ompetition. The mere mention of the word makes some cloggers shudder and exhilarates others. Ask those who have competed in clogging and some will tell you it has been the greatest experience of theirs lives. Others will say it divided their team and shattered their confidence.

An issue dedicated to competition may seem like a waste to those who do not enter contests. You will find that the tools necessary to prepare a team for competition are the same ones that can bring out your best in every performance venue. Like it or not, we are all judged — by our audiences. Competitions may use scoresheets and offer trophies and rankings, but our audiences judge us by their response to our shows. We owe it to them, and to ourselves, to be the best we can be.

John F. Kennedy said, "All of us do not have equal talent, but all of us have an equal opportunity to develop our talent." Luckily, clogging has created an extensive network of classes, workshops and dance opportunities that allow every dancer to develop their skills and reach their own dance goals – whether they include competition or not.

Often, competition can be the catalyst to motivate dancers to practice at performance level. It can foster a spirit within a group and give them a will to excel. In the end, regardless of the outcome of the competition experience, those attributes will remain. Too often we focus on winning. We all know that winning is the ultimate goal of competition, but if your team is not strong enough to handle losing, then they won't know how to handle winning in its proper perspective. I look back at my own competition days in the early 1980's and what I remember most is the experience itself and the people I met and friends I made. Sure, exceptional victories stand out in a person's memory, but in the end, the opportunity to be a part of that time is what endures. Listen to a group of competition veterans and you'll hear more stories about funny things that happened at competition than "who beat who."

Use the articles in this issue to help you strive to be the best clogger you can be.




C.C.A. Showdown of Champions



Preparing for Competition Day

by Joyce E. Pennington

PREPARATION— Have a special "run through" at home before you depart for clogging competition. Practice entering from both sides of the performance floor in case that your entry point may change. Do a taped critique for your team or have a local director come in for a "trade out" to critique each other's teams before competition.

GOALS—Sit down with your team for a question and answer time prior to the first clogging competition to answer questions they might have. This can set aside any anxiety or confusion about the contest day itself and allow them to concentrate totally on their own personal performance. Set the goals together that you want them to achieve. Never confuse "winning" with the positive experience you want them to have. Teach them to win joyously and to lose gracefully. Remember that you are only there to get the objective opinions of the judges and do not always expect to agree with them. With such a variety of philosophies in the clogging world, it is important to take in the feedback from everyone to build a stronger team. If they are not challenged, they will not learn.

SPACING—At some clogging competitions, you may

spacing—At some clogging competitions, you may have the opportunity to spend a few minutes on the floor for 'blocking' or 'spacing' of the routines. Do not confuse this for practice time or memory work. The formations of each routine should be numbered and 'rehearsed' prior to clogging competition day so that if the time is allowed, you can take the floor and go through each of your team routine formations within the time that you are allowed.

PARENTS— Meet with your parents or send home a memo to them about the important details of the clogging competition (date, time, where to sit, admission price, wear team colors, spirit signs, etc.). Never assume that they will automatically know these things. It would also help if they had a copy of the goals you have set for your team as well as a copy of the awards explanation for the clogging competition attending. This way they can cheer louder to know that the team has reached their goals and the meaning of their award.

DRESSING— Expect to have VERY LITTLE SPACE FOR DRESSING!!! Let's face it: If the clogging competition is located at an auditorium or school, you can be assured that your dressing space will be limited so plan accordingly. This does not mean that the space can be hoarded by the first team that arrives. Show good sportsmanship and only

use the dressing room when you are changing. Take your team and their belongings back out to the arena (if possible) to observe and learn from other teams. Keep your belongings together in the back of the space with a parent to watch them and don't drape clothes over a seat that a spectator could be using to see your performance.

TAPES— It is imperative to have a good quality tape or cd recording to get the best results from the sound system at clogging competition. The quality and dynamics of the music recording can determine the energy level that your team produces. Never use your performance cassette for practice as it can stretch or damage the tape. Never practice at a clogging competition site in the hallways as the sound carries into the performance area itself. By the time you arrive at clogging competition, your team should be prepared for their routines.

ITINERARY / LISTS— Type out an itinerary for the day so that each participant knows where to be, when, and what to wear. Your new members will especially need to have everything spelled out for them to lessen their fears. If you have several days planned for your team, it will be even more important to let them know the activities that will take place. Type out a checklist for the items to bring with them to competition. A forgotten costume can destroy the day for you and the team.

PICTURES— Make sure that you have assigned someone to take photographs or slides of the clogging competition including a group photo at the end with their awards. These will preserve valuable memories for their banquet or spring show.

BEFORE DEPARTURE—Have the managers or assigned parents go back to check the dressing area for items that may have been left behind and to pick up all trash left by your group.


HAVE FUN— Don't forget that clogging competition should be fun for everyone. Make sure that your nerves are in check so that your stress doesn't spread to the rest of the group. Make clogging competition a motivating experience, not a dreadful one! Plan to have a pizza party, tour an amusement park, go shopping, have ice cream sundae's or some kind of enjoyable activities for your team.

Planning Ahead for Competition

The preparation for a clogging competition season should actually begin in the end of the current competition season when the director is planning the activities for the year. In choosing the contest or

contests the team attends, they will make a strategy of how their team can achieve their greatest level of success. For the seasoned contest team, the director will choose the contests that will each be a stepping stone for the team's personal improvement.

For a first time participant, it is usually best to start by taking your team to observe a contest. There are many "seasoned" contest teams that know what to expect and how to approach the first contest where the beginner will need some preparation. Plan to stay for most of the day and especially through the awards so that they will know what to expect from going to and from dressing areas to sitting together in the stands and having a team representative retrieve the trophies during awards. These are small details that can make the difference in your team's confidence level going into the event.

Once the contest or contests have been selected for your team, here are some steps to take during the season that will take you toward the best results: A Year Ahead: Choose your contest(s). If you are new to contests, choose one that is possibly early in the competition year to give you and your team a chance to go to several contests to observe. Choose a contest for your team that will give them a chance to see other outstanding teams yet not so large to overwhelm them for their first experience. If your team is seasoned, you will probably choose two to three contests. The first one will be considered the "ice-breaker" to test your routines for effectiveness. The second will be to measure the improvement from the first. The third will be to vault your team's confidence to its highest level. Ideally, give your team at least two weeks between each contest to polish and correct any errors from the previous event. If you will be traveling out of town to compete, your parents should be consulted to assist in fund-raising efforts to offset expenses, as well as submitting to various travel agencies for travel bids. Beware of always choosing the lowest bid. There may be hidden expenses that may come up after your arrival. Five to Six Months Prior to Competition: Select your music, props, costumes as well as set up any outside choreographers. This is a most critical point in that these decisions will set the whole tone for your team's experience at contest. In selecting the music or theme, it is critical not to choose a tune that may be outdated or redundant by the time it is performed. If it is over used at a contest, it may draw a negative response from the crowd. If you are using an outside choreographer, allow him/her to be consulted in order

that they may have valuable input. Make sure to take the time and effort to have your music professionally recorded. Too often teams spend thousands of dollars on costumes and pennies on poor quality tapes. A good tape or cd professionally recorded with edits will cost between \$20 to \$50. If your parents are making the costumes or if you are having them professionally made, have them draw or make up several designs. It can also be helpful to have one of your team members "test" a prototype for its performability. Sometimes the greatest costume ideas have fallen apart on the floor during the performance or at the dress rehearsal when it is too late. Choose costume designs that are simple and effective. Remember that they will have to be transported easily as well as changed in an out several times during the course of a day. Some teams will use a basic costume and accessorize with different overlays, vests or belts that completely change the look for each routine but make changes quick and efficient. An easy costume change can lower your team's stress level at contest.

Three to Four Months Prior to Competition: Depending on the length of your competition season. It is best to start teaching the routines early. Remember that your team may have three to four to learn and perfect and your dancers may have double that many (including solos, and duos, duets or show duets). You and your cloggers will certainly want to choreograph some of your contest numbers and the team may want to choose a favorite instructor from a workshop or camp to do one or two routines. This will give your routine presentation a variety. Make sure to begin with the most challenging routine as it will require the most memory time and polishing. Allow time for learning and basic polishing before you go on to the next routine. It is advisable to encourage your dancers to schedule their own rehearsal time for their duos and duets separate from the team's practice time and that the team events are the first priority. This would be a good time to start looking into travel arrangements and accommodations for the events.

One to Two Months Before Competition: After all routines are taught, it is time to polish or "fine tune" the routines. Work on making all movements and patterns clean, aand all steps and hand movements precise. If you have mirrors or lines on the floor to mark positions, turn the team around or try a dress rehearsal in a different location to make them ready for a performance outside of their studio "comfort zone." Prior to the first contest, hold a special "show off" for parents and friends that will be your dress rehearsal. This will give the team an audience as well as an opportunity to perform in costume and preview



any technical problems in advance. This would also be a good opportunity to have one or two critique judges come to give them scores and comments on their routines. Have any solos or duos perform also. Make sure to time each routine to make sure that they fall into the time limit and insure that the tempo is correct. This "show off" should take place at least two weeks prior to the first contest so there will be ample time to make any necessary changes.

Contest Day Preparation: Just before you go to the clogging competition, make sure to let your parents as well as team members know what you expect from them. It is always great to have a large showing of parents at a contest and many will wear special shirts or jackets to display their support in team colors. Type up a general quideline sheet that will tell the location of the contest, times, any 'house rules' about dressing areas or food, and special instructions from you, the director. Make a checklist of items that your team members will need to have with them at contest. Some extras besides their costumes: bobby pins, hair spray, safety pins, rubber bands, water bottle, whole fruit, crackers, sleeping bag or pillow (if a long day), zip lock bags, walkman (to practice on own). Encourage them to leave all valuables at home. Most contests will not offer a completely secure dressing area. Make sure that your team has cleaned their

dressing area before departure. If you area going out of town, be more specific with your guidelines and have an itinerary mapped out with plenty to keep everyone busy.

Your team can have a very positive experience through competitions. There are many contests that will provide them with a quality, positive and rewarding experience. Make sure that you have covered your plans well and that you are confident in yourself as well as your team.

How to Beat the **Scoresheet**

Too many times, we as directors are guilty of allowing all of the wrong factors to effect our judgment when choosing routines and music for clogging competitions. This bad judgment continues when we prepare and polish the routine without ever analyzing how the judge will be able to score and what they will not be able to score.

From a judges point of view, they may truly LIKE one routine better than another and the "likable" routine scores less. Why? Because the score sheet did not allow them to score in the areas that appealed (Continued on Page 16)

to them. Many times you will find an average routine, without a lot of excitement, may outscore a more advanced routine, simply because it was technically correct and met the requirement of the scoresheet without a great number of step, formation or precision deductions.

Before you ever set foot in the record store, the costume catalog, or hire a choreographer, you need to try to see the score sheet by which your team will be judged. Look carefully at each category on the sheet and their point values and begin to visualize the routine through the judge's eyes. If you plan to attend more than one contest with more than one sanctioning organization, make sure to request EACH scoresheet as they will most likely differ slightly from contest to contest.

It is even a good idea to speak to one of the competition coordinators, in advance of your choreography, to find out what their general judging philosophies are and what areas they will want to emphasize with their judges.

Many other factors play a roll as well, including the facility where the contest is held: lighting, color of floor, color of background, level where the judges are seated, angle where the judges are seated. Make sure to check these factors prior to ordering costumes and creating formations and patterns. You would not want to choose a silver costume for a gray floor, nor a yellow costume on a yellow wood floor. If the judges are sitting low, your formations may not show up effectively.

When polishing the routine in the final stages, make sure to look at each category on TECHNIQUE, PRESENTATION, CONTENT, and PRECISION. Look at their point values as well as the individual comments. Make sure to see the finished product through the judges eyes. Go through a 'mock 'judging process with your team's performance video.

These steps will assure higher scores at contest with greater effect for your routines.

Winning in Solo Freestyle Competion


• Choose a costume that is right for you. Get some advise on what will be the most flattering not only for your figure, but suits the format. A show costume may be beautiful but may distract from the task at hand in solos... being the best clogger on the floor that day. Choose a color that is

flattering for your skin and hair coloring. If you have never been "color analyzed", check with your local beauty consultant. It could be a move in a positive direction not only for your solo, but for you, as well.

- Make sure to choreograph variety in your solo with floor coverage, level changes and change of pace. Do not try to do steps that you cannot execute properly. This will only cause point deductions. If you are unable to do any difficult steps, work hard to do your solo with as much energy, smoothness, personality and expression as you can with the steps you know. Being a winning soloist is a combination of many factors, not just "trick" steps.
- Invite your hardest critiques to critique your solo. This is when your Mother may not always know best (they will always think that you are perfect!). The more input you have on your solo prior to competition, the more chances you have to improve your performance.
- Read the rules carefully and make sure that you have followed all the guidelines. A good example is Traditional Solo. The rules disallow non-Appalachian styles like Canadian and tap, yet many good dancers enter and do double-doubles or tap syncopations and then cannot understand why they did not get called back.
- Make sure your shoes are clean and broken in.
 Competition day is not the best time to try to break in a new pair. You want to be focused on your performance.
- Make sure that your hair is secured away from your face. It does not always have to be all pulled back but should be functional for your routine.
 Secure all accent pieces and hair pins. Fallen costume pieces become distracting to the judges and audience.
- After the contest, take time if possible to ask the judges their opinion on your performance, then watch your solo on video and review it with the judge's responses in mind. This will better help you see your routine through the judge's eyes.
- Keep everything in perspective. Accept the challenge, yet be ready to lose gracefully. Nothing "stinks" worse than a poor loser. Remember that each experience of competition will build a stronger person inside, only if YOU perceive to make it happen. Remember, if it is to be, it is up to ME."




