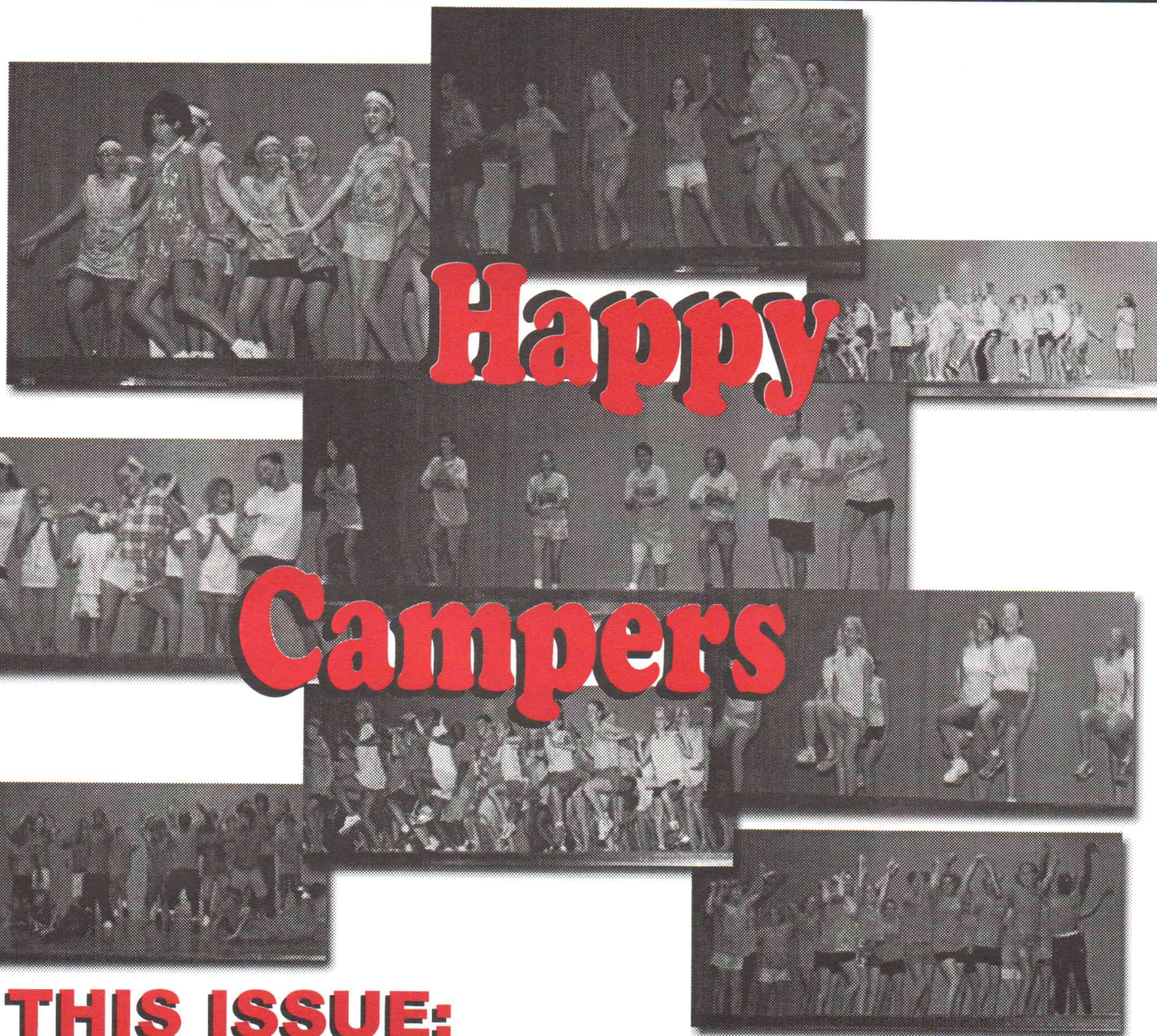

Batter Up!



Baseball is the only game growing up that I played even remotely well. My older brother and I joined the same little league team and I spent the weekends behind the plate while my mother stood in the stands screaming "Let him walk you"!

With the renewed fervor for baseball and October's series games, I spent some time reading about the sport of my childhood and reminiscing about the players that I idolized as a child. The legend of Ted Williams is still firm in my mind. Arguably the best hitter ever to play the game, Williams -- the left hander for the Boston Red Sox -- was always the standard to me by which players had to measure.

His batting average is still one of the highest in the game. I think if he hadn't been called to the war he would still have unbroken records. While his arrogance didn't always make him beloved to the fans, his dedication to the game rewarded them with over 20 years of great baseball.

Williams passed away in July and in reading about his career I discovered something that really inspired me. I knew that Ted Williams was obsessed with the mechanics of the game. He wrote a book in the early seventies called "The Science of Hitting" and I remember my little league coach quoting from it like a sports bible. What I didn't know was that Ted Williams had such a curiosity about the game and how to be his best that he would go to the factory where bats were made and ask to follow the entire process. Through understanding the dynamics of the bat he felt he could master it better. Williams dissected baseballs to understand the way they were made and spent countless hours using the knowledge to hone his skills at the plate. The fruit of the work came in his pure joy in hitting the ball. Ted Williams rarely struck out. He put forth the effort to understand the game to improve himself as a player. It wasn't in his contract. Other players thought he was a cocky fanatic, but no one can deny that Ted Williams left an important mark on his sport.

Now, what does this have to do with clogging? Think about it. How much do you know about the history of our dance? Do you know why taps are made the way they are to produce the sounds they make? You may find that investing time and energy into learning about clogging can give you the confidence and knowledge to reach your own personal goals.

I hope that future articles in the Double Toe Times can help provide information that will enrich your dance involvement. Step up to the plate, kick the dust off, and clog your *sox* off!

Emcee Adam Mowry of New York did a great job of keeping things moving and the judges, scorekeepers and music staff all worked very hard to make the long day a fun one for everyone.

Winners of the event qualified to participate in the C.C.A. Showdown of Champions to be held on January 24 - 27, 2003 in Knoxville, Tennessee. The champions took home some of the tallest trophies given in clogging, plus cash prizes and much-coveted Kentucky horse statuettes for category overall. Parrott's Custom Trophy was a sponsor of the event, and participants were delighted to take home an award that represents Kentucky.

The overall grand champion challenge team was Power and Precision, of Winchester, Kentucky, directed by Marlene Goodpaster. The overall grand champion amateur team was Hoosier Pride from Indiana, directed by Heather Grissom. Mike Curtis and Kelly Goodpaster of Kentucky were the overall duo/duet champions. Heather Grissom and Dustin Stephan of Indiana took home top challenge solo honors and Jessica Chapman and Aaron Hardin were awarded top amateur soloists.

Dancers from 8 states competed in the event, which has been held since 1986. Plans are underway for the 2003 event at a new location with two stages and lots of new ideas and opportunities for the dancers.

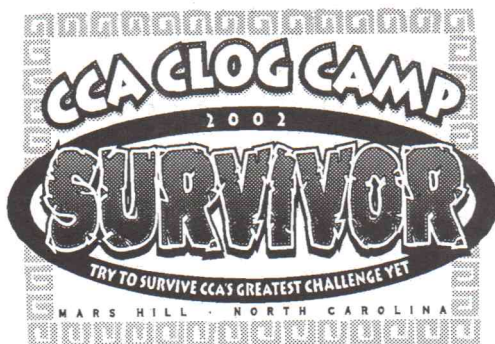
C.C.A. Organization Survives its First Kid's Clogging Camp

Florida Cloggers Tour Brazil as Part of International Festival

This summer, a clogging team from Gainesville, FL, was given the opportunity to perform for ten nights in Passo Fundo, Brazil. SoundStage Dance Company, under the direction of Andy Howard, demonstrated forms of traditional clogging and other forms of American song and dance. The event was managed by CIOFF which links traditional dance groups to festivals all over the world.

In Brazil, there were 11 other countries represented including: Argentina, Peru, Korea, Canada, Switzerland, Portugal, Spain, Amazonia (Brazil), Easter Island (Chile), Scotland, and many others. The countries gathered on stage under a big-top in front of sold-out audiences of 6,000 for each of ten nights. Director, Andy Howard, says that the highlight of the performances was on the final night. On that night, each country prepared a "goodbye" to the festival and incorporated it into their shows. Many teams did their most energetic numbers with their most elaborate costumes. The team from the United States taught one person from each of the other countries the Virginia Reel and had them all join on stage in their own traditional costumes. The effect of the union was very moving. The group also featured talented vocalist, Lynnette White, who enchanted audiences with American tunes such as Rocky Top and Walking After Midnight.

Reflecting on the experience, the team noted how the experience was different for the United States in comparison to other groups. Other groups learned about places unknown and new exciting cultures. The group from the United States learned about the traditions that many of their friends back home embrace. They often realized how fortunate they were to live in such a diverse country where many of these traditions are represented—particularly since most of the dancers attend the University of Florida.

Returning to the United States, SoundStage auditioned against 150 dance groups, bands, ensembles, and cultural groups for an opportunity to perform on stage with comedian Bill Cosby and an expected audience turn out of over 70,000. Only one group would be selected, and SoundStage took top honors. The group will be performing at "Gator Growl" on November

15th—the largest student-run production in the world which is in conjunction with the University of Florida homecoming. Tickets for the event can be purchased through Ticketmaster.

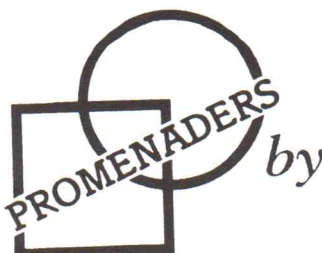

Clog Dancers Eligible for Presidential Fitness Award

The President's Challenge

"A strong vital America depends on physically fit Americans. Can we depend on you?"

The Presidential Sports Award program was developed by the President's Council on Physical Fitness & Sports in 1972 in conjunction with national sports organizations and associations. Its purpose is to motivate all Americans to become more physically active throughout life, and emphasizes regular exercise rather than outstanding performance. The program is administered by the Amateur Athletic Union (AAU).

The challenge of the Presidential Sports Award is to make a commitment to fitness through active and regular participation in sports and fitness activities. Earning the award means that you have put in time and effort to meet the challenge of personal fitness. The Award recognizes this achievement and the fact that you are part of a nationwide effort toward a healthier, more vital America. We hope that you encourage your family, friends, teammates and fellow employees to join in earning the Award.

Anyone age six (6) or older is eligible to participate in the Presidential Sports Award program. However, the completed fitness log(s) of all participants between the ages of 6-13 must be signed and verified by an adult. In addition, it is especially important that participants over the age of 40, who have not been active on a regular basis, undergo a thorough medical examination before undertaking any physical activity program.

The Award

You can earn the award for clog dancing, or for any one of the sports fitness activities listed in the program's brochure or on the website and you can earn as many Awards in as many categories as you like.

Clogging is eligible for the award under the category of *Dance*.

DANCE

Dance minimum 50 hours: Ballroom, Square, Folk, Round, Pattern, Clogging, Country Western or Dance Combination; no more than 1 1/2 hours credited daily.

To earn the Award:

Keep a record of your participation on the fitness log (if you need additional fitness logs, please make copies or attach separate sheets of paper).

When you have fulfilled the qualifying standards, send the completed and signed fitness log and \$8 per award for

The fitness log(s) of all participants age 13 or younger must be signed and verified by an adult.

Your Award Consists of the Following Items:

A certificate of achievement from President Bush personalized with your name and suitable for framing.

A letter of congratulations from the Co-Chairs of the President's Council printed on the inside of the frame mailer.

A blazer patch (embroidered emblem) signifying the sport or fitness activity in which you earn your award.

A frame mailer emblazoned with the Presidential Sports Award logo.

Note: To receive additional emblems, add \$4 to the award total for each additional emblem ordered and be sure to designate the category desired.

Family Fitness Award:

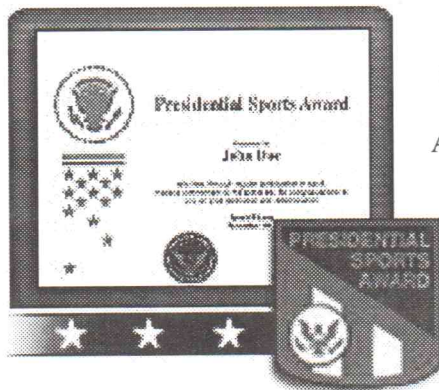
In addition to the standard award packet described, family members who participate in the program and earn awards together will receive an embroidered strip which reads Family Fitness and is designed to fit just above the award emblem. Family Fitness strips will be awarded each time a minimum of one parent/guardian and one child apply to receive awards at the same time and meet the program criteria. Each family member will receive one strip. There is no additional cost to receive the Family Fitness strip.

Qualifying Standards:

Now available for Ages 6 and Up

For maximum benefit, the criteria for each activity should be fulfilled within a four-month period. Exceptions will be made only for such things as (but not limited to) injury, illness, change for season, or individual medical history, and must be briefly explained when the participant applies to receive an award.

Individuals who participate in a variety of categories within a four-month period, but not enough to earn an award in any one category, should log their activity under either the Cross Training or Sports/Fitness categories. If requested, those who meet the requirements for Sports/Fitness can choose to receive an award for the category in which the majority of the 50 hours is accumulated.

USA National Dance List

American Instructor Missy Shinoski Follows the Lead of Australians in workign to Establish a list of Commonly Danced Routines to Make Workshop Dances More Fun

Have you ever been to a clogging workshop & attended the night dance, but felt like you did not know any of the songs being played? You are not alone. In the past, many of us knew the same dances whether you were from Georgia or Missouri or California. Take the routines to Rocky Top or High Horse, many of us still know the same dance to these songs, but there are still people out there who have never had the opportunity to learn these dances & may feel too shy to get up & follow along at a night dance. So, this is where the National Dance List can help out. After polling cloggers for several months, a list has been compiled with many clogging favorites. This list is being presented with hopes to put the "Fun" back in to our fun dances at or evening events. It was created to pick out several of the most popular routines & hope that if you go to GA, MO & CA that you could get up & dance "Rocky Top" with everyone else on the dance floor. One of the great things about clogging is the social aspect of the dance. How many other dance forms allow people to get on the dance floor & stand between a person from Tennessee & another person from Arizona & they can all three dance the same routine without ever meeting before that day? I believe clogging to be unique in this way.

To help get the list up & moving, the Top 35 songs (listed below) that were voted on have been selected & are being presented to all cloggers. The National CLOG Organization has offered their support in getting the information out through their website <http://www.clog.org/>. They are currently loading the cue sheets for the dances on the list we have so far & have several ready to download from the internet today. Also CLOG will be including the National Dance List at this year's convention in Atlanta on Thanksgiving weekend during the night dances. There may also be several workshops dedicated to teach some of the routines from the dance list.

The idea of a National Dance List is actually from Australia & New Zealand National Clogging Organizations. Missy Shinoski, of Kansas City, MO, had the

opportunity to teach in Australia a few years ago & was impressed by how well attended their night dances were at their conventions. Plus how many people were always on the floor & they all knew the majority of the same routines. This is because they have had a National Dance List for several years & they guarantee that during their night dances a certain percentage of the songs played will be from the National Dance List. The dance list also helps team directors with material to teach their dancers. Missy has been heading up the collecting of votes & finding cue sheets for the USA's list. Plus she has had great help from Steve Smith (KY), Matt Pearson (AZ), Kellee McChesney (FL), Jeff Driggs (WV) as well as many other cloggers around the country.

The USA's National Dance List is still in the building stages, but we wanted to get the ball rolling & see how well it is received. As with the other National Dance Lists of our clogging friends "down under," they are constantly updating & adding to their lists each year. They have 100 songs on their list & hold a contest during their convention to add one new choreographed routine each year.

The list is featured on the next page. Check it out and if you have any routines you would like to vote for, let Missy know at: kloghop@solve.net or write to: 12312 East 53rd Street Kansas City, MO 64133. Remember the name of the song, the artist & the choreographer's name. Also if you have the cue sheet for the dance that can also help. We are looking for the most popular routines, but in no way do we want to make people feel like the choreography selected for the National Dance List is the only acceptable routine for a certain song (but in order to present this list, there needs to be one choreographer chosen).

You should recognize several of the songs listed. Many of them are golden oldies. There is a plan to add current songs to the list later on. So don't be shy, let us know what songs you like to dance to! Remember this is a work in progress!

See the list on page 18 and let Missy know which songs you like and what others you would like to see. The more input the more dances we all will have to share when we travel to workshops.

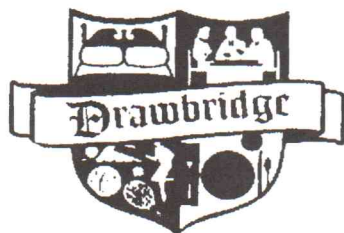

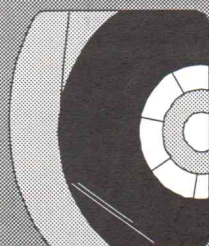

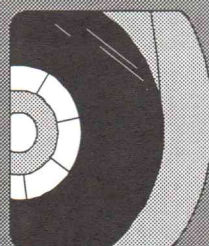
