

# Dancing In Your Heart



ow many times have you performed at a show to find folks comment to you after, "I could never do that, but I sure wish I had tried when I was younger.?" How many of your friends that don't understand our passion for a dance that keeps us in classes a couple of nights a week and on the road for workshops and competitions nearly every weekend will tell you they would try dancing if they had the time?

My Grandmother, Nancy James, is in her eighties now and in a care home in Florida. I had no greater cheerleader for my clogging efforts than she. While Granny always knew the jig step and could shuffle around the floor to her precious old-time and country music, whenever took the time to take a class in clogging. I used to think that she had missed so much but not trying to learn more steps. All my efforts to get her to try it brought a grin and a line, "Honey, I couldn't do that like you do in a million years." My family had squared danced as long as I can remember and both of my parents and a couple of my brothers ended up taking clogging lessons, but I was the only one that stayed with it through inter-In my mind, I thought I was the only one that had a mediate classes. genuine interest in the dance. Granny never missed a chance to see me perform and even went as a reporter for the local newspaper and a member of the West Virginia Silver haired legislature to see local groups perform and take pictures and do a story.

I often wondered why a woman who was fit enough to dance and loved it so much wouldn't want to learn more steps. As I began to teach workshops and travel I noticed so many parents and Grandparents that were at every event and beamed when their kids danced. The teacher in me wanted to pull them all into a side room for a quick beginners session.

The more I am around dance, the more I learn how it can be an expression of ourselves. I joke that the longer I clog the less I clog. My teaching style has gone from "watch this" to "let me tell you how to do this." Someone once said "You can dance anywhere, even if only in your heart." Looking back, I realize the joy in granny's eyes whenever she saw clogging made her heart dance like she had won a grand championship. The support of our friends and family for our activity makes them dancers on our *team*. While they may not tap the floor along side us, they are dancing with us in their hearts and deserve our gratitude and support. Be sure to acknowledge those who dance with your group in their hearts.

series of articles on running a dance studio and keeping your books in order, plus features by many of clogging's most respected instructors on how to choose music, choreograph, market yourself and more.

# Choreo 1, 2, 3

I went upstairs after we talked and started thinking about what you said about seeing and hearing footwork in your mind when listening to a piece of music. Here are some things I have learned in the process of writing routines to songs I like:

- 1. The music has to MOVE you.
- 2. Count the beats in each section of the song from beginning to end.
- 3. Determine the verses, choruses, instrumental, and an ending if there is an obvious one.
- 4. Label the sections A, B, C, etc.
- 5. When you hear a dance step to a particular part of the song don't worry about whether it's the beginning, middle or end of the song. Seeing the footwork to that part of the song will free your mind and emotions to feel footwork to the rest of the song. It's sort of like doing a jigsaw puzzle. You'll fill an eight count, then a 32 count and suddenly you are done. 6. Lots of times you will have what are known as "breaks" that may be 2,3, 4 or even 6 beats and are different from the main song. They are like bridges that take you from one part of the routine to another. Just treat them like pieces of the whole puzzle and fill them in when the right step comes to mind.

- 7. Don't choreo against the beat, style sound or feeling of the music. Remember, your feet have now become another instrument and you are adding them to the song like an additional soundtrack.
- 8. As a general rule, don't turn against the general direction your footwork is already carrying you.
  9. If you wish your routine to be accepted and danced, then choreograph at the level of the cloggers in your area.
- 10. After you SET the footwork, dance the routine with your clogging shoes on if you haven't already. It is quite possible that it will make you want to change a step here or there. If you change it, don't worry about it. Sometimes it comes easy, other times its like a baby -- it takes a little labor to bring it off.

I don't just sit down and say I am going to choreograph to a song suspect that for most of us it just happens. I am a car dancer! I play music going to and from work and the store and listen for a song that "hooks" me. I've done a lot of choreography behind the wheel of my van. I'm a good driver, too!





# Paducah Working with Major Clogging Organizations to Establish Museum

Paducah, city of quilts, riverboats and railroad locomotives, will add a new label to its resume: city of cloggers.

The National Clogging Hoedown Council, a division of the National Clogging Organization Inc.; America's Clogging Hall of Fame; and the Clogging Champions of America decided to locate the museum in Paducah during the National

Clogging Convention held in late November in Atlanta.

The Paducah-McCracken County Convention and Visitors Bureau made the announcement public in January.


Details on the museum's location and how it will be funded are being discussed. The National Clogging Organization Inc. will hold instructor workshops and regional competitions in Paducah on a regular basis, said Rosemarie Steele, CVB marketing director.

National and international competitions are also being planned.

Ray and Jennifer Hattaway, who represent the three national clogging organizations, visited Paducah in January to meet with local representatives and look for a home, as they plan to relocate to Paducah.

The Hattaways also participated in an official announcement at at the Paducah Parks Department, during rehearsals for the Quick Step Cloggers, a local clog dance group.

Paducah's initial contact with the National Clogging Organization Inc. was made last February



by Tom Erwin, owner of Annie's Horse Drawn Carriages, at the Spring Fling clogging convention in Gatlinburg, Tenn.

Said Erwin: "Since clogging is such an important part of our heritage in America, (we) felt that a museum would be a great idea to pursue."

Plans are underway to determine funding sources and MaryAnn Moreland of California and other clogging leaders are working to gather info and support for the museum.


# The 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Mid-Winter Hot Dog Clog Hog

The first thing one sees as you go past the big grinding wheel is the huge gambrel roof barn. It is so big one does not even notice the out of use little ticket house structure one passes as he drives down the plowed driveway.

Getting out of your vehicle and walking up the walk to the entrance at 8 am, one can't help but notice the 30 or so sheep in a fence to the right. They are covered with long wool which in turn is covered slightly with the snow. They are baaing loudly and will do it even more when you yourself baa in mockery back to them. A couple of Shetland ponies, with winter coats long, follow you as you go up the walk. The ponies are on one side and you are on the other side of the fence. Across their fenced in area is a small vard for the big work horses. They stand or move slowly around like giants that they are.

Entering the 'Gathering Place', an arts and entertainment center stuck out in the woods of nowhere, one is struck by the size of the room inside. 70' by 120' in size, chandeliers hang in two rows high from the ceiling. To the left at the south end of the barn is a big stage constructed for cloggers. You have now entered the Mid-Winter Hot Dog Clog Hog. 'Mid-Winter' is the

time of the year. 'Hot Dog' in the Appalachians mind is a fancy dancer. 'Clog' is the type of dance and 'Hog' means a lot of it.




The event has grown each under the leadership of founder Jan Lee and is staffed by her Biggest Little City Cloggers from Reno.
