People seldom think of the term "legacy" until they realize they are approaching the end of something. That is too bad. I wish more politicians would think about their legacy in the decisions they make in the here and now. Those who have invested their times and talents to building a clogging program can feel a need to preserve their efforts and build something that they can be proud of and that future dancers will benefit from. Thinking about your legacy doesn't mean that your clogging days are numbered. The Instructors and Dancers Directory in the back of the Double Toe Times is filled with "seasoned" cloggers who are kicking up their heels well into their 60's, 70's and 80's. Our bodies may tell us to slow down, but we can still let the Autumn of our clogging experience be a time to finally get around to those projects, those relationships and those goals that we put off for far too long. Who knows, you might even find time enroll in a dance class!


Like I said, Autumn is my favorite season. I keep looking out the window to see what the weather holds and keep digging through those boxes to clear out the clutter and enjoy some time with the treasures I have stumbled across that I had forgotten about having.

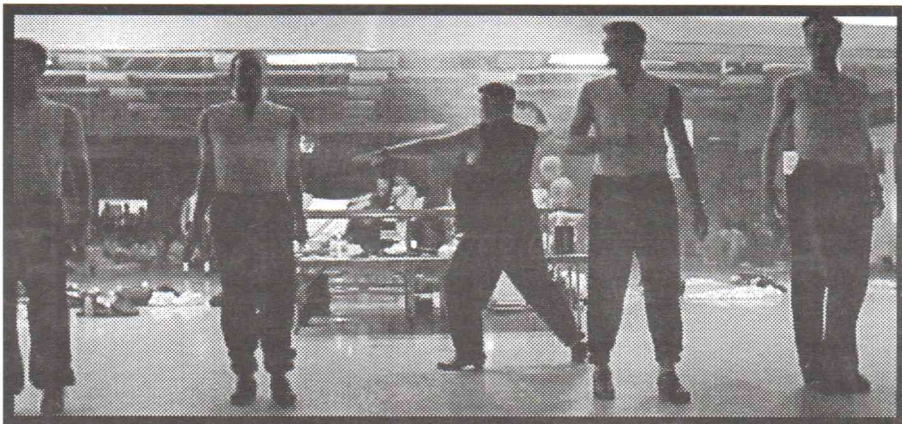
Cougar Clogging Classic Camp

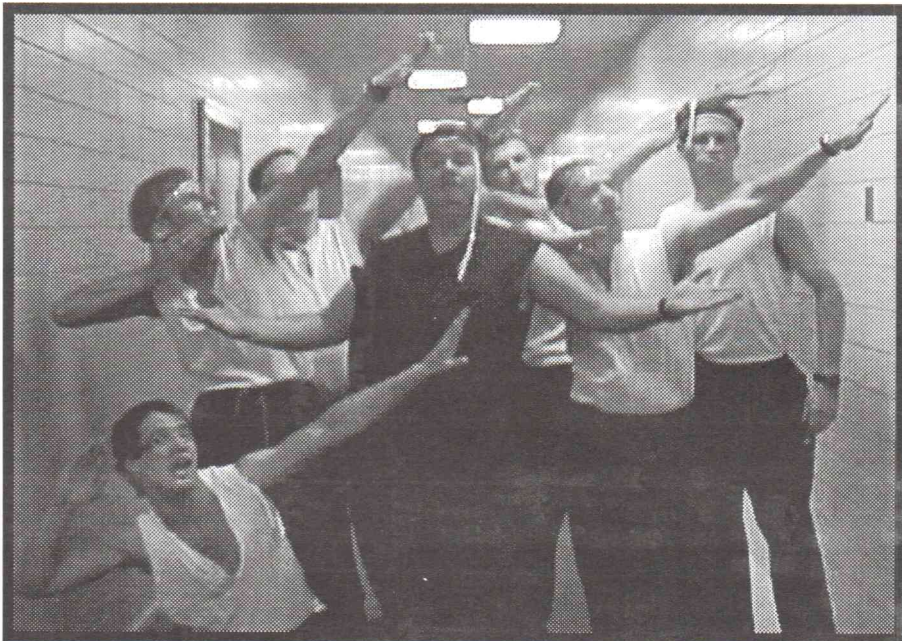

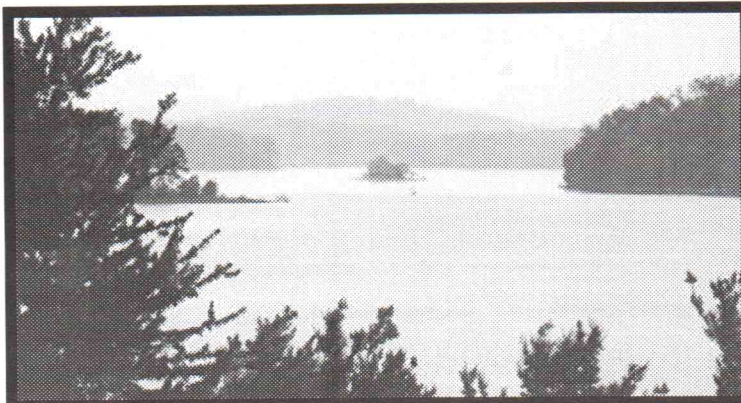
