...It's in the Details



I spent July participating in two of the hardest-working events I have ever been a part of... the International Clogging Expo in Washington, D.C. and the Clogging Champions of America Clog Camp at Mars Hill College in the mountains of North Carolina.

Each event was very different in its planning, its logistics, its preparation and its presentation. The Clogging Expo was a major undertaking -- transporting a group of over 1,000 through the Nation's capital during the most heightened period of security in our history. The C.C.A. camp brought together kids from preteen to 16 for a long weekend of workshops, crafts and activities. I was honored to be a coordinator of each of these events and I am thankful for the lessons I learn each time I am blessed to work with cloggers. After months of planning, the details we think are covered can change in a moment and the key to success is to keep a level head and to make it look like all of the chaos is just part of the package!

After a hectic July 4th of bus delays, security delay after security delay, and over 100 degree heat, I stood at the door of the Omni Shoreham Hotel in Washington, D.C. with my partners Lee Adams and Sallie Adkins fully expecting to usher home a group of weary travelers. Instead, we found group after group who echoed their gratitude and sense of honor to be a part of something so special. Our wreath-laying at the Pentagon was incredibly moving and performing for the opening ceremonies before families of victims of the Pentagon attacks touched each of us in a special way.

At the kids camp later that month, after 3 days of stifling heat, long days and lots of activities, over 150 kids thanked us with hugs and handwritten cards that said they had the time of their lives. The reward of a smile and a bashful "thank you" can make the sore back and tired legs all worth the effort.

I am constantly amazed at the attitude of cloggers when it comes to the efforts of their peers. We are our own worst critics and sometimes we get so caught up in the details of our classes and workshops and events -- all of the bells and whistles -- that we forget that the basic good times and fellowship of cloggers can make memories that last long after the decorations are down. Even when the lights didn't go out on cue, the hotel didn't have enough garlic toast, and the camper who wouldn't shower all weekend finally got thrown in the pool... while we sit in the conference room after lights-out wringing our hands, the dancers recognize the effort of someone --- just like them -- who took the time and energy to make a good show for them.

Thomas Edison said, "I have not failed. I've just found 10,000 ways that won't work." Oh, that I had more of that resolve. I am so thankful for the wonderful dancers who continue to support the efforts of their instructors and coordinators, and the leaders who constantly strive to provide great opportunities for their dancers. What more can we do than to do our best?

I have always said that cloggers are the best people in the world. This Summer has reminded how true that is and why it is so important to share our good fortune.

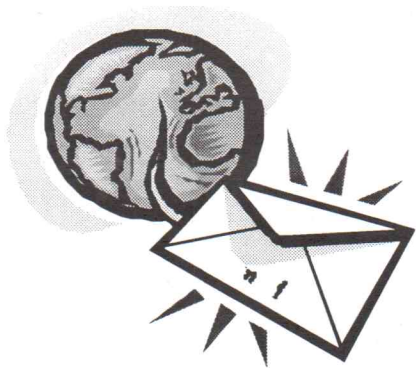

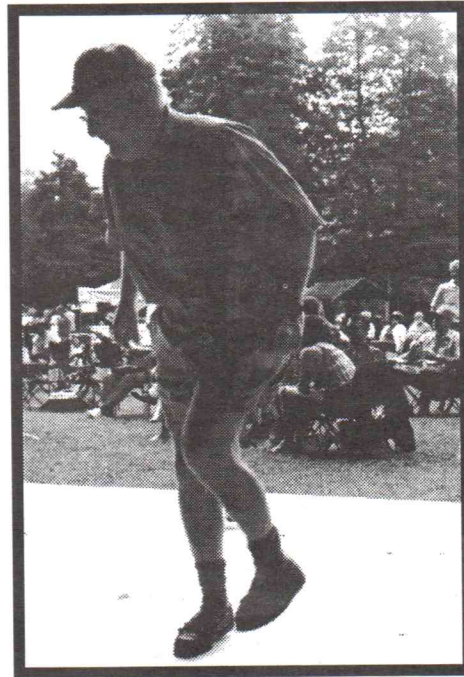
Flatfooting is Alive and Well

I really enjoyed seeing the 1940's picture on the cover on the June Double Toe Times. This type of solo clogging/flatfooting is still alive and well in many small rural communities in Western North Carolina. For example, every Friday night at the old depot in Marshall, NC, the dance floor is always packed with freestyle cloggers and flatfooters. A few have taps on their shoes, most don't. I recently attended the Bluff Mountain Music Festival in Hot Springs, NC, and the outdoor plywood dance floor was filled most of the day with young and old freestyle flatfooters.

I was also very happy to read your response to the "Shuffling is a Drag" letter in the May edition. That, as well as recent advertisements placed in your magazine for a flatfoot instructional tape and for flatfooting shoes makes me think that there are still people around who want to preserve this traditional way of percussive dancing. I'd really love to see more about this wonderful individually expressive style of dancing that people of all ages can participate in and perhaps less about the modern precision team clogging competitions in which only a relative few are able to participate.
