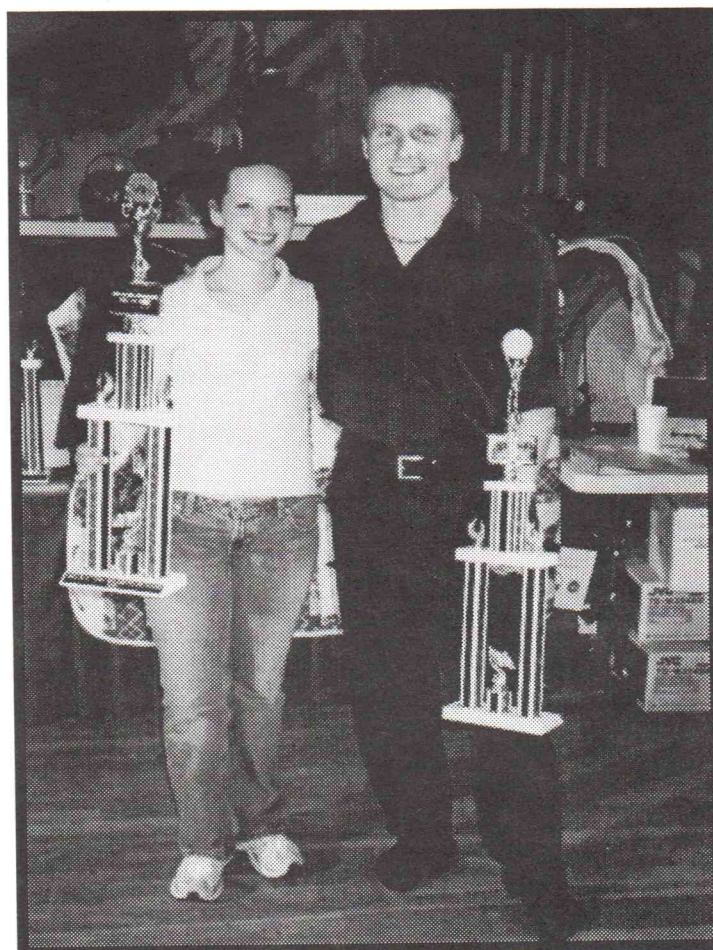
A.C.H.F. Grand Champion Dance-Off held at Maggie Valley Stompin' Ground

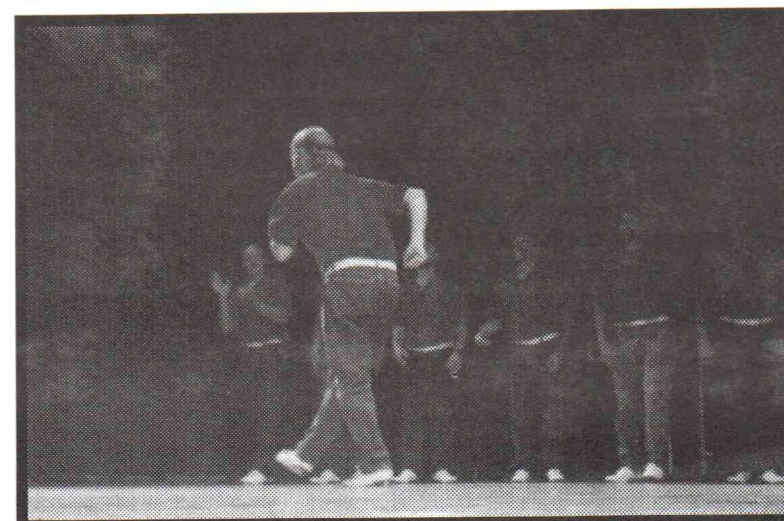

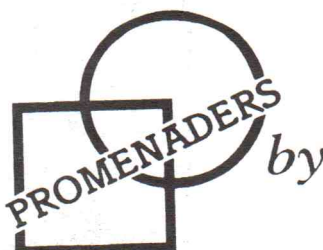

Success 101 - Hints on being a Successful Teacher

Your students worship you. Don't be surprised. You're doing something that they only dream of doing. You're a fabulous dancer in a great and magical occupation. Want to be successful? Don't burst their bubble. Support their fantasy...

Tips To Success

- **Dress the part.** Look sharp! Don't dress like the average Joe or Jane, dress better. Remember, in your students' eyes you're a movie star! Dress ordinary and your students will think of you as, well, um, ordinary. Burst!
- **Smell good. Smell fresh.** You're doing an aerobic activity so this may be tough to achieve, but nobody likes to take lessons from a smelly or grimy teacher. Besides, to support those stiff hourly fees you need to support their fantasy that you're super-human!
- **Arrive for your lessons on time!** Want to act like a big shot doctor and make your clients wait in the waiting room for half an hour? Well, do you know anyone that actually likes their doctor? OK. I've proved my point. Here's a policy I like:

- **Students** arriving late pay for the missed time anyway. (A student 15 minutes late for a one hour lesson gets the remaining 45 minutes but pays for a full hour.)
 - **Teacher** arriving late (by 10 minutes or more) - balance of lesson is free.
 - **Exception:** You've had a relationship with your student for a long-time. If this long time student is late once in a blue moon and you're not booked following his/her lesson, and they are also available, run it over. But you should still honor your side of the agreement (free lesson.)
 - **Be reachable.** Get a cell phone. You'll book more lessons and when people need to rearrange their time, they'll be able to. Want fewer lessons? That's easier... be hard to reach.
 - **Get business cards.** Scratching your name and number on a napkin just doesn't impress like it use to. As a performer and idol of many, unless you look like Freddy Krueger, I'd highly suggest **photo** business cards. For only \$20 VistaPrint will supply you with 250 color photo business cards. You can't beat that!
 - **Marketing/Advertising** — thought of as expensive — fortunately, advertising for dance teachers needn't be.
 - Internet:
 - Find free dance directory sites to list yourself on. Go for the free ones.
 - Get your own WEB site.
 - If you're serious about your profession, get a real one, not <http://www.geocities.com/whatever/myfreesite.com>. It's less expensive than you think.
 - Start a link exchange program.
 - Create a Dance Links page and get people to link to your site in exchange for your link to theirs.
 - Teach group classes or special workshops on a regular basis.
 - Travel to a variety of studios in different areas to teach your lessons.
 - Perform (for free if necessary) at local dance events.
 - Write articles for dance magazines.
 - Become involved with the local dance community, such as volunteering at USABDA.
- In advertising there's no *magic bullet* - there's no single activity that works 100% for you. The more you do of a *variety* of things, however, generally the greater success you'll achieve.
- **Listen to your students.** Teach them the dances they are interested in, not the ones you like! Teach them what they want to learn. Although you may know better, and you might provide some sage advice on what they should work on, make sure you listen to your students and give your students what they want.
 - **Keep notes on your students!** Keep a brief log of what each lesson has covered. Your student will really feel taken care of and trust that you're concerned about their progress.
 - **Give your students homework.** End each lesson with a verbal summary of what was covered and a homework assignment! Write it down in your log. Suggest that your student keep a log as well. Start each new lesson with a review of the previous one and a discussion of their *homework*. Your students will feel you're truly interested in their long term development.
 - **Keep an address book.** In case you need to get in touch to reschedule a lesson, you should maintain an address book with all your students addresses, telephone numbers (home/work/cell), and e-mail. And always carry it with you, of course. Also get their birth date (for next item.)
 - **Keep in touch.** Send *all* your students, past and present, a **birthday card** each year with a personal note showing that you care about them. Examples "You've made such great progress in your dancing this year! I'm so proud of you!" or "I haven't seen you for a long time. I hope you're doing well!". A quarterly newsletter about yourself is another great way to remind your non-regular students that you're still alive and dancing.
