dance floor.

Brittney has spina bifida, a birth defect that affects the spine, said Dori Martin, her mother. She's had eight fractures and spent six weeks last year in a body cast that covered her legs and hips.

Brittney steadies herself with a walker at home and school. At first, the plan was for her to clog with the walker. But, safety concerns and concerns about future fractures made clogging the traditional way – standing – out of the question right now. "She's been after me to learn," Hochstetler said.

So, she places a tray in front of her and her hands go to work. Brittney realizes the importance of the shoes with double taps. "I need four taps to do the steps so it doesn't sound like just the toe," she said, giving a quick demonstration of the dull sound with just the toe click. "It sounds better with four."

Loren Hartman, physical therapists and owner of Children's Therapeutic Services in Elkhart, said, 'It's wonderful her grandmother has adapted the clogging to enable Brittney to be a part of it. There are limited motor activities she can safely engage in,' adding that clogging aids in coordination, rhythm and self-esteem.

How often does Brittney practice? "Once in a blue moon. It doesn't take me long to get the steps. It's hard to learn at first, but once you learn it, its easy."

To demonstrate, she quickly and deftly performs a series of "double-toe, step rock steps," and "step together, step touches" during her interview. It's easier to start without music. "When I get better, I'll do it with music." Brittney is now working on the steps to "Turkey In The Straw."

Brittney started rehearsing with the clogging group, some 20 strong, just after her seventh birthday in

May. The group meets monthly at Farmer's Market in Goshen. "My grandma says the steps to me and I follow," Brittney said.

A spina bifida conference in New Orleans caused a few missed practices. Hochstetler and Dori found out by checking with others at the conference that Brittney may be the only child with that diagnosis who has taken up clogging.

Britney's struggles began early. Born at only two pounds and fourteen ounces, little Britney was diagnosed at birth with a hole in her heart, severe spina bifida and mental handicaps. Her survival probability was considered very weak.

However, Britney proved all the statistics and diagnosis wrong when she entered this world

fighting. Early tests proved no signs of mental problems and the hole in her heart that doctors expected was non-existent. Her strength and will have amazed all who meet her and her clogging has become a means of joy both for her and those who see her perform.

The Heartland Country Cloggers offer lessons 7 to 8 p.m. the first Thursday of the month beginning in October. Hochstetler said she'd like to start lessons one to one with physically challenged children. "Maybe this is the start of something," Hartman said.

Brittney sees a time in her future where she won't have time for clogging. "I'll be at work all day," she said about what she'll be doing once she's a paleontologist digging for dinosaur bones.



England's Queen Mother Dies at 101

Former Monarch is Credited with Giving "Clogging" Its Name

Compiled from writings by Joyce Riding and BBC Reporting

The Queen Mother Elizabeth, a symbol of courage and dignity during a tumultuous century of war, social upheaval and royal scandal died March 30. She was

101 years old. After years of frailty and ill health, the Queen Mother died "peacefully in her sleep" at Royal Lodge, Windsor, outside London, the palace said. The Oueen was at her mother's side when she died. The Oueen Mother had rarely been seen in recent months because of her failing health. The passing marks a page in the history of clog dancing, as many attribute the Queen Mother with giving the Appalachian percussive dance we perform the name "clogging."


In the early 1900s the main form of dance in the United States was square dancing, and from the late 1920s regular square dance competitions were held in Asheville, North Carolina: in



Queen Mother Dies at 101 Monarch Credited With Giving Dance Name of "Clogging"

United States. A remark by Queen Elizabeth of the similarity to British clog dancing resulted in the name change to American Clogging in press reports of the performance.

"Queen Elizabeth the Queen Mother had become increasingly frail in recent weeks following her bad cough and chest infection over Christmas," said a palace spokesman, who was not named in keeping with tradition. Britain's main television and radio channels interrupted regular programs with news of the death, which came during the four-day Easter holiday. National figures and ordinary people from all walks of life united in expressing admiration and grief for the Queen Mother.

Prime Minister Tony Blair said the Queen Mother was a symbol of Britain's "decency and courage" and the whole nation would join with the royal family in mourning her death.

"During her long and extraordinary life, her grace, her sense of duty and her remarkable zest for life made her loved and admired by people of all ages and backgrounds, revered within our borders and beyond," he said.

Former Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher said the Queen Mother was "a wonderful queen and an extraordinary person".

"Her death is more than a source of grief to the royal family. It is an irreplaceable loss to the whole nation," she said.

The Queen Mother was as popular at the end of her life as she had been a half-century before.

She was best known to younger generations as the mother of Queen Elizabeth II and grandmother of Prince Charles. Remarkably sprightly despite her age, the Queen Mother was a fixture at royal occasions, delighting in mixing with the public and greeting people who flocked to meet her.

To the thousands of dancers throughout the world who love to do this heritage-rich dance, we honor the memory of this monarch who was so taken by the clog dancers and will be remembered for giving the dance she saw the name "clogging."





A DISCOVERY IS AN ACCIDENT MEETING A PREPARED MIND

"A Discovery is an Accident Meeting a Prepared Mind" – This quote, by Albert Szent Gyorgyi, has always impressed me, not only as a thought to live by, but one to teach by, as well. Our creative juices flow from a multitude of sources and have many potential channels and rivers to fill.

The carefully trained, mentally and physically disciplined dancer and teacher has a far better chance for success in the field if he or she is technically and artistically alert, aware and informed – the difference then, is one of having choices – rather than being forced into choreography, that may or may not ring of success due to a lack of ideas or innovative movement.

As a choreographer, I'm always searching for new concepts, styles and meaningful phrases – and – this time of year is wonderful, for such research – a walk through the toy or clothes department of any store is not only fun, but helps the creative juices flow. There are balls, robots, ropes, hats, etc. – all of which set me to dreaming about "Little Recital" possibilities; or a trip through the music department with images on wide screens and large posters flaunting the latest and hottest vocalists – which help you to "keep in touch". However, you have to correctly decide on the "rise" or "demise" of these "Hits", in time for your show – for there is nothing as pitiful, as music that is an "Oldie" but has not remained a "Goodie".

I usually carry the class listing, names, sizes, heights, etc., while trying to keep in mind their potential age, level and whether they are going to be excited, about the concept, the wardrobe and just as important – how this number will fit into the total concept of the show.

I learned at an early age through numerous tragic incidents, to cut the music first – hopefully, before starting the routing or shortly thereafter. Procrastinating with this matter may lead to extended routines that are unnecessary and unwanted.

Another concept, which holds up as well, is to create a great, interesting opening and closing – the old concept being that, if you do a remarkable job at the beginning and the end, the audience tends to lose sight of some weaker moments, in the middle. I am not sure this works, but I will say some endings have stuck with me forever, for example, when I saw my first "run off" exit – or when the Rockettes, while doing their famous "Wooden Soldier" routine, lined up down stage, facing stage right, a cannon was brought out and fired at the first girl and the whole line fell backward. It all ended in a marvelous slow motion contagious. Try the unexpected and if it doesn't work – change it-routines are much like clay - they are intended to be molded and "worked upon."

Recitals and creating can be fun and not drudgery, inspiring and not defeating, your ego and self-esteem can in turn receive a big boost as long as you have remained focused. You also need a little luck – for that, you add a little prayer.

Sugarcane Showoff Award

Some teams have dancers who do not dance or perform to their full potential and get lazy and slack off by the end of the performing season. Outside of drilling and grueling with "pep talks" at practice and the constructive criticism, I searched every idea I could thing of to motivate my group into becoming a very exciting and entertaining performing troupe. So, the idea hit me that if I offered an incentive for their hard work, perhaps they would put more into their dancing. The trophy is not that expensive, the award was easy enough from the computer, and the team footed an appealing cash amount. This is what I came up with and we felt other teams may find it worthy to try in their groups.

Last Christmas, our team established a "Sugarcane Show-off" trophy and "Triple E" award for the dancer who displayed the most Energy, Enthusiasm and Excitement throughout the entire performing season. The team voted for this person based on these qualities and the winner was presented a trophy, award and cash prize during our team Christmas party.

The winner of our First Sugarcane Show-off trophy and Triple E award was Kathy Parsons from Pennington Gap, VA. Kathy certainly filled the requirements with each member voting, taking in consideration every aspect for this award. Watching Kathy dance definitely motivates one to want to join her or, at least, get a clap or pat of the foot and, at times, even to come to the edge of their seat. She is vivacious and vigorous and expressive in her dancing as well as using all of her effort and expertise in executing her steps and style with perfect accuracy. She obviously displays an inspirational enthusiasm that takes in all of the intensity, eagerness, zeal and fervor of a dancer who feels the music and loves the dance itself.

Kathy is quite an exceptional and exciting clogger – a good example of a "show-off". She is very dedicated and loyal, not only to the dance, but to her team. She was given the helm of the Sugarcane Team as Assistant Director in 1999 and 2000, while the Team Director was in Florida for the winter months.

Kathy first became interested in clogging when she saw the Sugarcane team in a performance in 1995. She was already dancing with the Mountain Hoedowners, a square dance group from her hometown, but Kathy wanted more than just figures and maneuvers. She wanted to learn foot work that matched the timing of the music. She talked with Anna and her husband, Ray, at the performance and arranged for clogging lessons. At the time, she felt that her husband Mike would not approve of her joining a clogging team, however, Ray kept encouraging her, and after Ray and I visited the "hoedown" sessions with her, we finally convinced her to attend the clogging lessons. Kathy jumped right in with both feet, taking to clogging like a duck in the water. She soon became proficient enough to work with the team and become "performance oriented." She realized that this "contagious fever" had consumed her to the point that there was no turning back. Unaware, her husband Mike who hardly traveled, was beginning a new aspect in his life as well. Little did they realize that the world of clogging was about to change

their life-style forever. Becoming committed to the clogging team meant traveling to places of performance. After the first few trips, Mike decided that he enjoyed the sights and sounds and getting out of Lee County, Virginia.

In the seven years that Kathy has been clogging, she has developed a special talent for choreography and instructing as well as being a "showy dancer". She, supported by her husband, now rarely miss any local clog workshops in the area such as Spring Fling or Radford and all the National Competitions they can attend.

Mike is a mechanic in a local garage, and Kathy works at DeRoyal Industries in Tazewell, Tennessee, a company which manufactures surgical supplies. They have no children, but enjoy their dogs which are just like family members. Kathy's mother, Martha Livesay also is a very devout and supportive member of her daughter and the Sugarcane team. Also, Mike is now a part of the team as the official sound technician for all of our performances. Who says clogging is not a family affair? Now, all we have to do is find a job for the dogs!





Photo: The First Sugarcane Showoff trophy and Triple E award winner - Kathy Parsons from Pennington Gap, Va.




