The Fontana teaching rosters are a who's who of clogging: Tandy Barrett, Scotty Bilz, Charlie Burns, Bob Johnson, Peg McLerran, Bill Nichols, Bobbie and Dewey Paul, Ralph Pierce, Boo Ruch, Steve Smith, and so many, many more that made amazing contributions to the clog dance.

I have heard from so many cloggers that are excited about going back and can't wait to recapture the spirit and fun of those "good ole days."

I was talking to a group of cloggers at a recent workshop and the talk turned to the "new generation" of dancers how many choices they had and the number of events and organizations and options available to them. One person said that they don't see the enthusiasm about clogging from the new dancers that they remember when they first began. I disagreed. 



America's Clogging Hall of Fame

Two are Honored at the Stompin' Ground in Maggie Valley, NC in October

Each year, The America's Clogging Hall of Fame organization inducts worthy individuals into it's Hall of Fame at the Stompin' Ground in Maggie Valley, North Carolina. These inductees have been clogging for at least 25 years and have been a positive influence on the preservation of the dance. This year, on the

last weekend of October, two more persons were extended this prestigious honor:

Ellen and Eugene Ratcliffe

Ellen and Eugene Ratcliffe were born in Highland County in the western part of Virginia near Monterery. They learned to dance as young teenagers at community square dances. They eventually married and settled in Monterery where they continued to dance wherever they could.

In 1980 she joined the Piney Mountain Cloggers in Millboro, Virginia under the direction of Jackie Plecker. In 1985 together they formed the High Country Cloggers in Monterery and began teaching clogging and old time square dancing. This group stayed together for ten years as a teaching, exhibition and a competition team.

In 1995 they formed a new group called the Highland County Hoedowners and have continued to teach clogging and square dancing in and around Highland County.



competitions in Maggie Valley during our Spring and Fall Festivals. Both were picked for the ACHF All American Team in 1995.

Mr. Cleo McCall

Mr. Cleo McCall was a free style dancer that you simply don't find anymore. He has been considered one of the best. Some say he never missed a beat.

Sue Ledford Reese explains this inductee simply as a dancer that performed "with the crying of the fiddle and the shuffling of his feet. He had lighting in his heels and a patter in his voice as he called the set while he winged his way through the figures. He kept the set moving and his voice was as clear as a bell." She added that he danced with humility, with his head held high and his shoulders lay back, you knew he was in charge when you were on the dance floor.

This gentleman started an exhibition team at Helen's Barn and every Wednesday, Friday and Saturday nights the team would perform to a packed house. He was also instrumental in helping organize the "Hillbilly Day" that was held each July in the early 1950's. Because of him, several well-known teams would put on performances during the day to the delight of the several thousand visitors who had gathered along Main Street in downtown Highlands, North Carolina.

The memory of his dancing is a captivating one. With his unforgettable two-tone, black and white wing tip shoes, you could spot him a country mile. With his shoes and a smile he gave his audiences their money's worth. Cleo McCall was as unforgettable as the years of your youth.

His award was proudly accepted by his brother, James McCall, along with several family members.

America's Clogging Hall of Fame

America's Clogging Hall of Fame is dedicated to the preservation of the old time square dance and clogging. ACHF calls the Stompin' Ground in Maggie Valley, North Carolina, its home.

ACHF was founded in 1981 by Dan and Sandy Angel for the sole purpose of honoring our past

leaders and providing a place for dancers from all walks of life to come together and dance.

ACHF is a rallying organization for clogging teams all over the world. The organization sanctions a network of dance competitions where teams and dancers can qualify to compete in a grand champion dance-off each October in Maggie Valley. A team placing 1st or 2nd in one of these sanctioned competitions qualifies to compete at this dance-off, 2 fun filled days of dancing and competing. The first dance-off was held in 1984.

In ACHF events, there are 19 sanctioned categories which consist of nine traditional couple categories, five open couple categories and five other categories. A panel of five judges and a rules official officiate at the dance off.

In addition to team categories ACHF features a male & female solo competition in which grand champion winners compete against each other for the Grand Ole Opry award. The male & female winners are featured in a performance on the stage of the world-famous Grand Ole Opry in Nashville, Tennessee.

In addition to the October championship dance-off we host a workshop and solo competition each April. Instruction is given in traditional as well as contemporary styles of clogging. Last year we had an attendance of about 500 dancers. In the evening, after the workshops, a dance at the Stompin' Ground is held with plenty of clogging and old time square dancing.

ACHF also chooses an All-American team each year. This is done through a nominating and selection process in which 24 of our best dancers are selected. These dancers are showcased at the dance-off in October.

Scholarships are also given to at least three deserving students entering college.

ACHF is a great organization for all ages from all walks of life who united together in one common goal of preserving our traditional dances. Membership in ACHF is \$15 per year. Membership includes a quarterly news letter as well as discounts on your subscription to the *Double Toe Times*. Membership also allows free entry into the spring workshop and fall festival.





The Secret Power of Music

I think the thing that draws most dancers to clogging is the love of music. And clogging feels *so connected* to the music whether you are free styling or doing a choreographed routine.

Since I had no classes over the summer this year, I spent some of the time reading and found some very interesting books on music and dance. One of those books "The Secret Power of Music" by David Tame is quite eye-opening and especially interesting to those of us who have so much of our time invested in dancing or listening to music.

Music is a force affecting all who hear it, not only as an art but as a power. Music has the power to change our mood, relaxing you soothingly or jarring your nerves, even regularizing our heartbeat. Researchers are beginning to expect the extent of the influence of music on our lives.

I have always felt the effects of music on my state of mind.
Growing up in a house with music as a constant backdrop has connected my life to music in a very positive way.

My father as a dairy worker needed music playing to block out the noise of everyday living going on as he went to bed at the early hour of 6pm. His choice of music every night was "ole time" country, gospel and The Grand Old Opry. If it was turned off he awoke and put it right back on. I guess that is where my love of country and bluegrass music began. I can still hear those ads for a dozen baby chicks, Martha White flour or Bibles by mail like it was yesterday.

As we arrived in the kitchen every morning my music loving mother had the radio on to whatever was popular at the time. From "How Much is That Doggy in The Window?" to Elvis and eventually The Beatles.

She taught my brothers and me to dance the box step waltz for those first dance dates, the jitterbug and even the Charleston. We just couldn't stand still listening to good dance music.

There is an axiom which declares that 'as in music, so in life'. In ancient China, an Emperor journeyed eastward in the second month of the year to check upon the kingdom

to insure order. Not by auditing books or observing the state of life by the populace or interviewing regal officials.

No... in ancient China it was considered to be much more revealing, accurate and scientific to test the nation by testing the exact pitches of their notes of music!

They had the eight kinds of ancient Chinese musical instruments brought before them and played by musicians to check the five notes of the ancient Chinese music scale. If the Emperor discovered that the instruments of the different territories were all different from each other he considered the conclusion that they would lose their unity and begin to squabble. If the music he heard began to sound immoral he would expect their morals to follow suit unless the music was corrected.

Wow, that's something to ponder, isn't it? Kind of a "Footloose" way of thinking?

Over the passing of the centuries the details of the ancient mysticisms of music were lost or

forgotten. The belief that music played a role in determining mans moral nature took on a more earth-bound rational.

Cyril Scott, an eminent twentieth-century composer noted his belief that music shapes consciousness and society. An innovation in musical style has invariably been followed by

an innovation in politics and morals.

Example.....the decline of music in Egypt and Greece was followed by the complete decline of their civilizations themselves. In places, as in China, where musical styles were limited, adherence to tradition is quite noti ceable.

We all are well aware of the presence of music for religious ceremony, as background for movies to change the mood of the storyline and even in sporting events. Everything seems to have a real connection to music. Subliminally, even changing our feelings unknowingly.

There is so much more to music and dance than just a pastime and it is so much a part of our lives that we should look deeper into this "secret power of music." I highly recommend reading this book for some very interesting information on music and its effects on us. But don't even think about sitting out a good clogging number. Get on your feet andkeep dancin'!


